RUTGERS SOFTBALL TRAVELS TO PENN STATE

Marking its final regular season road trip of the year, the Rutgers softball team travels to Penn State for a three-game series from April 21-23.

RU'S LAST TIME OUT

- Rutgers (11-29, 2-10 Big Ten) fell in its series at Iowa, 1-2, picking up a 2-0 victory in the finale.
- Senior **Shayla Sweeney** registered her third complete-game shutout of the season, allowing only four hits and striking out four batters in the win.
- Freshman **Taryn Atlee** sent in the winning runs with a two-RBI double in the top of the seventh.
- Atlee was named a top 25 finalist for the 2017 Schutt Sports/NFCA National Freshman of the Year award. Atlee ranks third in the Big Ten with a .410 batting average and second with 55 hits and four triples.

SCOUTING PENN STATE

- Penn State (18-25, 4-10 Big Ten) is coming off a doubleheader sweep of Bucknell on Wednesday night. Over the weekend, the Nittany Lions were swept by Nebraska in Lincoln.
- Marlaina Laubach leads the pitching staff with a 3.02 ERA in 109.0 innings and a win-loss record of 9-8.
- Tori Dubois owns a .330 batting average to guide PSU, including 38 hits and four home runs. Dubois ranks fourth with a .463 hitting clip in conference games only

SERIES VERSUS THE NITTANY LIONS

- In a series dating back to 1980, Rutgers trails Penn State, 28-20. RU looks to pick up its first win over PSU as conference foes.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Rutgers opened the 2017 season with 34-game road swing.
- The roadstand included five nonconference tournaments, two Big Ten road series, and four midweek matchups.
- The Scarlet Knights opened its home slate on April 7, kicking off a three-game series with Nebraska.
- Overall, RU has played 37 of 40 games on the road this season.

SCARLET HOMERS

- Six different Scarlet Knights have contributed at least one home run this season to total 23 as a team.
- **Rebecca Hall** leads the way with 11 homers and sits at fifth on RU's all-time single-season record list.
- **Sierra Maddox** matched her career high with two home runs in the 7-5 win over Indiana. Maddox has four on the season.
- **Nicole Bowman** and **Anyssa Iliopoulos** follow with three homers in their rookie campaigns.

THAT'S ANOTHER SWEENEY SHUTOUT

- **Shayla Sweeney** has registered three complete game shutouts and has totaled four shutouts overall this season.
- The right-hander allowed only five hits and no walks, while striking out eight batters in a 4-0 shutout of Boston College.
- The senior entered in relief against Lehigh to complete the shutout, allowing only two hits across five innings to close the 2-0 win.
- She picked up her second complete game shutout with a 7-0 win over Brown.
- In the 2-0 win over Iowa, she registered her third complete-game shutout of the season, allowing only four hits and striking out four batters. Sweeney struck out the side in the seventh to seal the victory.
- Overall, Sweeney has tossed 10 complete games this season, picking up seven victories throughout those contests.

TRIPLE TRIPLES

- Rutgers added three triples against North Dakota State on March 19, marking the most in a single game since RU posted two at FIU in 2016.
- **Nicolette Anico** and **Nicole Bowman** posted the first of their careers, while **Carly Todd** notched the second of hers.

FRESH LINEUP

- All five freshmen have earned starts this season, as **Taryn Atlee** and **Nicole Bowman** have started all 40.
- Freshmen immediately took to roles at shortstop, second base and left field.
- **Cambria Keefer** earned the starting nod in seven contests this season and has made 22 appearances.

ILIOPOULOS TO GREEK NATIONAL TEAM

- Freshman **Anyssa Iliopoulos** has been named to the Greek Softball National Team, the Greek Softball Federation announced Monday.
- Iliopoulos is one of the first seven athletes selected to the team which will represent Greece at the European Softball Championship to be held in Bollate, Italy, from June 25 to July 1, 2017.
- The announcement came after Iliopoulos, a dual citizen of the United States and Greece, had a breakout week at the plate. In four starts from April 5-9, the third baseman registered the first three home runs of her career, while registering a .429 batting average and a 1.071 slugging percentage.

Rutgers Athletics Unveils Hill Training Complex



PISCATAWAY, N.J. (January 31, 2017) – With Rutgers baseball and softball both in preparations for the 2017 season, Rutgers Athletics officially unveiled the Fred Hill Training Complex in a ceremony on Tuesday. The dedication included remarks, the ceremonial ribbon-cutting by legendary Rutgers coach Fred Hill and a batting practice display to show off the some of the capabilities of the new facility.

“Everything we do is showing people that we can get it done and that we will get it done here at Rutgers,” Director of Athletics Pat Hobbs said. “Already I am hearing from our coaches that this is changing the game in recruiting and in preparations. Good days are ahead for baseball and softball.”

“I was really excited see this fantastic facility,” said Hill, who won 1,089 games overall at the collegiate level. “It’s a long time coming. I know what it will mean to the two programs. It will mean they won’t be at a disadvantage any more in the winter when they need to get work in. It’s something Rutgers can be really proud of.”

“This is a first-class facility and one of the best in the nation,” head baseball coach Joe Litterio said. “It is special to have this facility and I want to thank everyone who had a hand in putting it together, including coach Hill and his many years of hard work. Our team looks forward to putting it to use and it will help elevate our program in a number of ways.”

“It makes all the difference in the world to our athletes,” head softball coach **Jay Nelson** said. “Our practice time is more reasonable. Having a consistent schedule is much less stressful on the athletes because they can plan their days for the week and weeks ahead and rest assured that they would not have to change their plans due to changing practice times. Additionally, the versatility of the space is fantastic. There are six nets we can raise and lower to configure different areas of the space to accomplish separate practice areas for different purposes. The added benefit is it is much safer due to all the protective netting installed throughout. It is a great facility and will aid us in the recruiting process.”

Spanning 22,500 square feet, the Hill Training Complex is equipped with state-of-the-art pitching machines, batting cages, bullpen mounds and a full turf infield. It was funded by nearly 100 generous donors to cover a cost of over \$3 million. The facility serves the needs of the baseball and softball programs, allowing the teams to have a dedicated home for workouts and practices.

Hill, who led the baseball program from 1984 to 2014, won 941 games during his tenure in Piscataway. The Scarlet Knights earned 11 NCAA Regional appearances, 12 regular season conference championships and eight conference tournament titles during the veteran mentor’s watch. He was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame and to the Rutgers Athletics Hall of Fame.

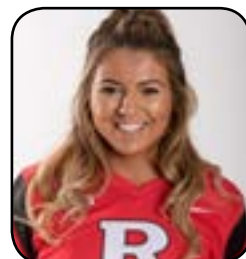

Jay Nelson continues his success at the helm of the Rutgers softball program as he enters his 11th year in 2016-17.

Nelson guided Rutgers to its second straight appearance at the Big Ten Softball Tournament last season since joining the league in 2014. The Scarlet Knights produced an NFCA All-Region selection for the second year in a row in senior Stephanie Huang, who led the stat sheet in batting average (.359), hits (65), walks (29) and runs (37). Off the field, RU saw 11 Scarlet Knights earn a spot on the 2016 Academic All-Big Ten list.

In 2015, Nelson led the program through its inaugural year in the Big Ten Conference. RU posted an overall record of 29-20, marking the second-most wins in program history, and 11 Big Ten victories, which were the most in conference play since the 1990 campaign. The 2015 squad also set highs in home runs (51) and RBIs (255), while the team's 433 hits and .310 batting average ranked third on the charts. The Scarlet Knights concluded the campaign ranked 7th in the league, earning their first trip to the Big Ten Tournament. Rutgers also produced two All-Big Ten Second Team selections and two NFCA All-Region honorees under Nelson's guidance.

Rutgers recorded one of its best seasons in program history in 2014 as Nelson guided the Scarlet Knights to an overall record of 28-19 and 9-9 in its first and only season as a member of the American Athletic Conference. RU captured its first postseason win since 1998, defeating Houston in the American Championships to advance to the semifinals. The squad also posted its highest winning percentage (.596) since 1995. As a team, the Scarlet Knights' .301 batting average, .435 slugging percentage and .375 on-base percentage were the second-best marks in the last 10 seasons.

The Scarlet Knights reached new heights in 2013, reaching 30 wins for just the fourth time in the 38-year history of the program and first time in Nelson's tenure. RU recorded the second-most doubles (78) in program history, tied for third in home runs (28), recorded the third-most RBIs (221) and tied for the third-most shutouts (12). Rutgers fell one game short of qualifying for the BIG EAST Championships, losing to Pittsburgh in the season-finale. A win would have given the program its fourth consecutive trip to the conference tournament.

With Nelson at the helm again in 2012, the Scarlet Knights recorded their highest win total (26) since winning the same number of games during the 2003 season. RU eventually fell, 5-0, to BIG EAST runner-up, Notre Dame, in the first round of the BIG EAST Tournament, but recorded nine conference wins for only the third time in the past 10 years.

Nelson led his 2011 squad to its first back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament berths in 13 years. Despite falling to DePaul in the tournament for the second-straight season, the Scarlet Knights finished the year ranked nationally - out of 289 teams - in stolen bases (23rd), doubles per game (28th), batting average (35th), scoring (39th), slugging percentage (55th) and double plays per game (61st).

The 2010 season saw the Scarlet Knights reach their first BIG EAST Championship since 1998. Rutgers finished its campaign with the most wins overall (24) and best winning percentage (.444) since 2004 (25, .462). The Scarlet Knights' nine conference wins were the most since 2002 (9).

In 2009, RU matched its win total from the previous year, finishing 23-33 overall and 6-18 in conference play. Three players hit for above .300 for the second time in Nelson's tenure - a feat that had not been accomplished since 2004 before his hire.

In Nelson's inaugural campaign, his squad amassed a 20-34 overall record, matching the combined win totals of the previ-

ous two seasons (15 in 2006, 5 in 2005). The Scarlet Knights also picked up seven victories in conference play, marking the most BIG EAST wins since the 2004 season.

Nelson saw his players received postseason accolades for the fourth-time in his six years "On the Bank," following the 2011 campaign. Senior Mandy Craig was named to the All-BIG EAST Second Team for the second time in three seasons, while junior Brittney Lindley earned NFCA All-Region First Team honors after making the second team in 2010.

In 2008, left fielder Amanda Heller earned All-BIG EAST Second Team honors under Nelson's guidance. Infielder Sarah Kalka, a First Team All-BIG EAST selection in 2007, was also named to the Louisville Slugger/NFCA Division I All-Northeast Region Second Team and ECAC Division I All-Star Team.

Academics continue to be a staple of Nelson's programs, as 13 players were recognized on the 2013 BIG EAST Academic All-Star Team. The squad earned the Big East Team Academic Excellence Award for the 2012-13 school year recording a 3.464 GPA to earn the honor.

Five student-athletes were named 2010 girls got game All-America Scholar-Athletes by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA), acquiring a 3.5 GPA or higher.

Prior to taking over the Rutgers program, Nelson completed 10 seasons as the top assistant coach on the highly successful staff at Seton Hall University. While at Seton Hall, he helped guide the Pirates to BIG EAST Conference championships in 2004 and 2005, and runner-up finishes in 1999 and 2001. The Pirates advanced to the NCAA Softball Tournament three times during Nelson's tenure.

Nelson's responsibilities at Seton Hall included serving as the team's defensive coordinator and on-field coach. He also handled recruiting, and organizing practice sessions. Nelson was also in charge of the day-to-day and long-term management of many program-related functions, including serving as the liaison in such areas as academic support, facilities, travel, equipment, and strength and conditioning.

Twice during Nelson's tenure at Seton Hall, the Pirates' coaching staff, under head coach Ray Vander May, was honored as the NFCA Northeast Region Coaching Staff of the Year. Nelson joined the Seton Hall program in 1996.

Prior to his tenure at Seton Hall, Nelson served as head coach at Mountain Lakes High School for 12 seasons (1985-96), guiding the Lakers to state championships in 1988, 1991 and 1993. He was named New Jersey High School Softball Coach of the Year in 1993, and was named Morris County Area High School Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991.

Nelson was also an assistant coach with the Clifton Charmers, one of the top ASA programs in New Jersey. He guided the team to a fifth-place finish in the 1996 ASA National Tournament.

Nelson, a 1974 graduate of St. Olaf College (Minn.), played competitively for the New Jersey Windmillers fast pitch team, and during that time participated in five World Tournaments and six National Championships, including a third place finish in 1996. Nelson also serves as the Vice President of BIG EAST Coaches Association. In 2009, Nelson was selected to the NFCA Top 25 poll committee, the ESPN/USA Top 25 poll committee and the ESPN/USA Player of the Year committee.

Nelson and his wife Gayle reside in Mount Tabor, N.J. with their daughter Jessica, a graduate of UCLA. The Nelsons became grandparents of twins Kenzie and Hayley in November of 2010.

JAY MILLER



Jay Miller enters his first season as associate head coach in 2016-17 after being announced to the staff in August 2016.

Miller brings a plethora of softball knowledge and success "To the Banks" with a resumé that boasts three stints and 26 seasons as a Division I head softball coach. During his head coaching career, Miller racked up over 1000 career wins, two Women's College World Series appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament appearances and three conference championships.

Most recently, Miller served as the softball pitching coach at the University of Louisville from 2014-16, aiding the Cardinals in four NCAA regional appearances as well as an AAC Championship title in 2014. This past season the Louisville pitching staff posted a 2.30 ERA to rank 26th in the nation.

Prior to Louisville, Miller registered nine seasons at the helm of the Mississippi State softball program from 2002-2011, guiding the Bulldogs to six regional appearances highlighted as the Regional Finalist at Texas in 2005. Highlighting his tenure at Mississippi State, Miller became the 13th Division I softball head coach to earn his 1000th career victory.

The most decorated section of his resumé comes during his time at the helm of the University of Missouri softball program from 1987-2002. In 15 seasons with the Tigers, Miller compiled a record of 556-309

and guided the program to two WCWS (1991 and 1994) and a total of five NCAA regionals. In 1997, Miller was named Big 12 Coach of the Year after leading the Tigers to the Big 12 Conference title. Prior to Missouri's entrance into the Big 12, Miller earned back-to-back Big Eight Coach of the Year honors in 1991 and 1992.

Miller's first role as a head coach came at Oklahoma City University, where he led the program to Sooner Conference Champions in 1986 and 1987. During his time, the Stars secured two top-five finishes in the nation (2nd in 1986, 4th in 1987), earning District Coach of the Year following both campaigns.

A member of the USA Softball National team staff since 1997, Miller served as head coach of the team from 2009-10. The squad earned five gold medals under his guidance, including the 2010 World Championship, 2009 and 2010 World Cup of Softball, Japan Cup and China Cup. Miller earned USOC National Coach of the Year accolades during both seasons at the helm.

Miller is a leading authority on the sport and has written more than 40 articles for professional publications. He has authored a chapter on offensive strategy for The Softball Coaching Bible, published by Human Kinetics Press, and developed five softball skills tapes. Miller is also considered one of the top softball clinicians in the world, having worked as a lead instructor for the National Fastpitch Coaches College, and other clinics in the United States, Netherlands Antilles, Italy, Czech Republic, Holland, France and Malaysia.

Miller began his educational career at the University of Grenoble in Grenoble, France, completing the international studies program. The native of Aurora, Illinois then went on to earn a bachelor of science in psychology and sociology at Illinois State in 1978 before obtaining a master's in education, with emphasis in counseling and personnel services, from Purdue University in 1979. Throughout high school and college, Miller played in major level men's fastpitch leagues.

Miller and wife Lacy Lee Baker have one daughter, Nicole.

Prior to her move to Memphis, Tennessee, St. Clair played in the National Pro Fastpitch League with the Akron Racers for the 2011 season. She competed in 32 games and batted .229 with one home run, 10 RBIs and seven runs scored. After the season, she took part in the NPF Back-to-School Tour that went around the country playing exhibition games against college programs.

St. Clair played her college ball as a catcher at Big Ten power Michigan from 2007-2010, helping the Wolverines to three Big Ten titles and an appearance in the 2009 NCAA Women's College World Series. She earned All-Big Ten First Team in 2009 and Third Team in 2010 for her success on the field.

During her four-year career at UM, St. Clair appeared in 224 games and started 190 behind the plate while she produced a .251 batting average with 153 hits, 30 doubles, 18 home runs and 111 RBIs. She hit a career-best .301 with 50 hits, 12 doubles, six home runs, and 33 RBIs during her junior campaign. In her final season, she broke career highs set the year prior in home runs (8) and RBIs (46) while she caught two perfect games and three no-hitters.

Off the field, St. Clair was awarded with Academic All-Big Ten Conference honors in 2008 and 2009, in addition to receiving the 2007 and 2009 U-M Academic Athletic Achievement Award.

A native of Livonia, Michigan, St. Clair graduated from Michigan in 2010 with a degree in sport management.

Roya St. Clair enters her first year as an assistant coach of the Rutgers softball program in 2016-17. A former Big Ten standout at the University of Michigan, St. Clair joins the staff following a stint as an assistant coach at University of Illinois at Chicago. Prior to her time at UIC, St. Clair spent four seasons as a volunteer and assistant coach at Memphis.

On the UIC staff in 2016, St. Clair served as the hitting coaching, prepping the Flames as one of the top offensive teams in the conference en route to its second consecutive Horizon League regular season championship. The Flames tabbed a .286 batting average on the year with a mark of .318 against conference opponents. The lineup included five All-Horizon League performers, including Horizon League Freshman of the Year in Lexi Watts after the rookie registered a .362 batting average behind the leadership of St. Clair.

At Memphis, St. Clair started as a volunteer assistant in 2012 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2013. St. Clair guided the Tigers to 89 wins during her time while producing five all-conference selections,
