Nittany Lions Open the 2012 Home Slate With Pittsburgh: Penn State opens its 2012 home schedule with a six-game homestand beginning with Pittsburgh on Wednesday at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. It will be "Dollar Dog Night" at the ballpark in the Nittany Lions' home opener. Penn State is looking to end a three-game skid, as it is coming off a tough three-game sweep to East Carolina this past weekend.

Media: Wednesday's game can be heard on ESPN Radio State College 1450 with Loren Crispell and Brian Tripp calling the action. Live stats will be available via a Gametracker link on GoPSUsports.com. In addition, fans can follow @psubaseball on Twitter for up-to-the-minute updates.

Most Recently: Penn State is coming off a tough three-game series sweep to the No. 25 East Carolina Pirates this past weekend. Penn State lost in walk-off fashion on Friday and Saturday, before dropping the series finale by a 7-4 count on Sunday afternoon. Sophomore Joe Kurrasch pitched a strong, complete game in the loss on Friday. Freshman Aaron Novak continued his hot hitting with a three RBI performance and two doubles on Friday. In this past Saturday's loss, Penn State got great performances out of freshman catcher JC Coban and junior starting pitcher John Walter. Coban was a single short of the cycle in a four RBI performance. Coban connected on an RBI double in the third, a two-run homer in the seventh, and an RBI triple in the ninth. Walter had his best outing of the season, going 7.2 innings of five-hit ball and giving up just one run.

What's Next: Following Pittsburgh on Wednesday, Penn State will open Big Ten play on March 23 against Indiana in the beginning of a three-game series. All fans that attend a game during the series will receive a free Penn State Baseball schedule magnet.

Scouting Pittsburgh: Pittsburgh comes into Wednesday's contest with a 10-7 overall record and a 3-1 mark in road games. As a team, the Panthers are hitting a solid .291 in 17 games. Pittsburgh is led by Anthony Defabio and Rick Devereaux, who are both hitting well above .400 this season. Defabio leads the team with 8 doubles on the season, while Devereaux has a team-leading four homeruns and 26 RBI. Right-handed pitcher Casey Roche is expected to make the start for Pittsburgh on Wednesday, as he has given up five runs in one appearance this season.

All-Time vs. Pittsburgh: Penn State is 27-15-1 all-time in contests with Pittsburgh, including wins in the last two contests between the rival schools. The series dates back to 1912, when Penn State won the first ever contest by a score of 11-2.

Coban's Career Day: In this past Saturday's loss, Penn State got a great performance out of freshman catcher JC Coban. Coban was a single short of the cycle in a four RBI performance. Coban connected on an RBI double in the third, a two-run homer in the seventh, and an RBI triple in the ninth. The freshman also scored two runs on the day. The four runs he drove in were the most of any Penn State player this season.

Diaper Dandies: Lately, the freshmen have stepped up into big roles for Penn State. Aaron Novak has started the last five games in right field for the Nittany Lions. On March 10 against UAB, Novak blasted a homer over the leftfield fence for his first career-hit as a Penn Stater. Novak recorded two hits in that game, which earned him a

start the next day. In Penn State's win on March 11, Novak hit two singles and drove in a run to help the Lions pick up a big win over the Blazers. In addition, catcher JC Coban has started the last seven games at catcher for the Nittany Lions and earned his first career RBI over Spring Break. He blasted his first career homerun at ECU last weekend in a four RBI performance. Coban is hitting .296 and slugging .519 in his eight career games.

100 in 100 for Searer: Penn State junior shortstop Elliot Searer recorded his 100th career hit in his 100th career game on March 3 against Samford. Searer currently has 103 hits in 106 career games as a Nittany Lion.

Lewis Earns First Win as a Nittany Lion: Penn State RHP Cody Lewis hurled a nice quality start against Samford to earn his first ever win in a Penn State uniform on March 3. Lewis went six innings, giving up seven hits and just one earned run. Notably, Lewis shut down 11 of the last 13 Bulldog hitters he faced to hold Penn State's lead in check. Lewis previously played his ball at Arizona (2009) and Saddleback JC (2010). The Laguna Niguel, Calif. native was required to sit out last year due to transfer rules.

Penn State to Have at Least Four Games Televised this Season: The Nittany Lion baseball team will play in four games televised by the BTN starting with the Friday, Apr. 13 matchup against Michigan at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. PSU's visit to Target Field to play Minnesota will air Saturday, May 5 at 3:00 p.m. as well Illinois' trip to Happy Valley on Sunday, May 13. Penn State's regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the

Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness:

Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. During 2011, Hill fired four complete games, which equals the total posted by every other Penn State pitcher since the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the 15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.

THIS SEASON: Has made two appearances this season ... Appeared in relief at UNCG (2/25), going to innings and giving up one run ... Earned the start against Mississippi State (3/6), pitching 3.2 innings.

AS A JUNIOR IN 2011: Appeared in 10 games and started nine on the mound for the Nittany Lions ... Posted a stellar 4-1 record during the year while ranking third on the squad with 50.2 innings of work ... Finished the season with a 4.09 ERA and 26 strikeouts ... Earned a victory in his first appearance of the season after scattering four runs on six hits over seven innings of work at Old Dominion on March 9 ... Also struck out six and did not surrender a walk against the Monarchs ... Fired an inning of scoreless relief against No. 26 Wichita State on March 18 ... Started three midweek games in March and April, including a victory against Pittsburgh on April 13 ...
