PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

• Penn State will once again to battle against its most common opponent when the Nittany Lions travel to Madison this weekend to conclude the opening semester of play against the Wisconsin Badgers. This marks the 42nd and 43rd meetings all-time with Penn State holding the 21-17-3 advantage.

• During a span of three seasons from the start of the 2014-15 season culminating with Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Tournament Championship in 2017, the Nittany Lions won 12-of-14 games between the two schools, however, since that double-overtime victory Wisconsin has evened the playing field holding the 9-8-3 edge over the last 20 meetings including a 4-1-0 record against Penn State last season. The Badgers also hold the 9-7-2 record at home.

• Senior Paul DeNaples leads all current Nittany Lions with seven points on two goals and five assists in 16 career games against Wisconsin while junior Connor McMenamin and Kevin Wall along with senior Clayton Phillips have each added a pair of goals against Wisconsin in their careers and have registered six, five and four points, respectively.

SECOND-YEAR SUCCESS

• Led by Tyler Paquette, the Nittany Lion sophomore class has tallied eight of the last 23 goals scored by Penn State over a six-game stretch. The second-year players also added 15 assists during that time and have now registered 45 points (16G, 29A) over 17 games this season already surpassing their freshman total of 37 points (12G, 25A) in 22 games last season.

• Paquette is currently riding a career-best four-game point streak (3-2-5). The second-year forward was named the Big Ten Second Star of the Week two weeks ago just a week after sophomore classmate Jimmy Dowd Jr. earned Third Star accolades.

• Dowd Jr.'s 12 points (1G, 11A) this season rank fourth on the team as he has already surpassed his season total of 10 from his freshman campaign. His 12 points are tied for fourth in the Big Ten among defensemen and good for 19th nationally while his 11 assists place him second in the Big Ten among defensemen behind only Michigan's Owen Power and tied with teammate Ben Copeland for eighth among all players in the Big Ten.

• Sophomore Chase McLane has registered points in back-to-back games for just the second time in his career after scoring a goal and tallying an assist last weekend against Michigan State. McLane now has points in four of his last six games.

TURN UP THE AUTO

• With his 18th career victory last Friday against Michigan State, senior goaltender Oskar Autio moved into a tie with Eamon McAdam for third all-time at Penn State. The senior's .514 winning percentage also ranks third all time.

• Autio is just 74 saves shy of 1,000 for his career which would make him the fourth Nittany Lion netminder all-time to hit that milestone. Autio currently has a .903 save percentage and a 2.61goals-against average while his seven victories this year are just two shy of his career-high nine achieved last season.

PERFECT TEN

• Junior Connor MacEachern is currently riding a career-long four-game point streak and has tied his career-best with a three-game goal streak. MacEachern scored in each game last weekend giving him 10 goals on the year a mark that is double the number of goals he scored in both his freshman and sophomore seasons combined. The junior's 15 points are also a new career-best.

• MacEachern's 10 goals ties him with classmate Kevin Wall for the third most in the Big Ten and 11th most across the nation. Wall's 16 points are good for 13th in the Big Ten while MacEachern's 15 are tied with teammate Ben Copeland for 14th in the conference.

• The junior's four powerplay goals this season are tied for second in the Big Ten and 11th nationally and are already tied for the 10th most in a single-season in program history just two shy of the Penn State single-season record of six held by four different individuals. MacEachern has added a shorthanded goal this season as half of his 10 goals have come as part of a specialty unit.

• MacEachern has now tallied at least one point in five of his last six games with goals in four of those games. Penn State is 8-3-0 this season when the junior gets on the statsheet.

SHOTS, SHOTS, SHOTS...EVERYBODY

• Penn State is averaging 37.47 shots per game which leads the nation paced by freshman Ryan Kirwan's national best 75 shots for an average of 4.41 per game. The rookie is on pace for 155 shots this season which would be the third most in a single-season in Penn State history.

• Kevin Wall ranks third in the nation with 68 shots for an average of 4.00 per game. Kirwan and Wall rank one and two in the Big Ten in shots per game while Danny Dzhaniyev and Connor MacEachern also crack the top-10 at 3.31 and 3.18, respectively.

YOU CAN'T SCORE IF YOU PASS

• Penn State is averaging 3.47 goals per game, a mark good for third in the Big Ten and 13th nationally. With 59 goals this season the Nittany Lions also rank third in the conference but are ninth in the nation.

• Each of Penn State's 10 wins this season have come when they have scored at least three goals including a perfect 9-0-0 record when scoring four or more goals. In 14 of the last 15 games between the Nittany Lions and the Badgers the winning team has scored at least four goals.

• Penn State also has 96 assists this season, a mark good for fourth in the Big Ten and tied for 12th in the nation.

FIVE KEEPS YOU ALIVE

• Penn State is 88-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals and have won 30-straight games when doing so, including all six so far this season, with the last and only loss coming at Wisconsin on December 1, 2018, an 8-5 defeat.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN



• Wisconsin (4-11-1) has already lost more games this season in just 16 games than they did all of 2020-21 when they finished the year 20-10-1 and captured the Big Ten regular season championship with a 17-6-1 record in conference play.

• Following splits against No. 2 Michigan and No. 5 Minnesota in consecutive weekends, the Badgers are currently on a seven-game winless streak (0-6-1) and also dropped a single exhibition game against the USNTDP last Thursday. During this current winless streak, Wisconsin is averaging just one goal per game and has been shut out twice, with an additional shutout in the exhibition contest against the U-18's.

• Wisconsin lost its top-4 scorers from last season's team including first-round draft picks Cole Caufield and Dylan Holloway. Caufield was the 2020-21 Hobey Baker winner after leading college hockey with 30 goals and 52 points in 31 games played.

• The Badgers are also without starting net-minder Robbie Beydoun, as Minnesota transfer Jared Moe and sophomore Cameron Rowe have split action on the ice. Moe leads the team having started 9 of the 16 games so far this season posting a 2-6-1 record with a .924 save percentage and a 2.54 goals-against average. Moe ranks tied for third in the Big Ten and 13th nationally in save percentage while his goals-against average is good for sixth in the conference.

• Senior Brock Caufield leads the team with seven points on three goals and four assists over 16 games played this season while classmate Tarek Baker paces the Badgers with four goals.

• The Badgers are scoring just 1.56 goals per game ranking last in the Big Ten and only ahead of Alaska nationally.

• Wisconsin is ranked second in the Big Ten for blocked shots with 211 total and an average of 14.07 per game.

• Wisconsin ranks second in the Big Ten behind only Ohio State in faceoff winning percentage, winning 482 of 906 faceoffs (53.3 percent).

• The Badgers are also dead last in the Big Ten on the powerplay converting just 11.3 percent of their chances (6-for-52) to rank 53rd nationally. The PK is even worse ranking only ahead of Ohio State in both the Big Ten and the nation stopping just 63.6 percent of chances against.





GET UP, STAY UP

• Penn State has scored the opening goal of the game in 12 out of 17 games so far this season and are 9-3-0 when doing so. Over the past five seasons, the Nittany Lions are now 76-20-9 when scoring first.

ROOKIE RULES

• Penn State's five-member freshman class has tallied 10 goals this season and the Nittany Lions are 8-1-0 when a rookie light's the lamp with their first and only loss in such games coming last Saturday against Michigan State.

NITTANY LION SPECIAL

• Penn State has scored at least one powerplay goal in 10-of-17 games this season and are 9-1-0 when scoring a powerplay goal. The Nittany Lions rank fourth in the Big Ten and 18th in the nation converting at 23 percent (14-for-61).

• Conversely, Penn State has struggled as of late on the penalty kill allowing at least one man-advantage goal in nine of its last 11 games after surrendering just one goal in 28 chances over the first six games to open the season. The Nittany Lion penalty kill ranks just fifth in the Big Ten and 39th nationally at 77.9 percent (53-for-68).

• Penn State takes the next few weeks off for semester break before returning to Pegula Ice Arena to ring in the New Year against the Maine Black Bears on December 31 and January 1.

THE B1G GADOWSKY

• Head Coach Guy Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State. Gadowsky is now 165-139-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.

• The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks 74th all-time throughout all divisions with 338 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 42nd with his 338 wins and is currently 14th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

• Recently coach Gadowsky crafted his own burger that is now available at The Field Burger & Tap. The burger consists of Eleven Oaks Farm Waygu with cheddar cheese, sauteed onions, bacon and sour cream topped with a perogie as the crown jewel all on a brioche roll.

• It should also be noted that associate head coach Keith Fisher has not eaten one single french fry in over 15 years.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Paul DeNaples was selected by his peers as the ninth captain in program history for the 2021-22 season. Senior classmates Adam Pilewicz and Clayton Phillips along with junior Connor McMenamin will serve as alternates.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season an continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 22nd collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 10th at Penn State in 2021-22.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.

Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucecse landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucecse took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual



national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 cam-

paign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn

State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's

arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season..
