2017 NOTES AND HEADLINES

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

The Spartans remain at Seccia Stadium for the second-straight weekend after sweeping Maryland in its first home Big Ten Conference series of the season. Michigan State carries a 19-11 overall record and a 3-3 record in conference after after being swept by Purdue in the opening weekend of B1G play.

As a team, the Spartans are hitting at a .316 clip with Lea Foerster ranking fourth in the Big Ten Conference with a .441 batting average that includes 41 hits, 14 doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 28 RBIs. In her sophomore season, Ebonee Echols has also been a force at the plate, bringing in a team-high 34 RBIs on 31 hits, including eight triples.

Bridgette Rainey has seen the most time in the circle this season for the Spartans, throwing 74.2 innings in 20 appearances and 14 starts. Rainey has a 4.22 ERA, allowing 45 earned runs to cross home and has struck out 88 batters. Kristina Zalewski has had the most success keeping runners from scoring for MSU with a 3.03 ERA in 39.1 innings of work and Jordan Watson carries a 3.93 ERA in 51.2 innings in the circle.

ARRIZURIETA MAKES THE MOST OUT OF OPPORTUNITY

Junior right fielder **Gianna Arrizurieta** got the nod for the start in game two against Indiana in the three-game series this past weekend. Arrizurieta appeared in two games with two hits, one RBI and scored once for a .400 batting average on the weekend. The Pembroke Pines, Fla. native made the most of her opportunity, making two huge catches in right field in the Nittany Lions narrow 3-2 victory against the Hoosiers. In game three, the junior outfielder went 2-for-3 at the plate, including two doubles, while scoring the game-winning run after reaching on a fielder's choice and stealing a base. Arrizurieta also made one putout on a diving catch in right center field to save a run in the fourth inning against Indiana.

WEBER EARNS STARTS AGAINST INDIANA

After starting four games as the designated player and coming into pinch hit on six other occasions, freshman **Destiny Weber** made the first starts of her collegiate career in the field against Indiana. The freshman started three games behind the plate against the Hoosiers, catching one runner stealing. Weber also dropped a clutch hit on the left field line in the bottom of the seventh inning in game three to move **Gianna Arrizurieta** into scoring position with one out before a single into right scored the walk-off run for the Blue and White. Weber has two hits, one RBI and has scored once in her 13 appearances this season.

_ehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three of ensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference

action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three BIG series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached its 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-ormore hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record the Blue and White. Furthermore, under Lehotak's tutelage, Jones ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine spots, respectively. careerbattingcategoriesatPennState.SeniorLexiKniefalsoclosed out her career in the top-10 of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions. Sophomore Alyssa VanDerveer tied the single game RBI record, driving in seven against Fordham and broke the single season RBI record with 50. VanDerveer found her name in A walk-off hit into right field from senior **Samantha Shanahan** solidthe career batting record book four times after her sophomore campaign, ranking fourth in home runs with 24 after two seasons. The Nittany Lions also saw two other single game career records in 2016 with Jones tying the single game home runs record with two against Michigan State and Tori Dubois knocking three doubles books with Miller ranking in the top-15 in batting average and RBI and Brackpool ranking in the top-10 in career home runs.

Defensively, Penn State finished the season ranked third in the Big Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. In its first appearance in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, Penn State outscored its opponents 19-6, giving up no more than three runs in any of its four games. The Nittany Lions posted back-to-back games with 10 hits while sweeping the weekend against Georgia Tech and Virginia Tech.

PENN STATE UPSETS NO. 4 LSU

After falling in its first game of the season, the Nittany Lions came back later that night to upset the No. 4 team in the nation with a 7-3 victory over LSU Friday, Feb. 10. The win over the top-ranked Tigers marked the first time that Penn State has defeated a top five team since it took a 1-0 victory over then-No. 1 Michigan, Feb. 18, 2006.

The Blue and White fell behind 1-0 in the bottom of the third back but answered with two straight multirun innings, including a five-run third inning that chased freshman starter Maribeth Gorsuch out of the game. The Tigers brought in ace Carley Hoover to shut down the Penn State offense, however, **Shelby Miller** launched the first homer of the 2017 season for the Nittany Lions over the center field fence.

Sophomore **Madison Seifert** got the start in the circle, throwing all seven innings and keeping the powerful LSU offense to just six hits and three runs, while striking out three.

FRESHMAN MAKE IMPACT IN OPENING WEEKEND

Four freshman made appearances in the lineup during opening weekend for head coach **Amanda Lehotak**. **Delaney Elling** started all five games behind the plate and finished the weekend with a .308 batting average, tallying four hits, including one multi-hit game in her first weekend donning the Blue and White. **Destiny Weber** notched three starts as the designated players, while **Christa Wagner** started one game in the designated player slot and pinch hit twice for the Nittany Lions.
