Penn State faces a tough test in its opening match with its third matchup against George Mason this season. The Patriots came out on top in both regular season meetings in 2019 in straight sets. The Nittany Lions have gotten the best of the Patriots in postseason matchups with an 8-0 record in the EIVA Tournament against GMU since rally scoring was implemented in 2001.

The Nittany Lions have won six of their last eight matches entering the tournament play and are making a familiar trip to Princeton having played in New Jersey last weekend.

As for their record against opponents in the other semifinal match, the Nittany Lions also dropped a pair of matches to host Princeton during the regular season while sweeping Saint Francis in that regular season series.

George Mason enters the tournament with a three-match win streak, including its late season win over Penn State at Rec Hall. Princeton is the hottest team of the bunch with five-straight wins coming into tournament play. Saint Francis dropped its last two matches to Princeton and NJIT.

- The 2019 EIVA Tournament field has been set with the following four teams: #1 Princeton, #2 George Mason, #3 Penn State, and #4 Saint Francis. The Nittany Lions have qualified for 42-consecutive conference tournaments dating back to their inaugural varsity season in 1977.
- Penn State will take on George Mason in the first semifinal match on Thursday evening at 5 p.m. Host Princeton will face Saint Francis in the second semifinal match scheduled for 8 p.m.
- It is the first EIVA Tournament Princeton will host in their history.
- Penn State has been the championship standard in the EIVA for its entire history with 31 total
 conference tournament titles dating back to 1981. The Nittany Lions have a 95-16 record in the
 EIVA postseason all-time and a 53-3 mark when led by head coach Mark Pavlik.
- Penn State's last conference title came in 2017 at home at Rec Hall when the Nittany Lions defeated Princeton in the semifinals and Saint Francis in the championship, both in straight sets.
- The Nittany Lions lost a five-set battle in last year's EIVA semifinals to Harvard.
- Penn State has a combined 2-4 record against the EIVA Tournament field from the regular season Princeton: 0-2, George Mason, 0-2, Saint Francis 2-0.

HEAD COACH MARK PAVLIK 25TH SEASON PENN STATE '82

- » Mark Pavlik holds an overall record of 573-198, good for a .743 winning percentage since the 1994 season.
- » His 559 career wins entering the 2019 season ranks second all time in NCAA DI-II men's volleyball history, trailing only Ohio State's Pete Hanson (702 wins, 34 seasons).
- » Pavlik's record against EIVA opponents sits at an outstanding 236-19 (.925) and includes 14 undefeated seasons in conference.
- » The Nittany Lions have finished in first place in the EIVA standings 22 of the last 24 season since Mark Pavlik took over as head coach of the program.

- » Pavlik was named the 2008 AVCA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year after leading the Nittany Lions to their second NCAA National Championship.
- » Before being named head coach in 1995, Pavlik was an assistant coach for Tom Peterson and was on the Nittany Lion staff during Penn State's first NCAA National Championship in 1994.
- » Under Pavlik's direction, the Nittany Lions have had at least three players earn All-EIVA honors each season.
- » Pavlik has been named EIVA Coach of the Year a record seven times, with the latest award coming in 2015.

About The Slate

- » Penn State is set to face seven teams ranked in the AVCA Division I-II Preseason Top 15 poll, including #1 ranked Long Beach State Feb. 8. The Nittany Lions' first home match against an opponent ranked in the Top 15 will be fourth-ranked BYU Jan. 18.
- » Penn State will participate in the Big Ten/Pac 12 Challenge as the Nittany Lions travel to Los Angeles to take on host USC and UCLA.
- » The Nittany Lions' home slate includes 12 total home matches in Rec Hall, including four matches each in January and March.
- » The 2019 schedule includes home and away matches with Penn State's Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association opponents, including Saint Francis (Pa.), Princeton, Harvard, Sacred Heart, NJIT, George Mason, and Charleston (WV).
- The Nittany Lions will take on three opponents for the first time in program history in 2019. Penn State's home matches against North Greenville, McKendree, and Lindenwood in January will mark the first time Penn State has squared off with each respective program.
- » The winner of the regular-season conference schedule will serve as host of the 2019 EIVA Tournament. The top four teams in the regular-season standings will earn a berth in the EIVA Tournament. The EIVA Semifinals and Championship will be held Thursday and Saturday, April 18 and 20, on the campus of the No. 1 seed.
- » Long Beach, Calif. will be the site of the 2019 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship May 2-4. Penn State served as the host of the event at Rec Hall on May 5-7, 2016.

Notable Numbers & Streaks

- » Matthew McLaren has 10+ kills in seven of the last ten matches. He has also swung better than .300 in seven of the last ten.
- » Henrik Falck Lauten has 6+ kills in 11 of his last 13 matches, including five matches with at least 13 kills since 3/1.
- » Falck Lauten has at least five kills in 23-of-28 matches in 2019.
- » Jason Donorovich has 19-straight matches with a block, including 14 matches with multiple stuffs.
- » Donorovich has five or more kills in eight of the last nine while hitting .300 or better in seven of the last eight outings..
- » Between setters Luke Braswell and Cole Bogner, the Nittany Lions have had one player reach 30 assists in six of the last 13 matches.
- » Penn State is 10-1 this season when holding the edge in service aces in matches.
- » In its 14 EIVA matches this season, Penn State holds a .300-.262 edge in team hitting percentage.

Scandinavian Firepower

Redshirt Junior outside hitter Henrik Falck Lauten has started every match for the Nittany Lions this season and has brought a spark to the regular rotation.

- » Falck Lauten leads the team with 236 kills. He set a new career high with 18 while swinging .538 (18-4-26) against NJIT 3/2.
- » He has 12 matches of double-digit kills in 2019 and has led the Nittany Lions in kills ten times, the most on the team.
- » Falck Lauten was named EIVA Defensive Player of the Week 3/25 after a team-best eight dig outing to pair with 10 kills 3/19 vs. Ohio State.
- » He hit .500 (9-2-14) in Penn State's 3-0 win over McKendree 1/25.
- » Falck Lauten recorded Penn State's first doubledouble of 2019 with 11 kills and a personal-best 10 digs 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » He has shown that he is also a well-rounded defender with 131 digs (2nd on team) and 49.0 blocks (3rd on team).

New Kids On The Block

Penn State has featured the depth of its lineup in 2019 with contributions from multiple first-year student-athletes throughout the roster.

- » Freshman Canyon Tuman has started 24 matches for PSU and is second on the team with 52 blocks.
- » Freshman Cal Fisher has had at least five kills in 10 of 20 matches played as an OH/OPP this season. He started the last four matches at libero for the injured Will Bantle.
- » Redshirt freshman Will Bantle had started 24 matches at libero led the team with 149 digs.

Big Man In the Middle

Redshirt junior Jason Donorovich has emerged as one of the top middles in the country this season:

- » Donorovich is 2nd in the EIVA with a .379 hitting percentage while ranking 18th in the conference in kills (165).
- » He has also been a gamechanger on the service line and on defense, leading the Nittany Lions in service aces (33) and total blocks (83).
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Feb. 18 after posting two single-game career highs with 13 kills 2/15 vs Harvard and four aces 2/16 vs Sacred Heart.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Defensive player of the week 1/28 after picking up 15 blocks (5 solo) in three games between 1/21-1/26. He had a nineblock game 1/26 vs. Lindenwood.
- » Donorovich started the last 10 games of 2018, beginning with a stellar offensive performance against Lewis on 3/10/18 when he converted 10 of his 12 swings into kills and didn't commit an attacking error.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Defensive Player of the Week 4/9/18 after his career-best 10 block effort 4/7/18 at George Mason.

Hot Rod McLaren

Now a well-known weapon on the outside for the Nittany Lions, Matthew McLaren is one of PSU's top options on the outside after his breakout 2018 season.

- » McLaren ranks second on the Nittany Lions with 233 kills this season.
- » In EIVA play, he leads the Nittany Lions with 115 kills (3.11 kps) in eight matches with a .305 hitting %
- » McLaren has 14 matches with 10+ kills this season, including six of the last eight matches. He set a season-high 18 kills 3/29 at Harvard
- » He was named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week 4/1 after posting 34 kills in three matches 3/26-30.
- » In his redshirt junior season, McLaren was named to his first All-EIVA First Team.
- » A former walk on, McLaren was the only Nittany Lion to play in all 26 games in 2018. He also started every match but one.

Wild Thing

Penn State freshman outside hitter Brett Wildman is poised to become one of the top scorers in the EIVA in just his first season

- » Wildman has played in 23 matches this season and put together a solid weekend in Los Angeles 3/8-9. He had a season-best 16 kills against USC 3/8.
- » He has made 11-straight starts at opposite for the Nittany Lions. Over that span, he has 77 kills and 39 digs along with 15 service aces.
- » Wildman was named to the United States Volleyball World University Games roster on 2/25. He is the youngest player on the US roster, the team's only true freshman, the lone representative of the EIVA on the team. The tournament will be held July 3-11 in Italy.
- » He ranks fourth on PSU with 149 kills and fourth with 184.0 points.
- » Wildman is also one of the Nittany Lions' top servers with 24 aces at a 0.30 aces/set rate, good for second on the team.

Bogging Down The Opposition

Freshman setter Cole Bogner has shown he has what it takes to play at a high level for the Nittany Lions ever since he stepped in for the injured Luke Braswell yersus RYII

- » Bogner started his first game in over a month 3/19 vs. Ohio State and finished with 32 assists.
- » Bogner had seven-consecutive starts under his belt 1/20-2/9 and has started each of the last eight matches.
- » He had 25 assists when playing the 3rd-5th sets of the BYU game 1/18.
- » His 40 assists at SFU 1/21 is a season high. He set a season high in digs with eight 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » Bogner has also played well at the point of attack defensively this season, tallying a season-high four block assists 1/26 vs Lindenwood and 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.

Mende Back For More

Redshirt junior opposite hitter Calvin Mende is proving once again to be one of the Nittany Lions' top offensive options in 2019.

- » Mende has provided a big spark off the bench in several matches, notably 3/29 at Harvard (14 kills) and 3/26 vs. SFU (8 kills, .545 H%).
- » Mende has battled injury in 2019 but returned to the lineup to lead Penn State with 20 kills against George Mason and Charleston 2/22-24.
- » Mende had at least five kills in 27-straight appearances from 4/8/17 to 1/12/19 which included 16 double-digit kill matches.
- » Mende has been named First Team All-EIVA twice in his career (2017-18).

(Br)aswell As You Can Do It

The Nittany Lions have a luxury to have an experienced, steady performer at setter to turn to in Luke Braswell.

- » Braswell set a 2019 season high with 47 assists against NJIT and added 45 more 3/8 at USC.
- » Braswell surpassed the 2,000 career assist mark 2/15 against Harvard, becoming just the 11th active player to reach the milestone.
- » Braswell has tallied at least 25 assists nine times in 2019, including reaching 30+ helpers seven times.
- » In 2018 Braswell had 8 games with 40+ assists, 4 games with 50+ assists, and a 60-assist match 1/20 vs. USC. He's had good success against the Trojans, adding a career-high 62 assists 1/7/17 against Southern Cal.
