LEADING OFF

- Penn State meets Ohio State for a three-game Big Ten series.
- The Nittany Lions and Buckeyes have met 113 times in program history, the most of any Penn State Big Ten opponent.
- Last season, Penn State won one of three games in Columbus, earning a 13-7 win on Friday with two homers each by Billy Gerlott, Kyle Hannon and Matt Wood.
- Penn State is coming off a 10-8 win over Youngstown State, scoring the go-ahead runs on a two-run double by Bobby Marsh in the eighth.
- Jay Harry was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Midseason Watch List on Tuesday. The award honors the nation's top shortstop.
- Harry is batting .324 with a team-high 44 hits and 11 doubles to go with five homers. 29 RBI and 32 runs.
- Kyle Hannon recorded his 24th steal of the season against YSU, moving him into a tie for second in a season at Penn State. He trails only Michael Campo (27, 2000).
- He's also riding a 17-game hit streak, tied for the eighth-longest in a season at Penn State.

Harry Named To Watch List

- Junior shortstop Jay Harry was named to the Brooks Wallace Award watch list on Tuesday.
- The award honors the nation's top shortstop.
- Harry has started all 33 games this season and is batting .321. He leads the team with 45 hits and 11 doubles, while collecting a triple, five homers, 29 RBI and 35 runs. He has also drawn 13 walks and stolen four bases.
- The New Jersey native paces the squad with 15 multi-hit games this season, including four three-hit games, while recording 11 multi-run games and eight multi-RBI games.
- He started the 2023 campaign with two hits, including a double, and three RBI in a win over No. 22 Miami. He also had three hits, including a double, at No. 14 North Carolina.
- He launched two homers, including a walk-off two-run shot, against Brown on March 11 and added two hits and three RBI against Georgetown.
- Harry tallied three hits, including a double, three runs and an RBI in a win over Pitt and launched a clutch solo homer against West Virginia.
- In his Penn State career, Harry has started 128 games, all as the primary shortstop.
- He owns 154 career hits, including 31 doubles and 11 homers, 73 RBI and 97 runs.
- In 2022, he tied a Big Ten record with six hits against Michigan State and recorded 164 defensive assists, tied seventh in a season at Penn State.

Luensmann, Ouderkirk Lead Staff

- Grad student Daniel Ouderkirk, a West Virginia transfer, has made an immediate impact in the Penn State rotation.
- Ouderkirk has tallied 53 strikeouts in 36.2 innings and has multiple strikeouts in 16 different innings this season. In nine outings, he has limited opponents to a .217 average.
- The 6-9 righty ranks 24th in the nation in strikeouts per nine innings (13.01), sitting third in the Big Ten. He's eighth in the conference in total strikeouts (53).
- Ouderkirk recorded at least 10 strikeouts in three straight starts: 11 vs. Northern Illinois,
 11 vs. Dartmouth and 10 vs. Brown. He has allowed just one earned run in each start against NIU, Dartmouth and Georgetown. He threw 3.1 shutout innings at Purdue.
- Ouderkirk became the first Nittany Lion with three straight starts of 10+ strikeouts since at least 2004.
- He is one of 16 Division I pitchers with multiple starts of 11+ strikeouts and 1 or less earned run this season and one of nine DI pitchers with three-straight 10+ strikeout starts this year.
- Junior Travis Luensmann was named Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the Week after striking out 10 in four relief shutout innings against Indiana. His 10 strikeouts were a career high.
- In nine appearances (six starts), Luensmann is 5-2 with a 3.05 ERA and 46 strikeouts in 41.1 innings. His five wins rank second in the Big Ten.
- He allowed just one run in five innings at No. 22 Miami, one run in five innings against Northern Illinois and no runs in five innings against Georgetown and no runs in 4.1 innings against Delaware State.

Transfers Provide Spark

- The Nittany Lions welcomed four transfers to the program ahead of the 2023 season and all four have had strong starts to the year.
- Joining Ouderkirk are grad students Thomas Bramley (Mount St. Mary's) and Grant Norris (Duke) and freshman Bobby Marsh (Florida Atlantic).
- Fellow grad student Thomas Bramley has started all 33 games, splitting time between catcher, outfield and designated hitter. Bramley is batting .331 with 40 hits, including eight doubles, a triple and four homers, including a grand slam at Purdue, and has drawn a team-high 30 walks. In the third game against Purdue, snapped a 36-game reached base streak.
- Norris has started 24 games at third base after transferring from Duke and is batting .329 with four homers and leads the team with 32 RBI.
- He recently snapped a 10-game hit streak.
- Freshman Bobby Marsh, a Bellefonte native and transfer from Florida Atlantic, has played in 27 games (21 starts). He owns nine doubles, three homers and 18 RBI.
- Marsh launched a solo homer in game two at Purdue and drove in the go-ahead run with a two-run double against Youngstown State.

Hannon Emerges As Power, Speed Threat

- Kyle Hannon leads the team in homers (six), runs (40) and steals (24). He's also riding a 17-game hit streak.
- He is on pace to become Penn State's first player with 10+ homers and 10+ steals in a season since Sean Deegan (12 HR, 15 SB). His 24 steals are already tied for second in a season at PSU and are the most by a PSU player since Deegan's 24 steals in 2010. Hannon needs just three steals to tie the season record held by Michael Campo (27, 1999).
- Hannon leads the Big Ten in steals per game (0.73), good for 10th in the nation, and total steals (24), sitting 15th in the country.
- Hannon is one of five Division I players with 6+ homers and 24+ steals this season, joining Toledo's Jeron Williams (6 HR, 33 SB), West Virginia's JJ Wetherholt (8 HR, 27 SB), VMI's Justin Starke (8 HR, 26 SB) and Cal's Rodney Green Jr. (8 HR, 25 SB)
- Hannon has six games this season with multiple steals.

Balanced Bats

- The Nittany Lions currently rank 31st in the country with a .307 team average, 39th in triples (11) and 53rd in steals per game (1.61).
- Thomas Bramley is batting a team-best .331 with 40 hits and 30 walks, good for second in the Big Ten in walks, while Jay Harry leads the team with 45 hits to go with 35 runs and a .321 average. Grant Norris holds the team RBI lead (32) and is batting .329 with 13 extra-base hits.
- Kyle Hannon (.307), Bobby Marsh (.329), Johnny Piacentino (.316) and Josh Spiegel (.323) are also hitting above .300 with Piacentino contributing 23 runs and 15 RBI, while Spiegel has 17 RBI. Marsh has 12 extra-base hits and 18 RBI.
- Tayven Kelley leads PSU with three triples this season and has nine for his career, tied for eighth all-time at Penn State.
- Against Binghamton, Anthony Steele went two-for-four with a homer, four RBI and a stolen base before taking the mound and striking out two. He also had three strikeouts and an RBI single against Delaware State.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Ohio State

- Bill Mosiello is in his first year as head coach at Ohio State.
- Mosiello spent nine years as associate head coach at TCU.
- The Buckeyes are 20-17 overall and 3-9 in the Big Ten. Last weekend, OSU took one of three games in a tight series against Maryland.
- Ohio State won both of their midweek games, earning a 12-11 win over Miami Ohio and an 8-7 victory over Dayton.
- The Buckeyes rank ninth in the Big Ten with a .274 average and eighth averaging 7.0 runs per game.
- Taylor Pettorini leads the team with a .327 average as one of six Buckeye regulars with an average above .300.
- Marcus Ernst paces the squad with six homers, while Henry Kaczmar leads with 31 RBI.
- Ohio State's pitching staff owns a 5.70 ERA, sitting ninth in the conference.
- Isaiah Coupet leads Buckeye starters with a 3.82 ERA and 55 strikeouts. He sits sixth in the conference in total strikeouts and second in strikeouts per nine innings (13.14).

Against The Buckeyes

- Penn State and Ohio State have met 113 times in program history.
- Last season, the Nittany Lions won one of three games in Columbus.
- In the first game of the series, Penn State won 13-7. Billy Gerlott, Kyle Hannon and Matt Wood each blasted two homers and each hit a first inning homer.
- This marks Ohio State's first visit to Happy Valley since 2018.

Head Coach

The 2023 baseball season is Rob Cooper's 10th as head coach of the Nittany Lion baseball program. Cooper was selected as the 14th head baseball coach in Penn State history on August 9, 2013. Not shy about stating his ultimate goal of returning Penn State to Omaha in June, the Lions have made significant strides under his leadership.

Under his tutelage, 12 players have been drafted and 13 total have signed with MLB teams in the last five seasons with a full draft. However, his strong belief in the first part of the term "student-athlete" is perhaps the top reason he has proven to be an excellent fit at Penn State. Even with state-of-the-art facilities, the chance to take on elite competition and a program history that includes five trips to the College World Series, Cooper cites the value of a Penn State degree as one of the top reasons to play baseball at Penn State.

In 2022, Cooper led the Nittany Lions to their first Big Ten Tournament appearance since 2012. Penn State finished the season with a 26-29 record, including an 11-13 mark in the Big Ten. The Nittany Lions earned the No. 6 seed in the Big Ten Tournament, picking up a 5-2 win over No. 3 seed lowa to open the tournament.

The Nittany Lions won Big Ten series against Purdue, Minnesota and Michigan State, sweeping the Spartans. Penn State also earned a win in each series against Rutgers, No. 23 Maryland, Northwestern and Ohio State.

In non-conference action, the Nittany Lions' wins included an 8-4 win at West Virginia and a 19-6 win over Pitt in PNC Park, highlighted by a 14-run top of the ninth.

Penn State had two All-Big Ten selections, led by first team selection Matt Wood. The junior catcher won the Big Ten batting average title in the regular season (.395) and led the Nittany Lions in average (.379), hits (75), runs (55), homers (12), RBI (53), total bases (132), slugging percentage (.667), on-base percentage (.480) and walks (36). Wood's incredible season included a 26-game hit streak and a 36-game reached-base streak. Wood was PSU's first All-Big Ten first-team selection since Jordan Steranka in 2012) and Penn State's 16th first team selection in program history and the third catcher to earn first team honors.

Wood finished the season ranking fourth at PSU in runs (55), sixth in total bases (132), tied seventh in walks (36), tied eighth in hits (75) and RBI (53) and ninth in homers (12) and slugging percentage (.667).

Wood was selected in the fourth round (132nd overall) by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2022 MLB Draft. Wood is the highest-selected position player in program history. The previous highest was catcher Ben Heath (fifth round, 153rd overall) by the Houston Astros.

In 24 Big Ten regular season games, Penn State collected 83 extra-base hits, including 43 doubles, 11 triples and 29 homers. Penn State set a program record with 19 triples in 2022, bettering the previous record of 18 in 1986, 2007 and 2010.

On the mound, the Nittany Lions' pitching staff set a program record with 503 strikeouts. Penn State tallied 21 games with 10+ strikeouts and 16 games allowing three or less earned runs. Six pitchers recorded at least 40 strikeouts. In 49 of 55 games, Penn State's starting pitcher was a Pennsylvania native.

In the classroom, Wood was a third-team CoSIDA Academic All-American. The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season with an 18-24 record, playing against exclusively Big Ten opponents. The wins included a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Michigan on March 26 and a series sweep over Michigan State in which Penn State out-scored the Spartans, 39-13. The Nittany Lions also won two series against Rutgers. Penn State scored 10 or more runs in six games, Penn State's most against Big Ten opponents since 2008 (8) and the most in a

season since 2016.

Penn State had four players drafted from the 2021 squad. Conor Larkin was selected in the ninth round (272nd overall) by the Toronto Blue Jays. Justin Williams was a 17th round selection (508th overall) by the Houston Astros and Kyle Virbitsky followed, being selected 518th overall by the Oakland A's. Bailey Dees was drafted in the 18th round (543rd overall) by the New York Yankees. All three members of the starting rotation were drafted, making Penn State one of only four schools to accomplish that in 2021.

Penn State baseball's trip to Cuba prior to the 2016 season is perhaps the best example of Cooper's commitment to the first part of the "student-athlete" term. The Nittany Lions attended academic lectures and toured Havana, becoming the first NCAA Division I team to compete against a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. team at any level to defeat a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. baseball team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties with Cuba, the second NCAA team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties (Coastal Carolina men's basketball, August 2015) and the fifth NCAA Division I baseball team to compete in post-revolutionary Cuba. The harmony between academics and athletics was on full display, as multiple Penn State professors and a group of journalism students also joined the travel party.

The rare, once-in-a-lifetime experience helped bring a young Penn State team together, and the Lions went on to earn their first winning record (overall and in conference) since 2012. The starting lineup included at least three freshmen in all but six games and five to six freshmen in 19 games, and took on nine eventual NCAA tournament teams, including a three-game series at home against College World Series participant TCU. The Lions' 28 wins were a 10-win improvement over the previous season, and its 12 Big Ten wins doubled the 2015 total. Haley and Anderson were the first drafted out of Penn State since 2012, and Anderson and senior outfielder Greg Guers became the program's first All-Big Ten picks also since 2012. Pitcher Justin Hagenman became Penn State's first Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American since 1997.

Shortly after Cooper accepted the PSU head coaching position in 2014, the California native traveled to Taichung, Taiwan to serve as the head coach of USA Baseball's 18U National Team at the IBAF U18 World Cup. Cooper steered Team USA to an 8-1 record in World Cup play, including seven consecutive victories to win the gold medal.

Not long after the triumph in Taiwan, Cooper received one of the highest honors bestowed in the profession, as he was announced as the Rod Dedeaux USA Baseball Coach of the Year. With the honor, Cooper became just the 16th individual in the award's history to receive the accolade, joining the likes of Scott Brosius, Davey Johnson and Tommy Lasorda.

Cooper was also a member of the coaching staff for the 2007 and 2009 USA College National teams. The 2007 team earned a silver medal at the Pan Am Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Fourteen of the 20 players on the 2007 team reached the Major Leagues, including 2013 All-Star Pedro Alvarez. Fourteen of the 22 members of the 2009 team also reached the Major Leagues, including three-time All-Star Gerrit Cole.

Cooper brought an accomplished resume to Penn State that included three NCAA Tournament appearances as a head coach at Wright State and five more at various stops as an assistant coach, including two trips to the College World Series with Miami (Florida). Cooper was twice named the Horizon League Coach of the Year and guided Wright State to three league tournament championships and two regular-season championships after the team suffered six losing seasons in the seven years before his arrival.

Cooper began his coaching career at national power Miami, spending two seasons (1994-95) as a student/graduate assistant on the Hurricanes' staff. While at Miami, Cooper helped the Hurricanes to College World Series berths in 1994 and 1995. Cooper spent the 1996 season as an assistant and team academic coordinator at Wake Forest, then moved on to Tulane for the next two seasons, serving as the Green Wave's hitting coach. In 1997, the Green Wave won the Conference USA regular-season crown, and in 1998, they advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Cooper left Tulane following the 1998 season and returned to Sacramento City College, where he starred in the early 1990's before lettering at Miami in 1993.

Along with his college coaching experience, Cooper also was an associate scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 1990-92 and has been selected to four coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Miami in 1994 and a master's in sports sciences/administration from Miami in 1996. He is married to his wife, Maureen, and has two sons, Jake and Tyson, who are both current members of the Penn State baseball team.
