Tournament Time ...

Penn begins its 12th NCAA Championship appearance as the No. 7 seed after a 13-4 regular season which resulted in an Ivy League regular season championship and a berth in the Ivy League Tournament title game. The 12 national tournament appearances are 14th-most among all Division I programs.

Notes to Know ...

- Penn is 13-11 all-time in NCAA Championship games
- Penn's 13 wins are tied with Temple for 11th all-time.
- The Quakers and Nittany Lions have met one time previously in the NCAA Tournament -- a 12-2 win for Penn State in the 1983 NCAA Second Round.
- The Quakers are 6-9 all-time against Penn State, the two teams have not met since 2009.
- **Nina Corcoran's** 19 career assists in NCAA Tournament games are tied for 6th most all-time.
- For her career, **Nina Corcoran** is averaging 2.71 assists-pergame in the NCAA Tournament -- second-best all-time.

Quakers Earn 10th Consecutive NCAA Bid ...

Penn has now qualified for the last 10 NCAA Tournaments, reaching the Final Four in 2007, 2008, 2009 with a title game appearance in 2008. Penn's at-large selection extends the nation's sixth-longest streak of national tournament trips. The only teams with longer active streaks of NCAA appearances are Maryland (26), Virginia (21), Duke (19), Northwestern (13) and North Carolina (12).

Penn's Regular Season Rewarded With No. 7 Seed ...

Penn is seeded for the fifth time in the NCAA Championship, and the No. 7 seed is Penn's first since entering the 2010 tournament as the No. 8 seed. Penn's previous seeded entries to the national tournament include No. 8 (2010), No. 4 (2009), No. 2 (2008), and No. 4 (2007). The Quakers are 9-4 all-time in the NCAA Tournament as a seeded team.

Quakers Win 14 Games in Back-to-Back Seasons for 4th Time ...

Penn's 15 wins this season are tied for third-most in a season by a Quakers club, and give Penn 14+ wins in back-to-back seasons for just the fourth time and for the first time since 2009-10.

Corcoran Named Ivy League Attacker of the Year

For the second year in a row, Penn has been deemed to possess the Ivy League's top attacker as *Nina Corcoran* was selected unanimous Ivy League Attacker of the Year. She joins Tory Bensen as the only Quakers to earn the honor. Corcoran leads the nation in assists with 48, and her 69 points are tops in the Ivy League.

Karin Corbett Named Ivy League Coach of the Year

The winningest coach in Penn Women's Lacrosse History, *Karin Corbett* was named 2016 Ivy League Coach of the Year for the first time after guiding the Red and Blue to their ninth Ivy League championship in the past 10 years. The 2007 IWLCA and Inside Lacrosse National Coach of the Year, Corbett won her 200th career game as a head coach on April 30 at Cornell – 187 of those wins have come as head coach of the Quakers.

Penn Lands Six on All-Ivy Team

The Quakers placed six players on the All-Ivy team for the second straight year, led by first-team All-Ivy selections *Nina Corcoran, Alex Condon* and *Iris Williamson*. Combined, that trio accounted for 140 of Penn's 340 points this season – or 41%. Also named All-Ivy were second-team selections *Lely DeSimone* and *Megan Kelly* who were joined by honorable mention goalkeeper *Britt Brown*.

Corcoran, Condon Named All-American

Penn had a pair of players named IWLCA All-American in **Nina Corcoran** and **Alex Condon**. Both first-time All-Americans, Corcoran was named to the second team while Condon was a third team selection.

Four Quakers Named All-Region

Just before the start of the 2016 NCAA Tournament, four Penn players were named All-Region by the IWLCA. **Nina Corcoran** and **Alex Condon** were selected as first-team All-Mid-Atlantic, while **Megan Kelly** and **Iris Williamson** earned second-team All-Mid-Atlantic honors.

Red and Blue Set Ivy Record for Weekly Awards

Through 11 weeks of Player of the Week Awards, Penn earned eight Offensive Player of the Week honors – a new Ivy record. **Nina Corcoran** accounted for six of those awards – also a single-season record – while **Alex Condon** garnered two.

Penn Claims 11th Ivy League Championship

With a 10-6 win at Cornell on April 30, Penn staked claim to its ninth Ivy title in the last 10 years – and its 11th overall. Women's Lacrosse now has the most Ivy titles of any women's program at Penn, surpassing the women's fencing team which has 10.

Quakers Knock Off Four Top-20 Teams

Again taking on a challenging schedule, Penn played six Top-20 opponents this season, posting a 4-2 record in those games. Three of those wins – No. 11 Princeton (12-7), No. 17 Towson (7-4) and No. 18 Cornell (10-6) were on the road, while the fourth was a 14-13 win over No. 8 Northwestern in overtime.



Karin Corbett Head Coach

Karin Corbett has guided the Quakers to new heights in her 17 years leading the Red and Blue. After taking over a team that went 1-12 the year before, Corbett has amassed 190 wins and averaged 11.0 wins a season since 2000.

Corbett inherited a program which had not won an Ivy League title since 1982. From 2007-2014, Penn won eight consecutive Ivy championships -- a new Ivy League record for consecutive women's lacrosse championships and the longest stretch of Ivy titles by any Penn women's team.

Those Ivy titles have led to deep runs in the NCAA Tournament. From 2007-09, Penn was a regular participant in the Final Four weekend, advancing to the championship game in 2008. Her 13 wins in the NCAA Tournament are a school record.

Along the way, Corbett has coached eightplayers named Ivy League Player of the Year and two Ivy Rookies of the Year. 48 players have been named All-Region and 17 have gone on to earn All-American honors.

Quakers Rank No. 9 in RPI

The latest NCAA RPI slots Penn in at No. 9 – second-highest among Ivy League teams. Of the eight teams ahead of the Quakers, Penn has played three of them. Penn has played six games against the RPI Top-20 and seven against the RPI Top-25. Penn is 5-2 against the RPI Top-25 this season.

Keeping It Clean

Penn is one of the stinglest teams in the country when it comes to coughing up the ball, ranking No. 3 in the nation with 10.59 turnovers per game. In ten games where Penn committed 12 or fewer turnovers, the Quakers are 10-2 with wins in their last ten after turning the ball over 11 times at Duke in the second game of the season.

Quakers Can Handle OT in NCAAs

Last year's 11-10 win over Albany was Penn's third overtime win in a NCAA Tournament game, tied for fourth-most all-time by any team. Overall, Penn is 3-2 in OT during NCAAs -- tied for fifthmost OT games in tournament history.

Corbett Looks to Keep Climbing

Karin Corbett's 12 wins in NCAA Tournament games are ninthmost all-time. Overall, her .526 winning% is 13th all-time in the NCAA Tournament and eighth among coaches who have appeared in 19 or more games.

Nina Knows Assists

Nina Corcoran's assist prowess has not been limited to just regular season games. In seven career NCAA Tournament appearances, she has recorded 19 assists - most by a Penn player. Her five assists last year against Syracuse in the second round are tied for No. 6 all-time in a game during the national tournament. Her eight assists during the 2015 tournament are tied for No. 10 all-time.

Quakers' Corcoran racking up assists

Many people contributed to the ninth regular-season Ivy League women's lacrosse title in the last 10 years for Penn, but a big assist goes to senior attack Nina Corcoran.

Make that several assists. Corcoran, who on Wednesday was named the Ivy League attacker of the year, leads the nation with 48 assists and 3.2 assists per game for the 12-3 Quakers, who are ranked No. 12 in the most recent Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association poll.

As with anybody who dishes to teammates with such stunning regularity, Corcoran is often thinking a play or two ahead of the opposition.

"She has tremendous vision," said Penn coach Karin Corbett, who was named Ivy League coach of the year. "She sees sometimes that a kid is open before that player realizes she is open."

Corcoran, who is from Sacred Heart Academy in Long Island, N.Y., likes to pass off the credit for her success the way she passes in a game.

"It is an awesome feeling, but I wouldn't be able to get this without my teammates and coaches," she said about the Ivy League honor.

Her teammates know that, when playing with Corcoran, they have to keep alert, because a pass could zip by at any time, threaded through the smallest of windows.

"She always has her head up and is always looking for the next play and is

out there to make everybody else better," said teammate Iris Williamson, a fellow all-Ivy League selection and product of Germantown Friends. "She is one of the most selfless players I ever played with."

Corcoran owns the Penn career mark with 117 assists, breaking a school record that stood since 1983. Yet she hasn't abandoned her scoring duties. This season she has 21 goals.

That's not bad for somebody who never played attack until late in her freshman season. Corcoran was always a midfielder before going to Penn and wasn't seeing a lot of playing time as a freshman at that position, until a Penn attack was injured.

"We saw some of the things she could do offensively, so we decided to try her there," Corbett said. "She has just blossomed at that position and has been our quarterback the last couple of years."

Penn will be the top seed when the Quakers host the Ivy League tournament semifinals Friday at Franklin Field.

At 4 p.m., No. 3-seeded Cornell will meet No. 2 Princeton. Penn will face No. 4 Harvard at 7 p.m. with the winners playing Sunday in the championship game at 11 a m

The tournament champion will earn the Ivy League's automatic NCAA bid.

Regardless of how Penn fares in the Ivy tournament, the Quakers still appear headed to the 24-team NCAA tournament, which will conclude with the semifinals and championship May 27 and



May 29 at Talen Energy Stadium in Chester, home of the Union.

Penn has earned nine consecutive NCAA tournament berths.


As her career is winding down, Corcoran wants to make one lasting impression.

"It is our last go, so we're leaving it all out on the field," she said.

In keeping with her selfless demeanor, she said she had no preference when it came to scoring or assisting.

"It doesn't matter," she said. "As long as the ball is in the back of the net, that is the only thing that counts."
