PENN STATE TAKES ON SPARTANS IN B1G QUARTERFINAL

The Penn State men's soccer team makes the trip to East Lansing, Mich. for the 2016 Big Ten Tournament Sunday, Nov. 6. The Nittany Lions earned the No. 5 seed in the tournament after falling to Northwestern, while the Spartans notched the No. 4 seed following a loss to Indiana.

BIG TEN TOURNAMENT HISTORY WITH MICHIGAN STATE

The Nittany Lions will play the Spartans for the 12th time in the Big Ten Tournament and hold a 7-3-1 record against MSU in conference tournament action. The two squads have met each of the last three seasons with each team earning one win apiece. Last season, Penn State earned the 2-1 overtime victory in the play-in match when thenfreshman **Dayonn Harris** scored his first collegiate goal in the closing minutes of the first overtime period. In 2014, the Spartans notched the 1-0 win over the Blue and White when Penn State was the No. 4 seed and MSU earned the No. 5 seed.

2016 NOTES AND HEADLINES

THREE EARN ALL-BIG TEN ACCOLADES

Penn State men's soccer seniors **Connor Maloney** and **Robby Sagel** along with freshman **Pierre Reedy** collected Big Ten individual honors, as announced by the conference office Friday, Nov. 5. Maloney was a unanimous First Team All-Big Ten selection, earning the honor for the third time in his career, while Sagel earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors and Reedy was a unanimous pick to the All-Freshman team. Additionally, **Ryan Gallagher** earned the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award for Penn State.

ABOUT THE SPARTANS

Michigan State checks in at No. 15 in the national rankings to start the Big Ten Tournament and carries a 12-4-1 overall record. The Spartans fell to No. 8 Indiana in their final regular season match but defeated No. 16 Notre Dame in its final non-conference match of the 2016 campaign. MSU brings an impressive 8-0-1 home record into the match with the Nittany Lions and is one-of-four Big Ten Conference teams to not suffer a loss on its home field in the 2016 campaign.

Michigan State is outscoring its opponents 23-13 on the season and are giving up 0.76 goals per match. Furthermore, the Spartans are allowing the opposition to take just 8.2 shots per match and only 67 have tested the MSU keepers. Ryan Sierakowski paces the Michigan State offense with 21 points on the season that includes nine goals and three assists, while Ken Krolicki and Giuseppe Barone each have eight points in 2016.

Jimmy Hague has been solid in net all season for Michigan State with 51 saves and a 0.75 goals against average. Hague has given up just 13 goals in 1560:18 minutes on the pitch and holds a .797 save percentage.

RECENT HISTORY WITH MSU

In the past five seasons, Penn State and Michigan State have met on the pitch a total of eight times with each team picking up four wins apiece. The Nittany Lions have come out on the winning end of the match in the last two contests with a 1-0 double overtime win in the 2016 season and a 1-0 overtime win in the 2015 Big Ten Tournament. Michigan State's last win over Penn State came in the 2015 regular season when it earned a 2-1 victory on its home pitch. However, under head coach **Bob Warming** the Nittany Lions are 1-2-0 when playing at Michigan State in the past six seasons.

BIG TEN TOURNAMENT HISTORY AT MICHIGAN STATE

The Nittany Lions will travel to East Lansing, Mich. for the Big Ten Tournament for the fourth time since joining the conference in the 1991 season. The Blue and White hold a 2-2-1 overall record at Michigan State in the B1G Tournament but have not played there since the 2007 campaign when it fell in the quarterfinals to the No. 5 seeded Spartans. Furthermore, Penn State has played MSU two times on the Spartans home field in its four visits, picking up a 2-1 double overtime win in 1999 and falling in penalty kicks in the 2007 campaign.

Entering his seventh season as Penn State's 11th coach in its storied history, Bob Warming has made his impact known in his first five years. Twice named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 by leading the Nittany Lions to back-to-back Big Ten titles, Warming has added a pair of trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2010, 2013), and led the Lions to three straight postseason appearances.

Warming led the Nittany Lions to a 7-8-3 overall record and a 2-4-2 Big Ten Conference record in the 2015 campaign. The Blue and White earned an overtime victory over Michigan State in the Big Ten Big Ten Champion Ohio State in the quarterfinals in overtime. Junior Connor Maloney paced Penn State, starting 17 matches with a team leading 17 points that included seven goals and two assists en route to his second First Team All-Big Ten honor. Freshman Austin Maloney also made his mark on the program, earning All-Freshman team honors after starting 14 games with two assists and a .800 shots on goal percentage. Of its seven wins in 2016, six of them came by way of the shutout with senior goalkeeper Matt Bersano tallying five and junior Evan Finney earning one.

2014 was a banner year for Warming and his Nittany Lions as they won 13 matches for the second straight year, going 13-6-1 overall and 5-3 in the Big Ten. They also recorded their 800th win in program history over Penn (Sept. 24), with a 6-2 win at Jeffrey Field. The team got out to a sizzling 10-0-1 start, it's best ever and won seven straight matches for the first time since 2005.

2016 NOTES AND HEADLINES

FINNEY RANKED AMONGST NATIONS BEST

Redshirt-junior Evan Finney finds himself amongst the elite in the nation as he ranks 20th with a .824 save percentage and 27th with a 0.73 goals against average. Furthermore, Finney leads the Big Ten Conference in save percentage, ranks second in goals against average, fourth in both shutouts per game (0.33) and saves per game (3.30) and ranks fifth with four shutouts on the season.

PENN STATE NOTCHES SIX MULTI-GOAL MATCHES IN 2016

The Nittany Lions tallied six multi-goal matches in the 2016 season with its last coming by way of a 3-2 win over Rutgers in double overtime. Of its six multi-goal games, four have ended in victory for the Blue and White, one has ended in a tie and it suffered one overtime loss to then-No. 4 Maryland after scoring two goals. It's six multi-goal matches this season tied its six in the 2015 campaign.

JEFFREY FIELD DOMINANCE

Penn State has enjoyed success at Jeffrey Field with over 300 victories at the famed field. Impressively, the Nittany Lions have never posted a losing season at Jeffrey Field in 43 years, going 328-85-36 all-time for a winning percentage of .771. This season, PSU finished 8-2-1 at the Jeff and over the past four seasons the Nittany Lions are 34-10-5 en route to a pair of Big Ten titles in 2012 and 2013. In the 43-year history of the stadium, Jeffrey Field has welcomed over 540,000 fans through its gates.

REEDY NETS GAME-WINNER WITH FIRST COLLEGIATE GOAL

Tournament play in match before falling to eventual Freshman Pierre Reedy has found ways to add points to his stat line at the right time. The freshman midfielder had his first two collegiate points against Rutgers having the assists on two goals before scoring his first collegiate goal against Wright State. Reedy gathered a pass from **Connor Maloney** 19-yards out and ripped a shot into the bottom left half of the net in the eighth minute of the match. The goal would prove to be the game-winner as **Evan Finney** and the Penn State backline pitched its fifth shutout of the season.

NITTANY LIONS IN OVERTIME PERIODS

Penn State played its third-straight double overtime match against Rutgers, marking the first time since the 2013 season that it has played three-straight double overtime matches. Furthermore, the Blue and White played its eighth overtime match of 2016, which ties the most since the 2005 campaign and is the third-highest in program history. Penn State holds a 4-2-2 overall record in overtime periods, tying with then-No. 1 Stanford and No. 22 Akron, while falling to then-No. 4 Maryland and UC Berkeley.

PENN STATE EARNS B1G WIN OVER RUTGERS

The Blue and White continues its dominance at Jeffrey Field, earning its seventh victory of the season with a 3-2 double overtime win over Rutgers. Junior **Aymar Sigue** notched his second game-winner of the season for the Nittany Lions on his third goal of the season with two minutes remaining in the second overtime period. Freshman **Frankie De La Camara** netted his first collegiate goal donning the Blue and White, while freshman **Pierre Reedy** notched his first collegiate points with two assists in the match. Finally, senior **Connor Maloney** scored his team-leading seventh goal of the season in the second half of the match.

MALONEY NETS TWO AGAINST NO. 22 AKRON

Senior **Connor Maloney** became the third Penn State men's soccer player to tally a multi-goal match when he found the back of the net on two occasions against No. 22 Akron. Maloney knotted the score at 1-1 in the 66th-minute before giving Penn State the go-ahead goal in the 74th-minute. However, Akron came back to tie the score late in the match as Penn State would play to a 2-2 double overtime draw with the Zips.

Maloney joins the company of senior **Mason Klerks**, who scored two goals against Ohio State, and sophomore **Dayonn Harris**, who netted two against then-No. 4 Maryland.

SAGEL HEADER LIFTS PENN STATE TO VICTORY

With less than two minutes left before the double overtime match with the No. 19 Spartans ended in a draw, senior **Robby Sagel** headed in the golden goal off a free kick from **Riley Grant**. The senior defender, who was in on the free kick, found an opening in the box and buried the ball into the lower right corner of the net to secure Penn State's first victory over a ranked opponent this year and third Big Ten Conference win of the season.

SAGEL KEY IN BEATING NATIONALLY-RANKED OPPONENTS

The win over No. 19 Michigan State marked the first time the Nittany Lions have defeated a top 20 opponent since Sept.13, 2015 when they beat then-No. 10 Indiana. Senior **Robby Sagel** netted the lone goal of the night in the double overtime win over the Spartans. Furthermore, Sagel found the game-winner against Indiana off a corner kick. The two goals are Sagel's only goals donning the Blue and White, having both come against nationally-ranked contenders.

NITTANY LION DEFENSE KEEPS PITT TO ONE SHOT

The Penn State defense gave up just one shot to the Panthers in its 1-0 victory Tuesday, Oct. 11. The one shot marked the least amount of shots a **Bob Warming** led team has given up in his six and a half seasons at the helm of the Nittany Lion program. For the second consecutive week, Penn State men's soccer has been awarded with the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week as freshman **Arie Ammann** earned his first career honor getting the win in both matches this past weekend.

Ammann earned the nod for both starts after an injury to senior goalkeeper **Evan Finney** and proved to be a good choice for the Nittany Lions as he played 181:42 minutes on the pitch and conceded just one goal in two matches.

The Round Hill, Va. native made his first start donning the Blue and White in Friday's home-opener against the JMU Dukes in which he made a career-high five saves in the match and tallied his first career shutout. Moving into Monday's contest, Ammann gave up one goal late in the match but held on in the remaining minutes as the Nittany Lions went on to a 2-1 overtime victory over Oakland. Ammann made two saves in the match and picked up his second victory in as many games.

On the week, Ammann tallied seven saves and gave up just one goal. The freshman keeper has made a total of nine saves in 191:01 minutes on the pitch and carries a .818 save percentage.

FINNEY NAMED BIG TEN DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior goalkeeper **Evan Finney** was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week for the period ended Aug 28. The award marks the first of its career and the second consecutive season that the Nittany Lions has earned B1G Defensive Player of the Week honors in opening weekend.

Finney had an outstanding weekend in net for the Nittany Lions, playin 191:32 minutes in goal. The San Francisco, Calif. native returned to his home state to keep the defending National Champion Cardinal scoreless through 110:00 minutes of play. Finney stopped six shots in the match and helped the Nittany Lions to a 0-0 double overtime tie over the No. 1 ranked Stanford Cardinal.

The senior keeper continued to look strong in net for the Blue and White in Sunday's match against UC Berkeley, stopping two shots and allowing just one goal before coming out due to an injury in the second half of play.

OPENING WEEKEND ON THE WEST COAST

The Nittany Lions fended off defending national champion Stanford in its season-opener on the west coast. Warming has an incredible coaching pedigree, including 456 career Division I victories -- second all-time among active Division I coaches and ninth all-time at DI. He was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 after leading PSU to a pair of league titles. Furthermore, Warming leads all Division I active coaches with a 28 combined regular season and conference tournament championships.

THREE NITTANY LIONS LAND PRESEASON HONORS

Seniors Evan Finney, Connor Maloney and Robby Sagel each earned Big Ten Preseason Honors as announced by the conference office. Finney closed out the 2015 season as the starting keeper for the Blue and White tallying a 2-2-1 overall record. The San Francisco, Calif. native earned one shut out and made 22 saves in his junior campaign, playing 476:10 minutes in the net. Maloney heads into the 2016 after earning First Team All-Big Ten for the second time in his career. The starting midfielder scored a team-high seven goals in 2015 and tallied two assists for a teambest 16 points. Finally, Sagel will take the pitch for his second season with the Nittany Lions after transferring to Penn State following his sophomore season. Sagel manned the backline for the Blue and White in 2015 and scored the game-winning goal against then-No. 10 Indiana at the Third Annual Mack Brady Game.

PRESEASON RECAP

Penn State came out strong in its 2016 preseason. The Nittany Lions welcomes University of Nebraska-Omaha to Jeffrey Field for an exhibition match in week two of the preseason. Penn State closed out its preseason slate when it traveled to Pittsburgh for a match against the Riverhounds. After a scoreless first half, the Riverhounds found the back of the net on one occasion to take the 1-0 win over the Blue and White.

DUERNBERGER AND GRIFFITH PROMOTED

Head men's soccer coach **Bob Warming** announced the promotion of **Chad Duernberger** to Associate Head Coach Friday, June 17. Duernberger enters his sixth season at Penn State and his first season as associate head coach for the Nittany Lions. He maintains a role in team training and is also involved in a variety of administrative duties. Duernberger helped the Nittany Lions capture back-to-back Big Ten regular season trophies in 2012 and 2013 and has been on the sidelines during two consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Warming announced the hiring of **Owen Griffith** as an assistant coach for the 2016 season Thursday, July 14. Griffith will work with all positions with an emphasis on defenders and midfielders, while helping with team operations, daily player management and communication. Griffith is entering his second season on the sidelines with Warming in the 2016 campaign. He joined the Penn State men's soccer coaching staff after completing a four-year playing career under Warming and served as a volunteer assistant in the 2015 season.

Should Penn State advance to the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament, the Nittany Lions will take on the winner of the No. 1 Maryland match vs. the winner of the No 8 Michigan/No. 9 Rutgers contest Friday, Nov. 11. The game will be at either 2:30 p.m. or 4 p.m. depending on television and will be played at Grand Park in Westfield, Ind.
