STORYLINES

- ✓ The Lady Lions is now 28-22 all-time in the NCAA Tournament after Sunday's win over UTEP.
- ✓ Penn State is now 14-3 in NCAA Tournament First Round games.
- ✓ PSU is 9-8 in NCAA Tournament Second Round games.
- ✓ Tuesday's game against LSU will be a road game despite that fact that Penn State will be the home team.
- ✓ The Lady Lions have 10 road victories on the season, the most by a Penn State team since the 1993-94 team won 11 contests away from Happy Valley.
- ✓ The Lady Lions are 3-2 all-time against LSU. Penn State and LSU have only met in Baton Rouge once with the Lady Tigers earning an 80-63 victory on Jan. 4, 2003.
- ✓ The teams have never met in the NCAA Tournament.
- ✓ Penn State is 21-27 all-time against SEC opponents.
- ✓ The last time the Lady Lions faced the Lady Tigers, Penn State posted an 83-46 win in the 2003-04 season opener on Nov. 21, 2003. Kelly Mazzante led the PSU charge with 22 points and five rebounds, while Tanisha Wright chipped in 15 points, eight rebounds and eight assists.
- ✓ **Coquese Washington** and Nikki Caldwell will square off for the first time as coaches after each were stellar collegiate players. The pair crossed paths on the basketball court during their collegiate careers with Caldwell's Tennessee Lady Vols getting the best of Washington's Notre Dame Fighting Irish three times (1991, 1992 and 1993). The Lady Vols held serve in Knoxville in 1991 (88-71) and 1993 (79-48) and earned the road win in South Bend in 1992 (85-82).
- ✓ Penn State claims its first back-to-back 25-win seasons since 2002-03 and 2003-04 with the win over UTEP.
- ✓ Penn State is 6-0 in games after a loss this season, beating its opponents by an average of 21.8 points.
- ✓ The Lady Lions made 14 consecutive free throws from the 5:13 mark until the 0:16 mark to seal the win over UTEP Sunday evening.
- ✓ With 23 points against the Miners, **Maggie Lucas** moved into 27th place on Penn State's career scoring charts (1,149).
- ✓ Lucas also moved into a tie for sixth place on Penn State's single-season scoring list (597) with her performance against UTEP. She is tied with Tyra Grant's performance during the 2009-10 season.
- ✓ **Alex Bentley** surpassed the 1,300-point mark for her career (1,317) with 21 markers against UTEP.
- ✓ Lucas had her consecutive free throws made streak stopped at 23 Sunday when she missed with 5:13 remaining in the game. The mark ties her career high for consecutive free throws made, set earlier this year.
- ✓ Lucas (23 pts.) and Bentley (21 pts.) each hit the 20-point plateau versus the Miners. It is the first time since Nebraska (Lucas, 24; Bentley, 23) on Jan. 15, 2012 that the Lady Lions had a pair with 20-point games.
- ✓ Sophomore **Ariel Edwards** returned after missing four games with a leg injury to tally seven points and four rebounds versus UTEP.
- ✓ Junior **Mia Nickson** surpassed the 400-rebound mark for her Penn State career (405) with six boards against the Miners.
- ✓ Junior Nikki Greene narrowly missed a double-double with 12 points and nine rebounds versus the Miners.
- ✓ With the addition of Sunday night's 21-point performance against UTEP, Bentley has scored 20 or more points in each of her first three career NCAA Tournament games. She had 25 points in the first round against Dayton and 21 tallies versus DePaul.
- ✓ Penn State is one of 12 teams to earn 23 or more NCAA Tournament berths.
- ✓ The Lady Lions' No. 4 seed is their the highest since PSU was a fourth seed in the 2005 tourney.
- ✓ The Lady Lions clinched the Big Ten regular-season title outright for the first time since 2004 with a 74-51 win over Minnesota Feb. 26.
- ✓ It is the 6th overall regular-season crown for the Lady Lions and 4th outright (2000, 2003, 2004).
- ✓ **Coquese Washington** was selected as the Big Ten Coach of the Year (coaches & media).
- ✓ Junior guard **Alex Bentley** and sophomore guard **Maggie Lucas** were both named to the All-Big Ten first team after stellar seasons.
- ✓ A first team choice last season, Bentley becomes the ninth different Lady Lion to earn first team accolades twice, while Lucas is the 12th different Penn State player to earn top all-conference honors.
- ✓ The Lady Lions have 26 All-Big Ten first team selections, the most of any team in the Big Ten since joining the conference in 1992-93.
- ✓ Junior center **Nikki Greene** earned third team All-Big Ten honors from the media and an honorable mention nod from the coaches.
- ✓ Senior guard **Zhaque Gray** and junior forward **Mia Nickson** were named Honorable Mention All-Big Ten.
