THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the first-ever meeting between Penn State and North Dakota. The Fighting Hawks are the second of four brand new opponents on the Nittany Lions' schedule this season. Penn State swept LIU to begin the year and have a pair of games each against St. Thomas on the road and Maine at home remaining on the schedule.
- Penn State is 0-3-0 all-time against teams from the NCHC having lost twice to Denver in the NCAA Tournament and once to Western Michigan during the Three Rivers Classic in 2014. The Nittany Lions are being outscored 15-5 in those three contests.
- Senior classmates Ben Copeland and Clayton Phillips are the only two Nittany Lions to have played against North Dakota prior to transferring to Penn State. Copeland has a career 1-9-0 record against the Fighting Hawks with one goal and a pair of assists to his credit. Phillips has one career game against UND as he was a member of the Minnesota Gophers during the 2018 U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame game in Las Vegas, Nevada. North Dakota won that contest 3-1.
- North Dakota is 7-3-1 all-time in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game dating back to its first appearance in 1978 when they lost to Minnesota, 5-3. The Fighting Hawks have won seven-straight U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame games with their last loss coming in 2001 against Minnesota a 7-5 defeat.

YOU'RE MY WONDERWALL

- Junior Kevin Wall paced the nation in goals last weekend with five in a series sweep against Niagara. Wall earned Big Ten First Star of the Week honors following his breakout weekend marking the first time in his career
- Wall scored a pair of goals during Thursday night's 4-0 victory before completing the hat-trick the following night with a penalty shot tally. The hat-trick was the first of his career and the tenth in program history and first in almost two years dating back to November 29, 2019 when Liam Folkes '20 scored three times at Merrimack.
- Wall leads Penn State in scoring with his six goals and seven points and is now second in the Big Ten in goals and tied for fourth in the country just one behind a trio of national leaders who each have seven.
- Of the 10 Hockey Valley Hat-Trick's, nine have occurred on home ice with eight taking place at Pegula Ice Arena. Penn State has had at least one hat-trick in eight of its first 10 seasons as an NCAA Division I program, faling to register one during the 2013-14 season and last season in 2020-21. The Nittany Lions have had multiple hat-tricks in a single-season twice in program history in 2017-18 and 2019-20.
- Wall's penalty shot marked the first for Penn State in over three years dating back to February 3, 2018 when Andrew Sturtz was stopped by Cale Morris in overtime.
 The last player to convert a penalty shot prior to Wall was Brandon Biro on the road at Wisconsin on January 27, 2018.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

 One Nittany Lion could have a little home cooking on his side this weekend as sophomore Chase McLane, a seventh-round selection by Nashville in the 2020 NHL Draft, will skate at Bridgestone Arena for the first time since being drafted by the Predators.

ALL THE WAY TUNED UP

- Senior goaltender Oskar Autio earned his fourth career shutout against Niagara last Thursday to tie Peyton Jones '20 for the all-time program record.
- Autio currently ranks fourth in the Big Ten with a .938 save percentage, a mark good for tenth in the nation while his 1.50 goals-against average is good for second in the Big Ten and sixth in the nation.

I CAN FEEL IT COMING IN THE 'SUUL-EE'-AIR TONIGHT

- Sophomore goaltender Liam Souliere had another strong showing between the pipes last Friday improving to 2-0-0 on the year with a 33-save effort against Niagara.
- Souliere's .945 save percentage is good for second in the Big Ten, behind only Michigan State's Drew DeRidder at .947, and sixth in the nation while his 2.00 goalsagainst average ranks fifth in the Big Ten and 21st nationally.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

- Penn State has scored the opening goal of the game in five out six games so far this season with a record of 5-0-0 when doing so. Over the past five seasons, the Nittany Lions are now 72-17-9 when scoring first.
- Penn State has also held the lead when entering the third period in all five of those games improving to 132-12-10 all-time when leading after 40 minutes.
- Penn State is outscoring its opponents 8-2 in the first period this season having scored at least one first period goal in five of six games.

KILL OR RE KILLED

• Penn State went a perfect 11-for-11 on the penalty kill against Niagara last weekend after going 10-for-10 against Canisius. In total, the Nittany Lions have now killed off 23-straight penalties and lead the Big Ten and rank fourth in the nation at 96.4 percent (27-for-28).

WELCOME TO GOOD BERGER, HOME OF THE GOOD BERGER

- Sophomore Christian Berger collected just one point in 22 games played during the 2020-21 campaign, but is currently second on the team with six points on two goals and four assists through the first six games this season.
- Berger, whose older brother Chase was a two-year captain and is Penn State's all-time leader in games played, is currently riding a career-best three-game point streak (1-4-5).

SCOUTING NORTH DAKOTA

- The Fighting Hawks, currently the No. 6 ranked team in the country, lost seven of their top-10 scorers including each of the top-five from a team that finished the 2020-21 season 22-6-1 bowing out of the NCAA Tournament in a 5OT thriller against Minnesota-Duluth in the Midwest Regional Final.
- In total, UND had eight players sign NHL contracts following the conclusion of the 2020-21 season and have 14 newcomers (five transfers, nine freshmen) on its roster this season.
- UND's highest scoring returner is sophomore Riese Gaber who finished out his freshman season in 2020-21 with 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points. Also returning are Jake Sanderson and Mark Senden after 15 and 14 point seasons, respectively.
- Aston Calder, a transfer from Lake Superior State, has begun his North Dakota career with four goals and seven points over the opening six games to pace the Fighting Hawks. In three seasons with Lake State, Calder scored 33 goals while adding 46 assists for 79 points.
- North Dakota also enters the 2021-22 campaign without the services of its top two highest saving goalies in Adam Scheel (.931 save percentage) and Peter Thome (.872 save percentage). Bemidji State transfer Zach Driscoll, has guarded the net all six games played this season posting a 4-2-0 record with a 2.49 goalsagainst average and a .901 save percentage.
- North Dakota is currently averaging 3.7 goals per game while allowing 2.5 and the Fighting Hawks powerplay ranks 16th in the nation converting at 25 percent (4-for-20). The UND penalty kill is 24-for-27 (88.9 percent), good for 15th in the country.
- Though they are only averaging 25.2 shots per game to Penn State's 40.3, the Fighting Hawks lead the nation in shooting percentage converting shots into goals 14.6 percent of the time.
- North Dakota is 3-0-0 this season when scoring four or more goals and are 44-3-2 since 2018-19 when hitting that mark.



ROOKIE RAMPAGE

- Penn State's freshmen are off to a hot start in Hockey Valley as the five-member class leads Penn State having registered 19 of the team's 61 points through the first six games of the season on seven goals and 12 assists.
- \bullet Penn State is 5-0-0 this season when a freshman scores a goal.

HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-O

- Penn State hit its magic number of five goals during the series finale against Niagara improving to 85-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals. Penn State was 4-0-0 in such games during 2020-21 after going 11-0-0 when scoring five or more goals in 2019-20.
- The Nittany Lions have won 27-straight games when scoring five or more goals, including three so far this season, with the last and only loss coming at Wisconsin on December 1, 2018, an 8-5 defeat.







 Penn State remains on the road to open Big Ten play with a two-game series at Ohio State next Friday and Saturday.

THE B1G GADOWSKY

- Head Coach Guy Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State. Gadowsky is now 160-133-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.
- The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks 74th all-time throughout all divisions with 333 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 42nd with his 333 wins and is currently 14th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Paul DeNaples was selected by his peers as the ninth captain in program history for the 2021-22 season. Senior classmates Adam Pilewicz and Clayton Phillips along with junior Connor McMenamin will serve as alternates.

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 129-of-141 home games where fans were permitted to attend, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games from March 14, 2014 through November 22, 2019.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 87 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds during the 2019-20 season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.
- In 2019-20, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).
- Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season an continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.



Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual

national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn

He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.
