FASTBREAK POINTS

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team plays its first road game outside New York State tonight when the Golden Griffins travel to take on Penn State in State College, Pa.
- ▶ Canisius is 3-4 overall and 1-1 in MAAC play after the Griffis lost at home to Quinnipiac by the score of 78-76 on Dec. 5
- ▶ Canisius' last three losses have come by a total of eight points, including a 98-96 overtime loss at cross-town rival Buffalo Nov. 28.
- ▶ The Griffis come into tonight's game averaging 87.3 points per game, which ranks first in the MAAC and 11th in the country.
- ▶ Canisius has scored 90-plus points in three different games this season. Under fourth-year head coach **Jim Baron**, the Griffis have scored 90 or more points a total of 11 times, where the team is 7-4.
- ▶ Senior guard **Malcolm McMillan** comes into tonight's game averaging 21.3 points per game, which ranks 20th in the country in scoring average. He had a season-low nine points in the Griffis' loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.
- ▶ Junior **Phil Valenti** scored a career-high 25 points in the loss to Quinnipiac. In the team's last three games, he has been good for 18.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per contest.
- ▶ Senior guard **Jamal Reynolds** leads the MAAC in rebounding average at 8.9 boards per game. He is averaging 7.7 rebounds per game in the team's last three outings.
- ▶ Penn State is 5-3 on the year after losing at George Washington on Tuesday.

FIVE NOTES ON THE STARTING FIVE

#1 Malcolm McMillan (G)

- ▶ Ranks 20th in the nation in scoring average with 21.3 points per game.
- ▶ Ranks 87th nationally (16th among guards) in shooting percentage at 54.7 percent
- ▶ Scored a career-high 33 points at Hofstra Nov. 13 in his first career game as a Griff.
- ▶ A fifth-year senior, who graduated from Central Connecticut State last spring.
- ▶ Currently working toward his master's degree in sport administration at Canisius.

#5 Kassius Robertson (G)

- ▶ Had 15 points in the team's loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.
- ▶ Scored in double-figures in 17 of the Griffs' last 25 games, dating back to last season.
- ▶ Has knocked down multiple 3-point field goals in six of the team's seven games this year.
- ▶ Matched a career-high with four assists in the win over Monmouth Dec. 4.
- ▶ Was named to the 2014-15 MAAC All-Rookie Team.

#23 Jamal Reynolds (G)

- ▶ Leads the MAAC and ranks 64th nationally in rebounding average with 8.9 boards per game.
- ▶ Ranks second country with his 5.1 offensive rebounds per game.
- ▶ Is the program's active leader with six career double-doubles (two this season).
- ▶ His 6.6 rebounds per game last season stands as the best rebounding average for a Canisius player in his first year with the program since **Micheal Meeks** in 1992-93.
- ▶ Named a team captain for the 2015-16 season by head coach **Jim Baron**.

#22 Phil Valenti (F)

- ▶ Scored a career-high 25 points to go with nine rebounds in the loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 4.
- ▶ Averaging 18.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game in the team's last three contests.
- ▶ Ranks fourth in the MAAC with his 7.4 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Knocked down a career-high five 3-pointers in the win over Lehigh Nov. 16.
- ▶ Named 2015-16 Preseason All-MAAC Third-Team by the league's 11 head coaches.

#14 Kevin Bleeker (C)

- ▶ Has played more games (87) in a Canisius uniform than any other Griff.
- ▶ Has started the team's last 17 games, dating back to last season.
- ▶ Good for two blocked shots in each of the team's last two games.
- ▶ Has knocked down two 3-pointers in each of the team's last two outings.
- ▶ Already earned his undergraduate degree from Canisius - working toward his master's degree in sport administration at the College.

OFF THE BENCH

#2 Jermaine Crumpton (F)

- ▶ Has scored in double-digits in three of his first four games this season.
- ▶ Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds in the loss to Buffalo Nov. 28.
- ▶ Averaging 22.8 minutes per game. He is the Griffs' first front-court player off the bench.
- ▶ Missed the first three games of the season (suspended for violating team rules).

#10 Cassidy Ryan (F)

- ▶ Knocked down his second career 3-point field goal in the win over Monmouth Dec. 4.
- ▶ Scored a season-high seven points in the Griffs' win over Cornell Nov. 21.
- ▶ One of four left-handed shooters on the Canisius roster.

#11 Chris Atkinson (G)

- ▶ Scored 12 points, on the power of four 3-pointers, in the win over Monmouth Dec. 4.
- ▶ Dished out five assists in the win over Monmouth as well.
- ▶ Tied for the team lead with seven steals this season.
- ▶ Earned All-Long Island honors last spring after finishing his senior year at Long Island Lutheran.

#13 Isaiah Gurley (G)

- ▶ Averaging 5.3 points and 2.7 rebounds per game as a reserve off the bench.
- ▶ Did not play last season, earning a redshirt.
- ▶ Was good for 16.6 points, 7.6 assists and 6.5 rebounds per game in his senior season at George Westinghouse High School.

#25 Adam Weir (G)

- ▶ Twelve of his 17 career makes from 3-point land have come in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ Has played in all 40 career games - sat out the 2013-14 season as a redshirt.
- ▶ Was named the 2012 Allen Wilson Western New York Player of the Year by *The Buffalo News*.

CANISIUS - PENN STATE SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ This will be the third all-time meeting between these two programs, with the Nittany Lions holding a 2-0 lead in the series.
- ▶ Canisius has played in Happy Valley just once before - but there was nothing "happy" about it for the Griffis, as Penn State defeated the Canisius 93-40 on Nov. 16, 2007. That 53-point loss is the largest in program history.
- ▶ Tonight's game in Rec Hall will mark the third different building these two teams have played in. Canisius and Penn State first met in the third-place game of the 1995 NIT in Madison Square Garden and the game here in 2007 was played in the Bryce Jordan Center.

RETURN TO THE REC

- ▶ Tonight's Canisius-Penn State match-up will be played in Rec Hall, which was the Nittany Lions' home court from 1926-96.
- ▶ Penn State played its first Return to the Rec game in the 2013-14 season, where the host school lost to Princeton in overtime.
- ▶ The Nittany Lions are 514-184 (73.6 percent) in Rec Hall, including a 45-game winning streak that ran from 1951 through 1955.

RUN WITH US

- ▶ The up-tempo Canisius men's basketball team starts tonight's game averaging 87.3 points per game, which is the most in the MAAC and 11th in the nation.
- ▶ In the team's first seven games, Canisius has scored a total of 611 points. By comparison, last year's team scored a total of 434 points in the first seven games of the season.
- ▶ The Griffis have posted 85-plus points on the scoreboard five times in the first seven games this season. Last year, Canisius scored more than 85 points just once in a game, and that came March 18, when the Blue and Gold defeated Dartmouth 87-72 in the first round of the CIT.

NEW SHOT CLOCK - SAME GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius has had no trouble adjusting to the NCAA's new shot clock rules, seeing as the Griffis played three games in the CIT last March where the shot clock was set for 30-seconds.
- ▶ Dating back to 2012-13, the Griffis have been charged with a total of eight shot-clock violations in 108 games under head coach **Jim Baron**.
- ▶ In 10 games (including three games in the 2015 CIT) with the 30-second shot clock, Canisius has scored 853 points, an average of 85.3 points per game.

IT'S RAINING THREES

- ▶ Canisius tied a Koessler Athletic Center record with 16 made 3-pointers in the team's 96-86 win over Monmouth Dec. 4.
- ▶ Prior to that Dec. 4 game, the last time Canisius hit 16 3-pointers in a home game was Jan. 10, 2001, when the Griffis drained 16 shots from behind the arc in a win over Siena.
- ▶ The 16 made 3-pointers was one shy of tying the school record for threes in a game, set Dec. 9, 2012 in a road win at Marist.

THE GRIFFS NOT AFRAID TO SHOOT FROM DEEP

- ▶ In four years under head coach **Jim Baron** where the Blue and Gold connected on 10-or more treys in a game 36 times.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold went 16-for-35 from 3-point land in the team's win over Monmouth Dec. 4. The Blue and Gold have knocked down 10 or more treys in four of the team's first seven games of this season.
- ▶ Since Baron took over the program before the 2012-13 season, Canisius has made 872 3-point field goals on 2,399 tries from long range. That breaks down to a 36.3 percent success rate.

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- ▶ The Griffis have good reason to be happy to calendar has rolled over to December.
- ▶ Under head coach **Jim Baron**, Canisius is 17-7 in games played in the final month of the calendar year. Some of those wins include victories over Temple, Stony Brook, cross-town rival Buffalo and MAAC rivals Fairfield and Siena.
- ▶ Prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius only had 11 wins in the month of December from 2008-09 through the 2011-12 campaigns.

LIVING IN THE 90s

- ▶ Canisius has posted 90 or more points in the scoreboard three times this season, making the Griffis one of nine teams in the nation to score 90-plus in three or more games.
- ▶ Canisius posted 96 points in back-to-back games Nov. 28 and Dec. 4 - the first time the Blue and Gold was plus-90 in consecutive games since Feb. 16 and Feb. 20, 2005.
- ▶ In four years under head coach **Jim Baron**, Canisius is 7-4 when scoring 90 or more points in a game.

BARON EARNS WIN NO. 450

- ▶ Canisius' 87-62 win over Cornell Nov. 21, marked the 450th career victory for head coach **Jim Baron**. Baron, who is in his fourth season at the helm of the Canisius program, has been a Division I head coach for 29 years, with stops at St. Francis (Pa.), St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island.
- ▶ Baron's 451 career victories after the team beat Monmouth Dec. 4, are the most among all active men's basketball coaches in the MAAC. He starts tonight's game ranked 81st on the all-time Division I college coaching wins list.

INTERNATIONAL GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius starts the 2015-16 season with six international players, led by senior **Kevin Bleeker**, who was born in Alkmaar, Netherlands.
- ▶ There are four Griffis from Canada on this seasons roster, which is the most for any team in the MAAC.
- ▶ Canisius also has its first Kenyan-born player with the addition of sophomore forward **Ronnie Gombe**.

CANISIUS' LOCAL CONNECTION

- ▶ Two players on Canisius' 2015-16 roster this season are familiar to Western New York, as two sophomore who grew up within a 30-minute drive of the school's Main Street campus, join the active roster.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Adam Weir** (Tonawanda, N.Y.) went to Canisius High School and he is the first Canisius High grad to sign an NLI to join the Griffis since Hall of Famer **Darren Fenn** signed his NLI out of high school in 1997.
- ▶ Fellow sophomore **Jermaine Crumpton** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.) graduated from Niagara Falls High School, a local high school powerhouse that has also produced players like **Paul Harris** and **Johnny Flynn**, who both played at Syracuse.
- ▶ Both players were named to the 2013 *Buffalo News* All-Western New York First Team, with Weir earning the 2012-13 Allen Wilson Player of the Year Award following his senior season at Canisius High.

SOUTHPAW SHOOTERS

- ▶ Canisius is one of five teams in the nation to have four or more left-handed shooters on the roster.
- ▶ Senior **Malcolm McMillan**, juniors **Keifer Douse** and **Phil Valenti** and sophomore **Cassidy Ryan** are all left-handed shooters for the Blue and Gold.
- ▶ Arkansas State and Oakland each have five southpaws on their team, while East Carolina and Texas-Rio Valley Grande also have four lefties.

SHARING IS CARING

- ▶ Last season, Canisius averaged 14.1 assists per game, which ranked second in the MAAC and 71st nationally.
- ▶ The Griffis are averaging 17 assists per game this season after dishing out 13 assists on 27 made field goals against Quinnipiac Dec. 4.
- ▶ Through seven games, Canisius has 119 assists on 206 makes from the field. That means 57.8 percent of Canisius' total field goals come off assists. According to kenpom.com, that ranks as the nation's 75th best assist-to-made field goals ratio. Last season, Canisius ranked 22nd in the same statistical category.

PROTECT THE ROCK

- ▶ Canisius starts tonight's game averaging 12.1 turnovers per game this season after being charged with 11 mistakes in the loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.
- ▶ The Griffis' 12.1 turnovers per game is the second-lowest turnover average in the MAAC and the 106th best turnover average in the nation.
- ▶ Canisius had a season-high 19 turnovers in the loss to Buffalo Nov. 28, and the team comes into tonight's game averaging 14.7 turnovers per game in its last three outings.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ Canisius ended the 2014-15 season with a 14-1 record when holding the lead with less than 5:00 left on the clock and the team was a perfect 15-0 when being in the lead in the game's final 2:00.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold is 31-1 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ Canisius led by three points with 5:00 left on the clock in the Nov. 13 loss at Hofstra. The Griffis are 28-4 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half.

McMILLAN TO RUN THE POINT FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius senior **Malcolm McMillan** will serve as the Griff's primary point guard this season in his first year wearing the Blue and Gold.
- ▶ A native of Baltimore, McMillan came to Canisius after earning his undergraduate degree from Central Connecticut State. There, he played in 91 games, making 87 starts before having his senior season (2014-15) cut short by a back injury.
- ▶ McMillan is one of 88 Division I men's basketball players from the Baltimore area. Recently, he was named as one of the top-20 D-I players from Baltimore by the *Baltimore Sun* sports staff.
- ▶ McMillan scored a career-high 33 points in his first game in a Canisius uniform at Hofstra Nov. 13 after he went 13-for-20 from the field, 4-for-9 from 3-point land and 3-for-3 from the free-throw line. He also had six assists in the loss to the Pride.

NO. 1 EQUALS NO. 20

- ▶ Canisius senior **Malcolm McMillan** starts tonight's game ranked 20th in the nation in scoring average with 21.3 points per game in his first seven games as a Golden Griffin.
- ▶ A native of Baltimore, scored a career-high 33 points at Hofstra Nov. 13, and then followed that effort with 31 points in Canisius' 98-89 win over Lehigh Nov. 16.
- ▶ McMillan was held to a season-low nine points in the Griff's home loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.
- ▶ Prior to the game at Hofstra Nov. 13, McMillan's career-high for a game was 26, which he scored Jan. 19, 2013 against Mount St. Mary's.

McMILLAN TO THE LINE

- ▶ Canisius senior **Malcolm McMillan** made a career-high 12 free-throws on 13 attempts in the Griff's loss to St. Bonaventure Nov. 24.
- ▶ Coming into tonight's game, McMillan has been to the line a team-high 46 times, which is third-most in the MAAC. He's connected on 40 of those trips, and his 87 percent effort from the stripe ranks fifth in the league and 67th nationally.

McMILLAN DISHING OUT ASSISTS, TOO

- ▶ Senior **Malcolm McMillan** matched a season-high with six assists in the team's loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5, the 30th time in his college career where he's been credited with five or more assists in a ball game.
- ▶ Entering tonight's contest, McMillan ranks seventh in the MAAC and 163rd in the nation in assists per game with 4.1 helpers per contest. He also fifth in the MAAC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.9.

VALENTI SCORES CAREER-HIGH IN LOSS

- ▶ Junior forward **Phil Valenti** scored a career-high 25 points to go along with nine rebounds, an assist and a steal in the team's 78-76 loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.
- ▶ In the team's last three contests, the Victor, N.Y., native is averaging 18.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Valenti starts tonight's game ranked 12th in the MAAC in scoring average with his 15.1 points per game, and he's ranked fourth in the league with his 7.4 rebounds per contest.

VALENTI FOR THREE

- ▶ Junior forward **Phil Valenti** scored 19 points in the team's win over Lehigh Nov. 16 on the power of five makes from 3-point land.
- ▶ The five makes from long-range for the Victor, N.Y., native is a new career high. Four of those treys came in the game's final 20 minutes, where the Griff's outscored Lehigh by a 59-48 clip.
- ▶ Last season, Valenti made 12 3-point field goals in 24 games. He starts tonight's action with 14 makes from behind the arc in seven games.

REYNOLDS CLEANS THE GLASS

- ▶ Canisius senior **Jamal Reynolds** starts tonight's game as the MAAC leader in rebounding average with 8.9 boards per contest. That number ranks 64th best nationally.
- ▶ Of his 62 total rebounds, the Pickering, Ontario native has pulled down 36 offensive rebounds. He ranks second in the nation with his 5.1 offensive rebounds per game.
- ▶ Reynolds had six offensive rebounds in the team's loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5. He has at least one offensive rebound in 34 of his 40 career games with the Canisius program.
- ▶ The senior guard was good for 6.6 rebounds per game last season, which ranked second on the team behind former teammate **Josiah Heath**.
- ▶ A newcomer getting 6.6 boards per game is an impressive accomplishment - but a deeper look makes it even more impressive. Reynolds' 6.6 rebounds per game last year stands as the highest rebounding average for a first-year Canisius player since former Griff **Micheal Meeks** averaged 7.1 rebounds per game in his freshman season in 1992-93.

KASSIUS HAS A CAREER DAY

- ▶ Canisius sophomore **Kassius Robertson** had a career-day Nov. 28, at Buffalo, as he scored a game-high 24 points in the Griff's 98-96 overtime loss to the Bulls.
- ▶ A member of the 2014-15 MAAC All-Rookie Team, Robertson has been good for 10-plus points in the scoring column 17 times in the team's last 25 games, dating back to last season, after he posted 15 points in the Griff's loss to Quinnipiac Dec. 5.

KASSIUS IS CASH-MONEY FROM DEEP

- ▶ Canisius sophomore **Kassius Robertson** knocked down a career-high five 3-point field goals in the team's overtime loss at Buffalo Nov. 28. For Robertson, his 24 points in the losing effort were a new career high.
- ▶ The Toronto native leads the team with 18 makes from behind the arc this season, and he starts tonight's game ranked seventh in the MAAC and 122nd in the nation with 2.6 3-point makes.
- ▶ So far this year, he's shooting 36.7 percent from long-range, which is 135th in the country.

CRUMPTON BRINGS A SCORING PUNCH

- ▶ Sophomore forward **Jermaine Crumpton** is averaging 10 points per game this year in his first four games of the season, highlighted by his 16-point effort in the loss at Buffalo Nov. 28.
- ▶ The Niagara Falls, N.Y., native missed the team's first three games, as he served a suspension for violating team rules.
- ▶ In addition to his 16 points, "Crump" also added nine rebounds in the loss at Buffalo, which is a new career high.

THE NEW GUY SERVES THEM UP

- ▶ Freshman guard **Chris Atkinson** recorded a career-high five assists in the team's win over Monmouth Dec. 5.
- ▶ Atkinson scored 12 points off the bench, one of seven Canisius players in double-figures, in the team's win over the Hawks. He scored all 12 of his points on the power of four made 3-pointers.

THE DUTCHMAN IN THE MIDDLE

- ▶ Senior center **Kevin Bleeker** has played more games as a Griff (87) than any other player on this year's active roster.
- ▶ The Alkmaar, Netherlands, native is averaging 8.0 points and 4.7 rebounds this season for the Blue and Gold. He has been credited with two blocks in each of the team's last two games as well and starts tonight tied for eighth in the MAAC in blocked shots per game average.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griff's own an all-time record of 211-122 (.634 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center, but are 90-90 (.500 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Athletic Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

CANISIUS IN THE CLOSE ONES

- ▶ Canisius is 16-23 in games decided by two points or less since 2001-02 and 29-44 in games decided by four points or less, dating back to 2004-05.
- ▶ The Griff's are 59-94 in games decided by six points or less, dating back to the 2002-03 season.

BARON NAMES 2015-16 CAPTAINS

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** named seniors **Kevin Bleeker**, **Malcolm McMillan** and **Jamal Reynolds** team captains for the 2015-16 season.

CANISIUS GREAT BOB MACKINNON PASSES AWAY

- ▶ On the afternoon of July 7, former Canisius student-athlete, head basketball coach and athletic director **Bob MacKinnon** passed away at the age of 87.
- ▶ MacKinnon, who was a member of Canisius' graduating Class of 1950, was the program's head coach from 1959-72, where he posted 142 career wins, which ranks second all-time in program history.
- ▶ A member of the College's first Sports Hall of Fame Class in 1963, MacKinnon grew up in Buffalo and played hoops for the Blue and Gold from 1946-50. There, he tallied 591 career points in 103 games, and he ended his career as a second-team All-American, as named by *Sporting News*.
- ▶ During his tenure as the Griff's athletic director, MacKinnon served on the selection committee for the NIT, the NCAA All-American selection committee and he was also an NCAA Rules Committee member. He left Canisius in 1972 when he joined the coaching staff for the Buffalo Braves.
- ▶ Later on in his professional career, he served as the head coach for the Spirits of St. Louis in the ABA and he also held the positions of general manager, lead scout and head coach for the New Jersey Nets.

CANISIUS LOSES HALL OF FAME TOM CHESTER

- ▶ Former Canisius mens basketball star **Tom Chester**, a member of the Canisius Class of 1963, passed away May 26 in Savannah, Texas. He was 73 years old.
- ▶ A two-sport athlete at Canisius, Chester was enshrined into the school's Sports Hall of Fame in 1974.
- ▶ Chester played 70 career games for the Griffs from 1960-63, where he tallied 1.017 career points to go with 695 career rebounds. Those 695 career boards ranks 12th on the school's career rebounding list.
- ▶ As a senior, Chester led the Blue and Gold to the 1963 NIT Championship game in Madison Square Garden, where the team fell to Providence 81-66. In that game, Chester had a team-high 21 points in the losing effort.

GRIFFS ADD FOLEY, JOHNSON DURING EARLY PERIOD

- ▶ Canisius head men's basketball coach **Jim Baron** recently announced that the team signed **Spencer Foley** and **Malik Johnson** to NLI's during the NCAA's early signing period.
- ▶ Foley is a 6-foot-6, 185-pound guard who plays at the Commonwealth Academy in Springfield, Mass. Prior to playing at Commonwealth Academy, he earned first-team all-state Class AA in Illinois after he helped lead Uplift Community High School in Chicago to a Class AA state championship.
- ▶ Johnson, a 5-foot-10, 155-pound guard from Blue Ridge School in St. George, Va., was named the 2015 VISAA Division 2 Player of the year. He led the Barons to the VISAA Division 2 state crown after he posted 12.8 points, 5.2 assists, 3.4 rebounds and 2.8 steals per game in his junior season.
- ▶ Foley is the first player in Commonwealth Academy program history to sign a Division I NLI, while Johnson follows in the footsteps of his older brother Robert, who is a sophomore guard at Indiana.

PRO GRIFFS

- ▶ Former Canisius men's basketball player **Josiah Heath** is the latest former Golden Griffin to sign to play professionally overseas. The 6-foot-9 power forward signed to play with Aris Leeuwarden of the Holland Eredivisie.
- ▶ Heath joins his older brother and former Canisius teammate **Jordan Heath**, who is currently in his second season as a professional basketball player in Europe. Jordan Heath currently plays with Proximus Spirou in Belgium, where he is joined on the roster with fellow Canisius grad **Billy Baron**.
- ▶ In the four seasons since Baron took over the Canisius program, a total of six former Griffs have signed to play pro hoops overseas.

FROM CANISIUS TO... THE NFL?

- ▶ Canisius has not sponsored varsity football since 2002. That fact didn't stop former Griff **Chris Manhertz**.
- ▶ Manhertz, a former three-time team captain who graduated from Canisius with both his undergrad and master's degrees in 2014, earned a spot on the New Orleans Saints' practice squad this past summer after closing out training camp with the team.
- ▶ The Bronx, N.Y., native originally signed with the Buffalo Bills last December, but was released midway through training camp. He signed with New Orleans as a free agent and then earned a spot on the squad's practice team after training camp ended in early September.
- ▶ Manhertz played four years of hoops at Canisius, where he started 94 of the 116 career games he appeared in. He averaged 6.5 points and 6.8 rebounds per game in his career, and he closed out his time on Main Street as just the second player in the last 30 years to lead Canisius in rebounding average three years in a row.
- ▶ Manhertz plays tight end for the Saints, which is somewhat ironic, seeing as he never played organized football prior to reporting to the Buffalo Bills' first team workouts in April of 2015.

UP NEXT

- ▶ Canisius travel to Kent State on Dec. 10, for a Saturday night game as part of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic, an exempt event that will also see the Blue and Gold play two games in Las Vegas Dec. 22-23.
- ▶ The Griffs and the Golden Flashes will be meeting for the fourth time in series history, and the game on Saturday will mark the first meeting between the programs since Dec. 31, 1983.
- ▶ Canisius leads the all-time series, which began Dec. 29, 1972 in Buffalo, by a 2-1 count.

- ▶ Canisius named **Jim Baron** the program's 23rd head coach in program history April 2, 2012.
- ▶ In his 28-year head coaching career, Baron has won 451 career games, has posted nine 20-win seasons and he's taken 11 teams at four different Division I schools to the postseason.
- ▶ By helping lead Canisius to the 2015 CIT, Baron is the first coach in program history to lead the Griffins to the postseason in each of his first three years at the helm of the Blue and Gold.
- ▶ Baron is the first Canisius coach in program history to lead the program to three-straight winning records in MAAC play after last year's team posted an 11-9 MAAC record.
- ▶ Prior to coming to Canisius, Baron served as the head coach at Rhode Island for 11 seasons, where he posted 184 total wins with six postseason appearances (all 20-win campaigns) and led the team to a four-week stint in the Associated Press Top-25 poll during the 2007-08 season.
- ▶ Baron was the head coach at his alma mater, St. Bonaventure, from 1992-01, and he led the Bonnies to their first NCAA appearance in 39 years when the team played Kentucky in the 2000 NCAA Tournament First Round.
- ▶ In all, Baron has been named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year four times. Only former Temple head coach and Basketball Hall of Famer **John Cheney** has won that award more than Baron.
- ▶ He got his first head coaching job at St. Francis (PA) in Loretto, Pa. He coached the team to the 1991 NEC championship and 1991 NCAA Tournament, the Red Flash's only NEC crown and NCAA Tournament berth.
- ▶ Baron served as an assistant coach for nine seasons at four different schools, including his alma mater, St. Bonaventure. He was a member of **Digger Phelps'** staff at Notre Dame for 1981-87.
- ▶ The Brooklyn, N.Y., native got his coaching career started at Aquinas High School in Rochester, N.Y.
- ▶ Baron won four varsity letters at St. Bonaventure as a player, where the team went 72-38 in four years.
- ▶ As a senior captain in 1977, Baron helped lead the Bonnies to a 24-6 record and the 1977 NIT Championship.
- ▶ Baron and his wife, Cindy, have two children - sons **Jimmy** and **Billy**. Both of his sons have played for him at the collegiate level.
- ▶ Baron's sons currently play for Proximus Spirou in Charleroi, Belgium. They are joined on that team by former Canisius power forward **Jordan Heath**.
- ▶ Billy was the 2013-14 MAAC Player of the Year and an Associated Press All-America selection, while Jimmy finished his college career at Rhode Island as the Atlantic 10's all-time leader in career made 3-point field goals.
- ▶ Baron is active in numerous charitable groups, including the American Cancer Society Coaches vs. Cancer program and Camp Good Days and Special Times.
- ▶ He is a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) International Coaches Group as well.
- ▶ He has been inducted into the St. Bonaventure Hall of Fame and the New England Basketball Hall of Fame as well.
- ▶ Since coming to Canisius, Baron has inserted himself in the Buffalo community, stressing to local youth groups and boy's clubs the importance of "Books and Basketball".
- ▶ His stance on strong academics is not just for the local youth in the Buffalo area - he also stresses school work with his players as well. In his head coaching career, all but two of his former players that played for him for four seasons have earned their undergraduate degrees.
