NOTABLES

- Saturday's game is the Panthers' first away from Pittsburgh this season. Pitt started the year with 10 consecutive home games, including an exhibition contest against IUP. It was the Panther's longest home stand since playing the first 11 games of the 1975-76 season in Pittsburgh.
- The Panthers lead the ACC in scoring defense (52.4 ppg), free throw percentage (.752) and assist/turnover ratio (+1.5).
- Jasmine Whitney leads the ACC with two games of 10 assists or more this season, tied with Alexis Peterson of Syracuse. She tops the Panthers with 4.6 assists per game with a +2.9 assist/turnover ratio.

A WIN WOULD...

- Improve the Panthers to 8-2 overall, extending their best start to a season since 2009-10 when they started the year at 9-1, with the lone loss being the team's last meeting at Penn State (Dec. 12, 2009).
- Be Pitt's first at Bryce Jordan Center (currently 0-8) and its first road win at Penn State since Nov. 30, 1988 (currently 1-17).
- Be the Panther's first against the Nittany Lions since Nov. 24, 2008, at Petersen Events Center (80-59).
- Be Pitt's first true road win in non-conference play since defeating St. Francis (Pa.), 72-59, Nov. 16, 2015.

LAST TIME OUT

Sophomore forward Brenna Wise recorded the 10th double-double of her career and her third of the season for Pitt in a 76-60 win over Bryant Tuesday night at Petersen Events Center. With the win, the Panthers snapped a two-game losing skid. It marked the 600th victory in program history, improving the all-time record to 600-620 (.492).

SCOUTING THE NITTANY LIONS

Penn State (7-2, 0-0 Big Ten) is riding a three-game win streak into Saturday's meeting, picking up a victory at Boston College (60-56) in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, then defeating Marshall (82-80) and Holy Cross (84-48). Sophomore guard Teniya Page leads the team with 20.3 points per game, and Kaliyah Mitchell is the top rebounder with 6.9 per game.

THE SERIES

The Nittany Lions lead the all-time series, 27-13, and are 17-1 against Pitt when playing in University Park. The Panthers' lone road win came in Year 1 A.S. (After Suzie) on Nov. 30, 1988, at Rec Hall (74-70). The teams played annually from 1974 to 2009, only missing the 1991-92 season.

Pitt has never won at Bryce Jordan Center, at 0-8 since the arena opened in 1995. The Panthers' last win in the series came Nov. 24, 2008, at Petersen Events Center when senior Xenia Stewart scored her 1,000th career point in Pitt's largest margin of victory over Penn State in school history, 80-59.

HOMECOMING

Saturday's game will be a homecoming for fourth-year Pitt head coach Suzie McConnell-Serio as well as first-year Director of Operations Brienne O'Rourke. Both are Penn State women's basketball alumnae, with McConnell-Serio playing from 1984-88 and O'Rourke from 2005-10. O'Rourke played high school basketball for McConnell-Serio at Oakland Catholic in Pittsburgh.

McConnell-Serio's number 32 is one of four retired women's basketball numbers at Penn State. In four seasons at PSU (1984-85 through 1987-88), she helped the Nittany Lions to a 95-33 record and four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. In the process, she was named the school's first First-Team All-American while setting NCAA Division I records for career assists (1,307), assists in a season (355 in 1987) and season assist average (11.8 in 1987). Her assist total and assist per game average led the nation in both 1986 and 1987.

O'Rourke was a four-year letterwinner at Penn State

from 2005-10. She earned Big Ten Conference honors in each year of her career, including being named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team in 2006. During her senior season she became the sixth player in school history to record 1,000 points and 500 assists in a career.

WELL-ROUNDED PANTHERS

Pitt leads the ACC with five different players who have recorded at least one double-double this season. Below is a list of Panthers with double-doubles in 2016-17:

PROTECT THE ROCK

Through games of Dec. 8, Pitt holds the best assist/turnover ratio in the ACC at +1.5 and rank fourth in the nation. Three Panthers rank in the top 10 in the league in assist/turnover ratio: Jasmine Whitney (sixth, +2.9), Kauai Bradley (seventh, +2.8) and Aysia Bugg (10th, +2.4)

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Pitt has played three games so far this year in which five Panthers reached double-figure scoring: in the season-opening win against Mount St. Mary's (Nov. 12) against Loyola Maryland (Nov. 21) and Slippery Rock (Nov. 23). Prior to this season, the last time the Panthers had five reach double-figures in a game was a 97-59 rout of St. Francis (Pa.) on Dec. 28, 2014.

WHITNEY, BRADLEY EARN WEEKLY ACCOLADES

Freshman Jasmine Whitney and sophomore Kauai Bradley earned weekly honors for their respective performances in the Panthers' first two games of 2016-17. On Monday, Nov. 14, Whitney claimed the year's first ACC Rookie of the Week title, and Bradley was named the First National Bank Female Athlete of the Week on Tuesday, Nov. 15.

Whitney led the Panthers with a double-double of 17 points and 11 assists in her collegiate debut in Pitt's 89-54 win over Mount St. Mary's (Nov. 12). She went 6-of-7 from the field, while making the first six

consecutive shots of her career, including a perfect 5-of-5 performance from beyond the arc. The honor is the first of her career. She is the second Panther in program history to earn the award, and the first since Yacine Diop did for the week of Dec. 8, 2014.

Bradley led the Panthers with a scoring average of 14.5 points over the first two contests of the season, and added 8.0 rebounds while shooting a blistering 58.8 percent from the field (10-of-17). She shot 57.1 percent from long range (4-of-7) and went 5-of-6 (83.3 percent) from the free throw line. She posted career highs of 16 points and 10 rebounds in her first career double-double against Mount St. Mary's (Nov. 12) and followed that performance with 13 points, six rebounds and career-high totals of four blocks and four steals against Youngstown State (Nov. 14).

TOUGHEST LEAGUE IN THE NATION

Seven ACC teams are ranked in this week's AP Poll, the most in a single week in ACC history. Joining Notre Dame (2), Florida State (7), Louisville (8), Miami (14) and Syracuse (20), which have been ranked in each poll this season, are No. 21 Duke and No. 25 Virginia Tech. The Hokies are ranked for the first time since January of 2006.

The USA Today Sports Preseason Top 25 women's basketball coaches poll featured five ACC teams ranked in the Top 25, including four in the top 13 - the most of any league. Notre Dame was the highest ranked ACC at No. 2, followed by No. 8 Louisville, No. 12 Florida State, No. 13 Syracuse and No. 20 Miami. ACC teams receiving votes include Duke, NC State and Georgia Tech.

EIGHTH ANNUAL SCHOOL DAY

The Panthers defeated Youngstown State, 63-50, on their eighth annual School Day game Monday, Nov. 14. The 9,771 fans at Petersen Events Center marked a record attendance for the event. Pitt is 6-2 all-time when hosting School Day, dropping decisions in 2012 and 2014. The Panthers faced Youngstown State on School Day twice prior to Monday's game, in 2010 and 2012.

THREE NEW FACES

Three newcomers highlight the Pitt roster in true freshmen guards Jasmine Whitney and Alayna Gribble, as well as DePaul graduate transfer center Brandi Harvey-Carr.

A native of Centreville, Va., Whitney is a 5-foot-9 point guard. She was rated the 25th best position player in her class by ESPN and was a 4-star recruit according to ProspectNation.com. She led Paul VI High School to four consecutive state titles and an overall record of 123-12 in her four years on the team.

Gribble, a local product out of Norwin High School, is a 6-foot shooting guard who was ranked the 33rd best position player in the country and the 118th overall by ProspectNation.com. She was the 2015 Pittsburgh Post-Gazette AAAA Player of the Year and led her team to the WPIAL title. She was also the 2015 Greenburg Tribune Review Player of the Year, the Daily News Athlete of the Year and was named to the USJN Nike U17 National Championship All-Star Team.

Harvey-Carr comes to Pittsburgh after spending the last three-plus seasons at DePaul. Over the course of four years, the 6-foot-4 center appeared in 102 games. She brings much-needed height and stature to the Pitt roster.

YOUNG BLOOD

Reminiscent of last season, the Panthers' roster is made up largely of underclassmen. This year, the team includes two freshmen, six sophomores, two juniors and two graduate students. All players on the roster have two or fewer seasons of experience with the Panthers.

Despite their youth, the Panthers return much-needed experience in their top two scorers from 2015-16, Brenna Wise (10.7 ppg) and Yacine Diop (10.4 ppg). Wise also led the team in rebounding (7.6 per game) and was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Jaala Henry, a 6-foot-3 post hailing from Riverdale, Md., was named the No. 39 best prospect in the nation by All Star Girls Report. ESPN ranked her No. 16 for her position and gave her a No. 90 scout grade. She also landed a top-30 ranking for her position by Dan Olson. In 2015, she was invited to play with the USA Basketball Women's U16 National Team. Henry will graduate from National Christian Academy in 2017.

"Jaala Henry fits our system both offensively and defensively," McConnell-Serio said. "She will allow us to play a high possession game and has the potential to impact our interior game immediately."



Cara Judkins is a 6-foot-3 forward from Olney, Md., who attends Our Lady of Good Counsel. She earned All-WCAC first team honors in 2016 and was named a Washington Post All-Met honorable mention. Other accolades include: All-County Private Schools first team (2016), All-Montgomery County first team (2016), and All-Sentinel Basketball Team (2015). She is a two-time Adidas All-American (2015, 2016) and played on the Adidas US Select Team that traveled to Treviso, Italy, in June 2016 to play against top European talent over a seven-day period. Judkins is ranked as a four-star recruit by ProspectsNation.com and is currently placed at No. 20 for her position by ESPN Hoopgurlz. She holds a 3.8 GPA as a senior and plans to study linguistics at Pitt.

"Cara Judkins is a true center with exceptional hands and footwork," McConnell-Serio said. "Her strength and versatility on the block make her a constant threat. Cara plays hard, can really score inside as well as extend her game to the perimeter."



Pika Rodriguez is a 5-foot-11 forward at Capital Prep Magnet School in Hartford, Conn. She has led her high school to three consecutive Connecticut State Championships. As a junior, she reached the 1,000-point milestone for her career, averaging 17 points and five rebounds per game. She received all-state second team honors from the New Haven Register in 2016 and earned all-conference second team honors for the 2015 Constitution State Conference Central Division. This past summer, she played on the Puerto Rican U18 National Team, garnering All-FIBA Americas first team honors. Rodriguez holds a 3.3 GPA as a senior.

"Pika Rodriguez can flat-out shoot the ball and with deep range," McConnell-Serio said. "She impacts the game at both ends with her size, ability to score and great instincts. Pika has competed at a high level and brings international experience, as well."

ACC TOURNAMENT MOVES TO MYRTLE BEACH

The 2017 Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will be held March 1-5 at the HTC Center on the campus of Coastal Carolina University in Conway, South Carolina.

The tournament will make its seventh appearance in the state of South Carolina and its first since a five-year run in Rock Hill from 1992-96. The HTC Center, which opened in the summer of 2012, is located a short drive from Myrtle Beach.

This year's ACC Women's Basketball Tournament will feature all 15 league teams. Play opens with three first-round games on Wednesday, March 1, and

concludes with the championship game on Sunday, March 5.

A proven winner at every level, Suzie McConnell-Serio enters her fourth season as head coach of the Pitt women's basketball team.

A member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and a two-time Olympic medalist as a player, McConnell-Serio inherited a Pitt team in 2013 that was winless in conference for two year before arriving, and quickly turned the Panthers into a contender.

In just her second season, McConnell-Serio guided the Panthers to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Pitt's first NCAA appearance since 2009, and the tenth-seeded Panthers notched a first round victory over seventh-seeded and 17th-ranked Chattanooga, snapping the Mocs' 25-game winning streak.

The Panthers had one of the biggest turnarounds in the country in 2015, going from 11-20 in McConnell-Serio's first year to 20-12 in year two. For her efforts, she was named a Naismith National Coach of the Year semifinalist.

In 2016, Pitt was one of the youngest teams in the country which featured a roster with zero seniors, three juniors and nine underclassmen.

Despite the youth, the talent was evident as freshman Brenna Wise became Pitt's first player named to the ACC All-Freshman Team. Wise led the team in both scoring (10.7 ppg) and rebounding (7.6). Her rebounds per game average led all ACC freshmen and it ranked her eighth overall in the league.

McConnell-Serio also guided the Panthers to their first ever win in the ACC tournament in 2016 with an 82-72 overtime victory against North Carolina in the opening round.

Following the conclusion of the 2015-16 season, McConnell-Serio was named the USA Basketball Women's U18 National Team Head Coach. In July 2016, she led the squad to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Tournament in Valdivia, Chile.

McConnell-Serio has won 20 games in six of the nine seasons as a collegiate coach. Two of the three years she did not win 20 games were in her first year of taking over a new program (2007-08 at Duquesne, 2013-14 at Pitt). She has a career coaching record of 167-118 (.586).
