### Preseason recognition

- BYU was picked to finish first in the WCC coaches poll for 2016.
- Nadia Gomes is on the 2016 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List, making her the seventh player in program history to be on the list.
- Ashley Hatch, Nadia Gomes, Elena Medeiros and Michele Vasconcelos were selected to the All-WCC Preseason Team.
- Last season, forward Nadia Gomes was named WCC Player of the Year and goalkeeper Rachel Boaz was named WCC Goalkeeper of the Year. Elena Medeiros and Michele Vasconcelos also made the All-WCC First Team, while Bizzy Phillips Bowen was selected to the All-WCC Second Team. Taylor Campbell Isom earned All-WCC honorable mention and Madie Siddoway was named to the All-WCC Freshman Team.
- BYU was ranked 16th in the inaugural NSCAA (coaches) Poll.
- Rachel Boaz was named one of the NCAA's five toughest goalkeepers to beat by the NCAA.

### Team accomplishments and trends

- BYU lost its 18-game home win streak dating back to 2014 on Aug. 22 against Nebraska. The streak was the longest in the nation.
- The Cougars had won five straight against Big Ten teams before dropping Monday's game to Nebraska.
- Having held their first two opponents in 2016 to one goal each, BYU has held 21 of their last 23 opponents, dating back to the beginning of 2015, to one or zero goals.
- The Cougars are one of four teams in the nation to have won the regular season conference championship in at least four straight years. Only Florida Gulf Coast of the Atlantic Sun Conference has won more consecutive titles at six. BYU, West Virginia (Big 12) and San Diego State (MWC) are tied with four each.
- BYU has won four-straight conference championships for the second time in program history and the third time in WCC history. BYU accomplished the feat from 1999-2002 in the Mountain West Conference, while Portland (2007-2010) and Santa Clara (2001-2004) have each won four-straight WCC titles.

### Player accomplishments and trends

- Rachel Boaz's goals against average of .44 is the best in program history, as is her save percentage of .892.
- With two goals against Washington State, Ashley Hatch passed assistant coach Aleisha Rose and Jaime Rendich Beck on the all-time scoring list to sit alone at ninth in program history with 30 career goals. Hatch is ranked fourth all-time in multiple-goal games (6) and 11th in points (75).
- BYU has four true freshmen — Danika Bowman, Lizzy Braby, Elise Flake and Brynlee Welch — who all played at least 15 minutes against Washington State and Nebraska. Bowman and Braby have both started at least one game, with Bowman playing every minute of both games. Redshirt freshman Alyssa Jefferson has also started both games.

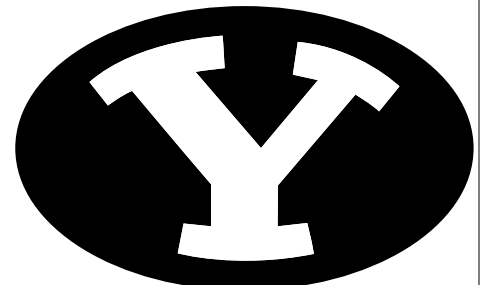
