

### PENN STATE HEADS TO HOOSIER COUNTRY FOR MATCH AGAINST IU

The Penn State men's soccer team continues its short road stint when it travels to Bloomington, Ind. Saturday Oct. 8 for a 7:30 p.m. match against Indiana University. The match will mark the third top 10 team that the Nittany Lions have taken on this season as Indiana comes into the match at No. 6 in week six of the 2016 campaign. For fans who are unable to make it the match, it will be aired on BTN Plus (\$) and live stats will be made available at IUHoosiers.com.

#### **SERIES HISTORY WITH THE HOOSIERS**

Despite Indiana carrying the advantage in the all-time series with Penn State, the Nittany Lions have been closing the gap in the past few seasons.

The Blue and White notched a 1-0 victory over then-No. 10 Indiana on Mack Brady Day in 2015 off a **Robby Sagel** goal. Prior to that, Penn State traveled to Bloomington, Ind. in both 2013 and 2014 and brought wins back to Happy Valley, including handing the Hoosiers their first Big Ten opening day loss in the history of the program in the 2014 campaign.

The Nittany Lions also played Indiana to a 0-0 draw in double overtime at the 2013 Big Ten Tournament, but fell in penalty kicks, 5-3, allowing the Hoosiers to advance to the finals.

#### **KEEPING INDIANA SCORELESS**

Penn State is looking to close the gap a little tighter this year in the all-time series as it travels to Bloomington, Ind. for the first time since the 2014 season when it brought back a 1-0 victory over the Hoosiers.

In the last five years Penn State has seen a lot of success against Indiana, coming away with five wins and losing once in a shootout at the Big Ten Tournament in the 2013 campaign. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions have not given up a goal in regulation play to the Hooisers in 450 minutes, dating back to 2011, and are hoping to continue that trend on Saturday.

#### **SCOUTING INDIANA**

The Hoosiers have quickly risen to the top of the rankings, coming in as the No. 6 team in the Saturday match. Indiana has a 6-1-4 overall record and is 1-0-3 in conference matches. IU currently leads the Big Ten Conference with 209 total shots and 87 corners on the season, while ranking second in goals with 14. Indiana strikers Richard Ballard and Tanner Thompson tie for third in the B1G with four goals and tie for sixth with 10 overall points. In net, Colin Webb paces the league with six shoutouts in the 2016 campaign and ranks fourth with 32 saves on the season.

#### **NITTANY LIONS LOOKING FOR FIRST ROAD WIN**

When Penn State heads to Bloomington, Ind. it will be looking to secure its first home win of the 2016 campaign. So far this season the Nittany Lions are 0-3-1 on the road with its tie coming against then-No. 1 Stanford.

#### **GETTING BACK TO SCORING**

The Nittany Lions have suffered a two-game scoring drought after scoring muliple goals in three-straight games this season. Prior to being shut out against Temple and at Michigan, Penn State had tallied six goals in three matches and picked up two Big Ten wins in that time period.

#### **NITTANY LIONS IN THE BIG TEN**

Coming into the fourth week of conference action, Penn State ranks third in goals per game with 1.30. The Nittany Lions' 13 goals on the season also tie for third with Ohio State and are only one goal shy of tying for second with Indiana.

Individually, senior **Connor Maloney** ties for second with four goals on the season and ranks second with 0.50 goals per game in 2016. The Harrisburg, Pa. native also ranks third in the conference with 11 points on the season and tied for third with three assists. Redshirt-junior goalkeeper **Evan Finney** leads the Big Ten with a .864 save percentage and a 0.62 goals against average while ranking second in the conference with 3.80 saves per match.

Entering his seventh season as Penn State's 11th coach in its storied history, Bob Warming has made his impact known in his first five years. Twice named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 by leading the Nittany Lions to back-to-back Big Ten titles, Warming has added a pair of trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2010, 2013), and led the Lions to three straight postseason appearances.

Warming led the Nittany Lions to a 7-8-3 overall record and a 2-4-2 Big Ten Conference record in the 2015 campaign. The Blue and White earned an overtime victory over Michigan State in the Big Ten Tournament play in match before falling to eventual Big Ten Champion Ohio State in the quarterfinals in overtime. Junior Connor Maloney paced Penn State, starting 17 matches with a team leading 17 points that included seven goals and two assists en route to his second First Team All-Big Ten honor. Freshman Austin Maloney also made his mark on the program, earning All-Freshman team honors after starting 14 games with two assists and a .800 shots on goal percentage. Of its seven wins in 2016, six of them came by way of the shutout with senior goalkeeper Matt Bersano tallying five and junior Evan Finney earning one.

2014 was a banner year for Warming and his Nittany Lions as they won 13 matches for the second straight year, going 13-6-1 overall and 5-3 in the Big Ten. They also recorded their 800th win in program history over Penn (Sept. 24), with a 6-2 win at Jeffrey Field. The team got out to a sizzling 10-0-1 start, it's best ever and won seven straight matches for the first time since 2005.

MALONEY ON THE EDGE OF ETCHING HIS NAME IN THE RECORDS

Senior **Connor Maloney** has scored 23 goals in his career thus far donning the Blue and White. If Maloney scores at least six more goals this season, the senior will rank 15th all-time in Penn State career goals with 29. Furthermore, Maloney needs just two more assists to tie for 18th all-time in Penn State laurels.

#### **NITTANY LIONS FALL AT MICHIGAN**

The Penn State men's soccer team was unable to come away with its first road victory of the 2016 campaign, falling to the University of Michigan 2-0 in a Big Ten Conference match Sunday, Oct. 2 at the U-M Soccer Stadium. The Nittany Lions totaled 12 shots in the match, three of which tested keeper Evan Louro, while the Wolverines had 18 shots with nine shots on goal. The Canadian duo of **Aymar Sigue** and **Dayonn Harris** had all three shots on goal for the Blue and White with Sigue putting two on net and Harris having one. Seniors **Connor Maloney** and **Riley Grant** each took one shot for the Nittany Lions. Penn State split time in net with redshirt-junior **Evan Finney** making five saves in the first half before **Arie Ammann** started the second half, making two saves and giving up two goals in the loss.

#### FINNEY MAKES HIS RETURN TO THE NET

After suffering an injury in the second match of the season, redshirt-junior **Evan Finney** made his first appearance in goal Sept. 23 when he notched the start against Wisconsin. The San Francisco, Calif. native made one save on the night of his return and earned his first win of the 2016 season. Finney started his fourth match of the season against Temple suffering the loss, making five saves on the night and giving up one goal.

#### PENN STATE SHUT OUT AGAINST TEMPLE

The Penn State men's soccer team was unable to come away victorious against the Temple University Owls in a mid-week non-conference match at Jeffrey Field. The Nittany Lions fell 1-0 when a goal from the Owls happened in the final six minutes of play.

Senior **Connor Maloney** led the Blue and White offensively with four shots, two of which landed on goal, while **Dayonn Harris**, **Riley Grant** and **Aymar Sigue** all had two shots on net for the Nittany Lions. Redshirt-junior **Evan Finney** suffered the loss in goal, making five saves on the night and giving up one goal.

#### **BOUNCING BACK AFTER LOSS**

Despite a heartbreaking overtime loss to Maryland in its second Big Ten Conference match of the season, Penn State bounced back to earn a 2-1 double overtime victory over Wisconsin, who was undefeated in conference play coming into the match. The Blue and White used an own goal from the Badgers before **Austin Maloney** scored the game-winning goal on a penalty kick.

#### PENN STATE NOTCHES FOURTH MULTI-GOAL GAME OF 2016

The Nittany Lions have tallied four multi-goal matches in the 2016 season with its most recent 2-1 double overtime victory over Wisconsin. Of its four multi-goal games, three have ended in victory for the Blue and White and it suffered one overtime loss to then-No. 4 Maryland after scoring two goals. If Penn State can manage two more multi-goal games in 2016 it will tie the six it had in the 2015 campaign.

#### HARRIS NETS TWO AGAINST THE TERPS

The No. 4 Maryland Terrapins did not have an answer for sophomore **Dayonn Harris** who found himself alone on three breakaways in the match. Harris was unsuccessful in his first attempt but scored easily on the next two to give Penn State the lead twice in the match. Harirs showed success from both sides of the field scoring his first goal down the right side of the pitch into the bottom left corner. In his second goal of the match, Harris picked up the ball on the left side of the field and drove it into the net for the Nittany Lions.

#### REVIEWING THE MARYLAND MATCH

Penn State took the lead twice in the match against the No. 4 Terrapins on two **Dayonn Harris** goals, but Maryland was able to come away with the win using two penalty kicks and an overtime goal to secure the win.

#### **B1G WIN OVER OHIO STATE ON MACK BRADY NIGHT**

#### **TOUGH SCHEDULE AHEAD FOR PENN STATE**

Head coach **Bob Warming** scheduled one of the toughest slates for the Nittany Lions in 2016 as they will take on six teams that were ranked in the top-25 of the NSCAA Preseason Coaches Poll. Penn State kicks off the season with No. 1 Stanford, Aug. 26, before taking on No. 18 Ohio State for its Big Ten Conference opener, Sept. 13. The top-25 tour continues Sept. 18 when Penn State travels to No. 4 Maryland before meeting up with No. 15 Indiana, Oct. 8. Finally the Nittany Lions will go up against No. 2 Akron and No. 25 Rutgers in back-to-back matches, Oct. 18 and Oct. 21.

The Nittany Lions fought to a 1-1 double overtime tie against the eventual Big Ten Champions Ohio State but were unable to overcome Akron and Maryland in the 2015 campaign.

THREE NITTANY LIONS LAND PRESEASON HONORS Seniors Evan Finney, Connor Maloney and Robby Sagel each earned Big Ten Preseason Honors as announced by the conference office. Finney closed out the 2015 season as the starting keeper for the Blue and White tallying a 2-2-1 overall record. The San Francisco, Calif. native earned one shut out and made 22 saves in his junior campaign, playing 476:10 minutes in the net. Maloney heads into the 2016 after earning First Team All-Big Ten for the second time in his career. The starting midfielder scored a team-high seven goals in 2015 and tallied two assists for a team-best 16 points. Finally, Sagel will take the pitch for his second season with the Nittany Lions after transferring to Penn State following his sophomore season. Griffith will work with all positions with an emphasis on defenders and midfielders, while helping with team operations, daily player management and communication. Griffith is entering his second season on the sidelines with Warming in the 2016 campaign. He joined the Penn State men's soccer coaching staff after completing a four-year playing career under Warming and served as a volunteer assistant in the 2015 season.
