Last Weekend's Sweep in Minneapolis

The Wolverines swept the #9 Golden Gophers last weekend, moving to 10-10-2 overall. It's the first time Michigan has swept Minnesota on the road since 1977. The wins also brought the Mariucci/Renfrew Coaches' Trophy back to Ann Arbor for the first time since the 2008-09 season. The trophy is awarded to either Michigan or Minnesota, based off of who has the better regular season record.

Junior Brendan Warren totaled three goals throughout the weekend, while the "DMC" line of Dexter Dancs (1g), Cooper Marody (2g) and Tony Calderone (3a) totaled six points (3g, 3a).

Red, White and Go Blue

U-M's Quinn Hughes, Will Lockwood and Josh Norris competed at the 2018 IIHF World Junior Championship in Buffalo, NY, from Dec. 26, 2017 - Jan. 5, 2018. The trio become the 45th, 46th and 47th Wolverines -- 39 for the United States, seven for Canada and one for Sweden -- to have played in the WJC.

The United States came away with the Bronze Medal after defeating the Czech Republic on Jan. 5. Sweden was awarded the silver medal, while Canada came away with the Gold Medal.

GOALL!!!

Michigan ranks eleventh in the nation in goals per game, averaging 3.32 goals over its first 22 games. Captain Tony Calderone ranks tied for sixth in the nation in goals per game at 0.68.

Block It Out

Michigan ranks sixth nationally with an average of 14.82 blocked shots per game and ninth in total blocked shots with 326 on the season.

D-E-F-E-N-S-E

The Wolverines held the Gophers to 18 shots in their last game, which is tied for the fewest Minnesota has taken all season, and the fewest the Maize and Blue have allowed. The two shots allowed in the third period is the least amount of shots Michigan has allowed in a period this year. The 45 total shots over the weekend by the Gophers is also the least amount the Wolverines have surrendered during a weekend series this year.

Run DMC

Michigan's "DMC" line of Dexter Dancs, Cooper Marody and Tony Calderone have combined for 75 points out of a total of 193 team points (38.9%) thus far through 22 games.

Tony Lights the Lamp

Calderone's 15 goals are the most by a U-M player in the first 22 games of a season since Louie Caporusso's 18 goals in 22 games during the 2008-09 campaign. This is the second season in a row that he leads the team in goals in the New Year.

Taming the Lions

Calderone has a five game point streak against the Nittany Lions, recording eight points (5g, 3a) during the streak.

Stars Align for Warren

Brendan Warren was named B1G First Star of the Week after recording three goals last weekend at No. 9 Minnesota, helping lead U-M to the weekend sweep.

Hobey Hopefuls

Calderone and Marody have both been nominated for the Hobey Baker Award, given annually to college hockey's top player. Michigan has had two Hobey Baker winners in its history, with Brendan Morrison winning in 1997 and Kevin Porter in 2008.

Climbin' the Ranks

Marody ranks tied for third nationally with 31 points on the season and second with 22 assists. Calderone is tied for seventh nationally with 15 goals.

Marody in Good Company

Marody's 31 points are most through 22 games since Kevin Porter had 39 in 2007-08 when he won the Hobey Baker Award.

Quintessential Blue liner

Freshman Defenseman Quinn Hughes' 13 points (1g, 12a) from the point are the most by a U-M freshman blue liner through 22 games since Zach Werenski had 18 points through that span in 2014-15.

MICHIGAN PLAYER AND TEAM NOTES

Double Vision for Coop

Marody ended his multi-point streak of eight games against Ohio State. Over the span he tallied 19 points (4G, 15A) and became the first Wolverine to record multiple points in eight consecutive games since Brian Wiseman did so during the 1993-94 season, when he tallied 21 points (6G, 15A) between Dec. 4, 1993-Jan. 7, 1994.

SHOTS, SHOTS, SHOTS

Michigan currently ranks eighth nationally with an average of 33.8 shots on goal per game, while ranking 15th in the nation with a +4.14 shots on goal margin per game.

Free Hockey

Michigan has had five games head to overtime so far this season. This is the most overtime contests for the Wolverines since they played in nine during the 2015-16 season.

Senior Superlative

U-M senior defenseman Sam Piazza is one of 20 NCAA men's ice hockey student-athletes selected as candidates for the 2017-18 Senior CLASS Award as individuals who excel both on and off the ice. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

Red Berenson Rink at Yost Ice Arena

Red Berenson was honored for his 33 season of coaching Michigan hockey when the ice rink inside Yost Arena was officially named the Red Berenson Rink at Yost Ice Arena.

Up Ahead

Michigan will travel to Columbus to take on rival Ohio State for a weekend series at Value City Arena at the Jerome Schottenstein Center for their fourth straight Big Ten Conference series. Puck drop in Columbus is scheduled for 7 p.m. ET on Friday, while Saturday's puck will drop at 8:00 p.m. ET.

Did you know?

- Michigan's average age of 20 years, 324 days to start the season is the third youngest in NCAA DI Men's Hockey, ranking only behind Boston College (20 years, 125 days) and Boston University (20 years, 127 days)
- Michigan freshman defenseman Quinn Hughes is the youngest player in NCAA DI Men's Hockey (Oct. 14, 1999), while fellow classmate Michael Pastujov is the fourth youngest (Aug. 11, 1999).
- With an average weight of 191.52 pounds, Michigan ranks as the ninth biggest team in NCAA DI Men's Hockey according to weight, with the biggest being UMass Lowell (199.66).
- Pearson is one of nine new head coaches in NCAA DI Men's Hockey with new programs.
- Michigan had 17 alums make an NHL opening night roster, second most amongst NCAA DI Men's Hockey programs behind Boston College (19). U-M had 22 alums make at least one appearance in the NHL last season, ranking only behind BC (24) and tied with North Dakota (22).
- With Carl Hagelin and Kevin Porter raising the Stanley Cup last spring with the Pittsburgh Penguins, U-M alums have now raised the cup 16 times, which is tied for third most amongst NCAA DI Men's Hockey programs (Wisconsin 19, Boston College 18, North Dakota 16).
- Michigan's 36 NCAA Tournament appearances ranks second behind Minnesota (37), while ranking tied for fourth with six appearances in the last 10 years.
- Michigan's 24 Frozen Four appearances ranks second behind Boston College (25).
- Michigan's 10 draft picks on the 2017-18 roster is the third most of any NCAA DI Men's Hockey program, trailing Minnesota (13) and Boston University (12).
- Built in 1923, Yost Ice Arena is tied for the second oldest arena in NCAA DI Men's College Hockey, trailing Northeastern's Matthews Arena (1910) and tied with Princeton's Baker Arena (1923).
- Jason Botterill '97 was named the General Manager of the Buffalo Sabres on May 11, 2017, becoming 12th GM of an NHL organization who played collegiate hockey.

The Penn State Series

Michigan and Penn State meet for just the 22nd time, with the series starting in 2014. Since then Michigan holds an 11-10 advantage over Penn State. The two teams first met on Feb. 7, 2014, when Michigan defeated Penn State 7-3 in State College, Pennsylvania. The Wolverines have won five straight contests against the Nittany Lions dating back to Jan. 28, 2016. In addition, Michigan holds a 6-2 record at home against Penn State and will look to add two more wins to that total this weekend.

Earlier this season in State College, Pennsylvania Michigan and Penn State split two games. Penn state defeated Michigan 5-4 (Friday, Oct. 27) in overtime in the first game, while Michigan was able to win the next game 5-2 (Saturday, Oct. 28).

The "DMC" line of Dexter Dancs (3g, 2a), Cooper Marody (1g, 5a) and Tony Calderone (2g, 2a) combined for 15 points (6g, 9a) during the weekend series.

Scouting the Nittany Lions

The Nittany Lions are led by head coach Guy Gadowsky, who is in his 19th year as a head coach for a NCAA program. He has been with Penn State for five seasons now. Gadowsky holds a record of 114-85-12 at Penn State and a 258-278-49 record overall since becoming a collegiate head coach. At Penn State, Gadowsky has been responsible for the rise of the Penn State since they joined the Division 1 ranks. He was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2014-2015 and also led the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season as a Division 1 program in 2015-2016. Prior to joining Penn State, Gadowsky was the head coach for Princeton and the University of Alaska.

Penn State enters the weekend against Michigan at No. 12 in the country with a record of 13-8-3 (6-5-3, B1G). Most recently, the Nittany Lions split a series against Ohio State in conference play.

Leading Penn State

Penn State's offense is led by Junior Andrew Sturtz. Sturtz heads into the weekend with 30 points (11g, 19a). In addition to Sturtz, Sophomores Denis Smirnov (10g) and Nate Sucece (11g) have both scored double digit goals this season.

In net, the Gophers are led by Sophomore Peyton Jones, who has started 21 games so far this season. Jones has gone 12-6-2 with a save percentage of .903. He has allowed 59 goals, which is a rate of 2.96 per game.

HEAD COACH MEL PEARSON



Mel Pearson was named the ninth head coach in University of Michigan hockey history on Monday, April 24, 2017.

Pearson returns to Ann Arbor following an impressive six-year stint as head coach at Michigan Tech. There, he led the Huskies to two NCAA Tournament appearances in the last three years while winning a WCHA regular-season title and a WCHA Championship in that span. Pearson registered a 118-92-29 overall record, including a 75-34-14 mark over the past three seasons.

Under Pearson's leadership, the Huskies finished the 2016-17 season ranked in the top 20 for a third consecutive year, all of them featuring 20-win campaigns. Pearson also earned two WCHA Coach of the Year honors in his time at Michigan Tech, which claimed the program's first-ever No. 1 national ranking on Nov. 17, 2014.

Pearson served as a U-M assistant coach from 1988-89 through 1998-99 and as associate head coach from 1999-2000 through 2010-11. He played an integral role in developing the Michigan program into one of the most successful in the country. During his tenure, the Wolverines posted a 667-243-71 record while capturing 11 Central Collegiate Hockey Association regular-season titles, nine CCHA Tournament crowns, two NCAA championships (1996 and 1998), and making 11 NCAA Frozen Four appearances.

Pearson assisted head coach Red Berenson with on-ice coaching and performed many of the program's administrative functions. He was also heavily involved in the Wolverines' recruiting efforts, helping Michigan land the core of its 1996 and 1998 NCAA champion teams.

After he helped Michigan to the 1999-2000 CCHA regular-season championship, Pearson was awarded the Terry Flanagan Award by the American Hockey Coaches' Association, which honors an assistant coach's career body of work. Pearson also served as a coach with the 1996 United States World Junior Championship team, and helped the Americans to a silver medal, the country's second-best finish at the event.

Pearson's prep (Willard Ikola) and college (John MacInnes) mentors earned varsity letters as goaltenders at Michigan. Pearson was a standout high school player for Ikola (1952-54) at Edina East (Minn.) High School, while playing his collegiate career out at Michigan Technological University under MacInnes (1946-50), one of college hockey's legendary coaches.

As a collegian (1977-81), Pearson collected 56 points (21-35-56) in 97 games, helping Michigan Tech to a third-place finish at the 1981 NCAA Championship. Ironically, Pearson's most "famous" goal was scored against the Wolverines in the championship game of the 1979 Great Lakes Invitational. He broke a 4-4 tie at 2:28 of the third overtime to give the Huskies the GLI title. The game still stands as longest in the 53-year history of the tournament.

After earning his bachelor's degree in business administration in 1981, Pearson remained at his alma mater to serve as an assistant ice hockey coach on the Huskies' staff from 1982-88.

The Flin Flon, Manitoba, native comes from a hockey family. His father, George "Mel" Pearson, played 15 seasons of professional hockey with the New York Rangers and Pittsburgh Penguins of the National Hockey League and with Minnesota of the World Hockey Association. His brother, Ted, played for the University of Wisconsin and spent time in the Calgary Flames organization.

Pearson and his wife, Susie, have three children -- Kim, Sarah and Paul -- and reside in Saline, Michigan.
