THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This week marks just the seventh and eighth meetings all-time between the 59th and 60th NCAA Division I programs and the first in over two years. Penn State leads the series 5-1-0 outscoring the Sun Devils 35-15 for an average of 5.83 goals per game.
- The last time the two teams met the Nittany Lions won a barn burner in the opener 6-5 before ASU secured its first-ever win against Penn State in overtime the following night on a goal from Johnny Walker.
- Only five current Nittany Lions took the ice in that series two years ago led by senior Alex Limoges who scored twice, including the game-winner, in the first game while adding a pair of assists in game two. Limoges has four career games against ASU joining senior Sam Sternschein who has added one goal and three assists in his four games played against the Sun Devils.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

• For the first time in program history, Penn State secured the Big Ten regular-season championship in 2019-20 and No. 1 overall seed entering the conference tournament. Penn State's 12 victories and 41 points in conference play last season were both program highs.

NINE TIMES!

- Penn State had scored just 10 goals in its first five games of the season entering Thursday night before erupting for nine goals in a 9-5 victory over No. 7 Michigan.
- The nine goals tie the third most in a single-game in program history and tie the most-ever scored against a conference opponent. Penn State defeated No. 5 Notre Dame 9-1 nearly two years to the day on December 8, 2018
- The Nittany Lions have now scored seven or more goals 24 times, including 16 times in the past three-plus seasons, and are a perfect 24-0-0 when doing so. Penn State has scored seven or more goals three times against ASU.
- Penn State also hit its magic number of five for the first time this season on Thursday night after going 11-0-0 last year when doing so. The Nittany Lions are now 78-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals with the lone loss coming during the 2018-19 season at Wisconsin.

SATURDAY NIGHT'S ALRIGHT FOR... NOTHING

- With a Friday-Sunday series lined up this week Penn State will have played a game on each day of the week so far this season except for Saturday.
- Historically Saturday has been the most successful day for Penn State. Over the past four seasons the Nittany Lions are 38-21-6 in games played on Saturday including a 10-4-1 record last season (6-1-1 in the second half).
- Over the past four seasons, Penn State has won the Big Ten Tournament on a Saturday, won it's first-ever NCAA Tournament game on a Saturday and last season camefrom-behind to defeat Minnesota, 3-2 on a Saturday in a game that became a defacto Big Ten regular-season championship game.

WHAT ABOUT BOB?

 Junior Bobby Hampton introduced himself to Hockey Valley last week against Michigan scoring a pair of goals, his first two as a Nittany Lion, including the eventual game-winning goal on Thursday.

• A transfer from Northeastern, Hampton had to redshirt the entire 2019-20 season due to the NCAA transfer rules. The goal was a combination of grit and hard work and was Hampton's first goal in over two years dating back to November 1, 2018, a span of 763 days.

FULLY CHARGED

- After going just 1-for-16 on the powerplay over the first five games of the season, Penn State regained its man-advantage swagger on Thursday going 4-for-6 on the powerplay including a pair of PPG's in the first 20 seconds of the man-advantage.
- Limoges netted his 10th career powerplay tally in the game moving into a tie with David Goodwin '17 for seventh on the Penn State all-time powerplay goals list. The senior leads the team with three powerplay point this season.

NIGHT FULL OF FIRSTS

- Along with Hampton's first goals as a Nittany Lion and Penn State's first win of the 2020-21 season on Thursday night a trio of freshmen also collected their first collegiate goals as Chase McLane, Jared Westcott and Jimmy Dowd Jr. each lit the lamp.
- All three players also added assists to collect their first-ever multi-point efforts while Westcott registered a career-best three points on one goal and two assists in the victory.

BREAK THE WALL DOWN

- Sophomore Kevin Wall had just seven points on a pair of goals and five assists in 26 games last season but he has already bettered his 2019-20 goal output in the first six games of 2020-21 having scored a goal in the first three games of the season.
- Wall leads the team with his three goals and three assists for six points this season as he has registered at least one point in five of the first six games of the season.

ADJUST YOUR AUTIO LEVELS

- With the graduation of Peyton Jones, Penn State has an opening in net for the first time in four years and both junior Oskar Autio and freshman Liam Souliere have seen action so far this season.
- Autio earned the starting nod both nights last week as Guy Gadowsky opted to use the same goaltender in each game for the first time this season. Thursday night marked Autio's first-career Big Ten victory.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Senior Alex Limoges was named Penn State's 2020-21 captain and earned his second-straight preseason First-Team All-B1G nod after earning honorable mention accolades at the conclusion of the 2019-20 season.
- Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 108 for his career to rank third nationally. His 43 career goals are the second-most among active players in the

SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE

- The Sun Devils enter the series winners in three of their last four and ranked 20th in the latest uscho.com poll after starting the season 0-3-1, however, all-time leading scorer Johnny Walker has been sidelined with a lower-body injury and will most likely miss his seventh and eighth straight games. Walker leads all active NCAA Division I players with 60 career goals and is just four points shy of 100 for his career.
- ASU returns most of its scoring from last season's team, but are led by freshman Matthew Kopperud with II points on six goals and five assists. Kopperud is tied for second nationally with his II points while his six goals ties for the nationally lead with Wisconsin's Cole Caufield. Sophomore Jax Murray has added four goals of his own while freshman Ryan O'Reilly and junior Demetrios Koumontzis each have three.
- Arizona State is tied for 30th nationally allowing 3.50 goals per game among of the 41 teams who have played at least one game so far this season while they rank 18th in the nation averaging 2.88 themselves
- Without Walker, the Sun Devils are near the bottom of the nation on the powerplay converting just 2-of-26 chances for a 7.7 percent efficiency rate. Of Walker's 60 goals over his first three seasons in the desert, 22, or more than a third, have come with the man-advantage.
- Between the pipes Freshman Cole Brady has split time with Evan Debrouwer as both goaltenders have made four starts and have identical .906 save percentages. Debrouwer has had slightly better luck in the win column posting a 2-2-0 record and has a slightly better goals-against average at 3.30.
- ASU is nearing the end of a 12-game, 35-day road trip as they travel to Ohio State next weekend to close out the first semester of play following the trip to Hocky Valley. The Sun Devils agreed to play a full Big Ten schedule entirely on the road this season in order to get games in as an independent. Each Big Ten team has agreed to give the Sun Devils one return trip at some point in the future.



Big Ten, only behind Michigan State's Mitchell Lewandowski with 44, and also tied for third nationally.

• Limoges became the eighth Nittany Lion in program history to reach the 100-point mark for his career last season and after a three-point series against Wisconsin has moved passed Andrew Sturtz into sixth on the Penn State all-time points list. His 43 goals are good for eighth all-time.

HOME SWEET HOME

• Penn State is 81-43-14 all-time at Pegula Ice Arena including an 11-5-3 record last season and a program-best 15 home victories during the 2018-19 season.

ETCHED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

- Penn State will look a little different when they hit the ice this season after graduating the largest senior class in program history and arguably one of the most decorated throughout the nation as well as having two juniors leave early after signing entry-level NHL contracts.
- The 2020 senior class accounted for 85 victories over their four years, just one shy of the most-ever by a single class, a distinction held by the class of 2019 with 86 wins.
- The group consisted of four of the top-10 scorers in program history led by Penn State's all-time leading scorer, Nate Sucese with 140 points and followed by Brandon Biro (116), Denis Smirnov (115) and Liam Folkes (103) in fourth, fifth and seventh, respectively. The group also featured Peyton Jones, the most decorated goalie in program history who holds nearly every single goaltending record Penn State.
- The 2020 senior class played in a total 1,142 games scoring 634 points on 258 goals and 376 assists and had four 100-point scorers.
- The Nittany Lions are also without the services of Evan Barratt and Cole Hults after the pair inked entry-level NHL contracts with the Chicago Blackhawks and the Los Angeles Kings back in April.
- Barratt ranked ninth on the all-time points list and tenth on the goals list at Penn State with 95 and 39, respectively, while Hults held nearly every single record for defensemen at Penn State and led the entire Big Ten with a plus-23 rating last season.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

- Head Coach Guy Gadowsky was named a finalist for Big Ten Coach of the Year last season after leading the Nittany Lions to their first-ever B1G regular-season title.
 The Bench Boss secured the seventh 20-win season of his collegiate coaching career and his fourth with the Nittany Lions with a 3-2 victory over Minnesota to close out the regular season.
- The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory earlier this year and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 319 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 319 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

EUROPEAN CONNECTION

- Penn State has a pair of players on its 2020-21 roster from Finland.
- Goaltender **Oskar Autio** is following in his brothers footsteps joined by longtime friend and New Jersey Devils draft pick **Aarne Talvitie**. Both players are from Espoo and grew up playing for the Esspoo Blues.

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 126-of-135 home games, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games that was snapped earlier this season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds last season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 in the last home game against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.
- Last season, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).
- Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its eighth season entering 2020-21. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New for the 2020-21 season is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey
- Arizona State will play each Big Ten team four times all on the road giving each team 28 regular season contests. ASU is not eligible for conference awards or the Big Ten Tournament.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 21st collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his ninth at Penn State in the 2020-21 campaign

AT PENN STATE

This past year, Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the 2019-20 Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.



Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten

wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Niittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with

the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semi-

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

cord in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a twoyear contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells
