PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- Penn State enters the weekend after seeing its 11-game unbeaten-streak snapped by No. 6 Ohio State last Saturday during a 5-1 setback.
- The Wolverines enter the weekend after sweeping Minnesota on the road, 5-3 and 3-1 last weekend. The sweep was the first in a B1G series for the Gophers at Mariucci Arena since the Big Ten began for the 2013-14 season.
- After splitting the first series of the season at Pegula Ice Arena in October, Michigan maintains the one-game advantage in the all-time series with an 11-10-0 record including the 8-4 mark over the past two-plus seasons, however, Penn State was 3-2 last year against the Wolverines including a 4-1 victory in the Big Ten Tournament to send Michigan home.
- Penn State is just 2-6-0 all-time at Yost Ice Arena including five straight losses as senior classmates James Robinson and Erik Autio are the only two current Nittany Lions to experience a victory at Yost as part of a 3-2 victory in November of their freshman seasons.
- Penn State is being outscored at Yost 28-5 in the last five games.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State has a modest 6-4-1 record this season away from Pegula Ice Arena, but they are currently riding a five-game unbeaten streak in road games (4-0-1) to tie its best road streak in program history which was achieved two seasons ago.

ZERO TO 100

- In just his sixth season behind the bench in Hockey Valley, Guy Gadowsky is just two wins shy of 100 at Penn State. The Nittany Lions are 98-88-15 under his guidance.
- Gadowsky's all-time record is 271-286-52 in this his 18th season as a head coach. Gadowsky currently ranks 19th among active NCAA Division I coaches in wins and third in the Big Ten behind Don Lucia of Minnesota (730) and Jeff Jackson at Notre Dame (468).

SECOND PERIOD SURGE

- Despite a slow second period against Ohio State on Friday, being outshot 22-11 and outscored 2-1, the middle frame is usually the best for the Nittany Lions. Penn State ranks third in the nation and tops in the Big Ten having scored 36 second period goals.
- While only allowing 21 second period goals to opponents, Penn State has a +15 scoring margin in the second period which ranks second in the Big Ten and fifth in the nation.
- This season Penn State is 12-0-2 when leading after two periods.

BLUELINE BEAUTIES

- With 71 points (15 goals, 56 assists) by defensemen this season, Penn State leads the entire nation averaging 2.96 points per game from its defensemen.

TREVOR

- Senior defensemen Trevor Hamilton is having a career-year for the Blue and White as he leads the Big Ten and ranks tied for third in the nation in defensemen scoring with 22 points on four goals and 18 assists.
- His 18 assists also lead the Big Ten for blue-liners and rank second in the nation. Hamilton has eight multi-point efforts so far this season.
- No other player in the country has been on the ice for more goals (34) than Trevor Hamilton while his plus-15 rating ties for sixth in the nation and third in the Big Ten. (Among defensemen he ranks first in the Big Ten and tied for second in the nation in plus/minus.)
- Hamilton's 54 blocks are also the second most in the Big Ten and tied for fourth in the nation.

HOBHEY HOPEFULS

- For the second consecutive season junior Andrew Sturtz and sophomore Denis Smirnov have been nominated for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award, presented to the top player in NCAA Division I men's hockey.
- Sturtz currently leads the team with 30 points to tie for third in the Big Ten and sixth in the nation. The junior has scored 11 goals and already has a career-high 19 assists on the season in 23 games played.
- His assist total ranks fifth in the Big Ten and tied for eighth in the nation. Sturtz recently had a career-long nine-game point streak snapped. Sturtz currently leads the team with 10 multi-point effort this season.
- Sturtz's 94 career points rank second all-time at Penn State and are tied for 19th in the nation among active players and fifth among the junior class.
- Smirnov missed eight games earlier this season due to an illness, but is still one of the top scorers in the conference with ten goals and nine assists for 19 points.
- The sophomore's 10 goals rank second on the team and eighth in the Big Ten while his 66 career points are the second most nationally among sophomore's, only trailing Henrik Borgstrom from Denver.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

- A year after leading the nation in goals per game with a 4.10 average, Penn State is right back atop the nation averaging 4.00 goals per game through the first 24 games this season.
- The Nittany Lions also lead the nation in goals (96), assists (169), points (265), shots on goal (962) and shots on goal per game (40.08) just one year after setting single-season program records for each category.

PERFECT ATTENDANCE AWARD

- Junior forward Chase Berger hasn't missed a single game in his entire Penn State career and last Friday played in his 100th consecutive game becoming the first Nittany Lion in program history to reach 100 games without missing a single one.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

-  The Wolverines enter the weekend with a 10-10-2 record and a 5-7-2 overall mark in Big Ten action placing them five points back of Penn State in the conference standings in fourth place with 18 points.
- Michigan is 5-4-1 this season at Yost Ice Arena and just 2-3-1 in home Big Ten affairs.
- Cooper Marody leads Michigan in scoring with 31 points (9 goals, 22 assists) to rank second in the Big Ten and tied for third in the nation.
- Tony Calderone leads the Wolverines in goals with 15 over his first 22 games of the season ranking first in the Big Ten and tied for seventh nationally. Jake Slaker has added nine goals of his own while Dexter Dancs, Josh Norris and Brendan Warren each have six goals to their credit to pace the offense.
- The Wolverines will most likely be without one of their top offensive weapons in Will Lockwood as the sophomore forward was injured during the 2018 World Junior Championships over the holiday break while skating for Team USA. Lockwood hasn't dressed in a game so far this semester after playing in all 16 games during the first semester registering four goals and seven assists for 11 points.
- Michigan ranks second in the conference, only behind Penn State, and 11th in the nation averaging 3.32 goals per contest, however, they rank last in the Big Ten and 45th in the nation allowing 3.23 goals per contest on average.
- Sophomore Hayden Lavigne has solidified himself as the starter between the pipes for the Wolverines as he boasts a 6-6-2 record with a .902 save percentage and a 2.73 goals against average. Those numbers are even better in Big Ten games where he is 4-4-2 with a .911 save percentage and a 2.63 goals against average.

NOT SO SPECIAL TEAMS

- Michigan's special teams have left a lot to be desired so far this season as its penalty kill ranks 58th in the nation out of 60 teams at 74.7 percent (65-for-87). The Wolverine power-play hasn't been much better converting just 14-of-86 opportunities to rank second to last in the Big Ten and 42nd nationally.
- Michigan's 22 power-play goals allowed is the most in the Big Ten and rank 13th nationally while its 14 power-play goals scored is the least in the Big Ten and rank tied for 44th in the nation.




FINISHING STRONG

- Senior Erik Autio is just a single assist shy of tying Luke Juha '16 for first on the Penn State all-time assist list for defensemen at 45.

- Also, with a single point he will tie long-time defensive partner Vince Pedrie for second on the all-time points list for Penn State defensemen at 52. Juha leads the way at 60 points.

ICE TUDDIES

- Following a 7-4 victory against Robert Morris in December, Penn State has now scored seven goals in a game five times this season after only hitting that mark four times total during 2016-17 in 39 games played.

- Of those five games, four have come at Pegula Ice Arena where the Nittany Lions have scored 51 goals in 11 games and are averaging 4.64 goals per contest this season.

- Penn State is 5-0-0 when scoring at least seven goals this season and 14-0-0 in program history when putting up seven or more goals. Ten of those 14 games have been played at Pegula Ice Arena with 11 being at home (PSU defeated ASU 8-3 at Greenberg on 11/30/12).


NEXT UP


- Penn State remains on the road next weekend for a pair of Big Ten tilts with Wisconsin on Friday and Saturday evening.

RECAPPING 2016-17

- Penn State finished the 2016-17 season with an overall record of 25-12-2. The Lions finished fourth in the Big Ten during the regular season with a record of 10-9-1 for the second straight season.

- The Nittany Lions became the first conference team to capture the Big Ten Tournament Championship by winning three games in three consecutive nights. PSU defeated Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin to secure its first ever title with the semifinal and final being decided in double-overtime.

- Penn State advanced to its first-ever NCAA Tournament where it defeated Union (N.Y.) 10-3 before falling 6-3 to eventual National Champion, Denver. The ten goals scored against Union tied an NCAA Tournament record for most goals scored by a team in its debut game and where also the most any team has scored since 1990.

- Penn State broke or tied 65 program/individual records last season including the program marks for most wins (25), points (425), goals (160), assists (265), shots (1,719) and shots per game (44.1).

- Andrew Sturtz became just the second 20-goal scorer in program history as he tied Casey Bailey's single-season record of 22 set during the 2014-15 season.

- The Nittany Lions led the entire nation averaging 4.10 goals per contest.

- The Nittany Lions led the nation in freshman scoring with 157 points on 64 goals and 93 assists.

SMIRNOV, JONES NAMED B1G PLAYERS TO WATCH

- Sophomore classmates Denis Smirnov and Peyton Jones were part of a 17 player watch list as voted on by the seven head coaches in the Big Ten.
- Both players were named an All-Big Ten honorable mention as well as a member of the All-Freshman team following the conclusion of the 2016-17 season.
- Smirnov led the entire nation last season in freshman scoring with 47 points. The Russian winger secured 19 goals and 28 assists for those 47 points all numbers, which are now single-season Penn State records for a freshman. His 47 points and 28 assists are also single-season Penn State records for any player.
- Jones also had a record setting season for Penn State as his 23 wins and 884 saves are both single-season program records.
- Both players were Hobey Baker Award nominees in 2016-17.

NHL HOPEFULS

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 74-of-76 home games, including all 20 during the 2016-17 season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 47 occasions including 12 games last season.
- In 2016-17, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (6,026) and led the nation in building capacity percentage (104.2 percent).
- Last season, Penn State had a season-total of 120,513 fans that have been to Pegula Ice Arena, which is the most in the facilities short four-year history.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its fifth season entering 2017-18. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member for the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The Big Ten tournament will take place at on campus sites for the first time in league history beginning during the 2017-18 season.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky, the 2017 Big Ten Tournament Champion coach, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 18th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2017-18. Gadowsky is currently coaching his sixth Penn State varsity team.

AT PENN STATE

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Along the way Penn State opened the season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com

No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest scoring team in the country averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

In 2015-16 Gadowsky led Penn State to its first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6th the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions

knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first

NCAA tournament berth since 1998, Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

Gadowsky had more than 20 Tiger players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.




