SERIES HISTORY WITH MINNESOTA

Penn State leads the all-time series with the Golden Gophers 38-21 but Minnesota has been closing the gap sweeping the series in the 2017 season. Prior to the 2017 season, the two teams have not met up on the field since the 2014 campaign when Minnesota won all three contests in Minneapolis. Penn State is looking for its first win since it swept the Golden Gophers in the 2012 campaign. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions are looking for their first road win since 2011 when it split a doubleheader.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA

The Golden Gophers are 34-14 overall on the season and are currently riding a 28-game home winning streak. Minnesota comes into the Big Ten Conference series with a 15-3 record, having lost to Northwestern twice and Michigan State once. Ellee Jensen leads the powerful Golden Gopher offense with a .408 batting average, which ranks third in B1G standings. Jensen has knocked 53 hits on the season hitting in the No. 9 spot in the lineup. Kendyl Lindaman has also seen a solid sophomore season for the Golden Gophers. hitting .362 with a conference-leading 18 home runs on the season. Lindaman also ranks first in the Big Ten in walks with 44 and second in both slugging percentage and on-base percentage. In the circle, Amber Fiser has filled the role as the ace since losing Sara Groenewegen to graduation following the 2017 campaign. Fiser has made 34 starts in 27 appearances and has pitched the Gophers to 24 of its 34 wins this year. The sophomore hurler has a 1.52 earned run average in 202.2 innings, allowing just 44 earned runs to touch home, while striking out 209 batters this season.

WALK-OFF DUBOIS

Junior **Tori Dubois** has proven time and time again why she is a leader for the Penn State offense. After securing just one hit in her first 11 at-bats of the Illinois series, the junior stepped in the box in the bottom of the ninth and drove a walk-off home run off the scoreboard in left field to secure the 4-3 victory over the Fighting Illini in the series finale. The walk-off RBI was the second time this season that Dubois has secured the victory on her hit as she also drove in the winning run in the bottom of the ninth against Kent State.

JOHNSON LOOSE AT THE PLATE

After transferring to Penn State in the fall of 2017, junior **Paige Johnson** has been looking for her groove in the batter's box. This past weekend, Johnson may have found the missing piece as she had two home runs against Illinois. The junior infielder drove a three-run home run over the fence in game one of the series to give Penn State the early 3-0 lead Friday night before the game was suspended due to rain. The Clarksville, Tennessee native followed it up with her second home run of the series in game two, this time a two-run homer. Johnson transferred from Northwest Florida State, where she hit 11 home runs in both her freshman and sophomore seasons.

Amanda Lehotak at a Glance

In her fourth season at the helm, Lenotak led the Nittany Lions to 23 wins, including to the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament after an upset victory over Nebraska. The Blue and White picked up two wins over ranked opponents in the 2017 campaign, including beating then-No. 4 LSU and then-No. 25 Ohio State. Lehotak guided First

Team All-Big Ten selection Tori Dubois to a .457 batting average in Big Ten play to rank third in the conference, while Rebecca Ziegler notched Big Ten All-Tournament honors in 2017. Senior Shelby Miller closed out her career under Lehotak ranking second in Penn State career laurels with 118 RBIs and went out as the career sacrifice hit leader with nine, while senior Kristina Brackpool ranks No. 7 all-time with 106 RBIs and No. 9 all-time with 19 home runs. In the circle, the Nittany Lions saw an increase in complete games going from 16 in 2016 to 25 in 2016, while strikeouts jumped from 180 to 194 in the 2017 campaign. Senior Marlaina Laubach started a team-best 25 games and threw 14 complete games en route to 12 wins. The right-handed hurler closed out her career as the all-time leader with 139 appearances in the circle and ranks third with 97 starts and fourth with four career saves Laubach tallied 46 career victories to rank sixth all-time and tossed 611.1 innings to rank fifth all-time in Nittany Lion laurels while her 49 complete games and 323 strikeouts rank seventh all-time for the Blue and White.

Lehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached their 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record and walk record with 137 career RBI and 100 career walks donning the Blue and White. Furthermore, under Lehotak's tutelage, Jones ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine career batting categories at Penn of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions.

Defensively, Penn State finished the season ranked third in the Big Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. In the circle, Marlaina Laubach established herself as the ace for Lehotak, tying for third in Penn State season history with 41 appearances and ranking fourth with 29 starts. Laubach also ranks 15th in innings pitched, tossing 165.2 for the Nittany Lions in the 2016 campaign.

>> Gianna Arrizurieta - Has appeared in 107 games with 85 starts in her four year career as a Nittany Lions in a variety of roles and positions. The Pembroke Pines, Florida native in a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a 2017 Big Ten Sportsmanship Award win-

>> **Jessica Cummings** - Has made 99 appearances with 57 starts in the circle, throwing a total of 338.0 innings for Penn State. The Owings, Maryland native is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a NFCA Easton Scholar-Athlete.

>> Ashton Mensinger - Walked on the team in 2018 after being a student manager for two seasons. Mensinger appeared in 16 games this season with one start and has thrown 23.2 innings.

LEGG FINDING THE LONG BALL

Recently, sophomore Kennedy Legg has found some big hits when getting up to bat for the Nittany Lions. Legg, a transfer from Ole Miss, has three home runs this season, which ranks second on the team. At Indiana, the sophomore catcher added her third round-tripper of the season on a ball off the right field foul pole. In her first season donning the Blue and White, Legg has 18 hits and 11 RBI.

VALLEJOS SEIZING OPPORTUNITIES

Freshman Haley Vallejos came on as a pinch hitter in both games against Saint Francis and proved to do a job for the Nittany Lions. In game one against the Red Flash, with runners on first and third, Vallejos drove a deep sacrifice fly into center field to score the runner on third for the Blue and White. In game two, Vallejos stepped in in her second pinch hit situation of the night and this time drove a single up the middle for the Nittany Lions.

DEFENSE MAKING BIG PLAYS

Despite not being able to come away with a win against Saint Francis, the Penn State defense made some exceptional plays against State. Senior Lexi Knief also closed out her career in the top-10 the Red Flash. Junior Toni Polk caught a ball deep in the left center gap to start game one before Amanda Grieco made a big backhand play up the middle in game two to get the lead runner. Finally, Gianna Arrizurieta, Destiny Weber and Grieco combined on a run down play to get the lead runner in game two against Saint Francis.

GRIECO STEPS UP

Sophomore walk-on Amanda Grieco was given the opportunity to pinch hit with runners in scoring position against Michigan Friday, April 6. The Basking Ridge, New Jersey native dug in and roped a double into the left center field gap, bringing in both of Penn State runs against the Wolverines. The extra-base hit marked the first of her career donning the Blue and White. Grieco has since earned the start at second base and was on a five-game reached base streak prior to the Saint Francis doubleheader for the Nittany Lions. The starting second baseman had two hits and brought in two runs for the Blue and White in game one of the three-game series against the Spartans.

The Penn State softball team capped off the week-The Nittany Lions have seen six of their eight wins come end series with a 7-3 victory over Rutgers. Dubois's grand slam marked the first for the Nittany Lions since the 2017 campaign when Delaney Elling laced a shot against lowa State, March 4.

COMEBACK KIDS

Penn State has had to work for each of its wins this season, coming back late in the contest from a large deficit to pick up its victories. Penn State came back from a 3-0 deficit against Maryland to pick up the 4-3 victory before going on to score six runs in the bottom of the fifth inning against Robert Morris to take the 9-7 win after trailing 7-0 through the first four and a half innings.

LEHOTAK TALLIES WIN NO. 100 AT PENN STATE

With Penn State's series opening win over Maryland, head coach **Amanda Lehotak** picked up her 100th win at Penn State. Furthermore, the win marked the 289th career win for the Lehotak. Lehotak is in her fifth season with the Nittany Lions, leading Penn State to a Big Ten Tournament quarterfinal appearance in 2017 and a semifinal appearance in 2016. Under Lehotak's tenure, the Blue and White had its most successful season in 2016 since 2011, winning 30 games and finishing fourth in the Big Ten Conference. The team has also broken multiple hitting and pitching records in her five seasons with the Nittany Lions.

HARD WORK PAYS OFF FOR ARRIZURIETA

Senior **Gianna Arrizurieta** has earned a starting position in the Penn State infield and her hard work at the plate finally paid off in the Maryland series. The senior starting shortstop hit just shy of .400, going 3-for-8 at the plate for a .375 batting average in the past three games. Arrizurieta went 2-for-3 at the plate in the final game of the series to start two key rallies for the Nittany Lions, while scoring once.

WILLIAMS CLUTCH AT THE PLATE AGAINST UMD

Junior **Meghan Williams** started all three games at first base against Maryland for the Blue and White, hitting .300 on the weekend with three hits. The junior tallied three hits and drove in two RBI for the Nittany Lions. This season, Williams has started 10 games and ranks third on the team with a .241 batting average. The Bethlehem, Pennsylvania native has seven hits with two RBI and scored three times for the Nittany Lions.

BATS COME ALIVE IN GAME ONE AGAINST UMD

In game one against the Terrapins, the entire Penn State starting lineup tallied at least one hit, while four brought in at least one run and seven scored. Sophomores **Kennedy Legg** and **Destiny Weber** paced the lineup with two RBI each and **Meghan Williams** had two hits with one RBI and scored once. Williams ended the day with a team-high three hits between the two games.

CUMMINGS THROWS TWO COMPLETE GAMES

Senior hurler **Jessica Cummings** pitched two complete games against Maryland, walking just two batters in 14 innings of work and striking out 12. The senior hurler earned the 8-3 win for the Nittany Lions, giving up five hits in seven innings of work, striking out seven and allowing no walks.

PENN STATE WINS IN THRILLING WALK-OFF FASH-ION

Freshman **Dani Fey** led off the bottom of the ninth inning with a double into left center field for junior **Tori Dubois**, who placed a single over the second baseman's head to score Fey from second and secure the nine-inning 11-10 series win over Kent State for the Penn State softball team Sunday, March 18 at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. The Blue and White battled for their victory over the Golden Flashes as it came back to tie the game in both the bottom of the seventh and bottom of the eighth, scoring four runs in the seventh and two in the eighth. In total, the Nittany Lions tallied a season-high 11 runs on 14 hits and did not make an error in the field.

DUBOIS BIG AGAINST KENT STATE

Junior **Tori Dubois** opened the 2018 home campaign for the Nittany Lions with a .455 batting average, lacing five hits, driving in three RBI and scoring four times. Dubois's most important RBI of the weekend came in the bottom of the ninth inning against Kent State when she roped a single over the second baseman's head to score the runner on second and secure the 11-10 walk-off series victory for Penn State. The junior outfielder also had three putouts in left field, while carrying a .538 onbase percentage and a .636 slugging percentage through the three-game series with the Golden Flashes.

FEY POWERFUL LEADING OFF THE LINEUP

Freshman **Dani Fey** continued to be a clutch lead off batter for Penn State as she notched a .462 on-base percentage and a .500 slugging percentage in the three-game series with Kent State. Fey hit .300 on the weekend with three hits, one RBI and scoring twice for the Blue and White, while drawing three walks at the plate. Fey ended the weekend with a double into left field in the bottom of the ninth and scored the winning run on a **Tori Dubois** single into right field.

SHAFFER FINDS CONFIDENCE IN THE CIRCLE

Junior hurler **Madison Shaffer** found her stride at the Jacksonville Tournament for the Nittany Lions. Shaffer made a statement in the circle in week three of the season, pitching in all five games and making two starts for a total of 16.1 innings. The junior hurler came in against Western Carolina in relief and tossed 4.0 innings, striking out four and surrendering just one run. In her second appearance of the day, Shaffer earned the start and struck out a career-high eight batters at Jacksonville, while giving up just five hits in the loss.

PENN STATE SECURES WIN NUMBER ONE

After searching for its groove with a young team, the Nittany Lions put it all together when they played their second game at Jacksonville Friday, Feb. 23. Penn State used a string of hits to bring in its runs, while getting the leadoff batter on four times in the contest. After the Dolphins tied the game, Penn State would answer to go up by one, 3-2, before Fey scored one final security run to help the Blue and White to a 4-2 victory.

THREE HITTERS EMERGE IN WEEK ONE

Despite playing only 12 innings opening weekend and only one hitter seeing over five at-bats outside, three hitters have emerged to lead Penn State this season. Junior **Tori Dubois** is poised to surpass her 2017 season, securing hits in back-to-back games over the weekend and tallying the lone hit against No. 11 Alabama, while sophomore **Destiny Weber** also notched two hits for the Blue and White. Weber placed a ball to the middle infield against Virginia Tech that would cause a throwing error, scoring Penn State's lone run of the weekend. Finally, junior **Toni Polk** laced the only extra-base hit of the weekend for the Nittany Lions with a double into the outfield.

NEW STARTERS GET FIRST TASTE OF THE FIELD

The Nittany Lions had just one starter returning in the same position in which they started a year ago and fans saw a completely new look at the Sand Dollar Classic. Four newcomers earned starts in the first two contests, while five others started in new positions for the 2018 campaign.

PENN STATE ROAD WARRIORS

The Nittany Lions will open their 2018 season with 20 road games before they play a home contest at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. The Blue and White participate in four road tournaments, kicking things off at the Sand Dollar Classic, Feb. 9-11. From there, Penn State will head to the Big Ten/ACC Challenge for the second-straight season where it will take on first-year team Duke as well as Virginia Tech, Feb. 16-18. Lehotak and her squad then travel back to familiar territory for the head coach as the Nittany Lions will play in the Jacksonville Tournament, Feb. 23-25. Finally, Penn State plays a single game against Texas A&M, March 6 and will play in the Houston Tournament. March 9-11.

CONFERENCE TOUR

Penn State will see a slew of representatives from several different conferences this season, taking on teams from 11 different leagues in 2018. The Nittany Lions will take on teams from the American Athletic Conference (UCF, Houston), Atlantic Coast Conference (Georgia Tech, Pitt, Virginia Tech), Atlantic Sun Conference (Jacksonville, Lipscomb), Big 12 (Iowa State), Colonial Athletic Conference (Hofstra, JMU), Mid-American Conference (Kent State), Northeast Conference (Robert Morris, Saint Francis), Patriot League (Bucknell), Southeastern Conference (Alabama, Ole Miss, Texas A&M), and Southland Conference (Central Arkansas).

BLUE AND WHITE TO PLAY 24 HOME GAMES IN 2018

Penn State will play 24 of its 56 scheduled games insides the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. The home-heavy schedule will be a nice change for the Blue and White as it played only 15 of its 56 games at home in the 2017 campaign. Penn State will kick off its season with 20 away contests before opening its 2018 home campaign with a weekend series against non-conference opponent Kent State, March 16-18. The Nittany Lions hold a 61-59-1 overall record at Beard Field in its seven year existence which is good for a .504 winning percentage. Penn State will play 10 home contests in the month of March before taking on six opponents in 14 games in the month of April.

LEHOTAK BRINGS IN FIVE FRESHMEN FOR 2018

Head coach **Amanda Lehotak** brings in five fresh faces for the 2018 season. The 2018 freshman class includes: **Dani Fey**, **Emily Hudgins**, **Erin Murray**, **Haley Vallejos**, and **Tori Hackenberg**. The class consists of two infielders, one outfielder, one catcher, and one utility player.

MORE NEW FACES

Along with its five freshmen additions, Penn State has also added two transfers and two walk-ons. Junior **Paige Johnson** joins the Nittany Lions from Northwest Florida State, while **Kennedy Legg** is a mid-year transfer for Penn State from Ole Miss. Finally, sophomore **Amanda Grieco** and senior **Ashton Mensinger** walked on.

NEW SEASON, NEW LOOK

Penn State softball fans will see a new look on the field as it returns just four starters to its 2018 lineup. The Blue and White will see almost an entirely new infield, while senior **Gianna Arrizurieta** will return to the dirt in a variety of positions in her final season. The Nittany Lions will also have a new look in the outfield as **Tori Dubois** is the lone returner in left field. Finally, Penn State will look to veterans **Jessica Cummings**, **Madison Shaffer** and **Madey Smith** in the circle while also adding help from senior newcomer **Ashton Mensinger**.

TOUGH BIG TEN SCHEDULE

The Big Ten Conference has become one of the most competitive leagues in NCAA Division I softball as it has two teams represented in the preseason Top 25 Coaches Poll with Minnesota coming in at No. 16 and Michigan ranking No. 18. The B1G also has three teams receiving votes to kick off the 2018 campaign. The Nittany Lions will take on both Minnesota and Michigan in regular season contests, as well as Illinois and Ohio State, who are receiving votes.

10 NITTANY LIONS EARNS ACADEMIC ALL-BIG TEN HONORS IN 2017

The Penn State softball team had 10 student-ath-letes receive spring Academic All-Big Ten accolades following the 2017 winter semester. The returning honorees include: **Gianna Arrizurieta**, **Jessica Cummings**, **Tori Dubois**, and **Madison Shaffer**. To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten selection, student-athletes must be letterwinners who are in at least their second academic year at their institution and carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

ABRAMS INDUCTED INTO HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME

Assistant softball coach **Jennifer Abrams** was inducted into the Reading High School Hall of Fame on Saturday, Nov. 18. Abrams earned 11 varsity letters at Reading High School with four in softball and ice hockey and three for field hockey, while captaining all three teams in her career. Upon graduation from Reading High School, Abrams earned a scholarship to Providence College, where she played both softball and field hockey. After completing her four-year softball career, Abrams used her fifth year of eligibility to play field hockey for the Friars.

HAEFELI JOINS STAFF AS VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH

Haefeli graduated from Seton Hall University in 2015 with a dual bachelor's degree from the Stillman School of Business in marketing and sport management, while earning a minor in English.

Head coach Amanda Lehotak and the Penn State softball team announced the hiring of Christina Diaz as the first-ever Director of Softball Operations. Along with her job as a research & evaluation associate, Diaz has been the head coach of the varsity volleyball team at Bellefonte Area School District since 2014. 


