NITTANY LIONS HOST **CORNELL & PENN SATURDAY**

The No. 28 Penn State women's gymnastics team (2-4, 1-4 Big Ten) returns home to Rec Hall to host Cornell and Penn in a non-conference tri-meet on Saturday, Feb. 17, at 4 p.m.

The Nittany Lions enter the meet following a season-best score of 196.025 last Friday at Ohio State. Penn State's score of 96.025 marked its third-straight meet with a season-best tally.

Against Ohio State, Penn State posted scores of 48.875 (vault), 19.025 (uneven bars), 49.050 (balance beam), and 49.075 (floor exercise). For Penn State, its score of 49.050 on the balance beam is a season-best and its score of 49.075 on floor exercise s its second-highest floor score of the year.

ndividually at OSU, Gianna LaGuardia captured the vault title vith a career-best 9.875, Sabrina Garcia won the balance beam itle with a career-best 9.925, and Garcia tied with Briannah Isang for the floor exercise title (9.875). Tsang also won her sixth-straight all-around title as she tallied a score of 39.325.

HEAD COACH SARAH BROWN



Sarah Brown begins her first year as the head coach of the Penn State women's gymnastics team in 2018. Brown was named the eighth head coach of the Penn State women's gymnastics program on May 4, 2017. A two-time Big 12 Conference Gymnast of the Year, Brown comes to Happy Valley after serving as the head coach at Eastern Michigan University.

During her lone season as the head coach of the Eastern Michigan women's gymnastics team in 2017, Brown led the Eagles to the Mid-American Conference (MAC) regular season title, the MAC Championship, an appearance at the NCAA Regionals and a final national ranking of No. 27. At the 2017 MAC Gymnastics Championships, Eastern Michigan tallied its second-best score in program history (196.500), recorded a school record on the uneven bars (49.300), and three gymnasts tied for the uneven bars title.

During the 2016-17 season, a total of 10 Eastern Michigan gymnasts were named Academic All-MAC and five were selected MAC Distinguished Scholars. Four of the Eagles' MAC Distinguished scholars owned a grade-point average of 3.85 or higher. During the 2016 fall semester, Brown's squad earned a combined 3.49 grade-point average and a 3.69 GPA in the spring of 2017.

Brown served for one season as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Michigan during the 2015-16 school year, helping the Wolverines win the 2016 Big Ten Championship. She assisted on all four events and helped with development of daily practice plans. Her role with the Wolverines also included assisting with community service, recruiting and team travel.

Before joining the Michigan coaching staff, Brown was an assistant women's gymnastics coach at Southeast Missouri State University for three seasons, where she was selected the Midwest Independent Conference Assistant Coach of the Year in 2014.

Brown was the head beam coach and beam/floor choreographer and helped develop three MIC individual champions in 2014, two MIC Freshman of the Year selections and four NCAA regional allaround competitors.

She also was the director of operations for the University of Missouri women's gymnastics program for one year before starting her collegiate coaching career.

Brown began her collegiate gymnastics career at the University of Utah for one season before completing her collegiate career at the University of Missouri. A four-time All-American at Mizzou, she was the Tigers' Female Athlete of the Year in 2009 and 2010 and earned the Director of Athletics Leadership Award in 2010.

Brown brings numerous achievements from her time as a student-athlete to Penn State. Along with her All-America plaudits, Brown was selected the Big 12 Conference Gymnast of the Year in 2009 and 2010, was named to the All-Big 12 Championship Team nine times and was a nominee for the 2010 Honda Broderick Cup award.

A 2015 Missouri Athletics Hall of Fame inductee, Brown was named the 2008 Big 12 Newcomer of the Year and earned South Central Regional Gymnast of the Year honors twice (2009-10).

While she was at Utah, Brown was a member of the team that finished second at the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships in 2007.

Prior to her collegiate gymnastics career, she was a four-time member of the USA National Team (2002-05).

A two-time graduate of the University of Missouri, Brown earned a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies with an emphasis in communication and business in 2010 and a master's of education in counseling psychology with an emphasis in sport psychology in 2012.

A native of Columbia, Missouri, the former Sarah Shire is married to Antonio Brown. Sarah and Antonio welcomed a son, Isaiah, to the family on August 9, 2017.



NEWS & NOTES

SCOUTING CORNELL

Cornell enters the meet against Penn State following a season-best score of 193.625 in a quad meet victory last weekend at the Big Red Invitational.

At the Big Red Invitational, Cornell posted scores of 47.900 (vault), 48.650 (uneven bars), 48.400 (balance beam), and 48.675 (floor exercise).

Nationally, Cornell ranks 60th in average score (192.135), 59th on vault (47.965), 60th on uneven bars (47.885), 52nd on balance beam (48.135), and 61st on floor exercise (48.150).

SCOUTING PENN

The Penn Quakers make the trek to Happy Valley after posting their fifth-straight meet with a season-best score last weekend in a quad meet at the Palestra.

In the quad meet against Bridgeport (194.225), Temple (194.700), and Ursinus (186.900), Penn finished third with a score of 193.725.

On the day, Penn posted scores of 48.300 (vault), 47.925 (uneven bars), 48.200 (balance beam), and 49.300 (floor exercise).

In their third-place finish, the Quakers tied their school record on the floor exercise with a tally of 49.300. Individually on the floor exercise, Alex Hartke scored a career-best 9.925 and Kyra Levi posted a career-best 9.900.

Nationally, Penn is 59th in average score (192.175), 68th on vault (47.330), 64th on uneven bars (47.515), 39th on balance beam (48.560), and 45th on floor exercise (48.770).

B1G GYMNAST OF THE WEEK X2

Senior Briannah Tsang has received Big Ten Gymnast of the Week honors twice in 2018.

Following a season-best all-around score of 39.425 against Nebraska, Tsang was named the Big Ten Co-Gymnast of the Week (Jan. 16).

On Saturday, Jan. 13, against the Nebraska Cornhuskers, Tsang won the all-around title and floor exercise title outright in addition to tying for the uneven bars title.

On the day, Tsang tallied scores of 9.900 (floor exercise & uneven bars), 9.825 (vault), and 9.800 (balance beam) en route to a season-best all-around score of 39.425.

After capturing three titles at Michigan State, Tsang was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week (Feb. 5).

At Michigan State (Feb. 4), Tsang won the vault (9.850), floor exercise (9.925), and the all-around (39.475) – all with season-best scores. In addition to her three titles, Tsang tied for second on the balance beam (9.850) and she tied for fifth on the uneven bars (9.850).

B1G FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Following the season opener against Eastern Michigan, Lauren Bridgens was tabbed the Big Ten Freshman of the Week.

In her Penn State debut, Bridgens tied for the vault title (9.825), placed second on the uneven bars (9.800), finished fourth on the balance beam (9.700) and on the floor exercise (9.725). Bridgens closed out the day with a score of 39.050 in the all-around as she shared the all-around title with Briannah Tsang.

BROWN BEGINS FIRST YEAR AT PSU

Head coach Sarah Brown is in her first year at the helm of the Penn State women's gymnastics program. Brown was tabbed the eighth head coach in program history on May 4, 2017.

WELCOME (BACK) TO HAPPY VALLEY

Head coach Sarah Brown completed her coaching staff with the hiring of Dallas Becerra and Rob Drass.

Becerra comes to Penn State after spending the 2017 season as an assistant coach under Coach Brown at Eastern Michigan.

Drass, a 1990 Penn State graduate, returns to Happy Valley with a wealth of coaching experience. Most recently, Drass served as the assistant head coach for the University of Pittsburgh women's gymnastics team from 2014-17. While at Penn State, Drass was a member of the Penn State men's gymnastics program.

2017 RECAP

The 2017 Penn State women's gymnastics season featured the Nittany Lions posting an overall record of 11-8, which included a Big Ten record of 4-5. As a team, the Nittany Lions qualified for its 36th-straight NCAA Regional meet and they finished the year with a No. 31 ranking.

Individually, junior Sabrina Garcia and senior Briannah Tsang competed as individuals in the all-around at the 2017 NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships.

Garcia received regular season All-America honors from the National Association of College Gymnastics Coaches for Women (NACGC/W).

She garnered Penn State women's gymnastics' 94th All-America honor, as she was named a Second Team All-American on the uneven bars.

PSU ON BTN THREE TIMES

The Penn State women's gymnastics team will be on the Big Ten Network three times during the 2018 season. Penn State's lone regular season appearance on BTN will be its meet at Michigan State on Feb. 4. The meet will be streamed live on BTN2Go.com starting at 1 p.m. and will be shown via a tape delay starting at 4 p.m. on BTN.

Along with its meet at Michigan State, both sessions of the Big Five Meet and the Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships will be aired live on BTN on March 17 and March 24, respectively. Penn State will compete in the 5:30 p.m. session of the Big Five Meet and will either compete at 3 p.m. or 8 p.m. at the Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships.

#SQUAD54

The Penn State women's gymnastics team is comprised of 10 returners and four newcomers. The Nittany Lions welcome freshmen Alissa Bonsall, Lauren Bridgens, Kourtney Chinnery, and Ava Verdeflor to the program.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP

The Nittany Lions return a veteran laden squad in 2018. Sabrina Garcia and Briannah Tsang competed as individuals in the all-around at the 2017 NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships.

Along with Garcia and Tsang, Mason Hosek, Gianna LaGuardia, and Peyton Schuller return to the Nittany Lions in 2018. Prior to the start of the 2018 season, Hosek has competed in 21 of 24 meets, LaGuardia has competed in 17 of 24 meets, and Schuller has competed in 18 of 24 meets.

TSANG'S 58 TITLES

Senior Briannah Tsang has captured 42 individual titles and 16 all-around titles in her Nittany Lion career.

With six meets into the 2018 season complete, Tsang has 17 titles to her name. On the year, she has won four floor exercise titles, three vault titles, two uneven bars titles, two balance beam titles, and has captured at least a share of the all-around title six times.

FRESHMEN DEBUTS

The Penn State women's gymnastics team opened its 2018 season with three freshmen making their Nittany Lions debut.

For Penn State, Alissa Bonsall, Lauren Bridgens, and Kourtney Chinnery competed in the Nittany Lion lineup along with Ava Verdeflor competing an exhibition routine on the uneven bars.

Bonsall opened up her Nittany Lion career with a third-place finish on the vault (9.800), a third-place finish on the uneven bars (9.775), a fifth-place finish on the balance beam (9.625), an 11th-place finish on the floor exercise (9.550), and a fourth-place finish in the all-around (38.750).

In Bridgens' Nittany Lion debut, she tied for the vault title (9.825), took second on the uneven bars (9.800), placed fourth on the balance beam (9.700), took fourth on the floor exercise (9.725), and tied for the all-around title (39.050).





Chinnery made her debut with a 9.725 on the vault to place sixth.

Against Nebraska, Verdeflor made her Nittany Lion lineup debut with a 9.250 on the uneven bars to place 10th.

SIX-IN-A-ROW

Senior Briannah Tsang has captured at least a share of the all-around title in each of the first six meets of the 2018 season. In her Penn State career, Tsang has won the all-around 16 times. With her fourth-straight all-around title on Jan. 27, Tsang became the first Nittany Lion since Sharaya Musser to win four-straight all-around titles (2/23-3/16/13).

PRESEASON POLL

The Penn State women's gymnastics team was selected 25th in the 2018 National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches/Women (NACGC/W) Preseason Coaches' Poll.

The Nittany Lions closed out the 2017 season ranked No. 31.

Penn State will compete against 11 programs that are ranked in the NACGC/W Preseason Coaches' Poll during the 2018 season.

Along with the NACGC/W Preseason Coaches' Poll, the Nittany Lions were selected fifth in the Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Preseason Coaches' Poll.

HOME SWEET HOME

The 2018 slate features five regular season home meets for the Nittany Lions inside Rec Hall. Along with the five regular season home season meets, Penn State will be one of the six NCAA Regional hosts.

Penn State opens its home slate against Eastern Michigan (Jan. 6) followed by hosting Nebraska (Jan. 13). After a road meet at Maryland, the Nittany Lions return home to host Illinois for a double dual on Jan. 27.

The Blue & White close out its regular season home slate with back-to-back meets in February. Penn State will host Cornell & Penn in a tri-meet on Feb. 17 before welcoming George Washington to Rec Hall on Feb. 24.

If Penn State is one of the 36 teams to qualify for the NCAA Regional round, the Nittany Lions will be automatically seeded in the University Park Regional on April 7.

BIG TEN GYMNASTS TO WATCH

Prior to the start of the 2018 season, freshman Lauren Bridgens and senior Briannah Tsang were named Big Ten Gymnasts to Watch.

Bridgens enters her first year as a Nittany Lion after competing at Hill's Gymnastics under coaches Kelli Hill, Cynthia Smaha, and Tian Zhang. Last summer, Bridgens tallied a pair of top-10 finishes at the 2017 Junior Olympic National Championships, as she finished second on vault (9.875) and she tied for eighth on floor (9.625).

During her time at Penn State, Tsang has qualified for the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships each of the past two seasons.

At the 2017 NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships, she placed 30th in the all-around with a score of 39.1000, and her best finish of the evening came on the floor exercise as she tied for 18th with a 9.9000.

The 2015 Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year, Tsang has won 41 career titles, has received All-Big Ten First Team honors twice (2016 & 2017), tallied All-Big Ten Second Team honors in 2015, and was named to the 2017 Big Ten All-Championships Team.

FIRST CAREER TITLES

Three Nittany Lions have captured their first career titles this season. For Penn State, Alissa Bonsall shared the uneven bars title against Nebraska, Lauren Bridgens tied for the vault title and the allaround title against Eastern Michigan, and Gianna LaGuardia tied for the vault title at Maryland.

FUTURE NITTANY LIONS

Melissa Astarita and Dymiana Cox have signed their National Letters of Intent to attend Penn State University and participate in women's gymnastics starting in the 2019 season.

Astarita joins the Nittany Lions after competing at Action Gymnastics under coach Magdalena During. A native of Morganville, New Jersey, Melissa is the daughter of Michael and Natalie Astarita. While at Penn State, Melissa plans to major in mathematics.

Cox joins the Penn State women's gymnastics program after competing for Parkettes Gymnastics under coaches Robin Netwall, John Holman, Bill and Donna Strauss. A native of Elmont, New York, Dymiana is the daughter of Darrell and Jessica Cox. While at Penn State, Dymiana plans to major in kinesiology and intends to attend medical school following graduation.

Since 1975, Penn State owns a 234-61 overall record in home meets. The Nittany Lions are 231-61 at Rec Hall and are 3-0 in meets contested inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The loss to North Carolina State on Jan. 9, 2016, snapped a seven-meet winning streak inside Rec Hall. The seven-meet winning streak was the fourth-best in program history.


