#### THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This week marks the 32nd and 33rd meetings in the all-time series with Michigan holding the 17-13-1 edge including a 7-4-1 mark since the start of the 2017-18 season.
- The Wolverines won the season series last year with a 2-1-1-1 record taking 8-of-12 possible Big Ten points. The Nittany Lions hold the 7-5-1 mark at Pegula Ice Arena.
- Penn State enters the week unranked in the USCHO. com poll for the first time in the last 66 polls, the longest streak in program history spanning over three calendar years. The last time the Nittany Lions played a game while unranked was on December 1-2, 2017 at Ohio State. Penn State won that series with a shootout win followed by a 4-0 shutout to secure 5-of-6 Big Ten points.
- Penn State is 5-2-1 all-time in home openers including four-straight home opening victories. The Nittany Lions are 4-3-0 all-time in Big Ten home openers.
- Senior Alex Limoges has fared well against Michigan in his time at Penn State having scored four goals while adding six assists for 10 points in 12 career games to lead all Nittany Lions. Only two other current Nittany Lions have scored against Michigan as senior Sam Sternschein and junior Aarne Talvitie have one goal each in 15 combined games. Sternschein's goal was an overtime winner in a wild 7-6 victory in Hockey Valley two years ago.

## FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

• For the first time in program history, Penn State secured the Big Ten regular-season championship in 2019-20 and No. 1 overall seed entering the conference tournament. Penn State's 12 victories and 41 points in conference play last season were both program highs.

#### **HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-0**

- Penn State's magic number is five, the Nittany Lions were 11-0-0 last year when scoring at least five goals and 77-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals with the lone loss coming during the 2018-19 season against Wisconsin at the Kohl Center in an 8-5 defeat.
- In 2019-20 the Nittany Lions were also 16-1-3 when scoring first and a perfect 15-0-2 when leading entering the third period.

#### **BREAK THE WALL DOWN**

- Sophomore Kevin Wall had just seven points on a pair of goals and five assists in 26 games last season but he has already bettered his 2019-20 goal output in the first four games of 2020-21 having scored a goal in the first three games of the season.
- Having scored the final goal of the 2019-20 season and the first goal of the 2020-21 season Wall pushed his career-best goal and point streak to four games, but was kept off the scoresheet in the series finale at Wisconsin to snap the streak.
- Wall leads the team with his three goals and four points this season while his goal total is tied for fourth in the Big Ten and tied for fifth nationally.

#### **ADJUST YOUR AUTIO LEVELS**

• With the graduation of Peyton Jones, Penn State has an opening in net for the first time in four years and both junior Oskar Autio and freshman Liam Souliere started a pair of games last week each splitting both series.

- Having never started a Big Ten contest against either Minnesota or Wisconsin in his previous two years, Autio will have a little more familiarity with his opponent this week as the only prior Big Ten starts of his career before this season have come against the Wolverines.
- Autio has three total appearances against Michigan in his career with a pair of starts and has posted a 0-1-1 record with a .907 save percentage and a 3.50 goalsagainst average.

#### O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Senior Alex Limoges was named Penn State's 2020-21 captain and earned his second-straight preseason First-Team All-B1G nod after earning honorable mention accolades at the conclusion of the 2019-20 season.
- Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 106 for his career to rank third nationally. His 42 career goals are the second-most among active players in the Big Ten, only behind Michigan State's Mitchell Lewandowski with 44, and also tied for third nationally.
- Limoges became the eighth Nittany Lion in program history to reach the 100-point mark for his career last season and after a three-point series against Wisconsin has moved passed Andrew Sturtz into sixth on the Penn State all-time points list. His 42 goals are good for eighth all-time

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

- The Nittany Lions return home to Pegula Ice Arena after four-straight road games to open the season. It was just the second-time in program history that Penn State played four-straight road games at the start of the year with the only other time coming to begin the 2017-18 season.
- Penn State is 80-42-14 all-time at Pegula Ice Arena including an 11-5-3 record last season and a program-best 15 home victories during the 2018-19 season.

## **WELL, THAT'S A PLUS**

- In two-plus seasons in Hockey Valley junior alternate captain Paul DeNaples is a plus-47 in 77 career games ranking tied for third all-time at Penn State behind the plus-50 of Andrew Sturtz '20
- DeNaples finished second in the Big Ten last season with a plus-18 rating only behind his defensive partner Cole Hults who was plus-23. As a freshman, DeNaples led the entire nation with a plus-31 rating.
- DeNaples has had just 14 games with a negative plus-minus out of his 77 career games played. In those games, Penn State is just 4-9-1 including a 1-3-1 record last season and an 0-2-0 record this season.

#### **SCOUTING MICHIGAN**

- The Wolverines enter the series ranked seventh in the nation, but coming off a sweep at the hands of Notre Dame over the weekend. With a 2-2-0-1-0 record and five conference points, Michigan is currently fourth in the Big Ten standings.
- Michigan lost its top-three scorers from last season's team to graduation, but have replenished with a plethora of first-round NHL draft talent to join 2019 first-round selection's Johnny Beecher and Cam York. Overall, Michigan has seven draft picks on its roster with a number of players who will go high in the draft come next June.
- Defenseman Owen Power has the possibility to be selected first overall in the 2021 draft. He has already showcased numerous highend skills in the first six games of the season with one goal and three assists for four points and you can't teach size, the Ontario stands at 6-5 weighing 214 pounds and just turned 18 a mere 10 days ago.
- Michigan is led on offense by three freshmen as future first-rounder Kent Johnson paces the trio with eight points on one goal and seven assists. 2020 second-round pick Thomas Bordeleau has added seven points on two goals and five assists while Matty Beniers has two goals and three assists. Senior Michael Pastujov leads the Wolverines with three goals.
- The Wolverines do return reigning Big Ten Goaltender of the Year in Strauss Mann. Mann posted a .939 save percentage and 1.85 goals-against average last year to lead the Big Ten and rank third and fifth in the nation, respectively. Mann currently ranks sixth in the nation with a .939 save percentage among goaltenders with multiple starts while his 1.33 goalsagainst average is good for third.
- Michigan's power-play leads the Big Ten and ranks tied for third in the nation at 30 percent (6-for-20) as the six power-play goals are the most in the nation. However, after going six for its first 14 over the opening three games of the season, Michigan is 0-for-6 in its last three games with the man-advantage.



#### **BIG TIME TIMMY JIM**

 Graduate transfer Tim Doherty secured his first Nittany Lion goal on Monday evening at Wisconsin. Doherty's 78 career points are good for 19th among active players and fourth in the Big Ten while his 35 career goals place him 12th nationally and fourth among Big Ten student-athletes.

#### **ETCHED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS**

- Penn State will look a little different when they hit the ice this season after graduating the largest senior class in program history and arguably one of the most decorated throughout the nation as well as having two juniors leave early after signing entry-level NHL contracts.
- The 2020 senior class accounted for 85 victories over their four years, just one shy of the most-ever by a single class, a distinction held by the class of 2019 with 86 wins.
- The group consisted of four of the top-10 scorers in program history led by Penn State's all-time leading scorer, Nate Sucese with 140 points and followed by Brandon Biro (116), Denis Smirnov (115) and Liam Folkes (103) in fourth, fifth and seventh, respectively. The group also featured Peyton Jones, the most decorated goalie in program history who holds nearly every single goaltending record Penn State.
- The 2020 senior class played in a total 1,142 games scoring 634 points on 258 goals and 376 assists and had four 100-point scorers.
- The Nittany Lions are also without the services of Evan Barratt and Cole Hults after the pair inked entry-level NHL contracts with the Chicago Blackhawks and the Los Angeles Kings back in April.
- Barratt ranked ninth on the all-time points list and tenth on the goals list at Penn State with 95 and 39, respectively, while Hults held nearly every single record for defensemen at Penn State and led the entire Big Ten with a plus-23 rating last season.

#### THE GREAT GADOWSKY

- Head Coach Guy Gadowsky was named a finalist for Big Ten Coach of the Year last season after leading the Nittany Lions to their first-ever B1G regular-season title. The Bench Boss secured the seventh 20-win season of his collegiate coaching career and his fourth with the Nittany Lions with a 3-2 victory over Minnesota to close out the regular season.
- The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory earlier this year and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

#### **CANADIAN INFLUENCE**

- Four Nittany Lions call Canada home.
- All four hail from Ontario: Will Holforster (Mississauga), Mason Snell (Courtice), Connor MacEachern (Brooklin) and freshman Liam Souliere (Brampton).

#### **EUROPEAN CONNECTION**

- Penn State has a pair of players on its 2020-21 roster from Finland.
- Goaltender Oskar Autio is following in his brothers footsteps joined by longtime friend and New Jersey Devils draft pick Aarne Talvitie. Both players are from Espoo and grew up playing for the Esspoo Blues.

#### **PACKING THE PEG**

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 126-of-135 home games, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games that was snapped earlier this season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds last season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 in the last home game against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.
- Last season, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).
- Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

#### **WELCOME HOME**

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

#### THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its eighth season entering 2020-21. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New for the 2020-21 season is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other leadule.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- Arizona State will play each Big Ten team four times all on the road giving each team 28 regular season contests. ASU is not eligible for conference awards or the Big Ten Tournament.

#### **MEET COACH GADOWSKY**

**Guy Gadowsky** guides the Nittany Lions in his 21st collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his ninth at Penn State in the 2020-21 campaign

## **AT PENN STATE**

This past year, Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the 2019-20 Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.



Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten

wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Niittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with

the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning re-

cord in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells
