#### **Five Things To Know**

- 1. A big reason the Gophers went 16-0 at home this season is because of a record breaking atmosphere. The Gophers broke a single game home attendance record with 1,389 fans at home against Iowa two weekends ago. They broke a Jane Sage Cowles season attendance record with 14,346 fans. They are no stranger to playing on the road though. Minnesota traveled the first eight weeks of the season and have won 32 games away from home.
- 2. For the second straight week the Gophers swept the Big Ten weekly softball awards. Kendyl Lindaman won her seventh B1G Freshman of the Week and first B1G Player of the Week plaudit. Sara Groenewegen was named the B1G Pitcher of the Week for the third straight week and fifth time this season. The Gophers have now won 18 weekly awards this season.

Lindaman hit .615 with an on base percentage of .722 and a slugging percentage of 1.462 this week. She drove in 10 runs with two doubles and three home runs. She scored a run in all five of the Gophers game and drew five walks. On defense she accounted for 42 putouts.

Groenewegen picked up three more victories in the circle this week with one against NDSU and two against Purdue. In all three starts she had 10 or more strikeouts with 34 on the week. On Friday Groenewegen pitched her seventh career no-hitter and had another one going through 4.1 innings of work on Saturday.

- **3.** Sam Macken has had many big moments for the Gophers throughout her career and put on a spectacular performance on senior weekend. Last week she hit .533 with a 1.200 slugging percentage. She stole two bases, had one double and hit three home runs including a walk-off to complete a run-rule victory and a grand slam.
- **4.** The Gophers are ranked top-10 in eight different NCAA statistical categories as a team and in 12 individual statistical areas. The most impressive is the balance between hitting and pitching. The Gophers are ranked third in the NCAA in batting average with a .347 as a team and are second in ERA with a 1.18 as a staff. They lead the entire country in win/loss percentage and no team has more than their 48 wins on the season.
- **5.** Lindaman already holds the Gophers single season home run record and has a shot at a couple more records. She is two walks away from the record with 45 this year. She is also third in RBIs with 64 this season. Sydney Dwyer is chasing the single season RBI record as well with 69 on the season. The record is 74 RBIs in a season.

Maddie Houlian and Danielle Parlich could crack the top-5 in runs. They have 53 and 51 respectively. The third fifth most runs scored in a season is 55 and three people are tired for second with 57 runs scored in a season.

Groenewegen is two wins away from cracking the top-5 in a Gophers season for the third year in a row. She is 25-2 this season. She is also just 40 strikeouts away from the Gophers career record. Sara Moulton currently holds that with 1,184 in a career.



#### The Coaches



Jessica Allister Head Coach

Minnesota head softball coach Jessica Allister enters her seventh season leading the Minnesota softball program coming off another great year in 2016 that saw the Gophers go 43-14. The Gophers have now made a program record four straight trips to the NCAA Tournament under Alliser. She is 274-105 overall in her career.

In Allister's sixth season the Maroon and Gold went over the 30 win mark for the sixth straight time, made their fourth straight NCAA Tournament and won their second B1G Tournament championship in three years. They went on a roll from April 15-May 20 winning 15 straight games to tie a program record for longest winning streak. In that stretch they outscored opponents 129-27. Minnesota beat the eventual national champions, Oklahoma, twice and topped No. 2 Michigan in a 10-inning thriller for the B1G Tournament championship title.

The Jessica Allister era of Minnesota softball began on Aug. 10, 2010, when then-director of athletics Joel Maturi named the former Oregon assistant and All-America catcher from Stanford the sixth head coach in Minnesota history. Academically, Allister's teams have featured 53 student-athletes who earned Academic All-Big Ten distinction, including 11 in 2014, 14 in 2015 and 12 in 2016.



Jessica Merchant Associate Head Coach

Jessica Merchant is in her seventh season as an assistant coach with the Golden Gophers softball program. She has helped guide the Maroon and Gold to a 234-102 record in that span. She served four years at UMass in the same capacity.

Merchant works primarily with the teams infielders. She helped former Gopher Malisa Barnes earn her third All-Big Ten honor and former Gophers Kaitlyn Richardson and Tyler Walker to three NFCA Great Lakes All-Region teams each. They both also earned three and four all-conference accolades, respectively. Both were named to the All-Big Ten First Team as sophomores in 2013 and as a juniors in 2014 and were all-region honorees in both years. Richardson was became the school's third two-time All-American with a third-team nod in 2013 and a second-team nod in 2014. She was also a top-25 finalist to the NFCA National Player of the Year Award. Again in 2015 Richardson earned All-American honors being named a senior class First-Team All-American. A two-time NFCA All-America shortstop, Merchant captained the Wolverines to the 2005 NCAA Championship, the first national title in program history.




Piper Ritter Pitching Coach

Former Minnesota pitcher Piper Ritter is in her tenth season with the Gophers as pitching coach, having already developed two of the top hurlers in Minnesota softball history, Brianna Hassett and Sara Moulton and another in current Gopher Sara Groenewegen.

Ritter guided Groenewegen to Big Ten Freshman of the Year and Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors in 2014, making the White Rock, B.C. native the third player in conference history to win both awards in the same season. Groenewegen is a two-time All-American

During her four-year playing career with the Gophers (2001-04), Ritter became one of the most accomplished pitchers in program history. She left the university with career records for strikeouts (1,122), innings pitched (921.1), games (173), wins (88), shutouts (33), and complete games (85).


