Nittany Lions Host Bucknell in Midweek Clash: Penn State baseball will host the Bucknell Bison in a midweek contest at 6:05 p.m. on Wednesday. The Nittany Lions look to make it 18-straight against the Bison, last being defeated in 1998. The Lions are coming off a successful 2-1 weekend series win against the Michigan Wolverines.

Most Recently: Penn State enters Wednesday's contest with a recent 2-1 big series victory over Michigan this past weekend. On Sunday afternoon, Penn State seniors Jordan Steranka and Sean Deegan once again played heroic roles in the Nittany Lions' huge 6-4 victory over the Wolverines. With the Lions trailing in the seventh, Deegan hit a two-run bomb to put Penn State up. Steranka added insurance with a homer in the eighth. On Saturday, the Nittany Lions broke out with a 14-run and 17-hit performance to top Michigan, 14-1. Senior Joey DeBernardis went 4-for-5 with three RBI and two runs scored. Steranka collected three hits and two homers to go along with five RBI in the victory.

Franky Taking the Hill: Senior Mike Franklin will get his sixth start on the hill for the Nittany Lions this season. Franklin enters Wednesday's game with a 2-2 record in five starts and six appearances overall. The senior is coming off a six-inning effort in a 5-3 loss at Pittsburgh last Wednesday. Franklin has allowed no more than four runs in any of his starts this season.

Scouting Bucknell: Bucknell enters Wednesday's contest with a 19-19 overall record and a 6-6 mark in Patriot League play. The Bison are hitting a solid .302 as a team and have five batters that are swinging at .300 clip or better. Leading the way for the Bison is Bob Donato, who is hitting .391 with six homers and 30 RBI this season. Donato leads the Patriot League in hits and homeruns while sitting second in the League in RBI. Rob Krentzman is also an elite hitter in the Bison lineup, as he is batting .360 with nine RBI this season. Krentzman is coming off a three RBI per-

formance against Lehigh this past weekend, as the Bison took two of three from the Mountain Hawks.

All-Time vs. the Bison: Penn State holds a 119-28-1 all-time advantage on the Bison, which includes 17-straight victories for the Nittany Lions in the series. Bucknell last defeated Penn State back in 1998. The last eight contests have been played on the University Park campus. Penn State clipped the Bison last year by a score of 7-3 at Medlar Field.

Steranka Tabbed Big Ten Co-Player of the Week: Jordan Steranka has been named Big Ten Co-Player of the Week, the conference office announced on Monday. Steranka picks up a weekly award from the conference for the first time in his career. The last Penn State athlete to be named Player of the Week was Steve Snyder back on May 3, 2010. Steranka is coming off arguably a career week, as he sported a .571 batting average in four games (eight hits in 14 at bats). He hit three homers and drove in eight runs with an OPS (on base plus slugging) of 2.029. He tied his career-high for home runs on Saturday with two against Michigan. Steranka drove five runs in that game as well, leading Penn State to a 14-1 victory. Steranka gave the Nittany Lions an insurance run with a solo homer in the eighth inning against Michigan on Sunday to give PSU a 6-4 lead. In addition, he moved into second place in program history in at-bats (790), a tie for fourth in RBI (153) and fourth in triples (11). The senior first baseman is just 31 hits shy of tying the school record for career hits. Penn State took two of three games from the Wolverines this past weekend.

Bats Coming Around as of Late: Penn State's offense has really picked it up as of late. Through its first 21 game this season, the Nittany Lions were averaging just 3.5 runs per game. In its last 14 games, Penn State is averaging 6.5 runs per contest. The Lions 10-4 in those 14 games.

Wine Wins his 200th: Penn State head coach Robbie Wine earned his 200th career win as Penn State skipper on Sunday. Wine becomes the fifth head coach in school history to eclipse the 200-win plateau, joining Joe Hindelang (389), Joe Bedenk (380), Chuck Medlar (308) and Shorty Stone (216).



Steranka Chasing the Hits Record: Jordan Steranka, who sits alone in second place all-time on the Penn State hits list, currently has 264 hits and trails Michael Campo by 31 hits for first. With 19 guaranteed games left, this is what Steranka will need to do to break the school hits record:

- Hits Needed:** 31
- Games Remaining:** 19
- Needs to Average:** 1.63 hits
- Hits/game this year:** 1.54
- Last 10 games:** 2.2 hits

Steranka is also third place all-time on the Penn State RBI list with 172. Steranka trails Chris Wright by four RBI for second place in the school record books. Steranka is approaching a handful of records including at bats (tied for second, nine behind first), runs (tied for fourth), doubles (third, seven behind first) and triples (fourth). With three homers against Michigan this weekend, Steranka moved into a tie for sixth in the school annals.

Opening the Gates in West Lafayette: After dropping the first two of the series and facing a potential sweep, Penn State closed out the weekend with a season-high 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-6 victory over the No. 19 Purdue Boilermakers two weekends ago. The Nittany Lions belted four homeruns and had a seven-run third inning. The first four batters in the Nittany Lion lineup collected a total of 11 hits and drove in 10 runs. Senior Sean Deegan started it all with leadoff homerun to begin the game. Senior Jordan Steranka had four hits and drove in three runs. Senior Joey DeBernardis drove in four and belted a two-run homer in the seventh inning. Sophomore Steve Snyder drove

in two runs and had three hits as he made his second start of the season in the No. 2 spot. The bottom of the order put together a great performance as well. Sophomore Alex Farkes had a three-hit performance and two RBI, which included a massive home run in the eighth inning. Freshman Aaron Novak belted his second homerun of the season as

well. Junior Elliot Searer collected two hits and a had a great game defensively in the field. Sophomore Steven Hill picked up his first win of the season as he went 6.2 innings, giving up four runs, three of which were earned. He walked just one batter and struck out three.

More Notes on Game 3 Win at Purdue:

The outburst resulted in a number of milestones for some players. Most notably, Alex Farkes homered in his second consecutive game and set or tied career highs five offensive categories. Farkes set career highs in at bats (5) and hits (3) and also tied his career best in runs (2) and RBI (2). Aaron Novak's three RBI that came on his homerun in the third inning are a single-game best for him. In addition, Joey DeBernardis scored a personal best four runs in Sunday's victory. The 16 runs were the most the Nittany Lions have scored since May 1, 2010 when Penn State defeated Michigan State by a score of 22-5.

Solid Pitching Against Nation's No. 1

Offense: Purdue's offense came into the weekend first in the country in hitting, but strong starts from all three Nittany Lion starters dropped Purdue from first to ninth nationally. The Boilermakers scored 18 runs (6.0 per game), which were 2.1 below their season average. Most notably, 10 of those 18 Boilermaker runs were unearned.

Firsts for Skerp: In Penn State's 7-1 game two victory over Coppin State, freshman Taylor Skerpon went 1-for-2 and earned his first career hit and RBIs.

With two outs in the second inning and the score tied at zero in game two, Skerpon hit a single the other way to right centerfield to give the Nittany Lions a 2-0 edge on the Eagles. Skerpon has started at shortstop in two games this season.

Patton the Stats: Also in the 7-1 vic-

tory over Coppin State, freshman Patton Taylor picked up his first career victory on the mound. Taylor pitched 2.2 innings in his first career start and struck out three batters to earn the win. Also noteworthy in that game was Alex Farkes, who hit his first career homerun. Mike Franklin additionally struck out a career-high eight batters in game one, as he picked up his second win of the season.

Penn State to Have at Least Four Games

Televised this Season: The Nittany Lion baseball team will play in four games televised by the BTN starting with the Friday, Apr. 13 matchup against Michigan at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. PSU's visit to Target Field to play Minnesota will air Saturday, May 5 at 3:00 p.m. as well Illinois' trip to Happy Valley on Sunday, May 13. Penn State's regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the week of May 23-27.

Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness:

Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. During 2011, Hill fired four complete games, which equals the total posted by every other Penn State pitcher since the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the 15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.
