#### **ALL-TIME VS. DREXEL**

- · Penn State is 25-4 all-time against the Dragons but the Nittany Lions have lost the last two matchins
- The teams played every year from 1973-96 before restarting the series in 2010.

#### LAST TIME VS. THE DRAGONS

- · Penn State scored the game's final five goals but fell to Drexel, 14-13, at Jeffrey Field on April 9, 2011.
- $\cdot$  Matthew Mackrides scored four goals, Nick Dolik tallied three times and Jack Forster scored twice.

#### SCOUTING DREXEL

- Drexel, which is on a three-game winning streak, can clinch a spot in the CAA semifinals with a win against the Nittany Lions.
- · Against common non-conference opponents, Drexel lost to Villanova (14-9), Notre Dame (6-5)

- and Bucknell (12-11).
- · Junior attackman Robert Church is tied for fifth in the nation with a 38-game point-scoring streak (76-39--115).
- · Led by Church, the Dragons have five players with at least 15 points.


#### ALL IN THE FAMILY

#### PENN STATE IN THE CAA

- · Penn State, which joined the CAA for the 2010 season, is 6-7 all-time in conference games.
- The Nittany Lions were 1-4 in 2010 and improved to 4-2 during head coach Jeff Tambroni's first season.
- · In 2011, the Nittany Lions clinched home-field advantage for the CAA semifinals.

#### MACKRIDES AMONG NATION'S BEST

- · Senior Matthew Mackrides ranks 15th in the nation among active players in career goals (87).
- · Mackrides currently ranks second on the team with 16 goals.

#### **FINDING FORSTER**

- · Senior attackman Jack Forster, who leads the team in goals (19), assists (8) and points (27), surpassed his 2010 point total (15) with a two-point performance against Lehigh.
- · Forster missed the 2008 and 2010 seasons due to injury, and ranked second on the team with 34 points (22g, 12a) as a redshirt freshman in 2009.
- · Forster has registered at least one point in nine games and is on a six-game goal scoring streak (14g).

#### **NITTANY LIONS IN THE NCAA**

· Through April 1 games, Penn State is tied for 11th in the country in scoring defense (8.00) and ranks 13th in caused turnovers per game (8.4).

#### **KAUT SOLID BETWEEN THE PIPES**

· Through April 1 games, sophomore goalkeeper Austin Kaut ranks sixth in the nation in save percentage (.601), seventh in saves per game (11.60) and 11th in goals-against average (7.79).

#### LIONS DOWN WILDCATS

· Tied 6-6 at the half, Penn State scored seven

- second-half goals en route to a 13-8 victory against then-No. 12/13 Villanova.
- The Nittany Lions held Villanova scoreless for a 31:57 span.
- · Freshman Kyle Baier scored his first collegiate goal.

#### PENN STATE VS. THE BIG EAST

• The Nittany Lions are 2-0 against the BIG EAST in 2012 after defeating then-No. 2/4 Notre Dame, 4-3, in overtime on Feb. 26 and then-No. 12/13 Villanova, 13-8, on March 31.

#### PENN STATE VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- · Penn State has played eight games against ranked opponents, including four top-10 teams and a pair of top-5 teams.
- · The Nittany Lions are 3-5 against ranked opponents in 2012.

#### PENN STATE VS. THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

• The Nittany Lions are 0-2 against Patriot League teams in 2012 after falling to then-No. 10/11 Lehigh, 9-5, on March 20 and No. 16 Bucknell, 9-6, on March 27.

#### **BUCKNELL RECAP**

- · Senior defenseman Ryan McGarvey scored his first career goal from his own restraining line, but Penn State fell to Bucknell, 9-6, on March 27
- · The game was tied at 4-4 at the half, but the Bison out scored Penn State by a 5-2 margin over the last two quarters.
- · Senior Jack Forster (2g) registered his sixth multi-goal game of the season.

#### NITTANY LIONS GET BACK ON TRACK

· Penn State snapped its three-game losing streak with a 7-3 victory against Saint Joseph's on March 24.

- · Jack Forster (2g) and Matthew Mackrides (1g, 1a) led Penn State with two points each.
- · Junior Nick Dolik and sophomore Shane Sturgis added a goal, while freshman Kyle Zittel recorded an assist.
- · Sophomore Austin Kaut made 9 saves.

#### **ALL-TIME IN CONFERENCE OPENERS**

- · Since Penn State joined a conference beginning in the 2000 season, the Nittany Lions are 2-11 in conference openers.
- · Penn State was 1-9 as a member of the ECAC (2000-09) and is 1-2 in the CAA (2010-pres.).

#### **UMASS RECAP**

- · Penn State fell to No. 3 Massachusetts, 9-8, in overtime at the Penn State Lacrosse Field.
- · In a back-and-forth game that produced seven lead changes, Matthew Mackrides, who scored three goals, tied the game with 5:30 left before Massachusetts won in OT.
- Mackrides registered a hat trick for the first time
   since a four-goal outing against Drexel on April
   9, 2011.
- $\cdot$  Tom LaCrosse scored twice against the Minutemen for the third straight game.

#### **DENVER RECAP**

- Penn State's three-game win streak was snapped with a 14-6 loss to then-No. 11/13 Denver.
- · Jack Forster and Nick Dolik scored two goals each. Shane Sturgis and Travis Crane also scored.

#### **DEFENSE DOMINANT IN PAIR OF WINS**

- · Penn State allowed only five combined goals in wins against Notre Dame and Ohio State.
- The five goals against was Penn State's best two-game defensive stretch since allowing a combined four goals in back-to-back games in 1961 (5/13/61: W vs. Swathmore, 9-0; 5/16/61: W vs. Gettysburg, 14-4)

## **PENN STATE CRACKS TOP 10**

· On March 5, Penn State was ranked in the top 10 in the USILA Coaches' and *Inside Lacrosse* Media Polls for the first time in program history.

#### **PSU CAPTURES CREATOR'S TROPHY**

- Penn State defeated then-No. 16/17 Ohio State,
  5-2, on Saturday, March 3 to clinch the inaugural
  Creator's Trophy.
- · The Trophy was established this season by the three Big Ten schools that sponsor men's lacrosse -- Michigan, Ohio State, Penn State -- as a way to promote the rivalry between the school.
- A 2-0 record is needed to capture the Trophy,
   and Penn State defeated Michigan, 16-9, on Feb.
   18.

#### **BEST START SINCE 2002**

 Penn State's 3-1 start was its best since the 2002 season. The Nittany Lions ended the 2002 campaign at 8-5.

#### **NOTRE DAME RECAP**

- · Penn State defeated its highest ranked opponent ever with a 4-3 OT win against then-No. 2 Notre Dame on Feb. 26.
- The Nittany Lions erased a 2-0 deficit before allowing the Fighting Irish to tie the game, 3-3, later in the fourth.
- · Senior Matthew Mackrides scored the gamewinning goal with two seconds left in the extra frame.

#### KAUT NAMED CAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

· Sophomore goalkeeper Austin Kaut was named CAA Player of the Week on Feb. 27 after an 18-save performance against then-No. 2 Notre Dame.

### MANLEY TABBED ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

 Freshman attack Pat Manley was tabbed CAA Rookie of the Week after totaling two points (1g, 1a), a ground ball and caused turnover in Penn State's 16-9 win against Michigan.

- · Senior Matthew Mackrides and sophomore Austin Kaut were named to the first installment of Tewaaraton Watch List.
- · The Tewaaraton Award is presented to the nation's best male and female lacrosse players.
- The selection committee will add student-athletes to the watch list as the season progresses before the 25 nominees are announced in late April. The five finalists will be announced in mid-May before the winner is unveiled May 31.

#### **NORTH CAROLINA RECAP**

- · Penn State fell to No. 6 North Carolina, 14-10, in front of nearly 7,000 fans in its season-opening game.
- The Nittany Lions trailed 2-1 after the first quarter and brought the game to within three early in the fourth, but the Tar Heels held on for the 14-10 win
- · Seven different Nittany Lions scored, including Pat Manley in his collegiate debut.

#### NITTANY LIONS TABBED FOURTH

- · Penn State was tabbed to finish fourth in the conference by the league's coaches. The Nittany Lions earned 23 points and one first-place vote.
- · Defending league champion Delaware was tabbed first with 31 points and three first-place votes.

#### SENIOR SELECTED IN MLL DRAFT

- $\cdot$  Senior midfielder Matthew Mackrides was selected 26th overall by the Chesapeake Bayhawks in the 2011 MLL Collegiate Draft.
- · After graduation, Mackrides will have the opportunity to become the 27th Nittany Lion to play professionally.

#### **PSU RANKED IN PRESEASON POLLS**

- $\cdot$  The Nittany Lions were ranked in both major preseason polls.
- Penn State was ranked No. 17 in the USILA poll and No. 18 in the Nike/Inside Lacrosse Media Poll.

· Sophomore goalkeeper Austin Kaut was named CAA Preseason Co-Player of the Year and was joined by senior midfielder Matthew Mackrides and defender Ryan McGarvey on the All-CAA Preseason Team.

#### PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

· Prior to the season, *Inside Lacrosse* named Matthew Mackrides, Austin Kaut and sophomore

- attackman Shane Sturgis Honorable Mention All-Americans.
- · Sturgis led Penn State with 34 points (18g, 16a) in 2011.

#### **KAUT IN NET**

- · Sophomore Austin Kaut returns in the net following a sensational freshman season.
- · Kaut earned USILA Honorable Mention All-America, CAA Rookie of the Year, All-CAA First Team and CAA All-Rookie Team honors in 2011.
- · He led the NCAA in save percentage (.635) and ranked 10th in goals-against average (7.90).

#### PRESEASON RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Nittany Lions will face nine opponents ranked in the USILA preseason top 20, including non-conference home matchups against No. 5 Denver (March 10), No. 10 Villanova (March 31), No. 12 Bucknell (March 27).
- · In addition to UNC, Penn State will visit No. 9 Notre Dame Feb. 26.

#### **PSU WELCOMES 15 NEWCOMERS**

- · Penn State welcomed 15 newcomers to the 2012 roster, including 12 freshmen and three transfers.
- · Five newcomers -- Travis Crane (2008), Reed Kennedy (2011), Riley Lasda (2011), Erik Myers (2010), Kyle Zittel (2011) who were honored as US Lacrosse High School All-Americans.
- · Midfielders Michael Richards and Taylor Stothoff garnered ESPN RISE honorable mention recognition.
- · The Nittany Lions' three transfers include Crane (UMBC), John Cugini (Denver), David Spadacene (Presbyterian).

### **SENIOR CAPTAINS**

- · Seniors Ryan Link, Matthew Mackrides and Ryan McGarvey were tabbed captains for the 2012 season.
- · Mackrides is the first two-time captain since Dave Daniecki, Greg Jackson and Tolleison Morriss each served in 1996-97.

#### **TAMBRONI IN YEAR TWO**

- · Head coach Jeff Tambroni will enter his second year with the Nittany Lions in 2012. At Cornell, Tambroni went from 7-6 in his first year to 11-4 and an NCAA tournament berth in his second season.
- · Tambroni holds a 116-47 career record as a head coach. His .712 winning percentage is good for sixth among active head coaches with a minimum of 100 games.
