Setting the Scene: The Nittany Lions travel to New Jersey on Sunday for a highly anticipated match against the defending NCAA national champions Princeton. Penn State enters the match ranked 13 while Princeton is currently third in the poll.

All-Time vs. Princeton: Sunday's match between Princeton and Penn State will be the 32nd meeting in the series between the two sides. Historically, The Nittany Lions have dominated the series, holding a 23-8 record over the Tigers heading into Sunday's showdown. However, the matchup has been much more competitive in recent years. Princeton has claimed a victory in the last two meetings, winning a 3-2 overtime thriller in University Park a season ago. The last win for the Blue and White in the series came on October 29, 2010. The Nittany Lions won a low scoring affair by a final score of 1-0. Each of the last three matches has been decided by one goal.

Scouting the Tigers: As of Thursday (Friday's match vs. Michigan State not included), Princeton has a perfect 2-0 record to begin the season. The Tigers have a current 16-match winning streak, the longest active streak in Division I field hockey. Through two outings, Princeton has outscored the opposition 7-4 in a 4-3 victory over Fairfield and a 3-1 defeat of Duke. The Tigers have yet to allow a first half score this season. The defending champs have nearly doubled the opposition in penalty corners, recording 13 to the opponents seven. Princeton's Teresa Benvenuti leads the team in goals scored with two, while adding one assist to total five points. Another impressive performer for the Orange and Black has been Michelle Cesan, who has produced five points off a goal and three assists.

Last Time Out: Penn State picked up a nice road win over intrastate rival Lock Haven University on Wednesday evening.

The Nittany Lions turned in their most dominating performance of the season in a 3-0 victory over the Bald Eagles. Ashtin Klingler scored the opening goal, her second on the season. The goal marked the first time all season that Penn State scored first in a match. Junior Jenna Chrismer added a goal before the half to put the Lions up 1-0. Chrismer's goal was her first of the season. The Blue and White added a third goal in the second stanza, as Whitney Reddig found the back of the cage for the

its opponents in every match this season, including at least 20 more in three contests, including its last two. The team matched a season high in shots against Lock Haven on Wednesday evening with a total of 23. Senior Brittany Grzywacz and junior Taylor Herold paced the squad, with each recording six shots. Grzywacz also leads the team with 26 shots on the season.

Lions Ranked No. 13 in NFHCA September 10 Coaches Poll: The first regular season NFHCA Coaches Poll was released on Tuesday, September 10. Penn State came in tied for 13th in the rankings, receiving 239 points. Through the first five games of the season, four of the Nittany Lions' opponents are currently ranked in the top 15 in the country. The Blue and White has played No. 4 UConn, No.

second time in as many games. The win ended a three match losing skid for Penn State. Redshirt junior goalkeeper Kylie Licata recorded her first shutout of her career in the winning effort. The Nittany Lions have now won 12 consecutive matchups against the Bald Eagles, dating all the way back to the 1986 season.

The Firing Squad: The Nittany Lions have taken 94 shots this season for an average of 18.80 strikes per match, as opposed to the opposition's 47 shots, an average of 9.4 per outing. Penn State has recorded more shots than

5 Virginia, No. 11 Temple and No. 15 Old Dominion, which Penn State defeated by a final score of 3-1 in the season opener. The Blue and White are one of three Big Ten programs currently in the top 20. The Lions have one more non-conference matchup with a top-rated team, when the squad travels to No. 3 Princeton on Sunday.

Lock Down Defense: The Nittany Lions turned in their best defensive performance on Wednesday, September 11, against Lock Haven University. The back line absolutely stifled the Bald Eagle attack throughout the entire game. Lock Haven did not record a shot or penalty corner opportunity through the first 60 minutes of the game and tallied only two shots and two penalty corners in the entire match. In addition, the two Bald Eagle shots were not on goal. The shutout marked the first time the Nittany Lions blanked the opposition since the team's 2-0 victory in the Big Ten Tournament championship game last season. The Blue and White recorded seven shutouts in 2012.

What's Next?: After the Sunday showdown with Princeton, the Nittany Lions return home to host the University of Delaware on Friday, September 20 at 5:00 p.m. The match will be played at the Penn State Field Hockey Complex.

CHARLENE MORETT PROFILE



The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett enters her 27th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program. Morett boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last five years, Morett has led the Nittany Lions to two Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett currently ranks fourth all-time in Division I history in wins with 445 and is one of just five DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 23 of her 26 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 28.

A seven-time NFHCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year, Morett is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett's tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorklaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Seven players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Coletta, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the ninth Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorklaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long and Anselmo are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more first team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's nine Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are four more than any other school.

With Amy, Laura Gebhart, Lauren Purvis, Grzywacz and Ashtin Klinger earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 89 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 62 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.

Overall, Penn State has had at least one first team All-American in 26 of the last 29 years, including every year from 1975-08. In 2007, for the first time since 2002, Penn State had two first team All-Americans in Long and Kiersten Wood.
