### THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 27th and 28th meetings alltime between Penn State and Michigan State with the Nittany Lions holding the 13-9-4 advantage. The teams split the season series in 2018-19, each going 1-1 on home ice during the season.
- Penn State is 7-2-3 all-time against the Spartans at Pegula Ice Arena with last year's loss being the first at home against MSU since the 2013-14 season, PSU was 7-0-2 in its previous nine home games against Michigan State prior to the 6-4 loss.
- The Nittany Lions are 11-3-2 against Michigan State since the start of the 2015-16 season.
- · Senior Nate Sucese leads all active Nittany Lions with 11 points in 12 career games against the Spartans scoring six goals while adding five assists. Junior Sam Sternschein has also had success against the Green and White with three goals and three assists for six points in just seven games. Senior Nikita Pavlychev has also added three goals and three assists in 10 games against Sparty.

### MOVIN' ON UP

- Penn State jumped six spots in the recent polls to No. 6 cracking the top ten for the second time this season. This also marks the highest the Nittany Lions have been ranked since a previous No. 6 mark on November 26, 2018. This marks the 26th week all-time Penn State has been ranked in the top-10.
- Penn State has now been ranked in 45 consecutive US-CHO.com polls and have only spent eight weeks outside the top-20 since November 23, 2015.

### **GREATER MARGIN OF VICTORY**

- Outside of the IVY League teams, which began play last weekend, Penn State is tied with UMass for the largest goal differential this season winning by an average margin of 2.57 goals per game.
- · Penn State ranks second in the nation, behind two IVY schools, averaging 4.57 goals per game while Notre Dame leads the country at 4.67 goals per game. PSU's 32 goals scored this year rank tied for second in the nation just one shy of Denver while its +18-goal differential is good for third in the nation.
- The Nittany Lions have tightened up their defense this year as well ranking tied for second in the Big Ten and ninth nationally allowing just 2.00 goals per game through the opening seven games of the season.
- Penn State has allowed just four goals in three games since losing to Alaska and have only allowed more than two goals twice this season.

### START FAST. FINISH STRONG

· Penn State has jumped out to early leads in five of its first seven games while outscoring opponents 10-2 over the opening 20 minutes of play so far this season. The Nittany Lions have also closed strong offensively with 14 third period goals outscoring opponents 14-7. PSU is 5-0-0 when scoring first this season.

· Last season the second period was the strongest for the Nittany Lions with 71 goals and a +16 goal differential. So far this season Penn State is outscoring opponents 8-4 during the middle frame.

### **HOCKEY VALLEY SPECIAL**

- Penn State has dominated the special teams battle so far this season as the Nittany Lions lead the Big Ten and rank sixth in the nation converting 31.4 percent (11-for-35) of their power-play chances including a 50 percent clip (5-for-10) last weekend against Wisconsin.
- The PK has also held its own allowing just three opponent power-play goals in 32 chances (90.6 percent) to rank second in the Big Ten and 13th in the nation. The Nittany Lions held a strong Wisconsin man-advantage to just 1-for-8 last weekend and have only allowed two power-play goals in their last 26 chances over the last

### MR. JONES

- · Senior goaltender Peyton Jones continued his hot start to the season improving to 6-0-0 last weekend after stopping 63-of-66 shots against the nation's second most potent offense entering the two-game series.
- Jones earned Big Ten First Star of the Week accolades earlier this week marking his eighth career weekly honor, the most by a single player in Penn State history.
- . Jones is one of just four goalies in the nation with at least three starts this season to remain unbeaten while his 64 career victories are the most among active goaltenders.
- His .947 save percentage leads the Big Ten and ranks. tied for second in the nation while his 1.67 goals against average is good for second and eighth, respectively.

### **DYNAMIC DUO**

- Senior Nate Sucese scored twice last weekend and is now tied with Andrew Sturtz for first on the Penn State all-time goals list with 54 for his career. His 54 goals are also the second most in the nation among active players only trailing the 56 of Minnesota State's Marc Michaelis.
- Sucese's 13 points this season are tied for the Big Ten lead and rank tied for third nationally while his 115 career points are third among active players and just three behind Chase Berger '19 (118) for second all-time at Penn State and 13 shy of David Goodwin's '17 (128) program
- Classmate Brandon Biro ranks tied for second in the Big Ten and fifth in the nation with his 12 points while his five goals tie for second in the Big Ten and 12th in
- Sucese's nine assists are also tied for first in the Big Ten and second in the nation while he has moved into fourth on the Penn State all-time assists list with 61 while Biro is tied for second with 67 for his career.

### **SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE**

- · Michigan State returns 23 letter winners after losing just three seniors from last season's roster however leading scorer Taro Hirose decided to forgo his final season in East Lansing and sign an NHL contract with the Detroit Red Wings. Hirose finished the 2018-19 season tied for the national points lead with 50 on 15 goals and a national best 35 assists.
- · With the departure of Hirose and the three seniors, MSU lost four of its top-10 scorers from last season, however, the Spartans do return a pair of 30-plus point getters in senior Patrick Khodorenko and junior Mitchell Lewandowski. Khodorenko leads the team with seven points, but between the pair they have only found the back of the net twice this season after 34 combined goals in 2018-19 finishing first and second on the team, respectively.
- The goaltending has been split through the first six games for the Spartans with both John Lethemon and Drew DeRidder each having three starts. Lethemon has put up the better numbers accounting for both victories with a .918 save percentage and a 2.68 goals against average.
- · The Spartans are tied for sixth in the Big Ten averaging just 2.50 goals per game so far this season while allowing 3.00, both marks are tied for 38th and 36th in the nation, respectively.
- The Spartan power-play has been their best source of offense so far this season scoring nearly half their goals on the man-advantage going 7-for-24 (29.2 percent) to rank fourth in the Big Ten and tenth in the nation. MSU's PK, however, is a different story ranking last in the Big Ten and 56th nationally stopping just 68.8 percent (22-for-32) of opponent power-plays.



### **BIG MAN'S GOT MOVES**

· Senior Nikita Pavlychev had his most productive weekend against the Badgers collecting four primary assists including one on the game-winning goal on Friday night. The senior now has five points on one goal and four assists in his five games played this season. Pavlychev's 30 career goals rank just outside the top-10 all-time.

### **BLUE-LINE BEAUTY**

- Junior Cole Hults added a trio of assists in the two game series against Wisconsin giving him eight points on four goals and four assists this season. His goal and point totals both lead all Big Ten defensemen while ranking tied for second and fifth nationally among blue-liners.
- With 56 career points, Hults moved past Trevor Hamilton '18 for fourth on the Penn State all-time scoring list for defensemen, just four points shy of Luke Juha's '16 program record of 60 points.
- · Hults is also tied for fourth on the program's all-time goals list for defensemen with 12 as current teammate Kris Myllari holds the record which currently stands at 17. The junior's 44 career assists also tie Hamilton for fourth among Nittany Lion blue-liners and rank just outside the top-10 all-time at Penn State.







- Penn State hits the road for the first time this season traveling to Minnesota for a pair of games next Friday and Saturday evening.
- The Nittany Lions have won nine of the last 11 meetings between the two teams dating back to the 2017 B1G Tournament semifinals. Both games will air locally on Fox Sports North-plus and can be streamed on BTN+.

• At 6'8" senior Nikita Pavlychev is one of three players in the NCAA that share the distinction of tallest player joining Stephen Mundinger of Maine and Keenan Suthers of St. Lawrence. There are then six players at 6'7".

### **VETERAN PRESENCE**

• With 10 seniors, the Nittany Lions have the second largest senior class in the nation behind only Boston College's 11, but factor in the nine juniors and Penn State has the most upper classmen in the nation with 19 of its 29 players as either a junior or senior.

### **FOUR LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-B1G TEAMS**

• Junior classmates Evan Barratt and Alex Limoges were named First-Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches as part of the preseason awards while junior Cole Hults landed on the second-team and Kris Myllari was an honorable mention.

- Barratt became just the fourth Nittany Lion to earn firstteam All-Big Ten accolades following the 2018-19 season scoring 16 goals while adding 27 assists for 43 points, the third highest single-season total in program history. Barratt's 1.34 points per game led the Big Ten and ranked fourth in the nation setting a new single-season program record while his 43 points were good for fourth in the Big Ten and 13th nationally.
- Hults' 28 points last season were the third-most by a Penn State defenseman in a single-season and ranked third in the conference for blueliners. His plus-19 rating was the second-best mark for defensemen in the Big Ten while his 68 blocked shots were good for ninth in the league. Hults enters his junior season seventh on the Penn State all-time points list for defensemen with 48, just 12 shy of Luke Juha's program record of 60.
- Myllari ranked second in the Big Ten and fifth in the nation last season with 90 blocked shots while his 21 points. were the ninth most in the conference for defensemen. The senior alternate captain set the Penn State career record for goals by a defenseman last season when he notched the 17th of his career at Michigan State.

# **NITTANY LIONS TABBED B1G FAVORITE**

- For the first time in program history Penn State was picked to win the Big Ten by the league coaches in the
- · After finishing in the cellar during the inaugural B1G season in 2013-14, Penn State has finished fourth in three-straight seasons and four of the last five mixing in a third-place finish in 2015-16.
- The regular season champion receives home-ice advantage and a first-round bye in the Big Ten playoffs while the next three seeds earn home ice in the best-of-three quarterfinal round.
- The semifinal and final are then single game contests at the higher-seeded school.

### **RECAPPING 2018-19**

- Penn State narrowly missing its third-consecutive NCAA Tournament last season after posting a 22-15-2 record and advancing to its second Big Ten Championship game in the past three seasons. The 22 wins are the second most in a single-season in program history.
- The Nittany Lions led the nation in several offensive categories during the 2018-19 campaign including goals (177), assists (301), points (478) and goals per game (4.54) each total set a new program record.
- · Penn State is returning 20 letter-winners from that 2018-19 roster including 82 percent of total offense. Nine newcomers will round out the 2019-20 roster.

in average attendance (5,801) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (101.7 percent).

# **WELCOME HOME**

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

### THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its seventh season entering 2019-20. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The Big Ten tournament will take place at campus sites once again during the 2019-20 season.

# **MEET COACH GADOWSKY**

**Guy Gadowsky** will guide the Nittany Lions in his 20th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program during the 2019-20 campaign and his eighth at Penn State.

# **AT PENN STATE**

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, along with becoming the winningiest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten



wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Niittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

In 2017-18, Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, which in turn, was the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 victory over Min-

nesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers by the Nittany Lions, which secured home-ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz become just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and became the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.



# **HEAD COACH GUY GADOWSKY**

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team during the 2014-15 season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season of play. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

# AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

Gadowsky, inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and in 2007-08 he guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998 and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

# **AT ALASKA**

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.



# **BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING**

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

### **PLAYING CAREER**

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

## **PERSONAL LIFE**

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.




