ON THE FLY...

- No. 20 Michigan State plays its last series in the month of January by hosting No. 9/9 Penn State this weekend at Munn ... The Spartans and Nittany Lions are tied for second place in the Big Ten with 25 points apiece, one point behind Ohio State.
- The Spartans enter the week at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings, while their strength of schedule ranks first in the nation.
- In recording its fifth shutout of the year last weekend, MSU has crept up to 16th nationally in goals-against per game at 2.29 ... In Big Ten play, the Spartans are even better at 1.93, which leads the league.
- Senior John Lethemon posted his Big Ten best fifth shutout last weekend, which is second most of any goaltender in the nation, and was named the Big Ten First Star of the Week for the third time this season ... His .943 save percentage is also second best in the country, while his 1.87 GAA ranks second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally.
- Lethemon has allowed one goal or fewer in three of the last five games and two or fewer in each of those five ... In Big Ten play, Lethemon leads the league with a 1.57 GAA, .954 save percentage and four shutouts, while having faced more shots than any other netminder.
- Patrick Khodorenko is tied for the third in the Big Ten in both points (25) and goals (11) ... Khodorenko has seven points (2g, 5a) over the last five games.
- Sam Saliba scored in both games at Wisconsin and has a goal in five of the last six games ... Saliba ranks fourth on the team with 14 points and is second in goals with nine.
- Michigan State has erased eight consecutive opponent power plays, including all five last weekend, and leads the Big Ten in league play with a .917 penalty kill percentage (44-of-48) ... Over the last 12 games (since Nov. 30), MSU has a .933 penalty kill percentage (42-of-45), which is the second best mark in the nation over the span.

About Penn State

The No. 9/9 Nittany Lions are coming off a loss (6-0) and tie (4-4, 3x3 L) with Michigan last weekend at home ... PSU leads the Big Ten and ranks fourth nationally in goals per game (3.83) and is 22nd nationally in goals against per game (2.50) ... The Penn State power play is second best in the country at 28.6% (26-of-91) ... Nate Sucece (9-19--28) and Evan Barratt (9-19--28) lead PSU in points ... Peyton Jones has started all but four games in goal and owns a 2.56 GAA and .922 save percentage.

From Last Weekend at Wisconsin

The Spartans blanked Wisconsin for the second time this season in Friday's win (4-0) ... John Lethemon made 39 saves in the win for his league-leading fifth shutout of the season ... Jerad Rosburg tied a career best with three points (2g, 1a) in the win, while Patrick Khodorenko (2a) and Tommy Apap (1g, 1a) also had multiple points ... Sam Saliba had goal in each game, while Gianluca Esteves picked up assists in both contests ... MSU went 1-for-8 on the power play, while erasing all five Badger power plays ... MSU won three of four games against the Badgers this season.

The Wall of Lethemon

John Lethemon continued his outstanding season last weekend by posting his fifth shutout and a .974 save percentage in the two games, which earned him Big Ten First Star of the Week honors for the third time this year. The senior goaltender ranks second in the country in save percentage (.943) and shutouts (5), while he's eighth in GAA (1.87).

Lethemon's current GAA is 1.26 better than his career average entering 2019-20, while his save percentage is .045 above where it was last year.

The native of Northville has allowed two goals or fewer in six of the last seven games in in 14 of 21 starts this season.

Tallying the Shutouts

John Lethemon's five shutouts are tied for the seventh most in a season by a Spartan netminder, while his 10 career shutouts rank sixth in school history. Here's a look at this year's shutouts:

1 - Nov. 8 at Penn State – 48 saves (career high); 2 - Nov. 16 at Michigan – 35 saves; 3 - Dec. 6 vs. Wisconsin – 41 saves; 4 - Dec. 15 vs. Arizona State – 36 saves; 5 - Jan. 17 at Wisconsin – 39 saves.

Patty Paces the Offense

After being among the top Spartan scorers the last two seasons, Patrick Khodorenko leads the team this year in goals (11), assists (14) and points (25). His 11 goals and 25 points are both tied for third in the Big Ten, while his eight goals in conference play are tied for first.

Khodorenko has points in seven of the last nine games with a 5-7--12 scoring line over the span. This span includes scoring an OT game-winner vs. Wisconsin on Dec. 7, and drawing the primary assists on Mitchell Lewandowski's OT winner against Arizona State on Dec. 15. He leads MSU with five game-winning points this season.

Earlier this season, Khodorenko compiled a career best six-game point streak from Oct. 26 - Nov. 14 over which he produced 12 points (6g, 6a).

... And Approaching 50

After scoring his 49th career goal against Minnesota on Jan. 10, Patrick Khodorenko has the highest goal total of any Spartan since Tim Crowder, who had 50 in 151 games from 2005-09. Khodorenko is looking to become the ninth Spartan since 2000 to reach 50-career goals.

Earlier this season Khodorenko hit the 100-career point mark when he second goal at Michigan in a 4-3 win on Nov. 14.

B1G Lockdown

The Spartans have improved their goals-against average by just over a goal per game this season. Entering Friday, the Spartans' 2.29 goals-against per game ranks 16th nationally and is 1.1 better than last year's average. In Big Ten play, the Spartans have been even stingier, leading the league at 1.93.

Since league play began for the Spartans on Nov. 8 at Penn State, MSU has allowed two or fewer goals in nine of 14 conference games. Earlier this season, the Spartans allowed three or fewer goals from Nov. 9 – Dec. 6 (all in conference play), marking the first time MSU allowed three or fewer in seven consecutive games since the 2013-14 season.

In Big Ten Games, MSU...

- Leads the league in goals against per game at 1.93
- Leads the league total goals allowed at 27
- Leads the league in penalty kill percentage at .917
- Leads the league in faceoff winning percentage at .545
- Is third in goals per game at 2.5

PK Getting The Job Done

The Spartans have a league-best 91.7% penalty kill percentage in conference play, which includes allowing just one power-play goal in the last eight conference games (29-of-30). Over the last 12 games, MSU has extinguished 93.3% (42-of-45) of opponent power plays. Earlier this season, MSU went six consecutive games without allowing a power play goal, killing 20 consecutive power plays from Nov. 30 – Dec. 15.

On the season, MSU ranks 22nd in the country with an 83.2% PK percentage, which is just over 6% above its average from last season.

The Captain is Coming Through

Second-year team captain Sam Saliba scored in both games at Wisconsin last weekend and now has goals in five of the last six games and a 5-1--6 scoring line over the span. With 14 points (9g, 5a), Saliba has his highest point total since his freshman season (18). Earlier this season against Notre Dame, he scored three of the Spartans' four goals in the series – including the game-winner on Nov. 23 with 1:10 to play – and was subsequently named the Big Ten First Star of the Week for his efforts.

Continuing the Progress

With last week's 4-0 victory at Wisconsin, MSU equaled its overall win total from last year (12); its Big Ten win total from last year (8); and its road game win total from last season (5).

Plenty of Gas in the Tank

One key to the Spartans' success in Big Ten games has been their ability to outscore opponents over the final two periods. In its 14 conference games, MSU has outscored opponents by a 25-14 margin in the second and third periods (not including empty-net goals). Further, in the third period of second games of a series, MSU holds a 7-3 edge (not including empty-net goals).

The Spartans have trailed in the third period in three of their seven B1G wins: Nov. 14 at Michigan (trailed 3-2 entering the third); Nov. 23 vs. Notre Dame (trailed 2-1 18 seconds into the third); Dec. 7 vs. Wisconsin (trailed 3-1 entering the third).

Spartans, Apap Strong in the Dot

The Spartans rank fifth in the country in faceoff winning percentage at .543. Junior center Tommy Apap has taken more faceoffs than any player in the Big Ten and leads the conference in faceoff wins (259) and is second in winning percentage (.583). The Spartans have won more faceoffs than their opponents in 16 of 24 games, including taking a season-high 69% of draws in a 5-1 win at Colorado College on Oct. 26.

Spartans' Strength of Schedule Ranks No. 1

Entering the weekend, Michigan State ranks first in the country in strength of schedule. Aside from Big Ten foes Ohio State (No. 7) and Penn State (No. 9), three of the Spartans' non-conference opponents rank in the top 17 in the PairWise – Cornell (No. 3), Arizona State (No. 11) and Northern Michigan (No. 17).

Sure, We'll Go To OT

The Spartans have two overtime wins this season – both coming in December – for the first time since 2011-12 when they also had two. The Spartans topped Wisconsin, 5-4, on Dec. 8 to complete a sweep of the Badgers. A week later on Dec. 15, MSU earned a split with No. 16 Arizona State with the first 1-0 OT win in program history.

The same three players have accounted for the two OT goals as Patrick Khodorenko – set up by Mitchell Lewandowski and Dennis Cesana – got the winner vs. Wisconsin, while Lewandowski – via Khodorenko and Cesana – gave MSU the win over ASU.

In the Rankings

The Spartans moved up one spot to No. 19 in the USCHO.com top-20 poll this week. For first time since Oct. 7, 2012, Michigan State appeared in the USCHO poll on Nov. 25, coming in at No. 20, following a tie and win with Notre Dame.

From the Minnesota Series

The two goals allowed by John Lethemon were the fewest total goals he's allowed in a series this season ... The Spartans extinguished 10-of-11 Minnesota power plays, including three 5-on-3's that lasted a total of 3:35 in the 4-1 win ... Gianluca Esteves got the first game-winner in the 4-1 victory ... The line of Patrick Khodorenko (2g, 1a), Mitchell Lewandowski (1g, 1a) and Sam Saliba (1g, 1a) accounted for seven points in the win ... MSU held Minnesota to seven shots through two periods on Friday.

Lambdin Producing...And at the Right Time

Senior Logan Lambdin is tied fifth on the team with 12 points (5g, 7a) – which equals his career best total from last season. MSU is 9-2-1 in games Lambdin has recorded a point this season.

Earlier this year he had the best point-producing spurt of his career with a six-game streak from Nov. 8-23. The streak tied Patrick Khodorenko for the longest by a Spartan this season as Lambdin produced six points (3g, 3a) over the span.

Lambdin's points came at big moments over the six-game span. The streak started Nov. 8 at No. 6 Penn State where he sealed the MSU win with an empty-net goal. Against Michigan, Lambdin broke a 3-3 tie by scoring the game-winning goal on the power play in the third period of a 4-3 win. Two nights later, he helped set up the game-winning goal. Against Notre Dame (Nov. 22-23), he scored the game-tying goal with 6:12 to go in the third period of the Spartans 3-2 come-from-behind win.

From the GLI

Michigan State tied a season-high with three first-period goals in the 5-2 win over Ferris State ... The Spartans 17 shots on goal in the first period were their most in any game this season ... MSU averaged 32.5 shots on goal in the two games ... Dennis Cesana was named to the GLI All-Tournament team for the second straight year after tying a career high with three points (1g, 2a) in the win.

Arizona State Series Recap

In their fourth consecutive series against a USCHO.com Poll top-20 opponent, the Spartans split a pair of games at Munn with then No. 15/16 ASU ... The Spartans trailed 2-0 and 3-1 in the opener before rallying to tie the game in the third period ... MSU outshot ASU 35-25 in the 4-3 loss and then both teams had 36 shots on goal in the 1-0 OT win ... Mitchell Lewandowski's OT winner was the first of his career ... The Spartans killed all six ASU power plays in the series, including three in each game.

The Spartans yielded just six shots on goal in the third period of both games and have held opponents to a season-low six shots in the third period of the last three games ... John Lethemon allowed just three total goals for the third consecutive series.

Notre Dame Series Recap

Seniors accounted for all four goals (Saliba 3g; Lambdin 1g) and six of the Spartans' nine total points in the two games ... Four of MSU's last seven games with Notre Dame have been decided by one goal ... Saturday's 3-2 win was the Spartans' second in the last four games when they have trailed in the third period ... The win was MSU's first vs. Notre Dame at Munn since January 2013.

Seniors Seeing (B1G) Stars in November

The Spartans boasted the Big Ten First Star of the Week for three consecutive weeks in November with seniors Sam Saliba (Nov. 26), John Lethemon (Nov. 19) and Patrick Khodorenko (Nov. 12) all garnering the accolade.

In scoring three of the Spartans' four goals vs. Notre Dame, including a game-winner, Saliba earned a weekly conference accolade for the first time in his career. Lethemon earned the No. 1 star honor for the first time in his career after he posted a .960 save percentage in the sweep of Michigan and earned his second shutout of the year in his 35-save effort in the 3-0 win. Khodorenko was named the Big Ten First Star of the Week for the second time in his career after he had four points in the series split at then-No. 6 Penn State (Nov. 8-9). Khodorenko scored the game-winner in the second period of a 2-0 shutout win. The following night, he scored twice and had an assist in a 6-4 loss. Khodorenko's second goal with 1:07 left pulled the Spartans to within a goal.

Michigan State basketball coach Tom Izzo and his family have pledged \$1.1 million toward the project.

Danton Cole, a coaching veteran with international, professional and collegiate experience, was appointed head coach of the Michigan State hockey program on April 11, 2017.

Cole, who was a key member of some of the most successful Spartan hockey teams in program history, came to Michigan State from USA Hockey's National Team Development Program where he mentored some of the nation's top young players on the U-17 and U-18 teams for seven seasons

Year two of the Cole era saw the Spartans improve both their Big Ten win and point total over the previous season. The Spartans posted a winning record at home for the second straight year and were also above .500 against conference foes at Munn Ice Arena, as the facility again ranked in the top 10 nationally in attendance. Half of the Spartans' victories on the season came against top-15 opponents, which included a road sweep of No. 8 Cornell.

The Spartans' continued progress under Cole was furthered by Taro Hirose, who turned in one of the best seasons by a Spartan since 2000. Hirose tied for the national lead in points and ranked second in assists en route to being named Big Ten Player of the Year, a First Team All-American and a Hobey Baker Award finalist. The Big Ten scoring champion signed an entry-level contract with the Detroit Red Wings following the season, becoming the 100th player coached by Cole to reach the NHL.

Hirose was one of a program-record six Spartans to earn All-Big Ten accolades.

With the fourth-youngest roster in the nation that included just three seniors and 19 underclassmen, Cole facilitated progress in all facets of the Spartan program during his first season behind the bench in 2017-18. With five wins against ranked opponents, including three vs. top-10 teams, the Spartans improved their win total over the previous season against a schedule that ranked fifth-toughest in the country. In posting a winning record at home, including going undefeated against non-conference teams, the Spartans were rewarded with strong home crowds as Munn Ice Arena ranked 10th nationally in average home attendance during the season.

The young Spartan roster was bolstered by the program's high-scoring trio of Hirose, Patrick Khodorenko and Mitchell Lewandowski. Lewandowski became the first Spartan since 2006 to be named a conference rookie of the year as he was voted Big Ten Freshman of the Year, while Hirose earned All-Big Ten second team accolades.

In the classroom, the Spartans have produced a total of 33 Academic All-Big Ten honors over Cole's first two seasons. The 2018-19 squad had 11 student-athletes with GPAs of 3.5 or better, while the team GPA of 3.2 was the fourth highest in program history.

Under Cole's leadership of the program, the home of Spartan hockey – Munn Ice Arena – is currently undergoing an \$18.8 million renovation that will be ready for the 2020-21 season. The expansion project on the south side of the arena will provide the Spartans with completely new team accommodations, including dressing room, weight room, video room, offices and players' lounge, among other amenities.

Prior to returning to Michigan State as the seventh head coach in program history, Cole's highly-successful run with USA Hockey included guiding the U.S. to two gold medals (2012, 2014) and one bronze medal (2016) at the International Ice Hockey

Federation Men's Under-18 World Championship and three top-three finishes at the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge (2011, 2013, 2014), the top events in each age group.

His teams also enjoyed success in numerous international tournaments, having captured U17 titles at the Four Nations (2010, 2012) and Vlad Dzurilla (2011) tournaments. While leading the U18s, the U.S. has placed first on three occasions in major competitions: twice at the Four Nations (2011, 2015) and once at Five Nations (2014) tournaments.

Cole's first taste of international coaching came with the U.S. Under-18 Select Team at the 2009 Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup, where he served as assistant coach. He assumed that same role in 2013 for the bronze-medal winning U.S. Men's National Team at the IIHF Men's World Championship.

Cole's coaching career started immediately following his playing days. After retiring from the Grand Rapids Griffins in 1999-2000, he remained with the team for the season as an assistant before spending 2001-02 with Muskegon in the United Hockey League, guiding the team to the playoff championship.

Cole followed that with a nearly three-year stint as head coach of the Griffins which included two Calder Cup Playoff appearances in 2003 and 2004. After coaching the UHL's Motor City Mechanics through 2006, he amassed a five-year pro coaching record of 222-126-17 (.632).

In 2006-07, Cole landed his first college job as an assistant at Bowling Green. After one year at BGSU, he was hired as head coach at Alabama-Huntsville where he went 23-59-12 in three seasons. He led UAH to the College Hockey America tournament title in his third season with the school in 2009-10, earning the program's second-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament, before moving on to USA Hockey in 2010.

Cole's playing career at MSU began in 1985-86 as he helped further the Spartans' trek to sustained national prominence. In his four years at Michigan State, the Spartans went 131-44-8 (.738), winning a NCAA National Championship (1986), making three NCAA Frozen Four appearances (1986, 1987, 1989), capturing two CCHA regular-season titles (1986, 1989) and two CCHA Tournament championships (1987, 1989).

As a junior at MSU, Cole was second in team scoring with 20 goals and 56 points, and then was the third-highest scorer as a senior with 29 goals and 62 points.

Cole, who was the recipient of the Distinguished Spartan Award in 2013, ended his Michigan State career with 69 goals and 94 assists for 163 points. He shares the MSU career games played record of 180 with former teammate Don McSween.

Cole graduated with a degree in finance and excelled in the classroom at MSU as he was a three-time CCHA All-Academic Team honoree. He is one of nine Spartan hockey players to have received the Big Ten Medal of Honor, garnering the accolade as a senior.

Cole was drafted in the sixth round, 123rd overall, by the Winnipeg Jets in the 1985 NHL Entry Draft. After making his pro debut with the AHL's Moncton Hawks in 1989-90, Cole saw his first action in the NHL that season as well.

Cole went on to play 11 seasons professionally. He played 318 NHL games over six seasons with Winnipeg, Tampa Bay, New Jersey, the New York Islanders and Chicago. His best season in the NHL came in 1993-94 when he put up 20 goals and 23 assists for 43 points in 81 games for the Tampa Bay Lightning. He is one of 15 Spartans to have hoisted the Stanley Cup as he helped the New Jersey Devils to the 1995 Cup.

Cole played four more seasons in the IHL for the Grand Rapids Griffins before retiring with the team in 1999-2000.

He represented the USA as a member of the Men's National Team on three occasions (1990, 1991, 1994) and earned outstanding player of the 1991 IIHF Men's World Championship.

A native Michigander, Cole was born in Pontiac and raised in Lansing.

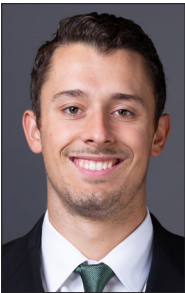
