2010 NCAA COLLEGE CUP SEMI-FINALIST

WOLVERINE BITES • Sophomore Robbie Mertz enters the weekend with goals in back-to-back matches, most recently scoring in the 48th minute in the 2-0 win over Detroit on Wednesday (Sept. 28). Against Northwestern, he netted his first career goal in the 2-1 double-overtime loss in the 55th minute on assists from Yamann Sahlool and Ivo Cerda. The helper for Sahlool was the third of his career. Cerda's secondary assist was his second of the season, and ties him with Rylee Woods for the team lead in helpers with two.

• The Wolverines rank No. 2 in the Big Ten, trailing only the national leader Indiana (18.67), and No. 14 in the NCAA with 16.20 shots per contest. Francis Atuahene leads the B1G and is No. 4 nationally in shots on goal per game with 2.38, while freshman Jack Hallahan ranks No. 7 in the conference in shots with 2.56 per game.

• Michigan has outshot teams 162-130 on the campaign, and own a 63-48 margin in shots on goal. The Wolverines have won the category in all but one match (Aug. 29 at FGCU). Additionally, U-M has outshot opponents 99-70 in the second half and overtime, but have been outscored 9-5 in that span.

• With three goals in nine matches this season, sophomore Francis Atuahene has 13 markers in his career, and has scored goals in ten of the 22 matches he has played in as a Wolverine. With his score against Detroit, he moves into a tie for ninth all-time in career goals with Fabio Pereira (2010-13).

• Junior goalkeeper Evan Louro ranks No. 2 in the NCAA in minutes played through 10 matches (996:16 minutes played), and is No. 5 in the Big Ten in saves per game with 3.20 and No. 4 in save percentage (71 percent). Following the clean sheet against Detroit, Louro now boasts 11 clean sheets on his career, placing him in fourth in school history in the category. Former teammate Adam Grinwis (2010-14) is next in his sights in the No. 3 spot with 14 shutouts.

• With the posting of the first NCAA RPI, U-M will take on No, 166 Detroit, No. 56 Penn State, No. 109 Rutgers, as well as No. 1 Notre Dame in the coming weeks.

OPPONENT PREVIEW

PENN STATE— The Nittany Lions, coming off a 1-0 loss vs. Temple on Tuesday night (Sept. 27) enter the week with a 4-4-1 overall record and 2-1 B1G mark. The Nittany Lions have yet to win a road match this year, sitting at 0-2-1, and like U-M, have played five overtime matches (2-2-1).

Most recently in Big Ten play PSU downed Wisconsin 2-1 in double-overtime on Friday (Sept. 23), and have beaten Ohio State 4-2 (Sept. 13) and lost to Maryland by a 3-2 count in overtime on Sept. 18 in Big Ten play.

Much like U-M, it could be said that PSU has had a bit of hard luck this season, as they are even on goals 13-13 on the year, but have been outshot 132-92. The goal number is No. 2 in the conference. One of the top offensive threats in all of the Big Ten, Connor Maloney, leads the offense with four goals and three assists for 11 points, ranking him second in the Big Ten and 32nd nationally in the category. He is paired with Dayonn Harris, who is second on the team in goals with two and an assist.

Penn State was also dealt a blow earlier in the season, as three-year starting goalkeeper Evan Finney was out. However, Finney returned to the lineup against Wisconsin, and has allowed only two goals in three matches (0.60 goals-against aver-

age, nine saves), giving PSU a reliable backstop.

• Sophomore's Francis Atuahene, Marcello Borges, and Junior Evan Louro were named to the Big Ten Preseason Players to Watch list prior to the start of the season. As a team, the Wolverines were pegged to finish fifth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches' Poll behind Maryland, Indiana, Ohio State, and Rutgers. Michigan State, Wisconsin, Penn State, and Northwestern follow in succession. Additionally, Atuahene was named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Best XI Third Team.

• U-M is in its fifth season under Daley in 2016, returning nine players with starting experience to the squad. The back four own 152 career starts in former Big Ten All-Freshman team members in seniors Lars Eckenrode, Andre Morris and Rylee Woods, as well as junior Billy Stevens. All four were members of the 2015 defense that allowed only 1.05 goals per game. Woods also possesses a dynamic left foot for set pieces, as he collected a team-best seven assists on the season which tied for the fourth most in a season in the U-M record books.

• Starter Evan Louro will be the man in net for the Wolverines after starting all 18 matches a season ago. In 2015, he finished fifth in the B1G in shutouts (7), which ranks No. 2 program history, and collected 58 saves. The South River, NJ native also had the second best goals-against average in program history (1.05).

• Returning to lead the offense is Big Ten Freshman of the Year and First Team All-Big Ten member Francis Atuahene, who lead the team a year ago in goals with 10 and points with 23. Hailed as one of the most dynamic players in the country entering the campaign, the 10 goals for a freshman were the second-most in a season in school history, and were seventh most for a freshman in the NCAA.

His name has also dotted the U-M single-season record book as the 10 scores rank No. 6 in program annals. The 66 shots were No. 4 behind program greats Soony Saad (2010, 152), Justin Meram (2010,104) and Mauro Fuzetti (2009, 68). Scoring a goal in eight of 16 matches this season, Atuahene is one of only three players in the conference to record a hat-trick, as he accomplished the feat in the 3-1 win over Niagara (Sept. 4) in only his second collegiate game, and was named Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts. Atuahene is the second Big Ten Freshman of the Year (Soony Saad, 2010), and is the 13th player to earn First Team All-Big Ten accolades.

• With an exemplary home mark of 6-2-2 last season, U-M will entertain numerous traditionally strong programs in 2016, welcoming four NCAA Tournament teams to U-M Soccer Stadium. The gauntlet begins on Sept. 14, as the Wolverines will host Indiana, and picks up again on Oct. 11, as Notre Dame will visit for a non-conference matchup. Ohio State will visit for a B1G contest on Oct. 21, while Daley's side will host Oakland (Oct. 25) prior to hosting Maryland five days later on Senior Day. In total, 12 of the 17 matches are of the home variety, and 13 teams of the 17 opponents are ranked in the top-100 of the RPI from last season.

•The Wolverines announced the addition of five student-athletes in Jack Hallahan (Redditch, England/Saint Augustine's Catholic), Joseph Hertgen (Toms River, N.J./Toms River North), Luke Rosendall (Ada, Mich./Forest Hills Eastern), Abdou Samake (Ottawa, Ontario/ Louis-Riel) and Andrew Verdi (Ivyland, Pa./YSC Academy). All five join the program with true freshman eligibility.

Over the summer, both Hallahan and Samake played for the PDL side of the Chicago Fire, while Rosendall (Crew Wolves Academy), Verdi (Philadelphia Union Academy/Bethlehem Steel) and Hertgen (PDA Academy) as sharpened their trade during the summer months.

• Prior to the season, seniors Lars Eckenrode and Brett Nason were named team captains for the first time in their U-M careers. Entering the year, Eckenrode has started 46 matches on the U-M back line in his career, while Nason rounded into one of U-M's most consistent performers in his first year as a starter, and found himself in the Starting XI in all 17 matches. He is also the team's community service liaison, providing leadership on and off the pitch.

• The Wolverines closed their Spring season with an unblemished 3-0-3 record, highlighted by victories over the USL Pro Pittsburgh Riverhounds (2-1) on March 13 and a 1-0 win over Michigan State on April 9 to capture the Michigan College Cup Championship.

• A quartet of Wolverines have changed numbers from last season, most notably Brett Nason, who makes the switch from No. 21 to No. 11, and Ivo Cerda who goes from No. 16 to No. 8. Tristan Jacob will also revert to No. 16, the number he wore during his true freshman campaign, after wearing No. 8 a season ago. Sophomore Johann Bittner will also make the switch from No. 13 to No. 21, filling Nason's old digits.

•Hosting La Liga superpower Real Madrid for the second time in three years in the International Champions Cup, the European Cham-

pions downed Chelsea 3-2 on July 30 in front of 105,862 fans inside Michigan Stadium. The attendance was less than 4,000 shy of the United States record attendance for a soccer match, set two years ago at Michigan Stadium when 109,318 watched Real Madrid and Manchester United squared off in the same tournament.

Chelsea also traveled former U-M signee and U.S. International Matt Miazga, who signed a letter of intent to play at U-M in 2013, but ultimately turned down the scholarship to play for the New York Red Bulls in Major League Soccer and signed with Chelsea last season. Miazga was part of the Red Bulls Academy since 2009, where he was teammates with current Wolverines Evan Louro, Billy Stevens, and Michael Kapitula.

• Prior to the 2014 season, a new playing surface was installed at U-M Soccer Stadium. The sod was derived from Graff's Turf Farm in Fort Morgan, Colo., and was installed by Bush Turf Colo. The sod was transported across the country in a pair of refrigerated trucks in rolls that were 100 feet long. The grass was grown in 90-percent sand base, which is a short cut stadium variety and is maintained at one inch. The previous playing surface was recycled and composted. The project was completed in April, allowing three months for the pitch to settle. The installation took five days in total.

• Two former Wolverines have featured in Major League Soccer this season in Justin Meram (Columbus Crew) and Kofi Opare (DC United). Meram has started 22 of the 24 matches he has played in this season, scoring three goals and dishing out five assists for the Crew, Three players for the 2014 squad are now refining their trade in USL Pro, as both Adam Grinwis and Marcos Ugarte are members of the Rochester Rhinos. Tyler Arnone is a member of the Real Monarchs.

COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH CHAKA DALEY

Chaka Daley was named as the second head coach in the history of the Michigan men's soccer program on Dec. 23, 2011. Now entering his fifth season as the leader of the Maize & Blue, Daley immediately turned around a Wolverine team with an 11-10-1 record in his first season in Ann Arbor, a six win turnaround from the previous season.

Michigan has played a top-20 schedule each of his seasons as the head man of the Wolverines, and his defensive tendencies shined through, as U-M surrendered only 1.05 goals per contest in 2015. Daley also saw his stellar recruiting class shine, as freshman Francis Atuahene took home Big Ten Freshman of the Year, and was named First Team All-Big Ten. U-M also successfully defended the Big Bear Trophy with a win over Michigan State in Ann Arbor, marking the first time in school history the Wolverines have won the trophy in back-to-back campaigns.

The 2014 season saw the Wolverines defeat No. 6 Notre Dame at home, and reclaimed the Big Bear Trophy with a 3-2 win at Michigan State, marking the first time U-M won in East Lansing since 2003. In individual honors, Daley mentored All-Big Ten honoree Colin McAtee, as well as senior co-captain Tyler Arnone, who earned second-team All-Big Ten honors. Arnone wrapped up his U-M career with three all-conference honors, becoming only the fourth player in U-M history to accomplish the feat. Additionally, freshman Billy Stevens and Ahinga Selemani were named to the Big Ten All-Freshman squad.

Prior to arriving in Ann Arbor, Daley spent the previous 12 seasons as head coach of the Providence College Friars.

In 2011, Daley guided Providence to an 11-8-1 record and an NCAA at-large bid, as the Friars defeated Dartmouth in the opening round of the 2011 tournament. In the past seven seasons, he guided the Friars to a 72-47-21 mark, and led his alma mater to seven consecutive winning seasons and five NCAA Tournament appearances. The Friars hosted NCAA Tournament match-ups during the 2010 and 2011 campaigns.

The 2010 Friars squad made a run during the latter half of the season, reeling off seven consecutive wins and going unbeaten in 10 matches (8-0-2) for the first time since 1984. The Friars earned a berth in the Big East Tournament and notched road victories at Villanova and at No. 1-seed Georgetown to advance to the semifinals. In the semis, the Friars defeated Cincinnati and earned a spot in the championship match for the second time in school history where they lost in penalties to No. 1 seed Louisville.

On Nov. 29, 2011, he was inducted into the New England Soccer Hall of Fame for his prowess on and off the field. In 2005, Daley was named NSCAA/ adidas NCAA Division I New England Coach of the Year in and was one of 8 coaches as a nominee for NSCAA National Coach of the Year that same season.

Two former Wolverines and members of the 2012 squad Luke Coulson (Cardiff City, English Premier League) and Kofi Opare (LA Galaxy) inked professional deals after one season under Daley, while four former Friars inked professional contracts under Daley's guidance in goalkeeper Chris Konopka (Kansas City, 2007) who is now a member of the Philadelphia Union, goalkeeper Tim Murray (New England, 2010), midfielder Andrew Sousa (New England, 2011), and midfielder Ryan Maduro (NY Red Bull, 2012)

Daley was also a member of the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship Committee for four seasons (2003-06). Daley was also the regional advisory committee chairperson for New England and was part of the 10-member selection committee for the men's tournament during that time.

Daley was affiliated with the U.S. Soccer Academy, serving as the head coach for the U16 FC Greater Boston Bolts (1998 to 2011). He also spent two seasons with the U17 & U18 Olympic Development Program in Rhode Island. Additionally, heholds a USSF "A" Coaching License and earned an MBA from Providence in 2005.

He and his wife, Heather, have a son, Donovan (9), and a daughter, Savanah (4).

ASSISTANT COACH TOMMY MCMENEMY

Tommy McMenemy joined the Michigan men's soccer staff on Jan. 30, 2012, and is entering his fifth season with the Wolverines after previously serving as an assistant at his alma mater, Columbia, for six seasons.

In addition to serving as the team recruiting coordinator, he handles all facets of coaching, orgainizing team training sessions, and leads the attacking unit tactics for the Wolverines.

McMenemy was elevated to the program's top assistant position in 2008 after joining the team as a volunteer assistant in 2006. At Columbia, McMenemy assisted in all phases of the program, including organizing training sessions, devising tactical strategies, and developing a competition schedule.

The Southampton, United Kingdom native, also served as the head coach of Landsdowne United, an amateur men's team in the top division of the New York premier semi-professional league, the Cosmopolitan League from 2006-09. McMenemy was the head man for team Sparta of the Manhattan Soccer Club, a premier U-17 boys club for one season.

In addition, he was a co-director and staff coach for New York's premier soccer academy, New York Soccer Academy, which boasts a roster of nearly 200 players. He holds an NSCAA National Diploma, as well as an FA Preliminary Coach License.

As a player for the Lions, McMenemy earned NSCAA Adidas All-American status as a senior in 2003, and was a two-time first-team All-Ivy League and first-team all-region selection (2002-03). He led the team in goals and assists in his junior and senior seasons, and was selected by his teammates as a team captain as a senior. McMenemy also excelled in the classroom, earning Academic All-Ivy League honors in his final two years as a student-athlete.

ASSISTANT COACH JHOJAN OBANDO

After two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach, Jhojan Obando was promoted to assistant coach on Feb. 18, 2014 and is in his second season as a full-time assistant coach. He will assist with all program duties and continue to work with the teams goalkeepers.

Obando played in 44 career matches and made 42 starts as a goalkeeper at Providence under the guidance of Daley as a player, helping the Friars to a 24-14-4 record and recorded 13 clean sheets over that stretch. In 2010, Obando helped the Friars to the championship game of the Big East Tournament and was named to the all-tournament team.

Additionally, he was part of three Providence teams that made the NCAA Tournament. During the last two seasons, the Friars hosted an NCAA Tournament first-round match for the first times in school history, and advanced to the second round on each occasion. He was one of four goalkeepers invited to the 2012 adidas MLS Player Combine and most recently played for the Des Moines Menace in the Premier Development League.

At Michigan, Obando has mentored 2012 All-Big Ten second-team honoree and Adam Grinwis. He also possesses a USSF National E License.






