#### THE SERIES

· This week, Michigan and Penn State are facing off for their 32nd & 33rd meetings. The Wolverines have built a 17-13-1 advantage over the Nittany Lions, going 2-1-1 last season. The teams split their two games in Ann Arbor on Dec. 6 and 7 (3-1, 1-3), while PSU forced a tie in the final meeting at Pegula (4-4) on January 18 to avenge a 6-0 Michigan win the night prior. Over the years in Happy Valley, the Wolverines gone 5-7-1.

#### WOLVERINE BITES

- This series looks to be the final games at full strength for the Maize & Blue until the second half. The team stands to lose a swath of talent to World Junior Championship preparations in the coming weeks. U-M will loan up to five players for the tournament.
- Newcomers continues to lead the team offensively. Forward Kent Johnson (1G, 7A) leads the Wolverines with eight points while Thomas Bordeleau (2G, 5A), Matty Beniers (2G, 3A), Brendan Brisson (1G, 3A) and Owen Power (1G, 3A) have been equally impressive early on.
- Strauss Mann continued his strong play against Notre Dame after four straight wins to start the season. Mann's 1.50 GAA and .932 save % have been a steady presence for the Wolverines. With seven career shutouts, he's tied for sixth all-time in Michigan history.

#### SCOUTING THE NITTANY LIONS

- Penn State welcomes eight newcomers to their 2020-21 roster, highlighted by blueliners Christian Berger and Jimmy Dowd, Jr. who have immediately stepped into playing time. Returning for the Nittany Lions up front are newly minted Captain Alex Limoges, Kevin Wall, Aarne Talvitie, and Sam Sternschein, among others.
- On the back end, Clayton Phillips and Paul DeNaples set the tone for a PSU team that lost an immense amount of talent in the offseason. In net for Penn State has been a tandem of junior Oskar Autio and freshman Liam Souliere.
- The Nittany Lions have stumbled out of the gates in the incredibly competitive Big Ten Hockey Conference, dropping their first four games on the road to Minnesota and Wisconsin. This week marks the team's first games in State College at Pegula Ice Arena.

## NOTES

### ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

- U-M dropped their first games of the young season this past weekend after being swept by Notre Dame in tightly contested 3-2 and 2-1 losses inside a barren Yost Ice Arena.
- Goaltender Strauss Mann battled for Michigan but his strong play wasn't enough. The junior netminder stopped 44 of 49 shots faced against a swarming, hungry Irish team.
- Freshman defenseman Jacob Truscott has stepped into a contributing role immediately, netting one goal and one assist in his first series against the Fighting Irish. Michael Pastujov leads in goals with three after he scored on Friday night against Notre Dame.
- Michigan's vaunted freshman class continues to shine. Out of the team's 60 total points, freshmen have accounted for 30 (8G, 22A), making up 50% of the team's scoring.

### POLL POSITION

- Michigan comes in at #7 in both the USCHO and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine polls this week. The Wolverines slipped in each poll after being swept by Notre Dame this past weekend.
- The Wolverines were in the top five in both polls last week, for the first time since 2018. That team, led by the DMC Line of Dancs, Marody, and Calderone with Quinn Hughes on the back end, went on to make a run to the Frozen Four in Coach Pearson's first season behind the bench for Michigan.

### WORLD JUNIORS

- Johnny Beecher, Matty Beniers, Thomas Bordeleau, Brendan Brisson and Cam York have been named to the USA Hockey World Junior 29-man roster and are set to report on Dec. 6.
- The five players will miss the Minnesota series on Dec. 8-9, as will three players invited from the University of Minnesota.
- USA Hockey expects to name the final 25-player roster by Dec. 13.
- Michigan assistant coach Kris Mayotte will be an assistant coach for Team USA for the International Hockey Federation World Junior Championship, scheduled for Dec. 25-Jan. 5, 2021, in Edmonton, Alberta.
- Beecher and York were members of the 2020 U.S. National Junior Team that competed in the Czech Republic. The U18 Men's World Championship, scheduled for last April, was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2019 Beecher, Beniers and York were members of that bronze-medal team.
- Owen Power was invited by Hockey Canada to its camp that began on Nov. 16 but did not attend. The length of the camp, 28-days, and academics were cited as concerns. Hockey Canada's camp entered a 14-day quarantine (Nov. 23-Dec. 6) due to positive COVID cases. Coach Pearson has stated that Power will be made available to Canada around Dec. 10.
- The 2021 IIHF World Juniors will be held Dec. 25 - Jan. 5 in Edmonton.
- Michigan players have earned 17 medals with USA Hockey at the World Juniors since 1980 and 11 medals as members of Hockey Canada.

### BRAVO FOR BORDELEAU

- Thomas Bordeleau's overtime game winner at Wisconsin was selected as the Top Play on ESPN's SportsCenter on Friday, Nov. 10.
- Bordeleau was named the B1G Third Star of the Week helping to keep Michigan undefeated. In addition to his OT game winner, Bordeleau had a three-assist game the previous night.
- Bordeleau is currently tied for fourth in the nation in scoring with seven points on two goals and five assists. Additionally, he has factored into three of Wolverine's game winners, scoring two game-winning goals and assisting on another.
- Bordeleau was named the San Jose Sharks Prospect of the Week

### STARSTRUCK

- In the Big Ten Hockey Conference's opening week, Michigan picked up 2 of the 3 Stars.
- First Star Strauss Mann posted a .970 save % along with a 0.50 GAA and one shutout.
- Third Star Kent Johnson, in his collegiate debut on Saturday, put up four assists for U-M. Johnson answered the bell on Sunday once again with his first career goal.

### PRESEASON PICKS

- Michigan was selected to finish second in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches Poll. Strauss Mann and Cam York were both named to the Preseason First-Team All-B1G, while Johnny Beecher was a Second-Team selection and Owen Power was an

- Michigan was selected 12th in the USCHO preseason poll and 11th in the USA Today/ USA Hockey preseason poll.
- Greg Cameron of College Hockey News lists Michigan as having the top recruiting class of 2020: Beniers, Bordeleau, Brisson, Groll, Holtz, Johnson, Lapointe, Portillo, Power, and Truscott.

### RECAPING 2019-20

- Michigan was 14th in the pairwise, 15th in the USA Today poll and 17th in the USCHO poll when the season was ended.
- In a tale of two seasons, the Wolverines went 11-3-2 in 2020 after starting 8-11-2. The squad was in last place in the Big Ten on Jan. 1 with just seven points, before going on to earn 26 out of a possible 30 points in a 10-game span to finish tied for second in the league (with Minnesota and Ohio State).
- U-M's scoring offense went from 44th in the nation, averaging 2.16 goals per game to 11th when the Wolverines widened their scoring to 3.31 gpg.
- U-M's defense ranks seventh nationally, allowing just 2 goals per game. The last line is Strauss Mann, who leads B1G goaltenders with a 1.85 GAA, sixth-best in the nation. He also sports the third-best save percentage at .939. Mann's six shutouts are second in the country. He's also chipped in two assists to help the offense.
- The Wolverines and goaltender Strauss Mann recorded back-to-back 3-0 shutouts in the Big Ten quarterfinals against in-state rival Michigan State. The weekend shutout was Michigan's first in over 12 years, with the last coming in the 2007 Great Lakes Invitational against Providence College (6-0) and Michigan Tech (1-0) in 20T to claim the John MacInnes Cup. That weekend, the Wolverines had four players missing action while playing at the World Junior Championship in Sweden (including Carl Hagelin suiting up for the hosts).

### SKATES TO FILL

- Last year the senior class led the team in scoring, accounting for 42 percent of the team's goals and 39 percent of the points overall. The top four scorers on the team were seniors.
- Luke Martin led the defense in shots blocked with 85, ranking second in the nation
- Nick Pastujov had the top face-off percentage out of the centermen, winning 55.8 percent of his draws.

### TWIST TO THE TOURNEY

- The 2021 Big Ten Hockey Tournament will return to the one-weekend, single-elimination format used during the first four years of Big Ten hockey and will feature all seven conference teams. The tournament will be held March 18-20 and will consist of six games (three games on Thursday; two games on Friday; and the championship game on Saturday).

### O CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN

- Jack Becker and Strauss Mann will serve as team captains this season with Nick Blankenburg and Jimmy Lambert serving as alternate captains. Mann is the fourth goaltender in Michigan history to wear a "C" and the first in 78 years.

### MANN THE MACHINE

- Strauss Mann was an award-collecting machine last season, including: B1G Goaltender of the Year, was a finalist for B1G Player of the Year, finalist for the Mike Richter Award, First-Team All-Big Ten, CoSIDA Academic All-American, Academic All-Big Ten, Michigan Athletics Male Breakthrough Performer of the Year, and finalist for Michigan Athletics Male Athlete of the Year.
- In 2019-20, Mann tied the Michigan single-season record of six shutouts. He also set single-season program bests in both GAA and save percentage. His 1.85 GAA surpassed Billy Sauer's 1.95 from 2007-08, while his .939 save percentage surpassed Shawn Hunwick's .932 from 2011-12.

### 2020 NHL DRAFT

- Michigan had four players selected in the 2020 NHL Draft. Brendan Brisson was selected in the first round, 29th overall by Vegas Golden Knights. Brisson is the first Wolverine to be drafted by Vegas. Michigan leads all NCAA teams in first-round picks with Brisson being the 25th.
- This is the 25th consecutive year U-M has had at least one player in the draft
- Thomas Bordeleau was taken in the seventh round 38th overall by San Jose, Jacob Truscott was picked in the fifth round 144th overall by Vancouver and incoming player Ethan Edwards was taken in the 120th overall in the fourth round.

### 2021 NHL DRAFT PROJECTIONS

- NHL Central Scouting lists Owen Power, Kent Johnson and Matty Beniers with an A rating. The trio is expected to go early in the first round of the 2021 NHL Draft
- The Athletic (Corey Pronman) projects them to go in top five with: Power 2, Johnson 3, Beniers 5; while the Hockey Writers (Josh Bell) has them Power 2, Johnson 6, Beniers 14.

### WHERE WE HAIL FROM

- Six current Wolverines played with the US National Team Development Program, 12 from the USHL, 7 from the BCHL, and one from each the AJHL, OJHL, and NAHL
- Nine players hail from Michigan, while California has the second-most current Wolverines with four. Wolverines also represent four Provinces in Canada as well as Sweden.

### FIRST YEAR IN THE BOOKS FOR HUGHES

- Quinn Hughes was the runner-up for the Calder Trophy and named to the NHL All-Rookie Team. He is the second Wolverine, joining Zach Werenski, to be named to the NHL All-Rookie Team
- Hughes led all NHL rookies in scoring during the regular season (eight goals, 45 assists, 53 points) in 68 games played. He is just the third defenseman in NHL's modern era (since 1943-44) to lead all rookies in scoring joining Bobby Orr (1966-67) and Brian Leetch (1988-89). His 53 points also marked the most points by a rookie defenseman in a single season since 1991-92, when Nicklas Lindstrom had 60 points in 80 games.
- Hughes also led all rookies in assists with 45, power-play assists (22) and power-play points (25), while ranking second in average ice time (21:53).
- Hughes set the league's record for assists by a rookie defenseman in a single postseason. His 14 assists also set an NHL record for most assists in a playoff year by a rookie defenseman. His 16 points were a Vancouver franchise record in the playoffs for any rookie regardless of position.
- With a goal and eight assists in six consecutive games early in this year's playoffs, Hughes matched the longest point streak by a rookie defenseman, joining Al MacInnis in 1984 and equaled by Zarley Zalapski in 1989. Hughes also tied the Vancouver franchise record of consecutive postseason games with an assist, tying Henrik Sedin.

### FREE AGENCY TRACKING

- Tyler Motte re-signed with the Vancouver Canucks, inking a two-year contract extension with an average annual value (AAV) of \$1.225 million.
- Jon Merrill signed a one-year, \$925,000 agreement with the Detroit Red Wings.
- Jack Johnson signed a one-year, \$1.15 million contract with the New York Rangers.
- Phillip Di Giuseppe agreed to terms with the New York Rangers. The one-year deal is worth \$700,000 at the NHL level and \$250,000 in the minors.
- From the Class of 2020: Will Lockwood signed with Vancouver, Nick Pastujov signed with Bridgeport of the AHL; while Griffin Luce, Hayden Lavigne, Shane Switzer and Jacob Hayhurst each signed ECHL contracts.

# COACH MEL PEARSON

• Mel Pearson was named the ninth head coach in University of Michigan hockey history on Monday, April 24, 2017.

• During his first season as the Michigan Head Coach, led the team to a 22-15-3 record, and a Frozen Four berth. He was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award.

• In that first campaign, the Wolverines only suffered losses to three teams following the annual Great Lakes Invitational that concluded January 2, 2018. Michigan won its last five regular season games in regulation before heading off to the Big Ten Tournament.

• Pearson led the Wolverines to an NCAA Northeast Regional Championship, defeating Northeastern and Boston University to return Michigan to the Frozen Four for a record 25th time.

• Pearson became the first coach in history to lead two different programs to NCAA Tournament berths in consecutive seasons and one of five coaches to lead a team to the Frozen Four in their first season at the helm in the past 20 years.

• Pearson returned to Ann Arbor following an impressive six-year stint as head coach at Michigan Tech. There, he led the Huskies to two NCAA Tournament appearances in his last three years while winning a WCHA regular-season title and a WCHA Championship in that span.

• Under Pearson's leadership, the Huskies finished the 2016-17 season ranked in the top 20 for a third consecutive year, all of them featuring 20-win campaigns. Pearson also earned two WCHA Coach of the Year honors in his time at Michigan Tech, which claimed the program's first-ever No. 1 national ranking on Nov. 17, 2014.

• Pearson served as a U-M assistant coach from 1988-89 through 1998-99 and as associate head coach from 1999-2000 through 2010-11. He played an integral role in developing the Michigan program into one of the most successful in the country.

• During his first tenure in Ann Arbor, U-M posted a 667-243-71 record while capturing 11 Central Collegiate Hockey Association regular-season titles, nine CCHA Tournament crowns, two NCAA championships (1996 and 1998), and making 11 NCAA Frozen Four appearances.

• After he helped Michigan to the 1999-2000 CCHA regular-season championship, Pearson was awarded the Terry Flanagan Award by the American Hockey Coaches' Association, which honors an assistant coach's career body of work. Pearson also served as a coach with the 1996 United States World Junior Championship team, and helped the Americans to a silver medal, the country's second-best finish at the event.

• Pearson's prep (Willard Ikola) and college (John MacInnes) mentors earned varsity letters as goaltenders at Michigan. Pearson was a standout high school player for Ikola (1952-54) at Edina East (Minn.) High School, while playing his collegiate career up at Michigan Technological University under MacInnes (1946-50), one of college hockey's legendary coaches.

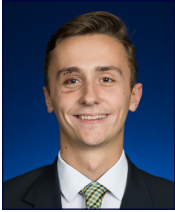

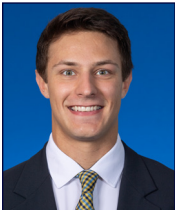
