Team

No. 9 Penn State fell short against Saint Francis in four sets (29-27,26-28,22-25,23-25) in the semifinal match of the EIVA championship match.

Tonight's loss sets the Nittany Lions' overall record back to 19-10 and EIVA record to 12-3.

Junior Chris Nugent recorded his second double-double performance of the season with a match-high 20 kills to go along with 12 digs.

Redshirt-sophomore Aidan Albrecht and redshirt-senior Matt Seifert also tallied double figure kills in the match tonight posting 12 and 10 kills, respectively.

PSU out-dug Saint Francis 45 to 39 with two Nittany Lions scoring double-digit digs. Redshirt-freshman Royce Clemens notched 14 digs while junior Chris Nugent had a total of 12.

Redshirt-sophomore Jalen Penrose led the team from the service line with a season-high four service aces in the first set.

Redshirt-senior Matt Seifert matched his season-high performance with 10 kills, marking his fourth match of the season with double-digit kills.

Series

Penn State owns a 37-2 advantage in the all-time series against Saint Francis, having played two matches against the Red Flash earlier in the season.

Players

Chris Nugent, junior outside hitter

Nugent led the offense with 20 kills, marking his second double-double performance of the season while adding 12 digs.

Tonight also marks his third match of the season with 20 or more kills.

Jalen Penrose, redshirt-sophomore outside hitter

Penrose registered both a match-high and season-high four aces from the service line to go along with two kills and one dig.

Matt Callaway, redshirt-junior middle hitter

Callaway led the blocking unit logging five blocks including one solo stuff.

Aidan Albrecht, redshirt-sophomore opposite

Albrecht finished second on the team with 12 kills, marking his fifth match with 12 or more kills.

Matt Seifert, redshirt-senior middle hitter

Seifert finished third on the team matching his season-high of 10 kills including two blocks and one service ace.

Taylor Hammond, redshirt-senior setter

Hammond dished out 51 assists, pacing the team to a .229 hitting percentage, adding nine digs and one block.

Tonight marks his fourth match of the season with 50 or more assists.
