NITTANY LION NOTES

No. 3 Penn State welcomes conference foes Northwestern and Michigan to Happy Valley for the penultimate weekend of hockey in University Park. The Nittany Lions will face No. 14 Northwestern Friday at 5 p.m., followed by a Sunday afternoon matchup against No. 9 Michigan to cap the weekend of conference play.

NORTHWESTERN SERIES HISTORY

Penn State leads 29-6-1 all-time in their series with the Wildcats dating back to 1992. Penn State is currently on a one-game slide vs. Northwestern, dropping their first game of the season last year on the road Sept. 23, 2016, in a 5-3 decision.

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN

The Wildcats sit at 6-3 on the year currently riding a four-game win streak that includes a win over No. 15 Louisville this past Tuesday.

Kirsten Mansfield leads the Wildcats in goals (4) as well as shooting at 1.000% on the season having only attempted four shots this year. Puck Pentenga has recorded eight assists this season that is second in the Big Ten and T-10th nationally.

MICHIGAN SERIES HISTORY

Penn State is 26-19 all-time in their series with the Wolverines dating back to 1992. Penn State beat Michigan 1-0 in its last meeting on Nov. 4, 2016, en route to the Big Ten Championship game last season.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

The Wolverines are currently on a two-game winning streak that has seen the Maize & Blue outscore their opponents 15-0 in the wins over UC-Davis and Michigan State in Ann Arbor.

Michigan started the year 4-0 before dropping back-to-back games prior to the current two-game winning streak. The Wolverines are ranked No. 9 in the latest Penn Monto/National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) Division I Coaches Poll. Meg Dowthwaite leads Michigan in goals with seven on the year that and is currently ranked T-No. 8 nationally in goals per game averaging 1.00. Guadalupe Fernandez Lacort is ranked T-No. 6 in the NCAA in assists per game currently contributing at a clip of 1.00 per contest.

PENN STATE IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

Penn State (7-1) checked in at the No. 3 spot in the latest National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) poll, as released Tuesday morning.

UConn is the last undefeated team left in the country, and the Huskies are also the No. 1-ranked squad in the (NFHCA) Division I National Coaches Poll.

Duke inched up two places to No. 2 in the poll, followed by No. 3 Penn State, No. 4 Virginia and No. 5 Delaware

Penn State at No. 3 is the highest-ranked Big Ten team in the poll ahead of No. 9 Michigan, No. 10 Maryland, No. 14 Northwestern, No. 19 Iowa, and No. 23 Rutgers.
