#### **Nittany Lion Preview**

The Nittany Lions improved to 6-1 overall this season after a 2-0 showing in their first home weekend of 2012. Penn State swept Mount Olive and Cal-Baptist in front of their home crowd on Feb. 3-4.

In two three set matches, three Nittany Lions combined for double-digit kills with sophomore Peter Russell leading the team with 2.83 kills per set. Redshirt freshman Nick Goodell averaged 2.60 kills per set, while freshman Aaron Russell had 2.00. Redshirt senior Edgardo Goas averaged 10.80 assists per set and guided four of his primary hitters to a .375 hitting percentage or better. Goodell led the team with 2.40 digs per set, while redshirt freshman Connor Curry was second on the squad with 1.83. Aaron Russell was a wall at the net with 2.17 blocks per set.

For the weekend, Penn State hit .450 and averaged 13.17 kills per set, 11.50 assists per set, March 1.83 aces per set, 8.00 digs per set and 3.58 blocks per set.

#### Penn State vs. Rutgers-Newark

The Nittany Lions are 82-24-1 all-time versus the Scarlet Raiders. Last season Penn State faced Rutgers-Newark on three occasions, twice during the regular season and once in the EIVA Championship. Penn State defeated the Scarlet all three times, including in the EIVA Semifinals before moving on to win the EIVA Championship and earn a bid in the NCAA National Semifinals.

#### Scouting the Scarlet Raiders

Rutgers-Newark is 4-1 overall this season and 1-0 in EIVA play. The Scarlet Raiders opened the season with a 3-2 win at NYU before suffering a 3-0 setback to NJIT in the Golden Dome Invitational. The Scarlet Raiders have won three straight matches, beating Kean in five set, and both EIVA foe Sacred Heart and York (NY) in three sets.

#### Penn State vs. NJIT

Penn State owns a 28-1 record against the Highlanders. The teams last met in 2009 with Penn State winning both matches, 3-0.

#### **Scouting the Highlanders**

NJIT has compiled a 4-3 record so far this season. After starting out 0-3, the Highlanders have won their last four matches, including defeating Hunter (3-0), Rutgers-Newark (3-0), Lees-McRae (3-1) and NJCU (3-0). The Highlanders take on Saint Francis on Feb. 10 before visiting the Nittany Lions.

#### **Weekly Recap**

The Nittany Lions are 6-1 after two wins on Feb. 3-4 against Mount Olive and Cal-Baptist. Sophomore Peter Russell led the Lions with 17 kills, while redshirt freshman Nick Goodell posted 13 and freshman Aaron Russell tallied 12. Redshirt senior Edgardo Goas paced the offense with 54 assists, while both Aaron Russell and sophomore Jace Olsen had three aces each. Goodell was strong on defense with 12 digs, as was redshirt freshman Connor Curry who posted 11. Aaron Russell was unbeatable at the net with 13 total blocks, including for solo.

#### Russell Tabbed EIVA Offensive Player of the Week

Sophomore Peter Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 6. Russell started both matches of the weekend at outside hitter. Against the Trojans, Russell posted a team-high nine kills on 14 errorless swings for a .643 hitting percentage. He also tallied an ace and two blocks. The following night against the Lancers, Russell tied for first on the team with eight kills with three digs and a block. For the weekend, Russell had a team-high 17 kills, averaging 2.83 kills per set on .474 hitting. He also contributed five digs and three blocks.

#### **Goas Named Primetime Performer of the Week**

Redshirt senior setter Edgardo Goas was named a Primetime Performer of the Week for men's volleyball. Goas was one of 16 honorees across 21 Division I sports. Goas guided the Nittany Lions to 3-1 victories against No.4 Stanford and No. 12 Pacific on the Ken and Dave Dunlap Invitational hosted by Ohio State on Feb. 27-28. As the starting setter in both matches, Goas paced the Penn State offense to a .377 hitting percentage for the weekend and averaged 13.50 assists per set. His five primary hitters had .333 attack percentages or better. Goas also contributed defensively with 1.62 digs per set and 0.50 blocks per set.

#### **Goodell Earns EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Laurels**

Redshirt freshman Nick Goodell (Ambridge, Pa.) was named the EIVA Player of the Weekon Jan. 30. This is the first honor of Goodell's career.

Goodell was integral to Penn State's wins against No.4 Stanford and No. 12 Pacific at the Ken and Dave Dunlap Invitational hosted by Ohio State on Jan. 27-28. Against the Cardinal, Goodell played three sets tallying 10 kills on .333 hitting and contributed two blocks. The following night against the Tigers, Goodell made his first start. Goodell led the team with 17 kills on .382 hitting. He also had a team-high three aces, as well as six digs and five blocks. For the weekend, Goodell was second on the team with 27 kills and had a .364 hitting percentage. He was also second on the squad with seven total blocks.

#### **Season Opening Record**

The Nittany Lions opened the 2012 season in Columbus, Ohio with a 3-0 sweep of the defending national champion Ohio State Buckeyes. Under head coach Mark Pavlik the Nittany Lions improved to 10-8 in season openers since 1995.

#### **Penn State Newcomers**

The Nittany Lions welcome the addition of four newcomers to this year's squad, including 6-4 setter Taylor Hammond, 6-9 middle hitter Aaron Russell, 6-8 middle hitter Kyle Gregan and 6-9 middle hitter Matt Seifert. In addition, redshirt freshmen Connor Curry (6-0, Libero) and Nick Goodell (6-4, Outside Hitter) will also have the opportunity to see time on the court this season.

#### **Season-Opening Change**

For the first time in five years, the Nittany Lion men's volleyball team will not open its season at the Hawaiian Outrigger Invitational in Honolulu, Hawaii. Penn State heads to Ohio State on Jan. 14 to take on the Buckeyes, who are 1-2 so far this season. The Nittany Lions last opened their season at Ohio State in both 2001 and 2002.

#### Men's Volleyball Debuts at No. 7 in AVCA Div. I-II Preseason Coaches Poll

The Penn State men's volleyball team debuts in the 2012 AVCA Division I-II Preseason Coaches Poll at No. 7. The Nittany Lions face eight teams in 2012 that are ranked in this year's preseason poll, including No. 8 Ohio State, No. 10 Loyola, No. 13 Lewis, No. 4 Stanford, No. 15 Pacific, No. 9 Pepperdine, No. 5 USC and No. 1 BYU.

#### Two Nittany Lions Named Off Teh Block Preseason All-Americans

Two members of the Penn State men's volleyball team were named to the Off the Block Preseason All-America Teams for Division I-II. Seniors Edgardo Goas and Joe Sunder were each selected. Penn State was one of five teams with multiple Preseason All-Americans selected. BYU, Stanford, UCLA and USC each had three players honored as First or Second Team honorees.






