#### **BRIEFLY ABOUT THE MAVERICKS**

#### Omaha vs. the Big Ten

The Mavericks have four different teams from the Big Ten on their schedule in 2022 and have gone 4-3 in those contests so far. Omaha won two of three games against league-leading Rutgers in a March 18-20 home series at Tal Anderson Field. It beat the Scarlet Knights in its final at-bat to open and close the series. The Mavericks also posted a walk-off win over Nebraska in their first of four meetings this year. Each team took two games, with the home team winning all four.

#### **Big Bat Boeve**

Sophomore third baseman Mike Boeve leads the Summit League batting average, hits, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, OPS, doubles, walks and hit-by-pitches. The Hastings, Neb., native was a All-Summit selection as a freshman and led the Northwoods League in hits last summer. He has twice been selected as the league's player of the week this season, most recently on April 11. Boeve had a walk-off double in Omaha's 3-2, 12-inning win over Rutgers on March 20 and a ninth-inning homer that beat Kansas 11-10 on April 12.

#### Ace Machado: Vet Effective

Sixth-year senior and longtime Friday starter Joey Machado has excelled in moving to the bullpen for the Mavericks this season. He entered the week ranked in the top 20 nationally in ERA and has posted a 4-3 record with three saves. Machado earned wins over in-state rivals Creighton and Nebraska in the same week earlier this season. He struck out all three batters he faced in the ninth inning of an 11-10 come-frombehind victory at Kansas on April 12.

## BY THE NUMBERS

The Mavericks have won the Summit League regular-season title three times since their transition to Divison I. They advanced to the NCAA tournament in 2019.

Third baseman Mike Boeve extended his hitting streak to 14 games with a double at Nebraska on Wednesday. His streak began in the finale of the Oral Roberts series on April 3 and has included five multi-hit games.

Omaha entered the week ranked 30th in team ERA among all Division I clubs. Friday starter Caleb Riedel's 0.86 ERA is tied for second in the nation, individually.

Starting pitcher Caleb Riedel put together a streak of 32 consecutive scoreless innings

between Feb. 27 and April 15. He didn't allow a run in five consecutive starts and has given up one in his last 35 innings.
