

PENN STATE RETURNS TO JEFFREY FOR MATCH AGAINST WISCONSIN

The Penn State men's soccer team returns to Happy Valley Friday, Sept. 23 for a doubleheader with the women's soccer team starting at 5:30 p.m. The Nittany Lions face off against Wisconsin in their third Big Ten Conference match of the 2016 season and second at Jeffrey Field.

NITTANY LIONS LIVE ON BTN

For the first time this season, Penn State is slated to appear on the Big Ten Network for its match against Wisconsin. Fans who are unable to make it out to Jeffrey Field can catch the Nittany Lions live on BTN starting at 5:30 p.m.

DOUBLEHEADER WITH WOMEN'S SOCCER

Friday's match will mark the second time in the 2016 season that the Blue and White have had a doubleheader with the women's team. Last time, the Nittany Lions played in the tail end of the doubleheader, falling to Saint Francis, while the women picked up a 3-0 victory over San Diego State.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN

Wisconsin is 3-1-1 overall on the season and 2-0-0 in Big Ten Conference play after defeating Northwestern 2-1 on the road. The Badgers have scored just six goals on the season and have given up four and are carrying a .406 shots on goal percentage compared to their opponents .347 shots on goal percentage.

Tom Barlow is the lone UW player with multiple goals on the season with two for the Badgers. Christphor Mueller and Mark Segbers have added one goal apiece to their stat line and have each dished out two assists for four points each. In goal, Phillip Schilling has played in and started all five games with 13 saves and a 0.73 goals against average.

HARRIS NETS TWO AGAINST THE TERPS

The No. 4 Maryland Terrapins did not have an answer for sophomore **Dayonn Harris** who found himself alone on three breakaways in the match. Harris was unsuccessful in his first attempt but scored easily on the next two to give Penn State the lead twice in the match. Harirs showed success from both sides of the field scoring his first goal down the right side of the pitch into the bottom left corner. In his second goal of the match, Harris picked up the ball on the left side of the field and drove it into the net for the Nittany Lions.

REVIEWING THE MARYLAND MATCH

Penn State took the lead twice in the match against the No. 4 Terrapins on two **Dayonn Harris** goals, but Maryland was able to come away with the win using two penalty kicks and an overtime goal to secure the win.

B1G WIN OVER OHIO STATE ON MACK BRADY NIGHT

Behind a season-high four goals, the Penn State men's soccer team remained undefeated in Mack Brady Matches picking up a 4-2 victory over Ohio State in its first Big Ten Conference match of the 2016 season Tuesday, Sept. 13 at Jeffrey Field.

The Nittany Lions notched their first win over Ohio State since the 2014 season when they took a 1-0 victory at Jeffrey Field in the second Mack Brady Match. The four goals in the match marked the first time Penn State has scored four goals since the 2012 season when it tied Northwestern 4-4 in double overtime on the road.

KLERKS SCORES TWO AGAINST OSU

Senior **Mason Klerks** paced the team against Ohio State with two goals on the night, scoring both in the first 26 minutes of action. The two goals were the first time a Penn State player has netted two in one game since **Connor Maloney** had two against Maryland in the 2015 campaign.

Entering his seventh season as Penn State's 11th coach in its storied history, Bob Warming has made his impact known in his first five years. Twice named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 by leading the Nittany Lions to back-to-back Big Ten titles, Warming has added a pair of trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2010, 2013), and led the Lions to three straight postseason appearances.

Warming led the Nittany Lions to a 7-8-3 overall record and a 2-4-2 Big Ten Conference record in the 2015 campaign. The Blue and White earned an overtime victory over Michigan State in the Big Ten Big Ten Champion Ohio State in the quarterfinals in overtime. Junior Connor Maloney paced Penn State, starting 17 matches with a team leading 17 points that included seven goals and two assists en route to his second First Team All-Big Ten honor. Freshman Austin Maloney also made his mark on the program, earning All-Freshman team honors after starting 14 games with two assists and a .800 shots on goal percentage. Of its seven wins in 2016, six of them came by way of the shutout with senior goalkeeper Matt Bersano tallying five and junior Evan Finney earning one.

2014 was a banner year for Warming and his Nittany Lions as they won 13 matches for the second straight year, going 13-6-1 overall and 5-3 in the Big Ten. They also recorded their 800th win in program history over Penn (Sept. 24), with a 6-2 win at Jeffrey Field. The team got out to a sizzling 10-0-1 start, it's best ever and won seven straight matches for the first time since 2005.

AMMANN MAKES IDENTICAL PK SAVE IN MACK BRADY MATCH

Exactly one year to the day of the 3rd Mack Brady Match and Penn State's 1-0 win over then-No. 10 Indiana, freshman goalkeeper Arie **Ammann** found himself in the same situation that **Matt Bersano** was in one year earlier. At the 2015 Mack Brady Match, Bersano came up with a huge penalty kick save when he dove to his left and knocked the ball to the sideline in an effort to keep the match scoreless. In the 2016 Mack Brady Match, Ammann made the same exact save in the same exact goal to keep the Nittany Lion three goal lead intact on a night that is meant to honor goalkeepers.

MALONEY TALLIES FIVE POINTS AGAINST THE BUCKEYES

Senior Connor Maloney was the leader on the field for the Blue and White against the Buckeyes tacking on at least one point in each of Penn State's four goals. The senior captain assisted both of the goals from Mason Klerks before netting his fourth goal of the season on a penalty kick and adding an assist on junior Aymar Sigue's goal.

NITTANY LIONS LOOKING TO BOUNCE BACK AFTER SFU LOSS

After falling in a 3-1 match against Saint Francis, Penn State is looking to bounce back in its Big Ten opener against Ohio State. The Blue and White were down 3-0 against the Red Flash before freshman **Christian Sload** found his first collegiate goal off a pass from Noah Pilato.

SLOAD SCORES FIRST COLLEGIATE GOAL

In his first collegiate appearance late in the match against Saint Tournament play in match before falling to eventual Francis, freshman Christian Sload found the back of the net on his first shot. The freshman traveled up the right side of the field as Noah Pilato gathered the ball in the middle of the field. Pilato brought the ball up about six-yards before passing it up to Sload who shot the ball past the keeper to net his first collegiate goal donning the Blue and White.

WARMING EARNS 450TH CAREER VICTORY

Head coach **Bob Warming** notched his 450th career victory as a head coach when the Nittany Lions picked up a 2-1 overtime win over Oakland Sept. 5. Warming ranks second among active Division I coaches in victories just behind South Carolina's Mark Berson who has 484 career wins as a head coach. Furthermore, Warming was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013 after leading PSU to a pair of league titles. Moreover, Warming leads all Division I active coaches with a 28 combined regular season and conference tournament championships.

PSU REMAINS PERFECT UNDER WARMING IN HOME OPENERS

Under the tutelage of head coach **Bob Warming**, the Nittany Lions are a perfect 7-0 in home openers since he arrived at Penn State in 2010. Furthermore, his squads have outscored opponents 10-1 on opening day and have not given up a goal since Warming's inaugural season in 2010 when they defeated Bucknell 2-1.

SIGUE RETURNS FROM COSTA RICA TO SCORE GAME-WINNER

Junior transfer **Aymar Sigue** made a week-long trip to Costa Rica to play for the Canadian Nationa Team, missing two regular season games for the Nittany Lions. The junior transfer missed Penn State's contest against Cal and its match against JMU before returning in time for its Labor Day match against Oakland. Playing just seven minutes in the second half after 10 hours of travel, Sigue found the ball six yard outs from the net in the first minute of overtime. Sigue blasted the ball right at the keeper who was able to make the save. However, the shot was too hard as it squeaked out of his hands, allowing Sigue to rip a shot into the lower half of the net for the game-winner.

AMMANN NAMED BIG TEN DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the second consecutive week, Penn State men's soccer has been awarded with the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week as freshman **Arie Ammann** earned his first career honor getting the win in both matches this past weekend.

Ammann earned the nod for both starts after an injury to senior goalkeeper **Evan Finney** and proved to be a good choice for the Nittany Lions as he played 181:42 minutes on the pitch and conceded just one goal in two matches.

The Round Hill, Va. native made his first start donning the Blue and White in Friday's home-opener against the JMU Dukes in which he made a career-high five saves in the match and tallied his first career shutout. Moving into Monday's contest, Ammann gave up one goal late in the match but held on in the remaining minutes as the Nittany Lions went on to a 2-1 overtime victory over Oakland. Ammann made two saves in the match and picked up his second victory in as many games.

On the week, Ammann tallied seven saves and gave up just one goal. The freshman keeper has made a total of nine saves in 191:01 minutes on the pitch and carries a .818 save percentage.

MALONEY FINDING THE NET

Senior **Connor Maloney** has found ways to score in the 2016 campaign, scoring one goal in each of the last three games for the Nittany Lions. Maloney scored the first goal of the 2016 for the Blue and White at UC Berkeley before returning to Happy Valley for the final home opener of his collegiate career. The senior captain netted what would be the winning goal against JMU as he tapped the ball into the lower half of the net as he fell to the ground. Maloney's scoring continued into Penn State's match against Oakland as he again scored the first goal of the match in the off a free kick just outside the 18-yard box.

Impressively, the Nittany Lions have never posted a losing season at Jeffrey Field in 43 years, going 323-84-35 all-time for a winning percentage of .771. Last season, PSU went 4-3-1 at the Jeff and over the past four seasons the Nittany Lions are 31-10-4 en route to a pair of Big Ten titles in 2012 and 2013. In the 43-year history of the stadium, Jeffrey Field has welcomed over 540,000 fans through its gates.

FINNEY NAMED BIG TEN DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior goalkeeper **Evan Finney** was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week for the period ended Aug 28. The award marks the first of its career and the second consecutive season that the Nittany Lions has earned B1G Defensive Player of the Week honors in opening weekend.
