SCOUTING OHIO STATE

Ohio State is fresh off a sweep of St. Francis (Pa.) and four of their first six games in the 2018 season.

All-American Nicolas Szerszen leads Ohio State in kills collecting 92 through six matches while teammate Jake Hanes is close behind with a season total of 61.

Sanil Thomas leads the Buckeyes in assist with 257, Szerszen and Thomas are a close 1-2 in digs with 41 and 40, respectively, while Blake Leeson is the team leader in blocks with 18 total.

Ohio State is currently tied for third-place in the MIVA with a record of 4-2 overall and 0-0 in MIVA play while entering the match as the T-No. 3 team in the nation (AVCA).

PENN STATE IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

Penn State is currently ranked in the top-25 in five different team categories including a top-five ranking in hitting percentage – .346 (3rd).

Individually, Jalen Penrose is ranked No. 4 in the nation in aces per set (0.60) followed closely by Aidan Albrecht at No. 11 in 11st averaging 0.50 aces per set. Luke Braswell is 11th in the nation in assists per set averaging 10.06.

NITTANY LIONS No. 8 IN LATEST AVCA POLL

Penn State enters week three at the No. 8 team in this week's American Volleyball Coaches Association DI-II (AVCA) poll.

Penn State (3-1, 0-0) is coming off a 1-1 weekend vs. No. 2 UCLA and No. 13 USC on the road.

Long Beach State remained the No. 1 team in the nation receiving 23 of 26 first-place votes with a record of 7-0, followed by UCLA (1) at No. 2 (7-0), Hawai'i (1) at T-No. 3 (6-0), Ohio State (1) at T-No. 3 (3-2) and BYU (5-1) rounding out the top-five.

PAVLIK KNOWS HOW TO WIN

In his 24th year at the helm of the program, head coach Mark Pavlik has amassed over 500 wins. Pavlik currently stands at 546-173 for his career.

FRESH FACES ON THE COURT IN 2018

The defending EIVA regular and tournament champion men's volleyball team returns a core group of 15 letter winners and four starters this year while welcoming five freshmen and one transfer to the roster.

The new additions include 6-5 Outside Hitter Will Bantle from Pacific Palisades, Calif., Louis Murray, a 6-2 Libero from Los Angeles, Calif., Mathew Gagnon, a 6-5 Outside Hitter from Cranberry Township, Pa., Jack Goedken, a 6-4 Outside Hitter from Carlsbad, Calif. and Henrik Falck Lauten, a 6-5 Outside Hitter from Drammen, Norway.

LAST TIME VS. OHIO STATE

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. - Chris Nugent's match point kill lifted No. 13 Penn State (14-9, 6-2) to a pulsating 3-2 victory over No. 1 Ohio State (23-2, 12-0) in historic Rec Hall.

The win over Ohio State marks the first time Penn State has defeated the No. 1 team in the nation since May 4, 2006 when the Nittany Lions upset the then-No. 1 UC-Irvine Anteaters in the semifinals of the NCAA Championship tournament in Rec Hall.

"When you come into a match with the Buckeyes, you know it's going to be a pretty physical match," said head coach Mark Pavlik.

"You know that they're going to be taking great swings, and you know that they're going to be teeing off from behind the service line," Pavlik continued.

Entering the fifth set tied 2-2, Penn State bolted to a 2-0 advantage in the deciding fifth game with a kill by Albrecht and an attack error by the Buckeyes. Ohio State tried to find their way back early in the set; but, Penn State forced a Buckeye timeout as the Nittany Lions earned another set of back-to-back points to take a 6-3 lead.

Nugent provided the eighth-point of the set giving Penn State an 8-4 lead and triggering the switch of sides'. Ohio State battled back as came within one point of Penn State, forcing the Nittany Lions to take a timeout while leading 8-7.

Tied at 10-10, the teams preceded to trade points before Albrecht and Nugent dished out consecutive kills to give Penn state a 14-12 lead and force Ohio State's second and final timeout of the set.

The timeout did not hinder the Nittany Lions, as Nugent was able to find his 19th kill of the match, giving Penn State a 3-2 win over Ohio State.

Three different Nittany Lions tallied double figure kills in tonight's match. Nugent posted 19 kills while redshirt junior Aidan Albrecht finished second on the team with 14 kills. Redshirt junior Jalen Penrose followed to finish third with 10 kills.

Freshman Nathan Smith recorded a double-double performance with 39 assists and 10 digs for the Blue and White.

Penn State out-dug the Buckeyes 42 to 35, led by a match-

high and career-high 10 digs from freshman Nathan Smith. Redshirt sophomore libero Royce Clemens and Nugent tied for the second highest dig total on the team with eight digs apiece.

Tonight's win moves the Nittany Lions' overall record up to 14-9 and 8-7 in non-conference play.

The teams met once earlier this season, with Ohio State capturing a 3-0 win on January 24, 2017 in Columbus, OH.
