#### **COMPLETING THE HOMESTAND**

The Penn State women's hockey team gets set for a Fri.-Sat. home series at Pegula Ice Arena welcoming the Holy Cross Crusaders to Hockey Valley Oct. 8-Oct. 9, wrapping up its six-game homestand to begin the season.

- Penn State and Holy Cross match up for the the second time in this week's series after kicking off the 2019-20 regular season facing each other at Holy Cross Sept. 27-28, 2019. Both games ended in ties (3-3 and 1-1).
- This series marks the first time the Nittany Lions will host the Crusaders at Pegula Ice Arena.

#### **IMPORTANT NUMBERS**

Penn State senior forward Natalie Heising is just one point away from becoming the third NIttany Lion to reach 100-career points, joining Laura Bowman and Amy Petersen. With 99 career points, she is six points shy of breaking Bowman's 104-point record.

The Nittany Lions had two more CHA player of the week honorees after week two, bringing their season total to five already. Josie Bothun was Goaltender of the Week and Mallory Uihlein was Defender of the Week.

Penn State has allowed just seven goals through four games this season, with sophomore goaltender Josie Bothun sporting a 1.73 GAA during that span.
