Coming off a two-game sweep of Michigan that propelled Minnesota into a tie for first place in the Big Ten and also moved the Gophers back into the national rankings, No. 15/17 Gopher Hockey returns to action this weekend with a two-game conference series at Penn State.

The two Big Ten foes meet for the first time this season on Friday, Feb. 20 at 6:40 p.m. ET (BTN, BTN2Go.com, 1500 ESPN, Gopher Radio Network) while the series finale at Pegula Ice Arena is set for Saturday, Feb. 21 at 5:07 p.m. ET (ESPNU, WatchESPN, 1500 ESPN, Gopher Radio Network).

Seniors Set the Tone

Since Minnesota started its current six-game unbeaten streak on Jan. 30, no class in college hockey has tallied more points than the Gophers' senior class. The six Minnesota seniors have combined to score 16 of the team's 29 points over the stretch including back-to-back hat tricks from Travis Boyd and Kyle Rau. All six seniors have tallied points during the run including the team's top three scorers over the unbeaten streak in Boyd (4-6--10), Seth Ambroz (6-3--9) and Rau (5-3--8).

The Minnesota Rau-ser

Kyle Rau's four-goal weekend against the Wolverines earned the team captain Big Ten Second Star of the Week honors. The senior forward and team captain tallied his second career hat trick in Friday's 6-2 win with a power-play goal, an even-strength goal and a short-handed goal before adding an empty-net insurance goal in Saturday's 2-0 win to complete the sweep. Rau's first tally on Friday night marked the senior's 150th career point as he now ranks 27th all-time at Minnesota with 153 points. Minnesota is 79-13-8 all-time when Rau tallies a point and 39-3-0 when the All-American records multiple points in a game. Friday's game at Penn State will mark Rau's 150th career game at Minnesota.

Wilcox Earns B1G Third Star, Climbs Record Book

After allowing just two goals all last weekend to the nation's top-ranked offense and picking up his conference-leading fourth shutout of the year, defending Big Ten Player of the Year and Goaltender of the Year Adam Wilcox was named the Big Ten Third Star of the Week. Wilcox has appeared in 105 games since arriving on campus as a freshman while the All-American continues to make a name for himself in the Gopher Hockey history books. Wilcox's 11 career shutouts rank second all-time at Minnesota behind Kellen Briggs' 13 while the junior's 67 career wins are fourth all-time at Minnesota. Next up on the list for Wilcox is Hobey Baker Award winner Robb Stauber with 73 wins while Briggs also holds the school wins record at 84.

Gophers Earn 300th Win at Mariucci

Friday's 6-2 victory over Michigan at Mariucci Arena gave the Maroon & Gold its 300th all-time win at the venue. The 2014-15 season marks the 21st campaign in which the Gophers have called Mariucci Arena home. Since opening Mariucci Arena, Minnesota is 301-115-46 (.700) on home ice. Since the start of the 2011-12 season, the Gophers are 59-12-7 (.812) on home ice including a 15-1-3 (.853) mark last year and a 11-2-1 mark this season.

Lucia Record Watch

Gopher Hockey coach Don Lucia is 667-353-97 all-time as a head coach including 388-198-68 at Minnesota. Only Doug Woog has more coaching wins behind the Gophers' bench with 390. Lucia's 667 career wins rank him ninth all-time in college hockey and third among active Division I coaches while he will enter his 28th overall season as a head coach and 16th season with the Gophers in 2014-15.

Reilly Leads NCAA Defensemen in Scoring

As a sophomore last season, Mike Reilly earned First Team All-Big Ten honors, Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors and became Minnesota's first First Team All-American since 2009. The defenseman is once again among the elite defensemen in the nation -- his 27 assists and 32 points are both first nationally among defensemen. Reilly is the first Gopher defenseman to lead the team in scoring since Mike Crowley tallied 56 points (nine goals, 47 assists) in route to All-America honors in 1996-97.

Power Play on Point

Minnesota continues to boast the nation's best power play at .287 (31-for-108). The Gophers' 0-for-2 performance in Saturday's 2-0 win over Michigan broke a streak of six-straight games with a power-play goal for the Maroon & Gold. Minnesota went 10-for-23 over that stretch (.435) and is now 10-for-25 (.400) over the last seven games.

Rau Up for Senior CLASS Award

Already a nominee for the Hobey Baker Award, Kyle Rau has now been listed as one of 10 finalists for the annual Senior CLASS Award -- given to one Division I hockey player based on achievement in the "Four C's" -- classroom, character, community and competition. Rau was honored as Gopher Hockey's John Mayasich Outstanding Student-Athlete Award winner last year and was recognized as the Henry L. Williams Legacy Award winner, which annually recognizes the top male student-athlete at the University of Minnesota who excels in competition and in the classroom while representing the values of the athletics department, earlier this year. Rau was an Academic All-Big Ten honoree as a junior last season and was a member of the All-WCHA Academic Team in 2011-12 in his first year of eligibility.

Bristedt Finds His Groove

Freshman forward Leon Bristedt had his four-game point streak snapped in last Friday's 6-2 win over the Wolverines, but the Swede rebounded with a fancy setup for Seth Ambroz's game winner the next night. Bristedt currently leads Minnesota's freshmen class with 10 points (four goals, six assists) and has five points during the team's current six-game unbeaten streak.

Iron Man in Net

Over his two-plus seasons with the Gophers, Adam Wilcox has arguably put up two of the top seasons in net in program history. The South St. Paul, Minn., native set a new school GAA record of 1.88 in 2012-13 as a freshman, earning All-WCHA Third Team honors. Last year was even better for the netminder. Wilcox set a new school save percentage record of .932 and earned Second Team All-America accolades as well as being named Big Ten Player & Goaltender of the Year and First Team All-Big Ten. He also was named a finalist for the Hobey Baker Award -- Minnesota's first finalist since Ryan Potulny in 2006.

Live and In Color

Thirty regular-season Gopher Hockey games will be available on television during the 2014-15 across several networks. FOX Sports will lead the way in Gophers television coverage this season with 15 games while the Big Ten Network will broadcast 11 regular-season games featuring the Maroon & Gold over the course of the season. The ESPN network follows up with another four Gopher games. The entirety of the 2015 Big Ten Hockey Tournament will be broadcast live on the Big Ten Network.

And on the Radio with Wally and Frank

Gopher Hockey will continue to call 1500 ESPN home for its radio broadcast after Minnesota and Learfield Sports' Gopher Sports Properties announced a three-year agreement with the radio station this summer. Every regular-season game as well as the entire post-season will be broadcast on the 1500 ESPN radio waves through 2016-17.

A First Time for Everything

Now in its 94th year of collegiate competition, the University of Minnesota has seen almost everything. However, the team did have a couple firsts last year. A new era of Gopher Hockey started in 2013-14 as Minnesota joined the Big Ten Conference and went on to win the first-ever Big Ten game on Nov. 29, 2013 (4-1 win over Wisconsin) as well as the inaugural Big Ten regular-season championship. Additionally, the conference crown gave Minnesota its third-straight conference regular-season title -- another first for the Maroon & Gold.
