### No. 13 Penn State Nittany Lions



#### March 16 Penn State (14-5, 8-1 EIVA) at Ohio State (14-3, 7-1 MIVA)



#### **Nittany Lion Preview**

The No. 13 Penn State men's volleyball team continues its month-long road trip with a visit to No. 9 Ohio State on Saturday, March 16. This is the third meeting between the two squads in 2013 and the series is tied at 1-1. Action is set for 7 p.m.

It was a tough weekend on the road for the Nittany Lions on March 9-10. Penn State suffered a 3-2 (25-18, 23-25, 25-29, 25-27, 11-15) loss at IPFW before falling 3-1 (20-25, 17-25, 25-18, 20-25) to Ball State. Sophomore Aaron Russell (Ellicott City, Md.) led the Nittany Lions with 3.78 kills per set, while junior Peter Russell (Ellicott City, Md.) averaged 2.33 kills per set and redshirt sophomore Nick Goodell (Ambridge, Pa.) hit 2.57 per set. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond (Mission Viejo, Calif.) paced the offense with 11.11 assists per set, while redshirt sophomore Connor Curry (Newport Beach, Calif.) had a team-best 2.33 digs per set. Aaron Russell was second on the team with 1.89 digs per set, while redshirt freshman Matt Seifert (Reading, Pa.) put up 0.56 blocks per set.

For the weekend, Penn State hit .242 and averaged 12.44 kills, 11.89 assists, 1.33 aces, 9.56 March digs and 1.33 blocks per set.

#### Penn State vs. Ohio State

Penn State has a 68-26-1 record against the Buckeyes. The two squads have already met twice in 2013. In the Hawaiian Outrigger Invitational, the Nittany Lions defeated the Buckeyes soundly, 3-0 (26-25, 25-17, 25-22), on Jan. 12. However, Ohio State visited Penn State less than a month later on Feb. 9 and swept the Lions, 3-0 (25-22, 25-20, 26-24).

#### **Scouting the Buckeyes**

The ninth-ranked Ohio State Buckeyes are 14-3 overall and an impressive 7-1 in the MIVA. The Buckeyes opened their season with a 3-0 sweep of Saint Francis on Jan. 5 before going 1-2 at the Hawaii Outrigger Invitational. From there the Buckeyes won 10 straight matches before Lewis handed them a 3-0 loss on March 2. Ohio State is coming off two 3-0 sweeps of Grand Canyon on March 8-9 heading into this weekend.

Redshirt sophomore opposite Andrew Lutz and sophomore outside Michael Henchy are Ohio State's top hitters with 3.67 and 3.46 kills per set, respectively. Redshirt sophomore Peter Heinen is averaging 11.29 assists per set as the starting setter, while sophomore libero Brennan Anderson has a team-best 3.33 digs per set. At the net, senior middle Grayson Overman is averaging an impressive 1.15 blocks per set so far this season.

#### Weekend Recap

It was a rough weekend with the Nittany Lions suffered back-to-back losses. Penn State is now 14-5 overall. Sophomore Aaron Russell combined for a team-best 34 kills, while junior Peter Russell recorded 21. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond dished out 100 assists and redshirt sophomore Connor Curry totaled a team-high 21 digs. Aaron Russell was second on the team with 17 digs, while Hammond posted 14. Redshirt freshman Matt Seifert was Penn State's top blocker with five and Peter Russell added four.

#### Seifert Pounds Career High in Kills

Redshirt freshman Matt Seifert was one of three Nittany Lions to post double-digit kills at IPFW on March 9. He finished third on the team with 11 kills, a personal best, and also tied for first on the team with three blocks. Seifert went on to post six kills and two blocks at Ball State on March 10.

#### Russell and Seifert Garner EIVA Weekly Awards

Sophomore Aaron Russell and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert picked up EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week awards, respectively. The duo helped guide the Nittany Lions to EIVA wins against George Mason and Princeton on Feb. 22-23. Russell led the Nittany Lions with 35 kills with a .329 hitting percentage. He was second on the team in blocks with eight, averaging 1.00 per set and tallied three aces and nine digs. Seifert was unstoppable at the net combining for 13 total blocks for the weekend. He averaged 1.86 blocks per set. Seifert also posted 12 kills on .350 hitting, with two digs and an ace.

#### **Nittany Lions Sweep EIVA Awards**

Junior Peter Russell and redshirt sophomore Connor Curry earned EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week laurels, respectively, on Jan. 28. The pair led Penn State to wins against Loyola-Chicago, Sacred Heart and Harvard. Russell hit .358 for the week and totaled 26 kills, four aces, 13 digs and eight blocks. Curry combined for 29 digs, averaging 2.64 digs per set. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .240 for the week.

#### **Russell and Curry Earn EIVA Weekly Honors**

Two Nittany Lions were named EIVA Players of the Week. Redshirt sophomore Connor Curry was named the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week, while sophomore Aaron Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Jan. 14. The duo helped Penn State to a 2-1 record in the Outrigger Invitational.

Russell, who was named to the Outrigger All-Tournament Team, led the Lions offensively with 42 kills and 45.0 points. He finished second on the team with 22 digs, averaging 1.69 per set and had a team-best 3.23 kills per set on .295 hitting. Curry was the starting libero for all three matches in Honolulu. He posted a team-high 29 digs (2.23 per set) and also had six assists. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .296 for the week.

#### **Outrigger Invitational All-Tournament Team**

#### Russell Named Off the Block Preseason All-American

Sophomore Aaron Russel was named to the Off the Block Preseason First Team All-America Team for Division I-II. He was one of 20 players nationwide selected to the teams. A total of 10 players were named Preseason First Team and Preseason Second Team All-Americans. Players from 11 different programs were picked. Russell helped guide Penn STate to a 23-6 overall record in 2012, including a 14-0 record in EIVA action. He was a 2012 Third Team Volleyball Magazine All-American, a First Team All-EIVA honoree and was named to the EIVA Championship All-Tournament team.
