OPENING TIP: Northwestern is the No. 2 seed at the Big Ten Tournament in 2023, its highest seed in the event's history. Its previous highest seed was No. 6 two times (2004, 2017). It will take on No. 10 seed Penn State (series history on Page 5).

- NU earned its highest Big Ten regular season finish since 1958-59, as it finished 2nd (12-8) in the Big Ten regular season standings in 2022-23. The '58-59 team also finished 2nd.
- The 'Cats 12 Big Ten wins are the most in school history, ahead of only the 1930-31 (11-1) team, the school's only outright Big Ten championship squad.
- NU's .600 winning percentage this year in Big Ten games is the program's best since the 1945-46 (8-4, .667) season.
- The Wildcats had a successful awards haul in the postseason BIG awards. **Chris Collins** was named head coach of the year, **Chase Audige** was named the defensive player of the year and a second team selection, and **Boo Buie** earned a first team nod. More info is on Page 5.
- **Chase Audige** was named to the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Watch List on Tuesday (Feb. 28).
- **Chris Collins** was named to the Naismith Men's College COY Late Season Watch List on Friday (Feb. 17) afternoon.
- NU secured an over .500 road record for the first time in program history since 1958-59 (7-2). NU has 10 seasons in program history with a road record over .500. The team's six BIG wins this year are tied for the most in a single-season in school history (1930-31, 6-0).
- NU's 21 wins this season are the most since the 2016-17 season that saw the 'Cats set a school record for single-season victories going 24-12. The team's 21 regular season wins are tied for the most in a single-season in program history with the 2016-17 'Cats.
- NU has won four straight games when facing AP ranked teams. NU last won three in a row in 1954-55.
- NU is 4-1 this season against AP ranked teams, tallying the most wins in a single-season in program history.
- For the first time since 2009, Northwestern won back-to-

back games against ranked opponents.

- NU has won four league games by 13+ points for the first time since 1966-67.
- Northwestern claimed its first win in program history over the nation's No. 1 team this season when it beat Purdue 64-58 on Feb. 12 inside Welsh-Ryan Arena.

RUTGERS RECAP: NU had four players score in double-figures and held Rutgers to 53 points in a 65-53 win in New Jersey to close out the regular season on Sunday night.

- **Brooks Barnhizer** posted his first career double-double contributing 16 points and a career-high 10 boards.
- Even after going scoreless in the first half, **Boo Buie** posted 14 points.
- NU's defense held Rutgers to a 2-for-17 mark from long range.
- The 'Cats improved to 20-1 when holding opponents under 64 points this season.

BIG BACKCOURT: The senior backcourt of **Chase Audige** and **Boo Buie** has shown to be one of the best in the conference.

- Buie (1st) and Audige (2nd) were named All-BIG, becoming the first NU teammates to be named 1st and 2nd team since 1963-64 (Rick Lopossa, 1st & Rich Falk, 2nd).
- Buie is averaging 17.2 points and Audige is averaging 14.1 points per game. **Scottie Lindsey** is the last Northwestern player to average 15 or more points per game in a season in 2017-18 (15.0). **John Shurna** is the last NU player to average 17 or more ppg (20.0) in a season in 2011-12.
- Two 'Cats haven't averaged 14 or more in the same season since 2016-17: guard **Bryant McIntosh** (14.8) and guard **Scottie Lindsey** (14.1).
- The tandem combined to average 32.5 points (Buie 19.1 ppg, Audige 13.4 ppg) of the team's 67.7 per game average during BIG games (48% of team's offensive output).
- Buie is 1 of 3 players in high-major conferences averaging at least 17+ points and 4.5+ assists per game.

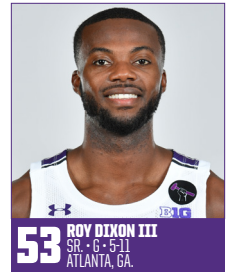
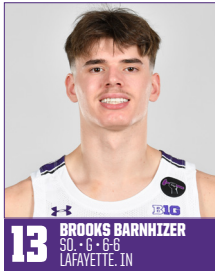

MORE NOTES...

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE D: Northwestern's defense has been its calling card this season. NU ranks 18th nationally and 2nd in the Big Ten holding opponents to an average of 62.3 points per game.

- The 'Cats are 40th nationally and 2nd in the Big Ten allowing opponents to shoot 41.2% from the field.
- Northwestern ranks 44th in the country in opponent field goal percentage on 2-point attempts (46.5%).
- NU's 4.2 blocks per game ranks fourth in the Big Ten.
- NU is second in the Big Ten in steals per game (8.0)
- NU has held 14 opponents to 60 or fewer points this year, its most in a season since 2013-14 (16).

AUDIGE SIEGE: Chase Audige has been all over the floor this season and is second on the team averaging 14.1 points per game (14th in Big Ten), and is second in the Big Ten and ranks 11th nationally averaging 2.4 steals per game. Audige leads the Big Ten with 74 total steals. He was named to a Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Semifinalist on Feb. 28 & the Big Ten DPOY.

- Audige is sitting on 153 career steals for Northwestern. He ranks 6th in a Northwestern career, the full program leaderboard can be found on Page 4.
- The senior has recorded a career-high 72 steals in 30 games this season. Last year he tallied 42 swipes in 24 games.
- Audige's 74 steals this season are the most by a Wildcat in a single-season since **Patrick Baldwin** recorded 74 in 1992-93, and are tied for the second-most in a single-season in program history.
- During his NU career, Audige has recorded four games totaling five steals or more, the most by any Northwestern player since at least 2010-11.
- This season, when Audige records four or more steals in a game, NU is 6-3. When Audige scores 20 or more points in a game, Northwestern is 5-0.
- Audige is the only high major player in the country averaging at least 14 points and 2.4 steals per game. He is one of three players nationally (Jameer Nelson - Delaware, Jaalen House, New Mexico).

THINGS TO NOTE:

- Northwestern is 20-5 this year when scoring 60 or more points. The team suffered its first such loss of the year on Jan. 11 against Rutgers (65-62).
- When NU leads at the half: 16-3
- When NU trails at the half: 4-5
- When NU is tied at the half: 1-2
- **Boo Buie** is 6th in the league averaging 17.2 points per game, while **Chase Audige** ranks 14th posting 14.1 points per game.
- **Boo Buie** also ranks 5th in the conference averaging 4.5 assists per game.
- **Chase Audige** is second in the Big Ten averaging 2.4 steals per game and ranks 11th nationally. **Ty Berry** is 6th in the Big Ten averaging 1.5 steals per game.
- **Matthew Nicholson's** 2.2 offensive boards per game rank 9th in the league. He also ranks 6th with 1.3 blocks per game.
- **Boo Buie** leads the Big Ten shooting 87.6% from the free throw stripe, which is 30th nationally.
- As a team, NU's 4.2 blocks per game are 4th in the Big Ten.
- NU's 8.0 steals per game rank 2nd in the Big Ten.
- Northwestern's team free throw percentage of 74.9% ranks 2nd in the Big Ten. NU's team free throw percentage

is currently the third-highest in a single-season in program history, trailing the 1990-91 (76.8%) and 1991-92 (76.3%) teams.

- The Wildcats lead the Big Ten in turnover margin (4.3) and rank 10th nationally.

BOO! Boo Buie is having a season to remember for Northwestern and is surging during Big Ten play.

- Against Purdue Fort Wayne he became the 39th player in program history to reach 1,000 career points.
- This season, when Buie scores 20 or more points, the Wildcats are 8-5, and when he records five or more assists, the 'Cats are 9-5.
- Buie has scored 20+ points in 12 of NU's 20 Big Ten games.
- Buie is one of four players in the Big Ten leading his team in points and assists, joining Jalen Pickett (Penn State), Jahmir Young (Maryland) and Chucky Hepburn (Wisconsin).
- During conference-only games, he ranks 4th in the league in scoring averaging 19.1 points per game.
- He scored a career-high 35 points at Illinois (2/23), becoming the first 'Cat to score 35 in a game since John Shurna against LSU on Nov. 17, 2011. It was his second career 30+ point game, after scoring 30 in the 'Cats upset of then-No. 4 Michigan State in 2020.
- His 1,485 career points rank 13th in program history. The program's career scoring leaders can be found on page 4.
- Buie is leading the Big Ten shooting 87.6% (113-of-129) at the free throw line. He ranks fifth for the highest single-season free throw percentage in program history. **Jim Stack** (1981, 90.0%) is the program's leader. The program's single-season free throw leaders can be found on page 4.
- His 532 points this year are the 10th-most in a single-season in school history. The single-season leaderboard is on Page 4.
- Buie has 434 career assists, which are fourth-most in program history. Assistant coach **Bryant McIntosh** is the school record holder with 700 assists. See below for the full career leaderboard.
- Buie is just the fifth player in program history to record 1,000+ points and 300+ career assists joining McIntosh, **Michael Thompson** (2008-11), **Patrick Baldwin** (1991-94) and **Craig Moore** (2006-09).

CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Chris Collins is in his tenth season at Northwestern. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013. He ranks third in school history in wins by a head coach.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during the 2016-17 season. The unforgettable campaign saw Northwestern accumulate a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history.

NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play – the program's first since 1933 – saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award. Following the season, Collins agreed to a contract extension that runs through the 2024-25 campaign.

He most recently led the team to a 15-17 record in 2021-22 and knocked off No. 10 Michigan State in East Lansing, his third victory over an AP-Top 10 team. In 2020-21 the 'Cats opened BIG play 3-0, earning a No. 19 ranking from the AP.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

While attending Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and four-year letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star and head coach, Doug Collins. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

RANKED EM: Northwestern earned a No. 21 ranking this week (Week 15) in the Associated Press Poll. Below are some facts about when the Wildcats are ranked.

- 2022-23 marks the first time NU has been ranked since the 2020-21 season.
- It is the latest Northwestern has been ranked in a season in program history.
- Northwestern has not won a game as a ranked team since 2017-18 when the 'Cats were ranked No. 20 and defeated La Salle, 82-74.
- Northwestern is 12-17 all-time as a ranked team.
- Northwestern hasn't won a Big Ten game as a ranked team since defeating Michigan State 85-71 on Jan. 4, 1969.
- NU's highest all-time ranking is No. 6, which happened two times during the 1958-59 season.

60 OR FEWER: Since **Chris Collins** arrived at Northwestern for the 2013-14 season, the 'Cats have held their opponents to 60 or fewer points 93 times. That ranks fifth in the Big Ten over that span.

BLOCK PARTY: Northwestern has recorded 130 blocks this season, which is fifth in a single-season in school history. Last season, the Wildcats rejected 108 shots. Eight of the school's top 10 single-season block totals have come under head coach **Chris Collins**.

- Martinelli prepped at nearby Glenbrook South HS (9 miles away from Welsh-Ryan Arena) and was ranked the No. 7 player in Illinois by 247Sports.

MORE DEFENSIVE NOTES: Northwestern's 62.3 points allowed this season is the program's best mark since at least 2010-11. The Wildcats last allowed 60 or fewer points per game in a season in 2006-07 (58.7).

COACHING STAFF CHANGES: Head Coach **Chris Collins** announced staff changes ahead of the 2022-23 campaign:

- **Bryant McIntosh** was elevated to an on-court assistant coach after spending the previous two seasons as assistant director of operations. McIntosh, who was instrumental in the program's 2017 NCAA Tournament berth as a player and the program's all-time assists leader, is the youngest Power 5 assistant coach in the nation at 27 years old.
- Veteran coach **Chris Lowery** comes to Evanston for his first year on staff. Lowery spent the previous 10 years as associate head coach at Kansas State, helping the Wildcats to two Big 12 regular season titles and five NCAA Tournaments. He also has a 145-116 record as a head coach and led his alma mater Southern Illinois to three NCAA Tournaments and 145 wins (2004-12).
- **Brian James**, Collins' longtime right hand man, has slid into an off-court role as special assistant to the head coach after serving as an assistant coach for nine seasons in Evanston. James has over 45 years of experience as a coach in high school, the NBA and college. Collins played for James in high school at nearby Glenbrook North HS.

HEAD COACH CHRIS COLLINS: Sullivan-Ubben Head Men's Basketball Coach **Chris Collins** is in his 10th season as the program's head coach, the third longest coaching tenure in program history.

- Collins is also third in program history with 154 victories.
- Collins is the fourth-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten, trailing Michigan State's Tom Izzo (28), Purdue's Matt Painter (18) and Iowa's Fran McCaffery (13).
- Collins was featured on the Netflix special *The Redeem Team* this year for his role as an assistant coach for the 2008 USA Basketball Olympic team in Beijing.

RETURN OF THE 'CATS: Chris Collins' squad is among the most experienced in the Big Ten heading into this season. The Wildcats returned four starters for the third-consecutive season, tied for second-most in the conference. The 'Cats return:

- 55.8% of scoring
- 58.3% of minutes
- 46.0% of rebounds
- 57.1% of assists

'CATS AWARD FACTS: NU had a historic award haul in the Big Ten postseason awards.

- Head coach **Chris Collins** won the Big Ten Coach of the Year Award, the second recipient in school history and the first since **Bill Carmody** in 2004.
- **Boo Buie** is the first NU first team selection since **John Shurna** in 2012, and the first guard since **Jitim Young** in 2004.

SERIES HISTORY VS. PENN STATE: Northwestern will meet Penn State for the second time in the last three games.

- Penn State leads the all-time series, 37-20.
- NU is 2-2 in the Big Ten Tournament, and will meet in the postseason for the first time since 2018, a 65-57 PSU win.
- NU won its first Big Ten Tournament game in 1999 in Chicago against Penn State in a 54-44 win.

LAST TIME VS PENN STATE: NU dropped its first overtime game of the season on Wednesday night, falling at home to Penn State on Senior Night, 68-65.

- **Boo Buie** tied his season-high with 8 assists for the fourth-time this year and scored a team-high 20 points. He either scored or assisted on 17 of NU's 24 field goals.
- Brooks Barnhizer tied his career-high of 19 points (scored in double-figures for 4th straight game) and led the team with 7 boards.
- After shooting 3-of-13 from 3 in the first half, Penn State went 8-for-13 from behind the arc in the second half.
- **Chase Audige** totaled 3 steals.

HISTORIC WIN AT INDIANA: Northwestern won at No. 15 Indiana 84-83 on Jan. 8, 2023. Below are some historical points about the game.

- Northwestern allowed its most points in a win since defeating then-No. 8 Michigan in overtime 97-93 on March 12, 1994.
- Northwestern ended a 25-game losing skid when facing a ranked Indiana team, winning for the first time since Jan. 11, 1988, 66-64, over the then No. 12 Hoosiers in Evanston.
- NU won back-to-back road games in Bloomington for the first time since 1966-68.
- The win improved NU's conference record to 3-1. The team

started with a 3-1 record for the third time in the last 55 seasons. 2020-21 (3-1) and 1967-68 (3-1).

- NU won back-to-back road games over ranked opponents for the first time in program history (defeated No. 20 Michigan State in East Lansing in previous road game).
- The Wildcats have defeated Indiana, Michigan State and Illinois in the same season for the first time since 1967-68

DOWN GOES NO. 1: Northwestern defeated No. 1 Purdue 64-58 on Feb. 12, 2023, its first win in program history over the No. 1 team in the country.

- According to ESPN, Northwestern was previously 0-19 against AP No. 1 teams, which was the second-most losses in the country without a win against the top team, trailing Washington State (0-27).
- Northwestern hadn't played the No. 1 team in the country at home since narrowly falling to Ohio State 58-57 in 2011.
- The win was Northwestern's sixth in program history over a top three team and the first since beating No. 2 Michigan 99-87 in 1977.

BERAN BUILDS ON SENIOR SEASON: Northwestern has received another year of improvement from senior **Robbie Beran**. The 6-9 forward has increased his scoring output every year of his career and is averaging career-bests of 7.7 points per game and 4.6 boards per game this year. Beran played in his 100th career game against Illinois, and has not missed a game in his career.

- Beran started the year scoring in double figures in three straight games for the first time in his career.
- When Beran scores in double-figures this season, Northwestern is 8-1.

BILLY MCKINNEY RECEIVES LEGENDARY HONOR:

Northwestern Athletics and Recreation and the Wildcats men's basketball program announced Sunday (Feb. 19) that one of the greatest student-athletes in the history of the University, Billy McKinney (1973-77), will have his jersey retired during the 2023-24 basketball season at Welsh-Ryan Arena. McKinney will be the first student-athlete in school history to have their jersey retired.

- Considered by many the best player in Northwestern history, McKinney scored 1,900 career points, a school record that stood for 35 years, and led the Wildcats in scoring each season of his career. His 768 made field goals still stand as the program's all-time record. McKinney earned All-Big Ten recognition in all of his four seasons and garnered First Team All-Conference and All-America honors as a senior when he averaged 21.3 points per game. A Wildcat has not made 17 or more field goal attempts in a game since McKinney when he posted 37 points against Notre Dame in 1974. Under head coach Tex Winter, McKinney was named the first three-time team MVP in program history from 1975-77. The Zion, Ill., native also suited up for the Northwestern baseball team, earned his degree in education in 1977, and was inducted to the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 1986. Since 2019, McKinney has served as the mayor of his hometown, Zion, Ill. The NU great is still heavily involved with the program and is the team's radio color analyst alongside the Voice of the 'Cats, Dave Eanet, on WGN Radio 720. NUDAR annually presents The Billy McKinney Award to the male student-athlete who has exhibited exemplary leadership qualities, constant (110 percent) effort, and a positive attitude that, in his coach's estimation, makes

him a "coach's dream."
