RIT Hits the Road For Two Games Against Penn State... RIT continues its five-game road trip with a weekend series against CHA rival Penn State. The Tigers and Nitany Lions will begin game one on Friday, January 29 at 7 p.m., and will close out the series on Saturday at 2 p.m. This is the third and fourth games of the season, between the two teams; the squads split a pair of games at the Gene Polisseni Center earlier this season.

Last Time Out/Tigers Pick up Split against CHA Rival Syracuse... Last weekend, RIT earned a split against Syracuse to close their season series. The Tigers and the Orange once again needed an extra period to decide a game, as RIT picked up a big victory on Friday at the Gene Polisseni Center, winning 2-1. Carly Payerl scored both goals, first tying the game in the waning moments of the second period, then getting the game-winner exactly a minute into overtime on the only shot of the period for both teams. Jess Paton assisted on both goals, while Brooke Baker had an assist in the game winner. Jetta Rackleff had one of her gutsiest performances this season, stopping 41 shots to preserve the victory. On Saturday the teams travelled to Tenny Ice Rink in Syracuse, and the Orange took advantage of home ice, winning 3-0. The Tigers ended their season series with a 1-3 record against their I-90 rivals.

About Penn State... The Nitany Lions skate into the weekend series after an unbeaten home weekend against Robert Morris, winning 3-2 on Friday, and a 2-2 tie on Saturday. They were the only team to go unbeaten last weekend, moving to fourth place in the CHA standings. Penn State is 2-0-2 in the last four CHA contests, bringing their overall record to 7-14-5 on the season, and 3-4-5 in the conference. Penn State is led by their junior tandem of Amy Petersen and Laura Bowman. Petersen leads the team in points (17), and assists (13), while Bowman leads the team in goals with 10, with 15 points on the season. In goal, Celine Whitlinger is one of the best goaltenders in the league, as she is tied for the league lead with a 1.67 goals against average, good for 10th nationally. Her .943 save percentage just edges Jetta Rackleff for the conference lead, as Whitlinger is 4-8-4 between the pipes this season.

All-Time vs. Penn State... The Tigers enjoy a 12-4-2 record all-time against the Nitany Lions, including a 1-2-1 record at the Pegula Ice Arena. Penn State has had the upper hand recently, winning four of the last five contests. Earlier this season, the Tigers and Nitany Lions split a pair of games at the Gene Polisseni Center. On Friday, January 15, RIT recorded its second shutout of the season, picking up its first CHA victory in a 3-0 win. Jetta Rackleff picked up her first shutout since November 29, 2014, stopping 33 shots. On Saturday, the Tigers rallied from a 2-0 deficit to tie the game on goals by Jess Paton and Reagan Rust, the latter coming with 2:23 left in regulation. In overtime, Laura Bowman scored on a power-play goal to lift Penn State to victory.

Home Sweet Home?... Both RIT and Penn State are still getting used to their new home arenas. The Nitany Lions are 14-25-5 since opening up at the Pegula Ice Arena, which opened in 2013. The Tigers are 10-20-3 in their second year of play at the Gene Polisseni Center.

Milestones... Senior forward Jess Paton is just two games away from being tied for second all-time in games played at the university, with 139. Paton would share the mark with former standouts Celeste Brown and Emilee Bulleid. The record for most games played is 143, set by Lindsay Grigg last season... Junior defender and team captain Taylor Thurston logged her 100th game as a

member of the Tigers on Saturday, Jan. 23 at Syracuse. This season, Thurston has scored a career-high three goals, as she is tied for fourth on the team with 11 points. Thurston has four goals and 30 assists in her 100 career games.

Tigers Picking up Their Play... RIT has played well recently, going 2-2-1 in the last five CHA contests. The Tigers have stepped up their scoring, getting two goals or more in three of the last four games, after a stretch in which they scored six goals in seven games. Jetta Rackleff has been a force in net for the Tigers in the last seven weeks. Since returning from injury on December 4, Rackleff has averaged 33.75 saves per game. She is second in the CHA and 12th nationally in save percentage, at .931.

New Look for CHA Championship... College Hockey America conference play is in full swing. This season, the semifinals and championship will be played at a neutral site, the HARBORCENTER in downtown Buffalo. RIT is the two-time defending CHA Champions.

January, the Swing Month... RIT hopes to turn around their season in the month of January, which is traditionally the best time to do so. This year, the Tigers have gone just 2-4 this month, but are 2-2 in CHA contests to move closer to the pack. Last year, the Tigers only went 3-4 in the opening month, but ended their season with five consecutive victories, and their first NCAA Tournament berth. Since the start of Bruce B. Bates Women's Hockey Coach Scott McDonald's tenure in the 2006-07 season, RIT is 44-20-8 in January.

By the Numbers ...

1 - RIT made its first-ever NCAA Division I tournament appearance last season, taking on nationally ranked No. 1 Minnesota, losing to the eventual national champions, 6-2.

1.81 - Jetta Rackleff has a remarkable 1.81 goals against average this season in CHA contests, tops in the conference.

4-0 - The Tigers record against the Nitany Lions in the postseason, with all games being played at home. RIT has played Penn State in the opening round of the CHA playoffs in two of the last three seasons.

10 - The amount of penalty minutes per game for the Tigers, tied for third nationally.

Bruce B. Bates Women's Hockey Coach - Scott McDonald

Scott McDonald, the program's all-time leader in coaching wins, begins his tenth season as the Bruce B. Bates Women's Hockey Coach at RIT in 2015-16, and fourth at the Division I level. In his tenure, McDonald has transformed the Tigers into one of the most successful and respected teams in all of college hockey. McDonald enters the 2015-16 season just 14 wins shy of 200 for his career at RIT.



On May 28, 2015, McDonald signed a five-year contract extension through the 2019-20 season. On July 7, McDonald became the Bruce B. Bates Women's Hockey Coach; the university's first endowed coaching position for Tiger athletic programs.

RIT won the CHA Championship for the second straight season in 2014-15, emerging as the No. 6 seed to knock off the top three teams and advance to the NCAA Tournament for the first time as a Division I program. RIT was one of seven Division I women's hockey teams honored by the NCAA for its excellent Academic Progress Rate (APR), as it received a Public Recognition Award.

The Tigers made history in just their second season as a Division I program in 2013-14 season, winning the CHA Championship in double overtime against Mercyhurst University, who advanced to the 2014 Frozen Four. RIT won its final seven games of the season and finished with a 20-15-3 mark.

On March 17, 2012, RIT defeated Norwich 4-1 to claim its first NCAA Division III Championship in its final season at that level. The Tigers opened and ended the year with two 14-game winning streaks and were the No. 1 team in the nation for 18 weeks during the season, finishing with an NCAA record 28 wins (28-1-1).

Three days later, RIT announced its intention to move to the Division I level. McDonald and the Tigers made a successful transition to the Division I ranks in 2012-13, as the team finished 16-16-5 and advanced to the College Hockey America Semifinals. RIT recorded wins over established programs Robert Morris, Yale, and Brown in its first Division I year.

In his eight seasons as head coach at RIT, McDonald has compiled an overall record of 186-72-23 (.703 winning percentage). He is Division III's all-time leader with a .835 winning percentage and is RIT's all-time leader in coaching victories, earning his 100th win at RIT on Jan. 29, 2011 vs. Buffalo State. He became the second fastest coach in Division III history to reach that milestone (128 games).

In 2010-11, the Tigers opened the season by winning their first 17 games and were unbeaten in 23 straight games. RIT won its first ECAC West Championship, while making a trip to the NCAA Division III National Championship game and the program's first No. 1 ranking. The Tigers finished 26-2-2 and boasted three All-Americans, including Sarah Dagg, the Laura Hurd National Player of the Year.

McDonald, the 2011 ECAC West Coach of the Year, has led the Tigers to one NCAA Division I Tournament appearance, three NCAA Division III Tournament berths, two ECAC West Championships, and one CHA title. The Tigers won at least 19 games in each of his first six seasons behind the bench and have won at least 20 games five times. He has coached nine different AHCA All-Americans, 36 All-ECAC West selections, and three All-CHA picks.

Under McDonald's tutelage, the Tigers have not only excelled on the ice and in the classroom, but have become active members in the community.

His first season (2006-07) was a landmark year, as the Tigers made the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first time and set a school record for wins in a season (22). He coached two RBK Division III All-Americans and boasted the leading two scorers in the country. He led the Tigers to a 21-3-2 record in 2008-09; they were ranked second nationally, the highest in program history. He was named the 2009 ECAC West Co-Coach of the Year and coached two RBK Division III All-Americans, and seven members of the 2009 All-ECAC West squad.

A 2000 graduate of Niagara University, McDonald played defense for the Purple Eagles — and then coach and former standout RIT defenseman Blaise MacDonald — from 1996-2000. He was part of the school's inaugural freshman and first graduating classes as a Division I program. During his senior year, he helped Niagara, in only its fourth season, to an NCAA Tournament at-large bid, beating the University of New Hampshire in the northeast regional.

McDonald later served as an assistant at Utica College for one season before moving to RIT to serve as the assistant coach for the RIT men's hockey program from 2003-06. He put forth an outstanding effort in recruiting talented student-athletes as the men's squad made the leap to Division I in 2005.

McDonald, a native of Oakville, Ontario, is the only person in NCAA history to play at the Division I and III level, and coach at both divisions on both the men's and women's sides.
