STARTING 5

With 75 games in the Colgate-Penn State series, there are only five opponents the Nittany Lions have faced more often in program history.

Penn State ranks No. 1 in the Big Ten in steals per game overall (8.9). The Nittany Lions recorded back-to-back games with 12 steals in conference competition for a 12.0 average in league games, also good for No. 1.

Lamar Stevens needs 15 more rebounds to reach the 500-career rebound milestone. Only 26 other Nittany Lions have achieved that career mark.

Senior guard Josh Reaves leads the Nittany Lions in both assists (25) and steals (23) so far this season. He ranks in the Penn State career top five for steals with 193, seven shy of 200, and in the top 20 for assists (241).

Nittany Lion freshman guard Rasir Bolton, who made his first career start vs. Indiana, has scored in double digits in six games so far with a career best 25 points vs. Jacksonville State.

LAST TIME - COMEBACK FALLS SHORT VS. IU

Penn State held Indiana without a field goal for the final 3:58 of the game, but couldn't pull off the comeback in the Big Ten opener, falling 64-62. Freshman guard Rasir Bolton scored 17 points to lead Penn State while junior forward Lamar Stevens had his third double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

Down 11 points in the second half, Penn State battled back behind nine points from Bolton with 3:58 remaining in the game, but a missed layup and turnover secured the win for IU in the final sec-

Myles Dread also contributed 12 points while senior guard Josh Reaves had seven rebounds and a game-high five steals.

The two teams matched in total field goals and free throws, but Indiana had seven 3-pointers to five for the Penn State. The Nittany Lions struggled from the free throw line in the first half, going 4-14 from the line and finished the game 11-26.

The Nittany Lions recorded 12 steals for the second-straight game with nine in the second half as they clamped down defensively on the Hoosiers. Indiana had 16 total turnovers, 11 in the second half.

Indiana held the lead throughout the second half after taking a 34-30 score into the locker room. The lead was trimmed to four again with 1:23 left in the game as Bolton hit a triple, then added two free throws before getting a basket off a Jamari Wheeler steal. Bolton's final layup with 22 seconds left put the Nittany Lions down by only two. 64-62.

Penn State ran out to a 9-0 lead, holding the Hoosiers without any points for the first four minutes and a half of the contest. Indiana pulled out to a six-point lead as freshman Romeo Langford accounted for 10 of the Hoosier's 13 points over a four-minute stretch before halftime. He finished with a share of the scoring lead with 15 of his 17 points coming in the first half.

STEVENS NAMED TO ERVING WATCH LIST

Penn State junior Lamar Stevens was named to the watch list for the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award as announced in October by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Stevens, from North Wales, Pa., is one of the 20 student-athletes selected for the watch list for the 2019 award.

Named after Class of 1993 Hall of Famer and 16-year professional basketball player Julius Erving, the annual honor in its fifth year recognizes the top small forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

Stevens was voted the Most Outstanding Player of the 2018 National Invitation Tournament as he helped lead Penn State to its second NIT title this past March. He scored a game-high 28 points in the championship game and with that total, eclipsed the 1,000 career point mark, becoming only the second Penn State sophomore to achieve that milestone. An All-Big Ten Conference honorable mention, Stevens recorded double figures in 33 games in 2017-18 and with 10 games of 20 points or more, including two 30-point games.

Senior guard Josh Reaves has proved himself to be quite the passer -- recording a career-best eight assists at DePaul -- to move him into the leader spot for the Nittany Lions so far this season with 22 total (3.1 apg).

With 238 career assists, he moved into Penn State's top 20 in that category and now stands at 19th. Reaves had 107 assists in 2017-18, second to Tony Carr's 186.

POINTS RISING

Just one of the indicators of Penn State's increase in its offensive output was the setting of the program's record for points scored overall (2,833) and in the Big Ten (1,297) in 2017-18, with the Nittany Lions' breaking their own league scoring record from a year ago.

When Stevens and Tony Carr recorded their 20-plus points in the game against Duquesne (11/13/16), it marked the first time since March 15. 1989 that two Penn State freshmen posted 20 or more points in the same game (Freddie Barnes-24 & Monroe Brown-32 vs. Murray State in the opening round of the NIT).

FIRST 20-WIN SEASON SINCE 2008-09

Coach Chambers and the Nittany Lions posted the first 20-win season since 2008-09 and Penn State's 10th season with 20 or more wins, fifth in its Big Ten era. The 26-win total is the second-highest all-time.

NATIONAL NOTICE

Penn State earned 19 votes in the final USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll, fifth among the other teams receiving votes. It was the first time since the 2008-09 season the Nittany Lions had been recognized. In the February 19 Associated Press poll, Penn State received six votes, the first time the program had received votes since December 29, 2014, and the most votes received since a total of 14 on January 31, 2011.

POWER RANKINGS

At the end of the 2017-18 season, Penn State had climbed to its highest rankings of the season in kenpom.com (19), the ESPN Basketball Power Index (20) and Sagarin (27).

RECORDS BROKEN

More than 50 Penn State records fell during the 2017-18 season with 31 individual and 21 team records being replaced. One Big Ten record, the individual single-season mark for 3-point field goals, a 23-year-old record, was broken by senior guard Shep Garner (120).

AH-MAZING MARCH

March was amazing for the Nittany Lions as they won seven games during the month, tied for the most by a Penn State team. The 2017-18 squad also posted the highest-ever win percentage in conference and postseason games in March 2018, at 87.5 percent (7-1 record).

THE WINS

Penn State has achieved 15 or more wins in five straight years - a first for the Nittany Lion program. Prior to the 2013-17* seasons under Chambers, the Nittany Lions had not previously reached at least 15 wins in four consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten.

The Lions also have at least eight regular-season, nonconference wins in each of Chambers' seven seasons with 10 in 2017-18.

"DETERMINED."

The new sign in the reception area of the Penn State men's basketball office in the Bryce Jordan Center is impossible to overlook. The word defines both the Nittany Lion program and Patrick Chambers, the coach who is determined to lead the program to its next level of success.

Chambers is determined to establish the Penn State program with a culture of teamwork and excellence, built on pillars of accountability, faith, humility, gratitude and passion. He's determined to set and achieve high expectations for Nittany Lion basketball. He's determined to challenge his student-athletes to get better each and every day and develop young men into leaders with the goal of competing for championships.

In 2017-18, Chambers had the Penn State basketball program poised to take the next step in its pursuit of consistent. sustainable success.

By the end of December, the Nittany Lions reached double-digits in wins and in January, the Nittany Lions stepped into the spotlight, defeating No. 13 Ohio State at Value City Arena, one of only two teams in the nation to accomplish that feat in 2017-18.

By the end of February 2018, the Nittany Lions racked up nine Big Ten Conference wins, the most, to date, in the Chambers era. A week later, Penn State picked up its 20th and 21st wins, the latter coming at the earliest point ever for the Nittany Lions.

Plaving their best basketball in March. Chambers' squad registered seven wins against only one loss and won the National Invitation Tournament title. Penn State defeated teams from the Atlantic Coast, Atlantic 10, Big East, Pac-12 and Southeastern conferences with an average scoring margin of 10.4 points per game in NIT contests.

Dozens of records were broken and the increase in offensive production saw Penn State score 70 points or more in 29 games, while the stalwart defense, a Chambers' hallmark. frustrated opponents. Fourteen teams in 2017-18 failed to score more than 60 points against the Nittany Lions.

Individual records were rewritten as well, as Shep Garner broke the 23-year-old Big Ten single-season record for 3-pointers with 120 and etched his name in the Penn State yearbook for both the single-season and career mark. Tony Carr became the first Penn State men's sophomore to reach the 1.000-point career mark with Lamar Stevens becoming the second to achieve that milestone.

A Philly native, Chambers was introduced as the 12th head coach in program history June 6, 2011, and has poured his passion and energy into building the Nittany Lion program.

Signing the top two recruiting classes in program history in back-to-back years, the 2016 group was ranked in the top 25 and the 2015 class in the top 30. A trio of players with freshmen eligibility started the 2016-17 season opener and would combine for 90 starts, with 23 more from a sophomore, giving the young Nittany Lions a birth by fire, but positioning them for success.

The impressive performances of the rookies earned them several honors during the course of their initial campaigns with Carr selected to the Big Ten All-Freshman team. Carr would become the first Penn State basketball player to earn Big Ten All-Tournament honors as a sophomore in 2018.

With Carr selected as a first-team All-Big Ten Conference pick by both the coaches and media following the 2017-18 season, junior Josh Reaves and redshirt sophomore Mike Watkins produced another program first - two Nittany Lions on the All-Defensive Team.

Chambers has sent Carr, Garner, Frazier, Newbill and numerous other players into the professional ranks. Garner inked a deal with the Grand Rapids Drive in fall of

2018 while Carr is playing for Fiat Torino in Italy's premier league. Frazier (2009-14) recently joined the New Orleans Pelicans organization and Newbill (2013-15) signed a new contract to play for the National Basketball League's Cairns Taipans. Over the summer months, Donovon Jack (2012-16) signed with KD Hopsi Polzela in Slovenia

AT BOSTON UNIVERSITY

Chambers came to Penn State after two years at Boston University, where in 2010-11 he led the Terriers to the America East Conference Championship and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in more than a decade. He posted a 42-28 record, becoming the only coach in BU history to earn 20 wins in each of his first two seasons and the fastest in program history to win a conference championship.

AT VILLANOVA

A native of Newtown Square, Pa., Chambers previously played for and coached with two of the nation's most successful college coaches. From 2004-09, he was a member of Wright's staff at Villanova, serving as associate head coach in 2008-09. He helped the Wildcats earn four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances and advance to the 2009 NCAA Final Four. Chambers played for Magee at Philadelphia University (formerly Philadelphia Textile), helping Magee become college basketball's all-time victories leader (941) and a 2011 Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame inductee.

During Chambers' five seasons on Wright's Villanova staff, he was instrumental in helping lead the Wildcats to a 126-45 record (.737), including the then-single-season win record of 30-8 in 2008-09. In 2008, Chambers helped lead the Wildcats to the 2009 NCAA Final Four, a first in 24 years, and saw Villanova advance to the Sweet 16 for the fourth time in its five NCAA Tournament appearances.

AT PHILADELPHIA

Chambers joined the NCAA Division II Philadelphia University's basketball team as a walk-on in 1990 and went on to have an outstanding career under Magee. He became the team's starting point guard, earning first-team All-ECAC honors, and helped lead the Rams to four NCAA Division Il Sweet 16 appearances and two Elite Eight appearances. He still holds the school record for career assists with 709.

THE CHAMBERS FAMILY

The Chambers family is well represented at Penn State basketball games. Chambers and his wife, Courtney, have four children, Grace, Ryan, Caitlin and Patrick and three of Chambers' 11 siblings are Penn State graduates - brothers, Chris and Joe, and a sister, Megan, who resides in State College.

CHAMBERS' COACHING RECORD
