THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 3-ranked Purdue Boilermakers look for their first road win of the season at a place that has been difficult to play, facing Penn State on Saturday at noon. The Boilermakers head to the Bryce Jordan Center where three of Purdue's last four wins have come in overtime. With four of its next five games on the road, Purdue is looking to build some momentum for its most-difficult stretch of the season.
- The Boilermakers enter with a 12-2 overall record, while Penn State is 7-5 overall, having won consecutive games against Indiana and Northwestern.
- The contest will be televised on the Big Ten Network with **Cory Provus** and **Stephen Bardo** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue is 1-2 in Big Ten play for the second straight year. The Boilermakers actually started 1-3 a year ago, but won 12 of their last 15 games to finish in the top four of the conference.
- 2) Purdue recorded just its fourth season of being unbeaten in non-conference play since the 1939-40 campaign with a 104-90 win over Nicholls. Purdue went unbeaten in non-conference play in 2021-22 (11-0), 2009-10 (12-0), 1993-94 (12-0) and 1992-93 (9-0).
- 3) Purdue's three quad-1 wins are tied for the fifth most in the country. The 3-1 record is also the fifth-best record.
- 4) Purdue has scored at least 40 points in 17 of the 28 halves played this year. It has also shot at least 50.0 percent from the field in 17 halves.
- 5) **Matt Painter** has an extensive coaching tree, but this will be the first game he will coach with one of his former assistants on the other sideline (**Micah Shrewsberry**). **Grady Eifert**, who started on Purdue's Elite Eight team in 2019, is also Penn State's video coordinator.
- 6) **Zach Edey**, **Jaden Ivey** and **Trevion Williams** were named to the Wooden Award midseason watch list on Wednesday. Purdue was the only school with three players named (Gonzaga, UCLA had two).
- 7) Purdue leads the Big Ten in field goal percentage, 3-point percentage and assists. It is second in scoring offense and scoring margin.
- 8) In the three years that Purdue won the league title under Painter, Purdue started league play 3-2 (2018-19), 3-2 (2016-17) and 2-3 (2009-10).
- 9) **Matt Painter** needs four wins to tie **Ward "Piggy" Lambert** (371) for second place on the Purdue career victories list. Painter also needs one Big Ten win to tie Michigan State's **Jud Heathcote** for seventh (182) on the all-time Big Ten wins list.

THE SERIES WITH THE NITTANY LIONS

- Saturday's contest with Penn State marks the beginning of an extremely-busy stretch for the Boilermakers. Combined with games and practices, Purdue will either play or practice for 18 straight days. Purdue will have two days of practice between six straight games ending with Northwestern on Jan. 23. Four of the six games will come on the road, making this the most-daunting stretch on Purdue's Big Ten schedule.
- The Boilermakers own a 41-13 series lead against Penn State, having won 11 of the last 12 meetings and 25 of the last 29 games during the **Matt Painter** era. The Boilermakers have won four straight games at the Bryce Jordan Center. However, the three previous wins before last year's 73-52 decision, came in overtime (2015, 2017, 2019).
- Purdue has scored at least 70 points in 10 straight games against Penn State.

- Purdue is one of three teams (Purdue, Kansas, Houston) to average at least 1.00 points / possession in every game played this season.
- Purdue has scored at least 80 points in 9-of-14 games this season. Last year, it scored 80 points in just 6-of-28 games.

- Over its last 104 games at Mackey Arena, Purdue is 93-11.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 19-7 at Mackey Arena against nationally-ranked opponents.
- Purdue will enter next season, having won 14 straight games at Mackey Arena against non-conference opposition.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue is 78-8 at Mackey Arena since the 2014-15 season.

- Purdue recorded 30 assists on 35 made field goals in last Wednesday's win over Nicholls, a total that ranked as the ninth-most assists in school history.
- The 30 assists are the fourth most nationally in a game this year.

PURDUE'S BIG THREE MAKING BIG IMPACT

- Purdue's big three of **Jaden Ivey**, **Trevion Williams** and **Zach Edey** are making a huge impact this season.
- The group is averaging 45.1 points, 21.2 rebounds, 7.5 assists, 2.6 blocks and 2.6 steals per game, shooting 238-of-397 (.599). The trio accounts for 52.5 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- Over the last four games, the duo is shooting 66-of-106 (.623) from the field.

• Through Wednesday's games, Purdue (Edey and Williams) and Richmond are the only schools in America to have two players with at least 180 points and 100 rebounds this season.

BEST SHOOTING PROGRAM IN THE COUNTRY?

- Purdue can lay claim to perhaps being the best 3-point shooting program in the country over the last few years.
- Since the 2016-17 season, Purdue is one of seven teams in America to have made 1,500 trifectas and shoot at least 37.5 percent from long range.

- During the same time frame, Purdue has had 23 games of 14 or more 3-pointers. Among Big Ten teams, Michigan and Iowa are next with 11.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES 3

- In the win over Wright State, Purdue had three players (**Zach Edey**, **Caleb Furst**, **Trevion Williams**) record double-doubles. It marked the first time since Nov. 21, 1977, that three players recorded double-doubles in the same game (**Walter Jordan**, **Wayne Walls**, **Joe Barry Carroll**). It has now happened 19 times in school history.

► **Record at Purdue:** 367-186 (.664) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 392-191 (.672) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
