THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- . This weekend marks just the fourth and fifth games alltime between Penn State and Canisius with the Nittany Lions holding the 3-0-0 edge.
- The two programs met in back-to-back years during 2015-16 for a single game in buffalo before playing a two-game series at Pegula Ice Arena early in the 2016-
- Penn State is outscoring Canisius 14-4 all-time in the series which was last contested on October 28-29, 2016.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD

- Penn State scored the opening goal in both games last week against LIU and went on to win each contest after going 7-4-0 when scoring first last season. Over the past five seasons, the Nittany Lions are 69-17-9 when scoring
- Penn State also held the lead entering the third period in each game against LIU moving to 129-12-10 all-time when carrying a lead into the final period. On the flip side, the Nittany Lions are just 13-96-7 all-time when trailing entering the third period with just one win in each of the past six seasons when in that situation.

HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-0

- Penn State hit its magic number of five goals during the series finale against LIU on Monday improving to 83-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals. Penn State was 4-0-0 in such games during 2020-21 after going 11-0-0 when scoring five or more goals in 2019-20.
- The Nittany Lions have won 25-straight games when scoring five or more goals with the last and only loss coming at Wisconsin on December 1, 2018, an 8-5 defeat.

UNDERCLASSMEN PACING PLAY

- Last week against LIU. Penn State scored eight goals and had 20 points led primarily by the sophomores and freshmen with six goals and 14 points combined.
- The sophomore class was paced by Christian Sarlo, Chase McLane and Xander Lamppa who each tallied one goal and one assist in the two games while the freshmen were paced by Danny Dzhaniyev who led all Nittany Lions with one goal and two assists for three points in the series sweep.

STRONG START FOR SPECIAL TEAMS

- Penn State was inconsistent on special teams in 2020-21, but started the 2021-22 season strong with a powerplay goal just six seconds into its first man-advantage of the season on Sunday. The Nittany Lions added another powerplay tally on Monday and went 2-for-7 (28.6 percent) overall.
- On the kill, Penn State was near perfect killing 6-of-7 (85.7 percent) powerplay chances for LIU including over 30 seconds of 5-on-3 time. The Nittany Lions ranked 41st out of the 51 teams who participated in the 2020-21 season on the penalty kill stopping just 76.2 percent (48for-63) of opponent powerplays last season.

IT STARTS WITH POSSESSION

• Penn State was strong up the middle last week winning 71-of-119 draws (59.6 percent) led by three players over 60 percent in Chase McLane (66.7 percent), Ben Schoen (65 percent) and MacEachern (61.1 percent).

AUTIO ON THE OFFENSIVE

- Senior goaltender Oskar Autio was solid in net each game against LIU stopping 40-of-43 shots over the two games registering a .930 save percentage and a 1.50 goals-against average.
- · Autio also turned to offense as he collected the lone assist on Connor McMenamin's late third period goal on Sunday afternoon.
- Autio is now the fifth different Nittany Lion net-minder to register a point. Peyton Jones '20 holds the career

XANDER 'LIGHT THE' LAMPPA

- Sophomore Xander Lamppa double his career point total on Monday night as he registered one goal and one assist in the 5-2 victory.
- In 13 games last season, Lamppa tallied just one goal and one assist for two points.

• Following a bye week, the Nittany Lions remain home to cap off their six-game homestand with a weekend series against Niagara on October 21-22.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

- Head Coach Guy Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State. Gadowsky is now 155-132-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.
- The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks 74th all-time throughout all divisions with 328 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 42nd with his 328 wins and is currently 14th among active NCAA Division Logaches.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Paul DeNaples was selected by his peers as the ninth captain in program history for the 2021-22 season. Senior classmates Adam Pilewicz and Clayton Phillips along with junior Connor McMenamin will serve as alternates.

NHL HOPEFULS

- The tenth-year program boasts three NHL draft picks on the 2021-22 roster.
- Clayton Phillips (2017, Pittsburgh)
- Kevin Wall (2019, Carolina)
- Chase McLane (2020, Nashville)

SCOUTING CANISIUS

- The Griffs open their 2021-22 campaign after finishing 11-6-0 in 2020-21 advancing to the Atlantic Hockey Championship game before bowing out to AIC, 5-2.
- Canisius returns 20 letterwinners from its 2020-21 roster including seven of its top-10 scorers from a season ago including leading scorer Keaton Mastrodonato who paced the team in each offensive category with nine goals and nine assists for 18 points in 17 games played. Second leading scorer Mitchell Martan is also back after a six goal and nine assist 2020-21 season.
- The Griffs also return both goal-tenders who played a significant role between the pipes last season including junior Jacob Barczewski who paced the team with a 7-3-0 record in 10 starts with a .926 save percentage and a 2.30 goalsagainst average as a sophomore.
- Canisius' 2021-22 roster features seven transfers including 2020-21 Atlantic Hockey Western Pod Rookie of the Year, Randy Hernandez, who transferred in from Rob-ert Morris. Hernandez ranked third nationally in freshman scoring a season ago with 11 goals and 14 as-sists for 25 points in 24 games.
- The Griffs were tabbed second in the Atlantic Hockey preseason coaches poll behind only defend-ing champion AIC.
- Canisius ranked third in Atlantic Hockey last season and 11th in the nation in scoring, averaging 3.47 goals per game last season.
- The Griffs struggled on special teams in 2020-21 ranking in the bottom third specially on both the powerplay converting just 18.6 percent (11-for-59) of their chanc-es and the PK at 78.6 percent (44for-56)
- Canisius did tally four shorthanded goals last season to tie for fifth in the nation, Penn State failed to record a shorthanded goal during the 2020-21 season.

- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds during the 2019-20 season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.
- In 2019-20, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).
- Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season an continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 22nd collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 10th at Penn State in 2021-22.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.



Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual

national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 cam-

paign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.


