EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS PENN STATE/BIG 10

- This is the first ever meeting between Winthrop and Penn State
- Hold an all-time record of 1-5 against opponents from the Big 10
- In the last meeting with a Big 10 opponent, the Eagles earned an 84-80 overtime win at Illinois behind 38 points off the bench from Keon Johnson

ON THIS DATE

- In the only game the Eagles have ever played on Nov. 7, the team opened the 2019-20 season at Hartford with a 67-57 victory
- Hunter Hale led three Eagles in double-figures with 15 points as the Eagles outrebounded Hartford 50-37 and had 15 second chance points

SEASON OPENERS

- This ties the second earliest start date in the history of the program (Nov. 6, 2018 at Vanderbilt is the earliest)
- Winthrop has won three straight season openers, 8-of-10 and 14 of the last 17
- All-time the Eagles are 29-16 in season openers
- This marks the 9th time the Eagles have face a Power 5 conference opponent in a season opener and the Eagles are 0-8 in those contests

LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3) and all four teams have completed their conference slate for '21-22
- Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season
- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

TEAM NEWS

- Coming off a 23 win season in Mark Prosser's first year at the helm
- It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Winthrop returns five players that saw action in 2021-22, two players returning that sat out last season and welcome eight newcomers
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote)
- Eagles received five votes in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll
- Three of Winthrop's opponents (or potential) are currently ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 (Furman 6th, IPFW 17th, Longwood 25th) and two received votes (Mercer/Campbell)
- This is just the second NCAA Div. I opponent from the state of Pennsylvania the Eagles have ever faced and the first of two this season (at Duquesne on Dec. 21)
- The only other matchup came in the 2021 NCAA Tournament (First Round) against 5th-seeded Villanova (lost 73-63)
- Hold an all-time mark of 115-85 all-time in the month of November (at least a .500 record or better in nine straight seasons in November)
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 267-255
- Averaged 28.6 points per game from its bench in 2021-22 as Winthrop finished ranked 14th nationally (Cornell led at 36.1 ppg)
- For the past three seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 52-4 when leading at the half (110-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/124-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 154-22 when leading at the half, 42-78 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- In the last 166 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 104 of them (63%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 135-41 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 35-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-63 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 60-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- Had a streak of 12 straight road wins (school record) come to an end (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won eight straigt regular season contests
- Have won 16 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 317 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Three straight year swith 20-plus victories

MARK PROSSER

- In his second season as head coach of the Eagles and 6th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 65-85 (57-60 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his second season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2,, 2021

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament. "My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country.'

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year. In the summer of 2008. Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg. the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage. Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.
