# 2013 PENN STATE WOMEN'S LACROSSE

## TODAY'S GAME

- Penn State returns home for the first time since its season-opening game when it hosts James Madison at Holuba Hall.
- The Nittany Lions and Dukes will be meeting for the first time since 2004.

## LAST TIME VS. JAMES MADISON

- Penn State fell to James Madison, 16-8, in the teams' last meeting back in 2004.
- Nittany Lion assistant coach **Amy Altig** was the junior goalkeeper for the Dukes.

## ALL-TIME VS. THE DUKES

- Penn State is 17-9 all-time against the Dukes. The teams last played in 2004 and the Nittany Lions last defeated the Dukes in 2002.

## PENN STATE IN THE NCAA

- Senior **Katie Guy** is tied for 17th in the NCAA in ground balls (14) and 20th in caused turnovers (9).
- Sophomore **Maggie McCormick** is tied for ninth in assists (12).
- Penn State ranks 14th in the country in scoring offense with 15.00 goals per game.

## JAMES MADISON IN THE NCAA

- Senior Casey Ancarrow ranks sixth in goals per game (4.00), while sophomore Schylar Healy ranks third in save percentage (.563) and ninth in GAA (7.00).
- The Dukes are 10th in scoring defense.

## ALTIG FACES ALMA MATER

- Nittany Lion assistant coach **Amy Altig** ('05) was a two-time All-CAA goalkeeper for the Dukes. During her senior season, she ranked among the NCAAs top-20 goalkeepers in GAA and save percentage.

## LECHNER EARNS PAIR OF HONORS

- After an eight-point weekend (5g, 3a) against Duquesne and then-No. 6/8 Virginia, sophomore midfielder **Kelly Lechner** was named the WomensLax.com Player of the Week and ALC Offensive Player of the Week.
- Lechner matched her career high with four points in both games. She also tied a personal best with three goals against Duquesne.

## HIGHEST RANKING SINCE 2007

- The Nittany Lions improved to No. 7 in the March 5 IWLCAs poll as they earned their

highest ranking since being tabbed sixth during the 2007 season.

## LIONS KNOCK OUTLAST VIRGINIA

- After trailing by an 8-5 halftime margin, the Nittany Lions netted 10 second-half markers as it edged No. 6/8 Virginia, 15-14, at Klöckner Stadium March 3
- Sophomore midfielder **Kelly Lechner** recorded a career-high four points (2g, 2a) for the second straight game, while junior **Mackenzie Cyr**, who added an assist, notched her third three-goal game of the season.

## STEADY CYR

- Junior attack **Mackenzie Cyr** extended her point-scoring streak to 11 games with four points (3g, 1a) against Virginia.

## PENN STATE VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

### COFFEY NAMED TO WATCH LIST

- Sophomore midfielder **Tatum Coffey** was named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List Feb. 22.
- The Tewaaraton Award annually honors the top men's and women's U.S. college lacrosse player.

### LIONS OPEN 2013 WITH WIN

- The Nittany Lions defeated Bucknell by a 16-goal margin for the second straight season with an 18-2 victory Feb. 20.
- Ten different Nittany Lions recorded at least one point, while goalkeeper **Emi Smith** garnered the victory in her collegiate debut.

### STELLAR DEBUTS

- Several Nittany Lions starred in their col-

legiate debuts. Midfielder **Jenna Mosketti** tallied three goals, attack **Madison Cyr** recorded two points (1g, 1a) and midfielder **Ally Heavens** added a free-position goal.

### DUO TABBED ALL-AMERICANS

- Sophomore midfielder **Tatum Coffey** and junior midfielder **Lizzy Carney** were tabbed *Inside Lacrosse* Preseason All-Americans.
- Last season, Coffey was the nation's only freshman to be named to an All-America team (third).

### OFFENSIVE PUNCH

- With the graduation of only three starting seniors, the Nittany Lions returned 79.9% of their scoring from a season ago.
- Sophomore **Maggie McCormick** led the Nittany Lions with 59 points and 30 assists, while senior **Molly Fernandez** paced the squad with 35 goals.

### BACK FOR MORE

- Although still a young team, Penn State returns its category leaders in each major category with the exception of ground balls.

### EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

- Senior midfielder **Katie Guy** and sophomore midfielder **Tatum Coffey** are the only two returning Nittany Lions to record double-digit ground balls, draw controls and caused turnovers in 2012.

### FAMILIAR FACES
