Nittany Lions Close Out Spring Break Trip at UAB: Penn State baseball closes out its 2012 spring break trip with a three-game series with the University of Alabama-Birmingham Blazers. The Nittany Lions (2-9) will be looking to snap a four-game losing streak. Penn State has lost its last four games to Samford (2) and Mississippi State (2).

Most Recently: Penn State is coming off a tough two-game series with the Mississippi State Bulldogs, in which the Nittany Lions lost both games. Despite having a 6-3 lead heading into the seventh inning, Penn State baseball (2-9) gave up four runs in the seventh and three runs in the eighth to lose by a score of 10-6. Sophomore Greg Welsh (Holland, Pa.) tossed a very solid game against a strong Mississippi State lineup. The lefty pitched a career-high 5.1 innings, giving up just two runs and four hits. He also fanned four batters. Freshmen JJ White and JC Coban each recorded their first RBI in the loss.

What's Next: Following the three-game set with UAB, Penn State will head to East Carolina next weekend for a three-game set with the Pirates. The Nittany Lions open the 2012 home season at Medlar Field on March 21 against Pittsburgh at 3:35. Big Ten play opens at home on March 23 against Indiana.

Scouting UAB: Alabama-Birmingham comes into this weekend's contest with a 10-3 overall record and a 7-1 mark at home. The Blazers are hitting .251 as a team in 13 contests. Jeff Schalk leads the way for UAB, as he's tallied 14 hits on the year and carries a batting average of .318. The Blazers have just two homeruns on the year, coming from Michael Busby and Patrick Palmeiro, the son of former MLB standout Rafael Palmeiro. The Blazers are strong in pitching, as they carry a team ERA of 3.00. Ryan Nance, the Blazers' closer, has been stellar this season as he has four saves and 14 strikeouts in 14 innings pitched.

100 in 100 for Searer: Penn State junior shortstop Elliot Searer recorded his 100th career hit in his 100th career game on March 3 against Samford. Searer currently has 102 hits in 102 career games as a Nittany Lion.

Lewis Earns First Win as a Nittany Lion: Penn State RHP CodyLewis hurled a nice quality start against Samford to earn his first ever win in a Penn State uniform on March 3. Lewis went six innings, giving up seven hits and just one earned run. Notably, Lewis shut down 11 of the last 13 Bulldog hitters he faced to hold Penn State's lead in check. Lewis previously played his ball at Arizona (2009) and Saddleback JC (2010). The Laguna Niguel, Calif. native was required to sit out last year due to transfer rules.

Penn State's regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the week of May 23-27.

Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness: Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. During 2011, Hill fired four complete games, which equals the total posted by every other Penn State pitcher since the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the

15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.
