Visit to Streaking Penn State

- Winners of four of its last five contests, Dartmouth travels to University Park, Pa., to take on an even hotter team in Penn State, which has run off nine straight victories.
- Last time on the court, the Big Green were able to defeat Northern Illinois in overtime, 58-55, avenging a 64-57 loss in DeKalb, Illinois, last year.
- Dartmouth's leading scorer, point guard **Alex Mitola**, was also its savior in the extra period, providing all 12 points with four three-pointers, including the game-winner as time expired.
- Mitola's final shot was the second successful buzzer-beater for the Big Green this year. Forward **Connor Boehm** drained a triple at the end of regulation to defeat IPFW on Nov. 28, 68-67.
- Along with Mitola's 15.2 points per game, two other Big Green players average in double figures — center **Gabas Maldunas** (11.4) and Boehm (10.3). They are the team's leading rebounders as well with at 7.3 and 7.0 a night, respectively.
- With Mitola ranking fifth in three-point percentage (.461), Dartmouth tops the circuit in that statistical category (.392). Guard **Kevin Crescenzi** is another long-ball threat at 43.3 pct. (13-of-30).
- One area in which the Green need to improve is at the foul line where they have converted just 64.2 percent, last among Ancient Eight schools.
- Dartmouth has been quite active on the defensive end of late, collecting at least 10 steals in three of the last five games, including a dozen twice.

Series vs. Penn State

- These two teams have met four times previously with each side winning twice. The last encounter came 31 years ago, a 72-67 overtime victory for the Nittany Lions on their home court.
- Thirty-one years before that, Dartmouth defeated Penn State in the 1942 NCAA Eastern Region Semifinals in New Orleans, 44-39. The Big Green advanced to the championship game, but fell victim to Stanford, 53-38.

- The Big Green are 7-25 all-time against current Big 10 schools with other wins over Minnesota, Northwestern, Ohio State, Rutgers and Wisconsin.
- The most recent showdown with a Big 10 school came last year at Illinois, a 72-65 defeat.
- Head coach **Paul Cormier** is 0-6 against current Big 10 teams, including two losses to Wisconsin.

Scouting the Nittany Lions

- Penn State has proven it knows how to finish close games with a 6-0 record in games decided by five points or less, including a 72-71 win over Ivy League member Cornell on Nov. 21.
- This is the final non-conference game for the Nittany Lions, who open Big Ten play at Wisconsin on New Year's Eve.
- Look no further than D.J. Newbill for a star on this roster. The 6-4 senior guard has led the team in scoring in all but one game and averages 21.8 points a night. He also tops the squad with 37 assists and 17 steals.
- Newbill, along with Brandon Taylor and Shep Garner — the other two Nittany Lions averaging in double figures — are all three-point threats with 20 or more apiece.
- On the boards, Ross Travis leads a solid Penn State rebounding effort with 7.6 rpg, while Taylor and Newbill add 6.5 and 5.0, respectively.
- The defense has held opponents to just 38.0 percent shooting and 31.9 percent behind the arc, but PSU has turned the ball over more often.
- Patrick Chambers is in his fourth season guiding the Nittany Lions and has posted a 49-60 record there to date. He previously was the head coach at Boston University, going 21-14 in each of his two seasons, including a trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2010-11.

HEAD COACH PAUL CORMIER



Paul Cormier rejoined the Dartmouth men's basketball team as head coach in April 2010. After spending most of the previous 12 years working with NBA organizations, Cormier is now in the fifth season of his second stint with the Big Green having served as the

head coach for seven seasons previously (1984-91).

Cormier, 62, has spent 18 years as a Division I head coach, splitting his time between Dartmouth and Fairfield while earning a combined 204 wins. Two of Cormier's Big Green squads posted two of the three winningest seasons at Dartmouth of the past 50 years — the 1987-88 team went 18-8 overall and 10-4 in the Ivy League (missing a share of the Ivy title after a one-point loss in the final game of the season), while the 1988-89 team went 17-9 overall with an identical 10-4 mark in conference play, just one game back in the Ivy standings.

After his initial campaign, Cormier's Big Green teams went 73-57 over the next five years, including 40-30 in the Ivy League. He is the only coach since 1960 to lead the Big Green to consecutive second-place finishes in the conference. One of his first recruits for Dartmouth was Jim Barton '89, the Green's all-time leading scorer (2,158 points) and three-point shooter (242 total, 45.4 percent).

The process of building a winner is an arduous one, and Cormier has shown signs of turning the program around after four seasons in his return to Hanover. The 2013-14 squad won its final three games to tie for sixth place with a 5-9 mark in the Ivy League standings, despite playing the conference slate without star center Gabas Maldunas. The previous season, Maldunas was selected to the All-Ivy League Second Team in leading the Big Green to victories in three of their last four contests to pull into a tie for sixth.

The 2011-12 iteration of the Big Green may have only won five games, but three players in the freshman class — Jvonte Brooks, John Golden and Maldunas — won a total of 10 Rookie of the Week awards from the league during the season. Even though Dartmouth has just two seniors entering the 2014-15 campaign, Cormier has plenty of experience returning with seven juniors and four sophomores to help break in five newcomers.

At Fairfield, Cormier built upon his successes at Dartmouth, building the Stags up to a 20-win team

by his fifth year in 1995-96 as they won a share of the MAAC regular-season crown. After losing a tough-fought MAAC Tournament championship game, Fairfield was awarded an NIT bid and hosted Providence in the opening round. Injuries plagued the favored Stags the following year, but they got healthy in time for the conference tournament, sweeping the three games to earn the school's third trip to the NCAA Tournament. Paired up against North Carolina as a 16-seed, Fairfield gave the Tar Heels (who eventually advanced to the Final Four) all they could handle before falling, 82-74.

Cormier made his foray into the NBA in 1998, serving as a scout and assistant video coordinator for the Eastern Conference Champion New York Knicks for one year. Two years later, he joined the Boston Celtics as an assistant coach and head advance scout. After five years with the Celtics, he joined the coaching staff of the Memphis Grizzlies for one year, then was hired by the New Jersey Nets as an advance scout and summer league assistant coach for two years. For the past year, Cormier has been the Eastern advance and collegiate scout for the Golden State Warriors.

The Massachusetts native has never strayed far from his coaching roots. Cormier has served as a skills instructor and lecturer at various basketball camps recently, including Five Star, Nike National Elite and the Orlando NBA pre-draft camp in 2007. And for the past 20 years, he has been the director of the Mid-Cape Hoop School in Cape Cod, Mass.

"Paul Cormier's hiring is an absolute home run for Dartmouth," said former University of Connecticut head coach Jim Calhoun. "He has an incredible basketball IQ and there is no person that would fit better for Dartmouth. The game of college basketball is better today because of this hiring, not only for Paul's coaching ability, but because he is a great person as well."

Prior to his first head-coaching job at Dartmouth, Cormier was an assistant coach at Villanova under Rollie Massimino — his high school coach at Lexington (Mass.) — for four years (1980-84). He was on the bench for the Wildcats' runs to the Elite Eight in 1981 and '83 as well as the Sweet Sixteen in 1982. But his lasting legacy at the school comes with his involvement in recruiting the entire squad that went on to win the 1985 NCAA Championship.

Cormier got his start in collegiate coaching as an assistant at Bentley College for two years (1978-80), helping the Falcons attain a national number-one ranking for Division II along the way.

A 1974 graduate of the University of New Hampshire with a degree in health studies, Cormier went on to work as a junior varsity coach at Newmarket (N.H.) High School before taking the head coaching job at Concord (N.H.) High School for three years (1975-78). A standout athlete, Cormier was a four-year letterwinner on both the basketball and baseball teams and was drafted by three different Major League Baseball organizations. He pitched for two years in the Cleveland Indians organization, earning a 5-5 record with a 4.09 ERA in the minors in 22 relief appearances. Cormier returned to UNH to earn his master's in educational administration and supervision in 1980.

The search committee for Dartmouth's men's basketball coach worked closely with an Alumni Advisory Committee chaired by the late Dave Gavitt '59, the founder of the Big East Conference. Previously the head coach at both Dartmouth and Providence, Gavitt also coached the U.S. Olympic team, served as President of USA Basketball and CEO of the Boston Celtics, and is a member of the Basketball Hall of Fame.

Cormier and his wife, Susan, currently reside in Grantham, N.H., and have four sons — Matthew, Jonathan, Chris and James, an assistant coach for the Big Green.

Looking for Another Win

Dartmouth has won four of its last five games, and a win over Penn State would give the Big Green their first 5-1 stretch since the 2006-07 squad won six of seven.

Overtime a Good Time

In each of the past four seasons, Dartmouth played exactly one overtime game. After losing the first three of those contests, the Big Green defeated Princeton after regulation last year, 78-69. Now with the 58-55 OT win over Northern Illinois, Dartmouth has won back-to-back overtime duels for the first time since the 2008-09 team topped Harvard and Brown.

40 Percent Threshold

Despite shooting just 33.9 percent from the floor against Northern Illinois, Dartmouth managed to beat the Huskies in overtime, 58-55. That win ended a streak of 67 consecutive losses when shooting less than 40 percent, dating back to the 2008-09 campaign. And the last time the Big Green shot worse than they did against NIU and still won came on Dec. 18, 2006, in a 56-53 win over Quinnipiac when they hit 19-of-56 field goals (.322).

Mitola Doubling Up on Digits ...

Alex Mitola has scored in double figures in each of the first 10 contests this season and ranks fourth in the league at 15.2 ppg. He is the first Big Green player with more than five in a row in one season since Alex Barnett '09 had at least 10 points in the last 15 games in 2008-09. Going back to last season, Mitola's streak stands at 14 games.

... While Boehm's Streak Ends

Connor Boehm had matched Mitola by scoring in double figures for seven straight contests. But his offensive success came to an end when he posted just seven points against Northern Illinois on Dec. 19. The junior is still averaging 10.3 points a game while shooting 51.3 percent from the floor.

Another Buzzer-Beater

For the fourth time already this season, Dartmouth took a shot at the buzzer with a chance to win the game when **Alex Mitola** launched a three-pointer in overtime against Northern Illinois on Dec. 19. He did not disappoint the home crowd, swishing the shot for a 58-55 victory.

The first three potential game-winning shots came in three consecutive games, starting with IPFW on Nov. 28. **Connor Boehm** began the stretch well by draining a three-pointer against the Mastodons to lift Dartmouth to a 68-67 triumph. Two days later, **Malik Gill** put up a frantic three-point try from 25 feet, but only drew iron in a 65-63 loss to New Hampshire. Then on Dec. 3, Mitola gave it a go with a 12-footer in the lane at Longwood, only to have it bounce off the back of the rim and leave the Green on the wrong end of a 74-73 score.

Three-Pointers Galore

Dartmouth is the most accurate team in the Ivy League from behind the arc, and knocked down a season-high 10 in just 19 attempts (.526) — its most since canning 12 against Cornell on March 1 — in the 67-51 win at Mercer. As a team, the Big Green are shooting 39.2 percent (73-of-186) to rank 39th among Division I schools. Junior **Alex Mitola** leads the charge with 3.5 treys per game (11th in the nation) at 46.1 percent (30th) and is a career 41.5 percent shooter from deep.

Georgia on Their Minds

Prior to the game at Mercer on Dec. 16, Dartmouth had never played against any school from the state of Georgia spanning 2,669 games dating back to the start of the varsity program in 1900, nor had it played within the state of Georgia. To commemorate the special occasion, the Big Green dominated the Bears in a 67-51 win, holding the lead for the final 33:29 and maintaining at least an eight-point advantage for the final 23:33.

Tale of Two Halves

Freshman **Miles Wright** and junior **Kevin Crescenzi** made for a perfect 1-2 punch off the bench at Mercer as each scored in double figures, all coming in one of the two halves. Wright provided a spark in the opening stanza, exploding for 14 points and four rebounds in just nine minutes as Dartmouth took a 33-22 lead at the break. After

the intermission, Crescenzi ripped off a career-high four three-pointers in as many attempts for a crucial 12 points in 15 minutes on the floor.

Beating a Tournament Team

With the 67-51 triumph over Mercer, the Big Green had their first victory over a team that had won at least one game in the NCAA Tournament since a 64-57 win over Cornell on Jan. 28, 2011. Mercer beat Duke in the tourney last year, while the Big Red advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2010.

600 Rebounds

With eight rebounds at Mercer on Dec. 16, **Gabas Maldunas** became the seventh Big Green player ever to accumulate 600 boards in a career. Should he continue at his current pace of 7.3 per game (which is both his season and career average), he will finish his stay in Hanover fourth all-time with over 700 rebounds.

Golden Return

Dartmouth may have lost at Jacksonville State, but it gained a player with the return of **John Golden** to the floor. The senior wing missed the first seven games with a knee injury, but he showed no ill effects from that by playing 26 minutes off the bench while hitting 4-of-5 field goals for eight points while hauling in six rebounds and dishing out two assists with nary a turnover.

Maldunas No Mal

That's a little Spanish mashed up with the Lithuanian **Gabas Maldunas**. The 6-9 center was not bad, but quite good at Jacksonville State as he scored 27 points and snared 10 rebounds for his second straight double-double. He knocked down a career-high 11 field goals in 15 attempts to come up one point shy of his career best of 28.

His previous double-double was also his first of the season — 13 points and 10 rebounds at UMass Lowell on Dec. 10. It was his first in almost a full calendar year (Dec. 18, 2013 at UNH — about a month before a season-ending knee injury), and he now has 12 in his career. Only Yale's Justin Sears has more (13) among current Ivy Leaguers.

Back-to-Back 20-Point Wins

Dartmouth had its first winning streak of the season by beating both Maine (23) and UMass Lowell (21) by at least 20 points. It had been more

than 15 years since the Big Green had 20-point wins in consecutive games, having last accomplished the feat Jan. 23 and 30 in 1999 against Denver (75-50) and Brown (70-46).

500 and 300

Dartmouth head coach **Paul Cormier** reached two milestones less than two weeks apart when the Big Green beat UMass Lowell on Dec. 10 — his 500th as a collegiate head coach between Dartmouth and Fairfield. He also coached his 300th game as Dartmouth's head coach on Nov. 30 against his alma mater, New Hampshire. Only two other coaches in program history have guided the squad for more games — Alvin "Doggie" Julian oversaw 419 games from 1950-66, and Cormier's former assistant Dave Faucher coached 344 contests from 1992-2004.

50 Percent Threshold

Connor Boehm and **Gabas Maldunas** are two of just seven players in the Ivy League hitting at least half of their shots. Boehm is fifth in the conference at .513 while Maldunas is sixth at .511. Even more impressive is that Boehm is shooting exactly 50 percent for his career, a mark only seven other Dartmouth players with at least 200 field goals have achieved, led by Brian Burke '84 (.572, 406-of-710).

Among the League Leaders

Entering this game, junior **Alex Mitola** is leading the Ivy League in two statistical categories — three-pointers per game (3.5) as well as assist-to-turnover ratio (2.9). He and **Malik Gill** make for a good combination in that latter category as Gill is second with a 2.5 ratio. Gill is also third in steals (1.7), while **Gabas Maldunas** is fifth in blocked shots per game (1.9) and seventh in rebounding at 7.3 boards a night.

Swipe Right and Left

Stealing isn't normally a character trait that one would find appealing, yet the Dartmouth Big Green went ahead and stole away, then stole some more. Against Maine on Dec. 6, Dartmouth swiped the ball 10 times in a 23-point win. The success made the Big Green bolder, so they went and took the ball a dozen times at UMass Lowell with **Kevin Crescenzi** leading the crime spree with a career-high five steals. **Malik Gill** matched those five steals when Dartmouth came away with 12 more pilfers against Northern Illinois.

First Action of 2014-15

Two players got their first taste of game action in the 74-51 win over Maine on Dec. 6. First came sophomore **Ike Ngwudo**, who played the final four minutes and grabbed two rebounds. For freshman **Alex Wolf**, his two minutes on the court were his first as a collegiate player. He was rewarded with a trip to the foul line where he scored his first point, and he also hauled in a carom off the glass.

Defense Shines vs. Maine

It wasn't just the offense that played well in the 74-51 win over Maine as the defense put the clamps down as well. The Black Bears could only muster 16 field goals in 50 attempts for a meager 32 percent, the lowest for a Dartmouth opponent this season. The last time a team shot that poorly against the Big Green was Dec. 14, 2013 when Jacksonville State went 17-of-56 (.304) in a 30-point Dartmouth win.

Johnson Gets It Done at the Line

Free throws have been troublesome for the Big Green this season with the team shooting just 64.2 percent, which would be Dartmouth's lowest since the 1997-98 season. With the veterans struggling, leave it to a freshman to show how it's done. **Taylor Johnson** converted 7-of-8 foul shots against Maine and is hitting 81.8 percent at the line on the season.

Gill in the Christmas Spirit

Malik Gill did something at Longwood that no Dartmouth player had done in over a dozen years — hand out 10 assists. The junior came off the bench early in the first half with the Big Green trailing 10-1 and provided a huge lift by immediately directing a 15-point run with three assists and a three-pointer to boot. Dartmouth then held the lead until the final five seconds, and Gill finished the afternoon with 14 points and career highs in trifectas (4) and assists (10) for his first double-double. The last player to hit double-figure dimes was Flinder Boyd '02, who provided 10 assists at Columbia on Feb. 22, 2002, his third and final double-double of points and assists.

Better and Better from the Floor

Through the first five games, Dartmouth's field goal percentage improved each time out. The season began with a woeful 35.8 percent showing at St. Bonaventure before ticking up to 43.2 percent at Hartford. The percentage bumped up even further at home versus IPFW (.446) and New Hampshire (.468) before a full-blown clinic took place at Longwood where the Big Green shot 56.3 percent. Entering this game, Dartmouth is third in the Ivy League with a shooting percentage of 44.5.

The Scoring is Wright

Going with a Price is Right reference here because one of the referees at Longwood was named Bob Barker. Seriously. Anyway, freshman Miles Wright enjoyed an offensive outburst against the Lancers by leading Dartmouth with a season-high 15 points thanks to hitting 6-of-9 from the floor with a pair of three-pointers. The rookie even swiped the ball three times, though I imagine Bob Barker would disapprove of stealing, what with wanting to know the prices and all ...

Boehm Buzzer Beater

Dartmouth got a huge boost from power forward Connor Boehm on Nov. 28 as the junior drained a three-pointer at the buzzer to lift the Big Green to a 68-67 win in their home opener against IPFW. Boehm had knocked down just 16 three-pointers in his first two seasons, and a mere six last year. But with sharp-shooter Alex Mitola triple-teamed on the final possession, Boehm was wide open from the wing to turn a defeat into victory. It was the first one-point win since David Rufful converted a three-point play with one second left to beat St. Francis (N.Y.), 65-64, on Jan. 18, 2010.

Don't Forget the Double-Double

With Connor Boehm's game-winning triple, he registered his third career double-double with 10 points and a career-high 14 rebounds. It was the first time the Big Green was on the winning end of his seven career games with at least 10 boards.

Rally from Double-Digit Deficit

When Dartmouth fell behind IPFW by 10 points in the first half on Nov. 28, recent history did not give the Green much chance of coming back to win the game. The last time they trailed by at least double digits at any point in a game and still won was against Army on Dec. 11, 2010. Dartmouth fell behind by 12 in the second half, and was still down 10 with 13:30 to play, yet defeated the Black Knights, 71-68, taking the lead for good in the final minute.

Mitola Tops 20

Point guard Alex Mitola became the first Big Green player to reach 20 points in a game this year with 21 against IPFW on Nov. 28. All of those tallies came in the final 22:09 of the game with 16 in the second half as he knocked down 9-of-15 shots with a trio of three-pointers. He currently has 166 long balls in his career, sixth all-time at Dartmouth.

Block Party

Senior Gabas Maldunas has 19 of Dartmouth's 34 blocks to move into fourth place on the program's all-time list with 126. He swatted four against IPFW, but trumped that total on Dec. 10 when he rejected five UMass Lowell shots. His career high is seven against Longwood last year, and the school record is 12 (which is also the Ivy League record) by Walter Palmer '90.

Tending to the Turnovers

One big reason for Dartmouth's losses in its first two games was turnovers as the Green committed 19 in each contest, a total they did not reach once all last season. Against IPFW on Nov. 28, however, Dartmouth corrected the error of its ways with a mere six miscues. At the same time, the defense was forcing 14 turnovers that led to 21 Big Green points, every one of which was vital to the 68-67 win.

Welcome to College

With senior wing **John Golden** sidelined with an injury for the first 4-6 weeks of the season, freshman **Miles Wright** was called upon to start in his first collegiate game. The rookie had a pair of field goals, one from downtown, to score six points while hauling in five rebounds in 25 minutes. Another freshman in **Taylor Johnson** played 22 minutes as well, tallying five points with a trifecta.

Season-Opening 20-Point Loss

Dartmouth had won its last two season openers, but both of those games came at Leede Arena. This year the Big Green succumbed to St. Bonaventure on the road, 77-57. The last season-opening loss by at least 20 came in 2010 at Providence in an 87-52 defeat. Dartmouth has not won a season opener on the road since toppling Vermont in 1987, but has twice as many wins (76) as losses (38) in all season openers.

Thou Shalt Not Steal

For the first time in 63 games, Dartmouth did not swipe the ball from an opponent even once in a game while St. Bonaventure took the ball a dozen times and went on to win by 20 points in the season opener on Nov. 15.

On the Rise

While Dartmouth's 12-16 record last year is not where head coach **Paul Cormier** wants his team to be, it was the best record for the Big Green since the 1998-99 squad went 14-12. Dartmouth also outscored its opponents for the first time in 17 years, and the 1,905 points were the most in 25 years.

Oh Captains my Captains

For the first time in four seasons, Dartmouth has co-captains leading the squad in senior **Gabas Maldunas** and junior **Alex Mitola**. The lone international player on the roster, Maldunas is on pace to become the Big Green's first 1,000-point scorer in six years and ranks among the program's top 15 rebounders of all-time. Mitola has enjoyed success on the court as well, starting every game in the point guard's first two seasons at Dartmouth while shooting over 40 percent from three-point range and averaging 11.5 points a game.

Man of Steal

Although he missed 10 games and averaged just 15.3 minutes per contest in his first two seasons, **Malik Gill** has made quite an impact on defense. He finished second in the Ivy League as a freshman with 50 steals, a total only four players in Dartmouth history had topped, including Kenny Mitchell '97 twice. Last year he once again led the team with 32, and is one shy of 100 for his career. Gill also has averaged one steal for every 8.9 minutes on the court. The next best ratio belongs to **Miles Wright** at 17.3 minutes per steal, nearly double Gill's rate.

Young But Experienced

Dartmouth may have just two seniors on the roster in senior **John Golden** and **Gabas Maldunas**, but 13 of the 15 players from last year are back on the court in 2014-15. The top four scorers return, and 1,625 of the 1,905 points (85.3 percent) are back in the fold as well, including 143 of the 174 three-pointers. The numbers on the boards are even more impressive with 93.5 percent (866 of 926) back with the Big Green.

LEEDE ARENA

The arena is named in honor of Edward Leede '49 — one of Dartmouth's all-time leading scorers and captain of the 1948-49 squad — and his family. The first game took place on Dec. 2, 1987 as Dartmouth cruised to an 89-63 victory over Holy Cross. The venue houses three regulation-size courts with retractable stands that seat 2,100 fans. Leede Arena has been sold out 30 times, with the game against Harvard on Jan. 21 of 2012 being the first in 11 years.

After hitting just two field goals in 10 attempts in the first 40 minutes, Mitola drilled 4-of-5 from long range to account for every Dartmouth point in the extra period and nearly matched the team's total for the entire second half (13).

The first two Mitola triples in overtime gave the Green a one-point lead, and his third came after a turnover had given NIU an easy layup, knotting the score at 55 with 45 seconds left.

The Huskies now had a chance to take the lead, but Michael Orris could not get his layup to fall and the rebound was tapped out of bounds. The referees originally gave NIU possession, but after referring to the replay, the call was overturned with 21.1 seconds on the clock.

Mitola got the ball with six seconds left but found no space, so he quickly dished off to senior Gabas Maldunas, who in turn gave it right back to Mitola. One dribble to his right later, Mitola launched his high-arching prayer that found its way through the net to give Dartmouth its fourth victory in the last five games.

The Big Green scored the final 14 points of the first half to take a 33-19 lead, then managed to hit just four field goals in the second half as NIU erased the advantage.

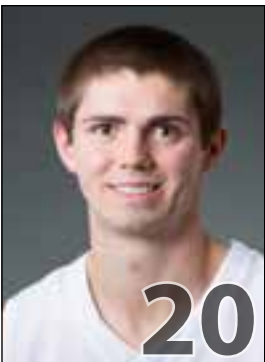

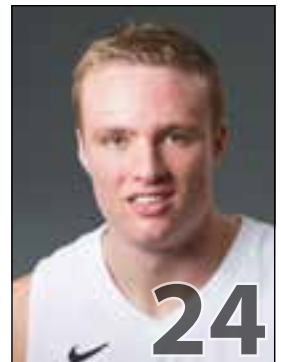
