SCOUTING OHIO STATE

The Buckeyes come into the midweek match as the No. 22 team in the nation following its weekend sweep over Rutgers. Ohio State boasts a 24-8 overall record and is 5-4 in Big Ten Conference play having been swept by Indiana and falling once to Wisconsin. The midweek series with the Nittany Lions will mark just the fourth and fifth games of the season for the Buckeyes at home as they have played 15 away games and 14 neutral site games this season. OSU is led by Lilli Piper, who is hitting an impressive .431 on the season to lead the entire Big Ten Conference. Piper has 47 hits which includes 12 double, one triples, 14 home runs and 40 RBI. The Buckeyes also have Shelby McCombs, who is hitting .341 with 21 RBI and Emily Clark, who carries a .260 batting average with 26 RBI on the season. In the circle, junior Morgan Ray has had a standout year with a team-low 1.90 ERA in 110.1 innings of work and has thrown 10 complete games with 109 strikeouts in 23 appearances and 16 starts. Also seeing time in the circle is McCombs, who has a 2.69 ERA in 88.1 innings.

MAKING PROGRESS AGAINST THE WOLVERINES

Despite dropping all the three games to Michigan, head coach Amanda Lehotak has seen progress in her team against the No. 17 Wolverines. The Nittany Lions played six innings in game one with sophomore Amanda Grieco stepping in as a pinch hitter and ripping her first career extra-base hit to drive in two runs. In Saturday's contest, junior hurler Madison Shaffer went all seven innings, giving up just three runs on five hits. In the series finale, junior Tori **Dubois** launched her team-best fifth home run of the season.

SHAFFER THROWS GEM AGAINST No. 17 MICHIGAN

Junior pitcher Madison Shaffer had the Wolverine hitters on their toes throughout all seven innings in game two of the series. Shaffer threw a complete game, having given up just two hits threw six innings of work before Michigan scored three runs on three hits in the top of the seventh inning to earn the win. The New Castle, Pennsylvania native struck out four Wolverine hitters in her seven innings of work.

GRIECO STEPS UP

Sophomore walk-on **Amanda Grieco** was given the opportunity to pinch hit with runners in scoring position against Michigan Friday, April 6. The Basking Ridge, New Jersey native dug in and roped a double into the left center field gap, bringing in both of Penn State runs against the Wolverines. The extra-base hit marked the first of her career donning the Blue and White. Grieco earned the start in the final two games of the series at second base, notching eight putouts and four assists.

In her fourth season at the helm, Lehotak led the Nittany Lions to 23 wins, including to the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament after an upset victory over Nebraska. The Blue and White picked up two wins over ranked opponents in the 2017 campaign, including beating then-No. 4 LSU and then-No. 25 Ohio State. Lehotak guided First

Team All-Big Ten selection Tori Dubois to a .457 batting average in Big Ten play to rank third in the conference, while Rebecca Ziegler notched Big Ten All-Tournament honors in 2017. Senior Shelby Miller closed out her career under Lehotak ranking second in Penn State career laurels with 118 RBIs and went out as the career sacrifice hit leader with nine, while senior Kristina Brackpool ranks No. 7 all-time with 106 RBIs and No. 9 all-time with 19 home runs. In the circle, the Nittany Lions saw an increase in complete games going from 16 in 2016 to 25 in 2016, while strikeouts jumped from 180 to 194 in the 2017 campaign. Senior Marlaina Laubach started a team-best 25 games and threw 14 complete games en route to 12 wins. The right-handed hurler closed out her career as the all-time leader with 139 appearances in the circle and ranks third with 97 starts and fourth with four career saves Laubach tallied 46 career victories to rank sixth all-time and tossed 611.1 innings to rank fifth all-time in Nittany Lion laurels while her 49 complete games and 323 strikeouts rank seventh all-time for the Blue and White.

Lehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached their 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record and walk record with 137 career RBI and 100 career walks donning the Blue and White. Furthermore, under Lehotak's tutelage, Jones ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine career batting categories at Penn of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions.

Defensively, Penn State finished the season ranked third in the Big Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. In the circle, Marlaina Laubach established herself as the ace for Lehotak, tying for third in Penn State season history with 41 appearances and ranking fourth with 29 starts. Laubach also ranks 15th in innings pitched, tossing 165.2 for the Nittany Lions in the 2016 campaign.

FEY POISED FOR BREAKOUT FRESHMAN SEASON

Freshman Dani Fey has been standout at the plate for the Nittany Lions since moving into the leadoff spot in the batting order in the third week of the season. Fey hit .385 in Jacksonville, Florida and carried a .556 on-base percentage, drawing four walks, while also holding a .385 slugging percentage. The freshman outfielder tallied five hits while scoring a team-high five times for the Blue and White in its five games at the JU Tournament. Since then, Fey has maintained the leadoff spot for the Nittany Lions, hitting .350 when she is the first batter of the inning. The Bangor, Pennsylvania native ranks fourth in the Big Ten Conference in walks with 23 base on balls.

POLK PERFECTION

Junior Toni Polk put together a perfect plate performance in game three of the Big Ten Conference series against Rutgers, going 4-for-4. The junior outfielder notched two singles and two doubles and drove in one run in the final game against the Scarlet Knights. Polk's performance allowed her to take a team-high .305 batting average and a team-best 29 hits.

BIG HITS AGAINST SCARLET KNIGHTS

The Penn State softball team capped off the weekend series with a 7-3 victory over Rutgers. The Nittany Lions tallied a season-high 16 hits, scoring seven runs and committing just one error in the field. Junior **Toni Polk** had a perfect day at the plate going 4-for-4 with one RBI. Junior **Meghan Williams** also had a big day at the dish for the Blue and White, going 3-for-4. Juniors Tori Dubois and Paige Johnson had two hits and two RBI on the day and sophomore Destiny Weber had two hits and one RBI. Dubois and Weber both had home runs for the Nittany Lions with Dubois hitting her third in four games and Weber ripping her first of the season.

FLASHING THE LEATHER

The Nittany Lion defense came up with some B1G defensive plays State. Senior Lexi Knief also closed out her career in the top-10 at Rutgers, despite falling in two games. Sophomore Destiny Weber made two stellar plays on the hot corner with a diving play and a line drive catch. Also making a huge catch with runners on base was sophomore **Delaney Elling**, who dove for a ball in no-man's land to prevent a run from scoring.

FINDING THE LONG BALL

Penn State went into the second weekend of Big Ten play with six home runs on the season and came out with 10 as three different players hit a round-tripper against the Scarlet Knights. Junior Tori **Dubois** notched three home runs on the week with a game-winning grand slam against Robert Morris before following it up with two home runs against Rutgers. Sophomores Kennedy Legg and Destiny Weber hit their first career home runs at Rutgers with Legg going yard in game two and Weber finding her round-tripper in game three of the series. In all, six Penn State players have hit a home run this season with Dubois having a team-best four homers and Paige Johnson hitting two.

The Nittany Lions will take on teams from the American Athletic Conference (UCF, Houston), Atlantic Coast Conference (Georgia Tech, Pitt, Virginia Tech), Atlantic Sun Conference (Jacksonville, Lipscomb), Big 12 (Iowa State), Colonial Athletic Conference (Hofstra, JMU), Mid-American Conference (Kent State), Northeast Conference (Robert Morris, Saint Francis), Patriot League (Bucknell), Southeastern Conference (Alabama, Ole Miss, Texas A&M), and Southland Conference (Central Arkansas).

BLUE AND WHITE TO PLAY 24 HOME GAMES IN 2018

Penn State will play 24 of its 56 scheduled games insides the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. The home-heavy schedule will be a nice change for the Blue and White as it played only 15 of its 56 games at home in the 2017 campaign. Penn State will kick off its season with 20 away contests before opening its 2018 home campaign with a weekend series against non-conference opponent Kent State, March 16-18. The Nittany Lions hold a 61-59-1 overall record at Beard Field in its seven year existence which is good for a .504 winning percentage. Penn State will play 10 home contests in the month of March before taking on six opponents in 14 games in the month of April.

Finally, sophomore **Amanda Grieco** and senior **Ashton Mensinger** walked on.

NEW SEASON, NEW LOOK

Penn State softball fans will see a new look on the field as it returns just four starters to its 2018 lineup. The Blue and White will see almost an entirely new infield, while senior **Gianna Arrizurieta** will return to the dirt in a variety of positions in her final season. The Nittany Lions will also have a new look in the outfield as **Tori Dubois** is the lone returner in left field. Finally, Penn State will look to veterans **Jessica Cummings**, **Madison Shaffer** and **Madey Smith** in the circle while also adding help from senior newcomer **Ashton Mensinger**.

TOUGH BIG TEN SCHEDULE

The Big Ten Conference has become one of the most competitive leagues in NCAA Division I softball as it has two teams represented in the preseason Top 25 Coaches Poll with Minnesota coming in at No. 16 and Michigan ranking No. 18. The B1G also has three teams receiving votes to kick off the 2018 campaign. The Nittany Lions will take on both Minnesota and Michigan in regular season contests, as well as Illinois and Ohio State, who are receiving votes.

To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten selection, student-athletes must be letterwinners who are in at least their second academic year at their institution and carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.


