The last eight games in the Penn State-Nebraska series have been won by the home team.

Nebraska and Penn State are ranked first (8.5) and second (7.9), respectively, in the Big Ten Conference team rankings for steals per game. Nittany Lion Josh Reaves is the league's individual leader (2.7 spg) while Nebraska's Thomas Allen (1.6) and James Palmer Jr (1.5) rank third and fourth.

The Nittany Lions' overall strength of schedule is No. 8 with a No. 32 ranking for the nonconference strength of schedule.

Redshirt junior Mike Watkins pulled down 10 rebounds vs. #22 Wisconsin to become only the 21st Nittany Lion to amass 600 career rebounds.

Junior forward and Julius Erving Award candidate Lamar Stevens has scored in double figures in every game this season, has six double-doubles and seven games with 20 or more points in 2018-19. He has started all 87 games in his career.



PERFECT NONCONFERENCE HOME RECORD

Penn State posted a perfect 5-0 record against nonconference opponents at home in 2018-19. That record includes a 63-62 win over then-No. 13 Virginia Tech, still the Hokies' only loss.

LAST TIME - #22 WISCONSIN SPOILS LIONS' **FIRST HOME GAME OF NEW YEAR**

Penn State couldn't recover from 11 first-half turnovers that gave No. 22 Wisconsin a 10-point halftime lead and a 71-52 win over the Nittany Lions Sunday night in the Bryce Jordan Center.

Paired with Penn State's 16 total turnovers, Wisconsin shot nearly 60 percent in the second half and had three Badgers post double figures in points. Lamar Stevens and Wisconsin's Ethan Happ tied for the game-high scoring total of 22 while Mike Watkins had a game-best 10 rebounds. Watkins became only the 21st Nittany Lion in program history with 600 career rebounds.

The Nittany Lions were coached by associate head coach Keith Urgo while coach Patrick Chambers served a one-game suspension.

Wisconsin made is first four field goals of the second half, including two 3-pointers, while Penn State struggled offensively, putting more distance between the Badgers and Nittany Lions, 43-23. Josh Reaves had the next two scores for Penn State with a layup and one-handed dunk. Reaves scored all six of his points in the second half and had a game-best five assists.

The Badgers continued their hot shooting at 80 percent (8-10) in the first 8:30 of the second period. Baskets by Stevens and Reaves started to fall, but the Nittany Lions shot 33.3 percent in the second half (10-30) and couldn't make up ground.

Four more turnovers in the first half allowed UW to build its lead to 13 points, 24-11, before Stevens had a layup and converted a threepoint play. Myles Dread connected on his second trey of the half and layups by Stevens and Bolton cut the lead to 31-23.

Wisconsin was kept scoreless for 3:08 until Brad Davison hit a jumper before the half to put the Badgers up 33-23 at the break.


Happ finished the night with eight rebounds and four assists with Davison scoring 14 and Nate Reuvers 11 for Wisconsin. Davison also had seven rebounds.

STEVENS NAMED TO ERVING WATCH LIST

Penn State junior Lamar Stevens was named to the watch list for the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award as announced in October by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Stevens, from North Wales, Pa., is one of the 20 student-athletes selected for the watch list for the 2019 award.

Named after Class of 1993 Hall of Famer and 16-year professional basketball player Julius Erving, the annual honor in its fifth year recognizes the top small forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

Stevens was voted the Most Outstanding Player of the 2018 National Invitation Tournament as he helped lead Penn State to its second NIT title this past March. He scored a game-high 28 points in the championship game and with that total, eclipsed the 1,000 career point mark, becoming only the second Penn State sophomore to achieve that milestone. An All-Big Ten Conference honorable mention, Stevens recorded double figures in 33 games in 2017-18 and with 10 games of 20 points or more, including two 30-point games.

REAVES' PASSING ATTACK

Senior guard Josh Reaves has proved himself to be quite the passer. He recorded a career-best eight assists at DePaul and added five more vs. UMBC to lead the Nittany Lions so far this season with 49 total (3.3 apg).

With 265 career assists, his total stands 18th behind Mike Lang's 267 (1980-83) at No. 17. Reaves had 107 assists in 2017-18, second to Tony Carr's 186.



GETTING DEFENSIVE

In preseason previews of the 2018-19 Big Ten Conference field and individual honors, senior guard Josh Reaves rises to the top as the pick for the league's top defensive player. Athlon Sports' superlatives tab Reaves and Lindy's also picked the league's two-time steals leader as its top defender.

REAVES, PRINCE OF THIEVES

Senior Josh Reaves moved up to fifth individually in the NCAA active career rankings for total steals (207) and ranks 11th for steals per game (2.01).

Reaves ranks fourth on Penn State's career list and needs just 12 more steals to pass Nittany Lion Titus Ivory for the No. 3 spot for PSU and No. 9 on the Big Ten Conference career list.

In addition to moving up on Penn State's career chart, Reaves snatched a spot on the single-season list with his 73 total (t-8th) in 2017-18.

POINTS RISING

Just one of the indicators of Penn State's increase in its offensive output was the setting of the program's record for points scored overall (2,833) and in the Big Ten (1,297) in 2017-18, with the Nittany Lions' breaking their own league scoring record from a year ago.

The 2017-18 points per game average of 74.7 was the highest since the 2000-01 season, highest under Chambers, and a 12.9-point difference from Chambers' first season in 2011-12.

NEW FACES

McCloskey became eligible to play as of Dec. 15, 2018 and will have four years to play basketball and Brockington will have three years of eligibility.





FACILITY RENOVATION PROJECT APPROVED

Athletics leadership approved a project to renovate the men's basketball locker room, strength and conditioning center and athletic training room.

"The renovation project helps us climb to the next level," said Nittany Lion coach Patrick Chambers. "It helps us show our student-athletes, recruits, alumni and fans of the program that we are committed to getting this program to the top of the Big Ten Conference."

NEW PLACES

Penn State guard and alumnus Tim Frazier (2009-14) recently signed a contract to join the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans. Shep Garner (2014-18 inked a deal with the Grand Rapids Drive of the G League during the fall while Donovon Jack (2012-16) signed with KD Hopsi Polzela in Slovenia. In June 2018, D.J. Newbill (2012-15) agreed to a new contract to play for NBL's Cairns Taipans.

Tony Carr, drafted by the New Orleans Pelicans in June 2018, is currently playing for Fiat Torino in the Italian Lega Basket Serie A. Brandon Taylor tipped off the 2018-19 season with his new team, Salon Vilpas, in Finland's Korisligga.

6 FOR 8,741

During coach Patrick Chambers tenure at Penn State, six Nittany Lions have added their names to the 1,000-point career scoring list for a current total of 8,741 points. Three Nittany Lions finished their careers in the top 10: Tim Frazier (1,543), Shep Garner (1,629) and D.J. Newbill (1,812).

In 2017-18, Tony Carr (1,161) and Lamar Stevens became the first- and second-ever Penn State men's basketball sophomores to reach the mile-stone.

THE WINS

Penn State has achieved 15 or more wins in five straight years – a first for the Nittany Lion program. Prior to the 2013-17* seasons under Chambers, the Nittany Lions had not previously reached at least 15 wins in four consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten.

The Lions had at least eight regular-season, nonconference wins in each of Chambers' seven seasons with 10 in 2017-18.

BIG WINS

With the February 3, 2018 Big Ten victory over lowa, the 2017-18 Nittany Lions made another impact on Penn State's Big Ten basketball history. The sixth league win for coach Patrick Chambers gave the Nittany Lions a third consecutive season with six or more Big Ten wins, accomplished only once before in 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96.

HIGHEST WINS AVERAGE

Following the 2017-18 season, Patrick Chambers claimed the highest per year wins average among Penn State men's basketball coaches at 16.14 wins per season. Elmer Gross (1949-54) averaged 16 wins during his five-year tenure.

ON THE ROAD, AGAIN

Penn State won six "true" away games (at an opponent's arena) in 2017-18, a total achieved only four times since joining the Big Ten Conference for the 1992-93 season. The 11 "away from home" wins logged was the most since the 2000-01 campaign (11).

FIRST 20-WIN SEASON SINCE 2008-09

Coach Chambers and the Nittany Lions posted the first 20-win season since 2008-09 and Penn State's 10th season with 20 or more wins, fifth in its Big Ten era. The 26-win total is the second-highest all-time.

EARLIEST TO 21 WINS

When Penn State recorded its 21st win of the 2017-18 season, a thrilling 69-68 win over No. 13 Ohio State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament on March 2, it marked the earliest, by date, that Penn State achieved 21 wins.

AH-MAZING MARCH

March was amazing for the Nittany Lions as they won seven games during the month, tied for the most by a Penn State team. The 2017-18 squad also posted the highest-ever win percentage in conference and postseason games in March 2018, at 87.5 percent (7-1 record).

TOP HALF

Penn State finished in a tie for sixth in the 2017-18 Big Ten standings, earning the No. 7 seed in the 2018 Big Ten Tournament. The sixth-place finish was only the third time in history the Nittany Lions have finished in the top half of the standings and sixth time finishing above .500 at 9-9.

The No. 7 seed is highest achieved in Chambers' tenure and is tied for second-highest since the Big Ten Tournament started in 1998 (#6 – 2009, 2011, #7 - 1998, 2008).

BIG BYE

Penn State earned a bye in the first round for only the second time in the 20-year tournament history, its first in 2016.

LUCKY 7

Penn State became the first No. 7 seed to advance to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals since 2011 (Michigan State). It was the Nittany Lions' fourth trip to the semifinals since the inception of the tournament in 1998 and second under Chambers.

29 GAMES WITH 70+ POINTS

Penn State scored 70 or more points 29 times in 2017-18, the most games in a single season in program history and breaking the old record by five games (24, 1999-2000)

POWER RANKINGS

At the end of the 2017-18 season, Penn State had climbed to its highest rankings of the season in kenpom.com (19), the ESPN Basketball Power Index (20) and Sagarin (27).

NATIONAL NOTICE

Penn State earned 19 votes in the final USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll, fifth among the other teams receiving votes. It was the first time since the 2008-09 season the Nittany Lions had been recognized. In the February 19 Associated Press poll, Penn State received six votes, the first time the program had received votes since December 29, 2014, and the most votes received since a total of 14 on January 31, 2011.

TOP HALF

Penn State finished in a tie for sixth in the 2017-18 Big Ten standings, earning the No. 7 seed in the 2018 Big Ten Tournament. The sixth-place finish is only the third time in history the Nittany Lions finished in the top half of the standings and sixth time finishing above .500 at 9-9.

BIG STATEMENT

The Nittany Lions won games in consecutive years in the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since the 2000 and 2001 tournaments. In its last four Big Ten Tournament appearances, Penn State posted five wins, most in any four-year span since the tournament began in 1998.

In 2017-18, Chambers had the Penn State basketball program poised to take the next step in its pursuit of consistent, sustainable success.

By the end of December, the Nittany Lions reached double-digits in wins and in January, the Nittany Lions stepped into the spotlight, defeating No. 13 Ohio State at Value City Arena, one of only two teams in the nation to accomplish that feat in 2017-18.

By the end of February 2018, the Nittany Lions racked up nine Big Ten Conference wins, the most, to date, in the Chambers era. A week later, Penn State picked up its 20th and 21st wins, the latter coming at the earliest point ever for the Nittany Lions.

Playing their best basketball in March, Chambers' squad registered seven wins against only one loss and won the National Invitation Tournament title. Penn State defeated teams from the Atlantic Coast, Atlantic 10, Big East, Pac-12 and Southeastern conferences with an average scoring margin of 10.4 points per game in NIT contests.

Dozens of records were broken and the increase in offensive production saw Penn State score 70 points or more in 29 games, while the stalwart defense, a Chambers' hallmark, frustrated opponents. Fourteen teams in 2017-18 failed to score more than 60 points against the Nittany Lions.

Individual records were rewritten as well, as Shep Garner broke the 23-year-old Big Ten single-season record for 3-pointers with 120 and etched his name in the Penn State yearbook for both the single-season and career mark. Tony Carr became the first Penn State men's sophomore to reach the 1,000-point career mark with Lamar Stevens becoming the second to achieve that milestone.

A Philly native, Chambers was introduced as the 12th head coach in program history June 6, 2011, and has poured his passion and energy into building the Nittany Lion program.

Signing the top two recruiting classes in program history in back-to-back years, the 2016 group was ranked in the top 25 and the 2015 class in the top 30. A trio of players with freshmen eligibility started the 2016-17 season opener and would combine for 90 starts, with 23 more from a sophomore, giving the young Nittany Lions a birth by fire, but positioning them for success.

The impressive performances of the rookies earned them several honors during the course of their initial campaigns with Carr selected to the Big Ten All-Freshman team. Carr would become the first Penn State basketball player to earn Big Ten All-Tournament honors as a sophomore in 2018.

With Carr selected as a first-team All-Big Ten Conference pick by both the coaches and media following the 2017-18 season, junior Josh Reaves and redshirt sophomore Mike Watkins produced another program first – two Nittany Lions on the All-Defensive Team.

Chambers has sent Carr, Garner, Frazier, Newbill and numerous other players into the professional ranks. Garner inked a deal with the Grand Rapids Drive in fall of 2018 while Carr is playing for Fiat Torino in Italy's premier league. Frazier (2009-14) recently joined the New Orleans Pelicans organization and Newbill (2013-15) signed a new contract to play for the National Basketball League's Cairns Taipans. Over the summer months, Donovon Jack (2012-16) signed with KD Hopsi Polzela in Slovenia

AT BOSTON UNIVERSITY

Chambers came to Penn State after two years at Boston University, where in 2010-11 he led the Terriers to the America East Conference Championship and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in more than a decade. He posted a 42-28 record, becoming the only coach in BU history to earn 20 wins in each of his first two seasons and the fastest in program history to win a conference championship.

AT VILLANOVA

A native of Newtown Square, Pa., Chambers previously played for and coached with two of the nation's most successful college coaches. From 2004-09, he was a member of Wright's staff at Villanova, serving as associate head coach in 2008-09. He helped the Wildcats earn four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances and advance to the 2009 NCAA Final Four. Chambers played for Magee at Philadelphia University (formerly Philadelphia Textile), helping Magee become college basketball's all-time victories leader (941) and a 2011 Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame inductee.

During Chambers' five seasons on Wright's Villanova staff, he was instrumental in helping lead the Wildcats to a 126-45 record (.737), including the then-single-season win record of 30-8 in 2008-09. In 2008, Chambers helped lead the Wildcats to the 2009 NCAA Final Four, a first in 24 years, and saw Villanova advance to the Sweet 16 for the fourth time in its five NCAA Tournament appearances.

AT PHILADELPHIA

Chambers joined the NCAA Division II Philadelphia University's basketball team as a walk-on in 1990 and went on to have an outstanding career under Magee. He became the team's starting point guard, earning first-team AlI-ECAC honors, and helped lead the Rams to four NCAA Division II Sweet 16 appearances and two Elite Eight appearances. He still holds the school record for career assists with 709.

THE CHAMBERS FAMILY

The Chambers family is well represented at Penn State basketball games. Chambers and his wife, Courtney, have four children, Grace, Ryan, Caitlin and Patrick and three of Chambers' 11 siblings are Penn State graduates – brothers, Chris and Joe, and a sister, Megan, who resides in State College.
