FIRST SERVE

- » Penn State hosts the top team in the country in Long Beach State and No. 12 Call State Northridge in this weekends non-conference matches in Rec Hall. The Nittany Lions will face the AVCA DI-II No. 1 49's of Long Beach State on Friday at 7:30 p.m., followed by a Saturday March 5 matchup with the Matadors of Cal State Northridge with a first whistle slated for 7:30 p.m.
- » Penn State men's volleyball notched its eleventh and twelfth wins of the season this past weekend moving to 7-0 in EIVA play in the process. Penn State downed Charleston (WV) in straight sets (25-15, 25-13, 25-14) and defeated George Mason, led by former Penn State men's volleyball assistant coach Jay Hosack, in four-sets (25-23, 25-23, 16-25, 25-20).
- » Penn State held steady at No. 6 in the latest AVCA Top 15 Coaches Poll. PSU has been in the top 15 the last six consecutive weeks since debuting at No. 10 in the AVCA DI-II pre-season poll. The Nittany Lions have now seen or will see a total of nine teams from the top 15 at some point during the regular season.
- » This weekend's matches against Cal State Northridge and Longg Beach State are the fifth and sixth games of an 11-game homestand at Rec Hall for the Nittany Lions. Penn State will compete at home for over a month with their next road match coming on April 1 in Princeton, N I
- » Penn State currently leads the EIVA with a 7-0 record in conference play. Harvard is second in the EIVA with a record of 4-2 in conference play and 7-6 overall. Saint Francis (Pa.) is in third-place with a 4-3 record in conference play and 9-6 record overall.
- » The Nittany Lions wrapped up its February schedule with a record of 7-0 during the month.
- » Penn State begins the March slate of their schedule on an 11-game win streak, and last lost a match in the month of March back in 2014 on March 21 in a 3-1 loss at Loyola in Chicago, III.
- » Penn State enters Friday's match leading the Matadors in the all-time series 10-4, having notched the tenth win of the series last year on the road in a sweep. Penn State trails Long Beach State 7-15 in the all-time series dating back to 1985. The Nittany Lions earned their seventh win of the series on the road last year in a 3-0 sweep.
- » Following a 2015 season that featured Penn State men's volleyball's 17th consecutive trip the NCAA national semifinals, the Nittany Lions return a core group of nine letterwinners and three starters this year, while welcoming four freshmen to the roster
- » Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in four different team categories including top-10 rankings in Blocks Per Set 2.54 (7th), Kills Per Set 13.35 (3rd), and Assists Per Set 12.59 (3rd). Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked eighth in the nation in Points Per Set (4.84) and seventh in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.20), while Matt Callaway is currently ninth in the nation in Blocks Per Set averaging 1.20. Taylor Hammond is third in the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.49.
- » The 27-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team was selected as this year's EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's seven head coaches, receiving six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll.
- » The Nittany Lions will square off a total of nine teams featured in the this season's AVCA preseason poll including eight teams ranked within the top 15 and two receiving votes.
- » University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship.

Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked eighth in the nation in Points Per Set (4.84) and seventh in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.20), while Matt Callaway is currently ninth in the nation in Blocks Per Set averaging 1.20. Taylor Hammond is third in the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.49.

PENN STATE VOTED EIVA PRESEASON FAVORITE

The 17-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team has been selected as the 2016 EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's eight head coaches. Penn State received six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll, while George Mason picked up two. The Patriots are slotted to finish second, while Princeton, NJIT and St. Francis (Pa.) round out the top

five in spots three through five.

NITTANY LIONS PICKED 10TH IN AVCA PRESEASON POLL

Penn State, along with No. 6 Ohio State and No. 14 George Mason were the only EIVA schools to earn a spot on this year's AVCA DI-II Men's Volleyball Preseason Poll. The Nittany Lions checked in at No.10. BYU earned this year's No. 1 overall spot, while UC-Irvine grabbed the No. 2 position. Defending

NCAA national champion Loyola-Chicago checked in at No. 3, while Long Beach State and UCLA rounded out the top five at No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship. The announcement came during the 2014 NCAA announcement of its host sites through the 2017-18 season.

ANDERSON, HOLT, AND RUSSELL SET TO REPRESENT TEAM U.S.A FOR 2016 RIO OLYMPICS

Earlier this year Nittany Lion alums Matt Anderson, Max Holt, and Aaron Russell qualified for the 2016 Olympic Games and won the FIVB World Cup Sept. 23 in Tokyo, Japan as a part of the U.S. Men's Volleyball National Team.

The new additions include 6-11 opposite hitter Calvin Mende from Redlands, Calif., Jason Donorovich, a 6-9 outside from Lockport, N.Y., Luke Braswell, a 6-4 setter from Manchester, Pa., and Frank Melvin, a 6-5 outside from Mohrsville, Pa.

2015 (Redshirt-Junior): Played in 23 of the team's 31 matches during the 2015 season, starting every game he played in ... Finished third on the team in blocking with 58 total blocks, averaging 0.67 blocks per set ... Had four kills and three blocks against No. 8 UC Irvine (1/8) ... Tallied one kill, one ace and two blocks against No. 10 Hawaii (1/9) ... Had a season-high nine kills at Ball State (1/16), adding a teamhigh three blocks ... Had 24 assists, two digs and a block at No. 10 Hawaii (1/9) ... Dished out a career-high 60 assists to go along with five digs at Ball State (1/16) ... Recorded a double-double with 47 assists and a career-high 14 digs vs. No. 1 Loyola (1/23) ...
