2017 NOTES AND HEADLINES

A QUICK GLANCE AT MARYLAND

The Terrapins record can be deceiving as they are 9-33-1 but two of those wins have come over top top-20 teams in the 2017 campaign. Maryland opened up the 2017 season with a 4-2 win over then-No. 1 Florida and most recently stole one game from then-No. 18 Michigan with a 2-1 victory at home. UMD has also earned four of its nine wins in the friendly confines of Maryland Softball Stadium.

The Terrapins have three players hitting .300-or-better in the 2017 season with Amanda Brashear leading the team with a .308 batting average that includes 44 hits, while Juli Strange is hitting .300 with 36 hits. Kristina Dillard has driven in a team-high 19 RBI this season but has been prone to strikeouts as she ties for first on the team with 25. Once on the base path, Maryland is not afraid to take a base as three players have swiped at least four bases this season and the team has taken 20 bases on 25 attempts in 2017.

In the circle, Madison Martin has made a team-high 35 appearances and 19 starts to earn six of Maryland's nine wins this season with a 3.51 ERA. The Terrapin's three final wins have come while Hannah Dewey has been in control in the circle as she has made 30 appearances with 15 starts and a 5.34 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST UMD

The 2016 sweep of the Terrapins capped off a historic weekend for the Blue and White as it has its second-straight sellout crowd at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions moved to 6-0 in conference play at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, making it the first time since 2012 that Penn State has swept two conference series at home. Moreover, the sweep of UMD in 2016 was just the first time in program history that the Blue and White had swept three three-game series in Big Ten Conference play.

SHAFFER PITCHING QUALITY INNINGS TO CLOSE 2017

Sophomore **Madison Shaffer** has been used as a reliever for the entire 2017 season before earning her first start against Saint Francis Wednesday, April 26. Shaffer was steady through eight innings of work, allowing just seven hits, striking out four and giving up one run on a double in the top of the eighth. The New Castle, Pennsylvania native also came on in relief against Bucknell to toss five innings and earn her first victory of the 2017 campaign as she struck out three and allowed only one run to score. Shaffer has seen her ERA drop by at least 1.00 each of the last three weeks as she has worked it down to a 3.75 to rank second on the team.

Amanda Lehotak enter her fourth

successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included

its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five confer-ence series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached its 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record and walk record with 137 career RBI and 100 career walks donning the Blue and White. Furthermore, under Lehotak's tutelage, Jones dano homer. ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine careerbatting categories at Penn State. Senior Lexi Kniefalso closed out her career in the top-10 of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions. Sophomore Alyssa VanDerveer tied the single the career batting record book four times after her sophomore campaign, ranking fourth in home runs with 24 after two seasons. 2016 with Jones tying the single game home runs record with two against Michigan State and Tori Dubois knocking three doubles Brackpool both found their names in the Penn State career record books with Miller ranking in the top-15 in batting average and RBI three players hitting a home run. and Brackpool ranking in the top-10 in career home runs.

Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. In the circle, Marlaina Laubach established herself as the 15th in innings pitched, tossing 165.2 for the Nittany Lions in the 2016 campaign.

The Blue and White advanced to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for just the third time in program history with three student-athletes earning First Team All-Big Ten honors. Seniors Macy Jones and Lexi Knief and sophomore Alyssa VanDerveer earned the honor, marking the first time since 2013 that Penn State has had a first team honoree and the second time in program history that the Nittany Lions have had three first team nods. VanDerveer and Shelby Miller notched Big Ten All-Tournament team honors with VanDerveer knocking a grand slam in the quarterfinal and Miller being solid both offensively and defensively. Jones capped off her career as a NFCA All-Great Lakes Region First Team honoree and Knief earned third team honors for the second-straight season. In the classroom, 13 players earned Academic All-Big Ten honors for the Blue and White in the 2015-16 academic year.

NITTANY LIONS EARN TWO WINS OVER TOP-25 PRO-GRAMS

Penn State picked up its second top-25 victory of the season when it defeated No. 25 Ohio State in the first game of a doubleheader Wednesday, April 12. The Nittany Lions started off the 2017 campaign with a 7-3 win over then-No. 4 LSU, Feb. 10. The two wins over top-25 teams mark the first time Penn State has done so since the 2009 since when it notched victories over then-No. 13 DePaul and then-No. 12 Arizona.

MILLER TIES FOR FOURTH IN CAREER RBIs

With her 27 RBIs this season, senior **Shelby Miller** has eclipsed the 100-career RBIs mark. The senior third baseman has driven in 113 career RBIs in her 194 appearances and currently ranks No. 4 in Nittany Lion career RBI laurels.

OFFENSE NOT ENOUGH AGAINST MSU

Despite outhitting Michigan State 9-7 in its final game of the series, the Nittany Lions were unable to come away with the victory in the rubber match, falling 6-4. Penn State earned the 7-3 victory in game one of the series with **Shelby Miller** driving in three runs on a home run. Sophomore **Tori Dubois** led the Blue and White at the plate in the doubleheader with five hits, three RBIs and scoring three times.

ARRIZURIETA MAKES THE MOST OUT OF OPPORTUNI-TY

Junior right fielder **Gianna Arrizurieta** got the nod for the start in game two against Indiana in the three-game series this past weekend. Arrizurieta appeared in two games with two hits, one RBI and scored once for a .400 batting average on the weekend. The Pembroke Pines, Fla. native made the most of her opportunity, making two huge catches in right field in the Nittany Lions narrow 3-2 victory against the Hoosiers. In game three, the junior outfielder went 2-for-3 at the plate, including two doubles, while scoring the game-winning run after reaching on a fielder's choice and stealing a base. Arrizurieta also made one putout on a diving catch in right center field to save a run in the fourth inning against Indiana.

WEBER EARNS STARTS AGAINST INDIANA

After starting four games as the designated player and coming into pinch hit on six other occasions, freshman **Destiny Weber** made the first starts of her collegiate career in the field against Indiana. The freshman started three games behind the plate against the Hoosiers, catching one runner stealing. Weber also dropped a clutch hit on the left field line in the bottom of the seventh inning in game three to move **Gianna Arrizurieta** into scoring position with one out before a single into right scored the walk-off run for the Blue and White. Weber has two hits, one RBI and has scored once in her 13 appearances this season.

LAUBACH HAS SOLID OUTINGS AGAINST HOOSIERS

Senior **Marlaina Laubach** made three appearance this past week for Penn State, earning one save and one victory. The senior hurler came in with runners on second and third against with Penn State leading 3-2 and no outs against Indiana. Laubach secured all three outs the Nittany Lions needed to take the victory and earn her first save of the season. The Northampton, Pa. native came back in the series finale against the Hoosiers to throw all seven innings and allow just five hits while striking out three for her sixth win of the 2017 season.

BOTTOM OF THE ORDER PROPELS PENN STATE TO WIN

The Nittany Lions saw just six hits in the series finale against Indiana, five of which came from the bottom half of the lineup. Junior **Gianna Arrizurieta** secured the first two hits of the game and an RBI for the Blue and White hitting in the seven spot, while **Toni Polk** lined one hit and scored once. Finally, **Destiny Weber** and **Sam Shanahan** had one hit apiece for the Nittany Lions, hitting in the eight and nine spots, respectively.

SHANAHAN DRIVES IN GAME-WINNER AGAINST INDI-ANA

A walk-off hit into right field from senior **Samantha Shanahan** solidified the 2-1 Big Ten Conference series victory over Indiana for the Penn State softball team Sunday, April 2. The win marks the second-straight season Penn State has earned the series victory over Indiana and its first home series win over the Hoosiers since the 2012 campaign.

STRANDED BASE RUNNERS PLAGUES NITTANY LIONS

The Penn State softball team fell 7-1 to in-state opponent Pitt after stranding eight base runners in the contest. The Blue and White scored one run on a Kristina after taking two games from Niagara and picking up Brackpool single up the left field line but was unable to bring in any further runs in the contest with the Panthers. Brackpool ended the day going 3-for-4 at the plate with one RBI.

SMITH PROVES TO BE BRIGHT SPOT AT NO. 19 MICHIGAN

Freshman hurler Madey Smith has proven time and time again that she has what it takes to go up against the top hitters in the nation and keep them off balance. In her second career appearance. Smith gave up just one run to the powerful No. 8 Washington Huskies. This past weekend, the Washington, N.J. native threw 5.1 innings, four of which were scoreless, to No. 19 Michigan. Smith gave up just three runs while striking out three in the loss.

BRACKPOOL MOVES INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF NO. 9 SPOT

Senior Kristina Brackpool moved into the No. 9 all-time spot when she blasted her 19th career home run against Rutgers, April 21. With Penn State down 5-0, Brackpool launched a lead off solo home run over the left field wall to open up scoring for the Blue and White. The home run would be the start of a four run inninng for Penn State.

ZIEGLER STEADY AT THE DISH

Redshirt-sophomore Rebecca Ziegler has been comfortable as the leadoff batter for the Blue and White but has also been a force with runners on base. The starting center fielder has driven in a team-best 18 runs, including five RBIs against Virginia Tech in the Nittany Lions 7-1 victory. Ziegler has tallied nine multi-hit games to total 32 base knocks on the season. Furthermore, Ziegler has 11 extra base hits, which includes eight doubles.

SMITH FINDING A HOME IN THE CIRCLE

After studying behind senior Marlaina Laubach and sophomore Madison Seifert in the first four weeks of the season, freshman Madey Smith is starting to find a place in the rotation for the Nittany Lions. Smith made her career debut in week four of the season against Colorado State and has seen action every weekend since. The right-handed hurler tossed her first collegiate complete game against George Washington striking out a career-best eight batters while giving up just three hits and two runs in the 4-2 victory.

BLUE AND WHITE EARN THREE WINS IN NATION'S CAPITAL

Penn State returned to Happy Valley with three wins one win over George Washington, March 18-19. The Nittany Lions earned a decisive 13-4 victory in game one against the Purple Eagles before going on to win a 4-2 game against George Washington. Penn State closed out the tournament with a 7-1 victory over Niagara and a 7-2 loss to GW.

NITTANY LIONS PICK UP ONE WIN IN SEATTLE

Penn State notched a 6-2 victory over South Dakota to open the day before falling to No. 8 Washington, 15-0, in a five-inning night game Friday, March 10 at Husky Softball Stadium. Redshirt-sophomore Rebecca **Ziegler** led Penn State at the plate with four hits on the day, recording back-to-back multi-hit games while driving in three runs for the Blue and White on a double against the Coyotes. Also recording a multi-hit game for the Nittany Lions was Toni Polk who tallied two base-knocks against South Dakota while Meghan Williams drove in two runs for the Blue and White. Senior Marlaina Laubach set a career-high in strikeouts in her 11th start of the season, fanning eight batters against South Dakota. The senior right-handed hurler tossed all seven innings, giving up just six hits and earning the 6-2 victory over the Coyotes.

PENN STATE NOTCHES SEASON-HIGH GAME AGAINST **BUFFALO**

The Nittany Lions tallied a season-best 14 hits and scored 14 runs against Buffalo on the final day of the Colorado State Classic. The Blue and White surpassed its previous season-best of 10 hits, which it had accomplished two time, while scoring nine runs in the second inning alone against the Bulls. Furthermore, four Nittany Lions notched multi-hit games and five brought in multiple RBIs.

ELLING FINDS THE LONG BALL

Freshman **Delaney Elling** found a groove at the plate as she drove in six RBIs over a four-game stretch at Colorado State. The freshman stepped up to the plate with Penn State trailing 5-1 and launched her first career grand slam over the center field wall to knot the score at 5-5 against Idaho State. Elling followed up the performance with her second career home run, this time over the left field wall, to bring in two runs for the Nittany Lions against Buffalo.

2017 PENN STATE SOFTBALL

CUMMINGS NOTCHES CAREER DAY AGAINST CLEVE-LAND STATE

Junior **Jessica Cummings** made her second start of the season and earned her first victory over the Cleveland State Vikings at the Chanticleer Showdown. The left-handed hurler posted a career day, striking out nine batters in only five innings of work, including two innings with two strikouts.

PITCHING DOMINANT AT BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

Senior **Marlaina Laubach** pitched 15-straight innings for Nittany Lions earning both wins on Saturday in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. Laubach picked up the 1-0 win after going eight innings against Virginia Tech and giving up just five hits and striking out four. In her second outing of the day, Laubach went seven innings against Georgia Tech, giving up up eight hits and three runs.

Sophomore **Madison Seifert** also had a good weekend in the circle for the Blue and White, earning two victories. The right-handed pitcher threw 14.0 innings, matching a career-high six strikeouts at Georgia Tech in her first appearance of the weekend. Seifert gave up just three runs on the weekend for the Nittany Lions and has struck out 16 batters in 2017.

ZIEGLER'S BAT LIGHTS UP AT BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

Redshirt-junior **Rebecca Ziegler** had a breakout week at the dish for Penn State, hitting at a .467 clip with seven hits in 15 at-bats. The Tucson, Ariz. native has a fourgame hitting streak and a three-game RBI streak, driving in one RBI in game one against Virginia Tech and game two against Georgia Tech. In her final game of the tournament, Ziegler went 3-for-4 at the dish with two doubles and her first career home run, while driving in five RBIs for the Blue and White in its 7-1 victory. Finally, Ziegler had seven putouts in center field, while robbing one homer.

PENN STATE BATS FIND A GROOVE IN ATLANTA

In its first appearance in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, Penn State outscored its opponents 19-6, giving up no more than three runs in any of its four games. The Nittany Lions posted back-to-back games with 10 hits while sweeping the weekend against Georgia Tech and Virginia Tech.

PENN STATE UPSETS NO. 4 LSU

After falling in its first game of the season, the Nittany Lions came back later that night to upset the No. 4 team in the nation with a 7-3 victory over LSU Friday, Feb. 10. The win over the top-ranked Tigers marked the first time that Penn State has defeated a top five team since it took a 1-0 victory over then-No. 1 Michigan, Feb. 18, 2006.

The Blue and White fell behind 1-0 in the bottom of the third back but answered with two straight multi-run innings, including a five-run third inning that chased freshman starter Maribeth Gorsuch out of the game. The Tigers brought in ace Carley Hoover to shut down the Penn State offense, however, **Shelby Miller** launched the first homer of the 2017 season for the Nittany Lions over the center field fence.

Sophomore **Madison Seifert** got the start in the circle, throwing all seven innings and keeping the powerful LSU offense to just six hits and three runs, while striking out three.

FRESHMAN MAKE IMPACT IN OPENING WEEKEND

Four freshman made appearances in the lineup during opening weekend for head coach **Amanda Lehotak**. **Delaney Elling** started all five games behind the plate and finished the weekend with a .308 batting average, tallying four hits, including one multihit game in her first weekend donning the Blue and White. **Destiny Weber** notched three starts as the designated players, while **Christa Wagner** started one game in the designated player slot and pinch hit twice for the Nittany Lions. Finally, **Amanda Ferlisi** came in twice as a pinch hitter for Penn State in opening weekend.

TRAVELING NITTANY LIONS

Penn State softball will hit the road for 39 of its 56 games, traveling a whopping 13,199 miles in the 2017 season. The Nittany Lions first travel to Baton Rouge, Louisiana. for the LSU Tournament before heading to Atlanta, Georgia for its first appearance in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. The Blue and White close out the month of February in Conway, South Carolina for the Chanticleer Showdown and open the month of March at the Colorado State Classic. Penn State continues its five weeks of travel in Washington with a doubleheader against Seattle and two games in the Husky Classic. Penn State returns from spring break and travels to Washington D.C. for four games at the GW Capital Classic, March 18-19. Following a mid-week home-opener, the Nittany Lions go back on the road to Michigan and Pittsburgh and also make trips out to Michigan State, Nebraska and Maryland in the 2017 campaign.

NITTANY LIONS COMING OFF HUGE 2016 SEASON

Lehotak led Penn State to its most successful season Penn State will see a slew of representatives from since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 ny Lions will take on teams from the Atlantic Coast Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached its 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding percentage.

HOME PSU TO PLAY 17 CONTESTS 2017 IN The Nittany Lions will play 17 of its 56 scheduled games in the friendly confines of the Nittany Lions Softball Park and Beard Field. Last season, Penn State played 20 regular season games at Beard Field, posting an 14-9 overall record. The Blue and White also hosted the Big Ten Softball Tournament for the first time in school history where it picked up a win over Nebraska and fell in the semifinals to Michigan. Penn State has posted a 54-51-1 overall record at Beard Field in its six year existence which is good for a .514 winning percentage.

ABRAMS JOINS COACHING STAFF IN 2017

Jennifer Abrams comes to Happy Valley after assisting the Seton Hall Pirates for three seasons and will serve as the Penn State's hitting coach as well as work with catchers, make travel arrangements and manage camps.

Serving as the Seton Hall hitting coach for three seasons, Abrams improved eight hitting categories for the Pirates including helping the 2015 Big East Rookie of the Year to finish 20th nationally with 20 home runs in 2015. Most notably, Abrams increased the team's home runs from 27 in 2014 to 60 in 2015, while increasing slugging percentage from .378 to .459 and RBIs from 140 to 231. Abrams coached four First Team All-Big East honorees, two Second Team All-Big East honorees and one Big East Rookie of the Year in her three seasons as the hitting coach at Seton Hall. Furthermore, Abrams helped with the outfielders, devising individualized skill workouts.

Furthermore, the Nittany Lions will be featured on the Big Ten Network twice in the 2017 season with their first game against the Michigan State Spartans set to air on Friday, April 7 at 4 p.m. The Blue and White will also take on the Terrapins of Maryland live on BTN Friday, April 28 at 6 p.m.
